- This marks the eighth meeting all-time between Chattanooga and Mississippi State. The Bulldogs currently lead the series 4-3 over the Mocs.
- These teams met last year on Dec. 3, 2023, in McKenzie Arena, where the Mocs upset the then-No. 21 ranked Bulldogs 59-53. The win marked UTC's sixth ranked win in program history and the first since 2014.
- It also marked UTC's first win over a Power 4 (then-Power 5) team since 2017.
- The Mocs have had a different scoring leader across each of the team's opening four games:

vs. Shorter: Karsen Murphy (16)

vs. Tennessee Tech: Brooke Anya (12)

at NC Central: Gianna Corbitt (12)

vs. Troy: Caia Elisaldez (15)

- UTC currently leads the Southern Conference in three-point defense (.220), turnovers forced/game (21.8) and three-point attempts/game (24.8).
- Each of Chattanooga's four true freshman are currently averaging 4.5 points/game or higher for the Mocs to open the year.

DEANDRA SCHIRMER

First Season • USC Aiken, 2011

Schirmer was named the eighth head coach of the Mocs, Vice Chancellor for Athletics Mark Wharton announced on April 4.

She comes to Chattanooga from Valdosta State University where she was head coach for five seasons. Schirmer amassed an impressive 114-31 record (.786) and 86-19 mark (.819) in the Gulf South Conference. She built a DII juggernaut going 78-16 (.830) overall, 60-7 (.896) in league play, over the last three years.

Her Lady Blazers earned NCAA Tournament berths the last four campaigns with a trip to the Elite Eight in 2022. They won the GSC in 2021 and 2024 and boasted three DII All-America selections in a record run.

The 2023-24 season was one for the record books with a 30-3 overall mark and 23-1 in GSC play. The Lady Blazers reeled off a school record 27-game win streak which earned league Coach of the Year honors to go with the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Wednesday release of Schirmer being the 2024 Whack Hyder Georgia Women's Coach of the Year. Her squad ranked as high as second and finished 11th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association Poll.

Her initial Lady Blazers squad lost 10 games in GSC play going 10-10 in 2019-20. They lost just nine in the next four years combined.

Schirmer was an all-conference and all-region performer at Cloud County (Kan.) Community College before finishing her playing career at USC-Aiken. She helped lead her squad to an eighth-place finish nationally as a senior earning CSC (former CoSIDA) Academic All-District first team honors.

A year as a graduate assistant in marketing and promotions at Georgia State led Schirmer back to the court. She completed her GA assignment on the Panthers bench in 2013-14 before her first full-time opportunity opened in St. Pete, Fla.

Schirmer completed five seasons as an assistant coach at Eckerd College. She helped lead the Tritons to 20-win ledgers every year as Paul Honsinger's ladies went 106-45 over that span. They went to the NCAA Tournament in four of those five seasons and

were the No. 1 seed in the South Region in 2017 earning the program's first postseason victory.

Originally from Holton, Kan., Schirmer was an all-state star in basketball and volleyball during her prep career at Holton High School. She captained both sports while also lettering in cross country and softball. Her efforts earned the coveted Naismith Award. She's a 2012 Business Marketing graduate of USCA and got her Master's in Sports Admin. from GSU in 2014.

"I am humbled and honored to be the head women's basketball coach at UTC," Schirmer said. "There is a tremendous tradition of success along with a fan base that is supportive of its women's basketball program. I'm grateful to Dr. (Steven) Angle, Mark Wharton and his staff for providing me this opportunity to not only be a part of that tradition, but to take it to new heights. I'm excited to get to Chattanooga and get to work!"

LAST TIME OUT - Chattanooga 66, Troy 76

WBB DROPS NON-CONFERENCE MATCHUP WITH TROY, 76-66

Chattanooga women's basketball dropped a 76-66 result to Troy on Thursday night in the Roundhouse. A slow start from the Mocs proved the difference as the Trojans were able to pull out to a 21-3 advantage on UTC over the opening seven minutes of action. While the Mocs hung with Troy for the remainder of the night, even cutting the lead down to as little as four at one point, it was too little too late as Troy emerged victorious in a physical battle with the Mocs. Following a Caia Elisaldez three-pointer saw the scoreboard reading 4-3 in favor of Troy at the 8:49 mark of the first quarter, it was all Trojans in the remainder of the frame as Troy would string together 17 unanswered points to help build a 21-3 lead on the Mocs. Despite the ugly start to the night, the Mocs remained steadfast and together with UTC using the remainder of the first half to regain their footing an inch back into the contest. Heading into the halftime locker room down 44-33, there was some work to be done in the second half for Chattanooga. It was Chattanooga's bench players that would help provide a much-needed spark to the offense, as the collective of Ava Card, Frode Flos van der Schans and Kailyn Farrell helped the Mocs cut Troy's lead down to 54-49 at the 1:09 mark of the third. While the Trojans finished the quarter on a nigh note, pumping their lead back up to 56-49 at the end of the frame, the Mocs could feel that they weren't out of the game yet. Leaving it all out on the floor, the starting duo of Sigrun Olafsdottir and Caia Elisaldez threw everything they had at the Trojan lineup. A three from Olafsdottir with 5:22 left in the game cut Troy's lead right back down to 58-54, but unfortunately for the Mocs, that would be the closest they would come to completing the comeback. Even with the late run by UTC, the Trojans were able to fend off the Mocs to secure a 76-66 win over Chattanooga on the night. Caia Elisaldez would finish with a career-high and teamhigh 15 points on the evening. She was followed closely by Olafsdottir's 13 points. The Iceland native added a team-best nine boards, yet another career-high for the Mocs in the game. She also wrapped up her night with a five-steal performance, a season-high for the reigning SoCon All-Defensive Team honoree.

FROM THE HEAD COACH

"I feel like we knew this was going to be a dogfight," head coach Deandra Schirmer said. "I have a lot of respect for Troy and the program that coach has built over there. They were ranked top 15 in the mid major poll at the beginning of the year for a reason. They're very physical. I feel like we did a lot of preparation going into this game, but you don't really know what it's like until you get into it, so it took us a little bit in the first quarter to kind of figure out what the physicality looked like, what that quickness looked like, and by the time we adjusted, it was too late."

TOP TAKEAWAYS

- Marked the seventh all-time meeting between Chattanooga and Troy.
- The series now stands at 4-3 in favor of the Trojans.

• MILESTONE NEWS AND NOTES

OLAFSDOTTIR CLOSES IN ON HISTORY

Over her five-year playing career, Olafsdottir has checked into a grand total of 124 games for the Mocs. This has the Iceland native closing in on Chattanooga women's basketball history, as she sits just 12 games shy of tying Abbey Cornelius (2018-23) for the most games played in over a career. Not only has Olafsdottir appeared in every single game for the team since arriving on campus in 2020, but Olafsdottir has started in all but three of those games for the Mocs, currently sitting at 121 career starts all-time. This already stands as the program record for most starts in a career in Chattanooga women's basketball history.

THE CHASE FOR 1K POINTS

Sigrun Olafsdottir also ranks as the closest Mocs player to reaching the 1,000 career points mark, with the Iceland native currently having 741 over her four-year UTC career. Kailyn Farrell (692), Jade Moore (602) and Brooke Anya (566) are all within striking distance themselves, sitting within 500 points of the mark. Kalifa Ford, who has scored 1,259 in her career, is the lone Moc that has already surpassed the 1K point mark.

• INDIVIDUAL NEWS AND NOTES

PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR THE MOCS

Both Sigrun Olafsdottir and Kalifa Ford were selected to the Preseason All-Conference Team, the SoCon announced in October. This now marks the second consecutive season that the Mocs will enter the year having had two players be recognized on the list prior to the season tipping off. Olafsdottir is coming off a 2023-24 season in which she finished second in the SoCon's Defensive Player of the Year voting, while Ford was named a WBCA Division II All-American last year at Valdosta State. Chattanooga was also projected to finish sixth in the SoCon's Preseason Coaches Poll.

CONSISTENT-SI

While Chattanooga women's basketball has experienced vast amounts of change over the past half decade, there has been one point of consistency for the Mocs: Sigrun Olafsdottir. A member of the 2020-21 UTC roster as a freshman, Olafsdottir is currently the longest tenured Moc for the men's AND women's basketball programs. This also means that Olafsdottir is entering a season with her third different head coach of the Mocs, having played under Katie Burrows (2020-22), Shawn Poppie (2022-24) and now Deandra Schirmer.

THE SWISS (OR ICELANDIC) ARMY WOMAN

Sigrun Olafsdottir has been a woman on a mission for the Mocs over the first four games of the 2024-25 season, with the veteran currently filling up stat sheet after stat sheet for the Mocs in nearly every way possible. So far this year, Olafsdottir has scored double-digit points in three of UTC's

four contests, averaging 9.3 points/game. She's also had 4+ rebounds and 3+ assists in every game this season, alongside recording multiple steals for the Mocs in three games this year. One of Olafsdottir's most impressive stat lines came in UTC's blowout win over NC Central, where she nearly recorded just the fourth triple-double in program history after wrapping up the night with 10 points, 8 rebounds, 8 assists and 3 steals. Her most recent game against Troy saw Olafsdottir finish witha season-high 13 points, 12 of which came from behind the three-point arc, as well as logging 9 rebounds, 5 steals and 3 assists.

CAN'T STOP CAIA

Sophomore Caia Elisaldez has already taken a major step up for the Mocs in her second year with the squad. As a freshman a year ago, Elisaldez averaged just 4.1 points/game having played in all 33 games on the year including making three starts. Now in 2024-25, Elisaldez has started for the Mocs in each of the first four games of the year, scoring 43 total points (10.8 points/game) on an impressive 19-for-36 (.528) clip. The Whittier, California, native has now had a total of seven career double-digit scoring efforts, three of which have come in the team's opening four games this season. Her most recent scoring outing saw her tie her career-high against Troy after leading the Mocs with 15 points.

• TEAM NEWS AND NOTES

EYEING THE THREE-PEAT

The Mocs head into the 2024-25 season with a target on their backs once again, as UTC is coming off a 2023-24 campaign in which Chattanooga captured both the SoCon regular season and tournament titles. The Mocs have now amassed a total of 23 regular season and 20 tournament titles as a member of the SoCon, which both mark conference-leading totals. Having won the 2023 SoCon Tournament as well, the Mocs enter the new season under Coach Schirmer with their sights set on going back-to-back as regular season champions as well as three-peating as SoCon Tournament champions. In program history, the Mocs have had a total of four instances in which the team has strung together 3+ SoCon Tournament titles. The most recent time came from 2013-17, when the Mocs were able to win the SoCon Tournament five straight times.

RECEIVING VOTES

In the most recent iteration of the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 Poll (released November 12), the Mocs were receiving a total of 14 votes, sitting just outside of the official Top 25. There are multiple UTC opponents on this year's 2024-25 slate that also appear in the poll, including FGCU (6th - 638 pts), Wofford (14th - 297 pts), Penn (RV - 22 pts) and Western Carolina (RV - 8 pts). The Mocs also have a pair of Power 4 foes on their schedule that are currently appearing in both the AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches polls. UTC's next opponent, Mississippi State, is currently

receiving votes in each, while Nebraska is actively ranked 21st and 20th in each, respectively.

IT'S (BEEN) RAINING THREES IN CHATTANOOGA

Chattanooga WBB finds itself near the top of the chart on a rather unusual streak in the NCAA, with UTC having made a three-pointer in each of their last 780 games dating back to December 1999. This stands as a nearly 25-year streak for the Mocs, and it unofficially ranks as the second-longest streak of having a three-pointer in the NCAA behind only lowa State. The Cyclones' streak currently dates back to Feb. 19, 1995.

HANGING OUR HAT ON DEFENSE

The Mocs currently rank as on the nation's top defensive teams, ranking in the NCAA's Top 100 in numerous defensive categories. Right now, UTC ranks 46th in the country in three-point defense (.220), pairing that with the 50th-best scoring defense (52.3) in the nation. The Mocs also rank 69th in field goal defense (.347) and 75th in turnovers forced/game on the year. UTC's three-point defense and turnovers forced numbers both actively lead the Southern Conference.

THE ROOKIES GOT GAME

Each member of UTC's freshmen class has had glimmers of promise over Chattanooga's opening four games of the year. Gianna Corbitt, Izzy McPherson, Ava Card and even Masa Buzic have each showcased special moments and stat lines for the Mocs to get excited about for the future. When looking at UTC's stat output this year, Chattanooga's freshmen have accounted for 81 of the team's points (32 percent), 37 of the team's rebounds (27 percent), 12 of the team's steals (29 percent), 11 of the team's assists (21 percent) and four of the team's blocks (31 percent) to open the season. Each freshman is also currently averaging 4.5 points/game or higher on the year: Corbitt (7.5), McPherson (7.0), Buzic (5.0) and Card (4.5).

• MOCS STAFF NEWS AND NOTES

THE DEANDRA SCHIRMER ERA

On April 4, Vice Chancellor for Athletics Mark Wharton announced that Deandra Schirmer would be named the eighth head coach of the Chattanooga women's basketball team. Schirmer comes to UTC from Valdosta State, where she had spent the previous five seasons helping to build the Lady Blazers into a perennial powerhouse at the Division II level. She capped off her time at VSU with a record of 114-31, having won two Gulf South Conference regular season title and one GSC Tournament championship, while also leading the Lady Blazers to four consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

AN ALL-FEMALE STAFF IN THE SCENIC CITY

With the addition of Coach Schirmer, Chattanooga women's basketball also was able to bring in four new assistant coaches to round out UTC's coaching staff ahead of the 2024-25

season. Accompanying Schirmer on the bench for the Mocs will be Associate Head Coach Tianni Kelly, who joins the Mocs after most recently serving as the head coach for the University of Charleston. Nicole Heyn, Mallory Odell and Alexis Uffmann round out Coach Schirmer's staff, with each of those three holding Assistant Coach titles. Entering the program's 51st season of existence datng back to the 1974-75 season, this marks the first time in the history of Chattanooga women's basketball that the program will have an all-female coaching staff.

TEAMMATES TURNED COACHES

An interesting tidbit regarding UTC's staff this season is that multiple members of Chattanooga's 2024-25 roster have actually played alongside members of the Mocs coaching staff. Taylor Searcey, who transferred to the Mocs this summer following a multi-year stint playing under Coach Schirmer at Valdosta State, actally played with two of her current assistant coaches during the 2021-22 season: Nicole Heyn and Mallory Odell. The connections don't stop there for Coach Odell, as prior to her time playing at Valdosta State she attended Longwood University, where she spent a season as a teammate to current Chattanooga grad transfer Brooke Anya during the 2020-21 campaign.

THE COACH SCHIRMER COACHING TREE

For head coach Deandra Schirmer, all of the faces joining her 2024-25 coaching staff this year have had some past tie with her during her five-year tenure at Valdosta State. Associate HC Tianni Kelly served as Schirmer's assistant coach at VSU over the course of the 2019-20 season. Nicole Heyn and Mallory Odell not only played under Coach Schirmer during the 2021-22 season, but both ended up becoming graduate assistants for the Lady Blazers immediately after. Odell worked with Schirmer from 2021-23 while Heyn spent the 2022-23 season alongside her. Finally, Alexis Uffmann has served as Coach Schirmer's primary assistant coach for each of the past three seasons at VSU dating back to the 2021-22 campaign.

• ROSTER NEWS AND NOTES

NEW LOOK MOCS

Outside of the team's new coaching staff, the 2024-25 Mocs have plenty of new faces to learn up on ahead of the new season. Eight of Chattanooga's 14-woman roster are newcomers to the program, with four having come from the transfer portal and the other four signing with the Mocs out of high school. Sigrun Olafsdottir and Karsen Murphy mark the only two starters returning from last year's roster. Also returning are Takia Davis (Sr.), Caia Elisaldez (So.), Frode Flos van der Schans (R-So.) and Kailyn Farrell (Sr.).

MEET THE YOUNGSTERS

A total of four true freshmen have joined the UTC squad ahead of the 2024-25 season, as the Mocs have welcomed Gianna Corbitt, Ava Card, Izzy McPherson and Masa Buzic to the team. The trio of Corbitt, Card and McPherson each finished their high school careers as 1,000-point scorers for their respective schools, raking in numerous honors and accolades in the process. Buzic, a native of Belgrade, Serbia, adds international playing experience to the Mocs roster with Buzic having been a member of Serbia's U18 National Team during the 2023 FIBA Women's European Championship in Turkey.

INTERNATIONAL MOCS

A total of three Chattanooga women's basketball players hail from countries outisde of the umbrella of the United States: Sigrun Olafsdottir (Iceland), Frode Flos van der Schans (the Netherlands) and Masa Buzic (Serbia). The last time UTC had 3+international students on its roster came during the 2021-22 season, when the Mocs had four players from outisde of the US: Sigrun Olafsdottir (Iceland), Pare Pene (New Zealand), Lara Habling (Hungary) and Ruona Uwusiaba (Nigeria).

• SCHEDULE NEWS AND NOTES

HOME GAMES

A total of 14 home games await the Mocs in 2024-25, starting with the team's home and season-opener on Monday, Nov. 4 against Shorter. The Roundhouse will then welcome the likes of Tennessee Tech, Troy, King, Lipscomb, Kennesaw State and Salem to its wings over the course of non-conference play before the team transitions to Southern Conference action. The Mocs' final home game, Senior Day, is set to take place on Saturday, March 1 with Wofford coming to town.

ROAD GAMES

The Mocs will also have a total of 12 "official" road matchups, along with one additional neutral site game hosted by FGCU, on the season. UTC's first road clash of the year will take place on Monday, Nov. 11 with the Mocs traveling to Durham, North Carolina, to take on NC Central. Other road games for the Mocs include heading to Mississippi State, FGCU, Bellarmine and Nebraska during non-con play. The Mocs' SoCon season will also start with a roadtrip, as Chattanooga will open the New Year with road games at Western Carolina and UNCG.

HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT ACTION

Chattanooga is set to take part in one holiday tournament this year, with the Mocs taking part in the annual FGCU Homewood Suites Tournament hosted over Thanksgiving/Black Friday Weekend. UTC's time in Fort Myers, Florida, will open with a neutral site matchup against Penn, which is set to take place on Friday, Nov. 29. The Mocs will then have to wrap up their tournament with a difficult test as tournament host and perennial mid-major powerhouse FGCU hosts UTC on Saturday, Nov. 30 in the tournament finale.

POWER FOUR FOES

UTC will have two road games this season that will likely be highlighted for the Mocs, as it will serve as two opportunities for Chattanooga to play spoiler to Power Four opposition during non-conference play. On Nov. 17, the Mocs head to Starkville, Mississippi, to take on SEC foe Mississippi State. Nearly a month later, the Mocs will then fly up to Lincoln, Nebraska, where the currently Top 25-ranked Cornhuskers will be waiting for a Dec. 15 matchup with the Mocs. UTC will be aiming for a result similar to last year's game against Mississippi State in the Roundhouse, in which the Mocs toppled the then-Top 25 ranked Bulldogs in dramatic fashion.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE PLAY

The Mocs' 14-game Southern Conference slate kicks of Jan. 9 with UTC heading to Cullowhee, North Carolina, to take on Western Carolina. UTC's first home SoCon game of the year is set for Thursday, Jan. 16 with Samford coming to town. To put a bow on the 2024-25 season, the Southern Conference will then host its annual conference tournament in Asheville, North Carolina, beginning March 6 and running until Championship Sunday on March 9.

• ALUMNI NEWS AND NOTES

PRO DEAL FOR JADA GUINN

Recent UTC grad and SoCon Tournament MVP Jada Guinn became the latest Chattanooga alum to ink a professional deal playing overseas, as Guinn signed a contract with the Newcastle Eagles of the Women's British Basketball League back on August 18. Guinn is one of four former UTC players currently playing professionally internationally. In her debut game for the Eagles, Guinn would finish with 12 points, four rebounds, an assist and a steal.

OTHER PRO MOCS TO FOLLOW

As was mentioned before, Guinn is just one of the four UTC women's basketball alumni currently playing professionally on international soil. Another notable alum, Yazz Wazeerud-Din (2022-23), currently plays for HGB Horbisa GreenKW Barakaldo in the Spanish LF Challenge League. Lara Habling (2021-22), plays in the same league as Jada Guinn as Habling currently serves a a forward on the Cardiff Met Archers. Last but not least, Chelsey Shumpert (2013-17) is currently playing in the Iraqi 1 League for Ghaz Al-Shamal.

Chattanooga vs. Mississippi State

Sunday's game will be the eighth meeting alltime between Chattanooga and Mississippi State. Right now, the Bulldogs lead the series 4-3 with UTC having won the most recent meeting between the teams last season. The Mocs are 1-3 on the road against MSU, with Chattanooga's lone road win coming in 1985.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

The Chattanooga women's basketball team did its best David v. Goliath impression at the Roundhouse, as the Mocs pulled off the Power 5 upset over No. 21 Mississippi State by a score of 59-53 to extend the team's winning streak to six straight as non-conference action wages on. It was all hands on deck for the Mocs as the team powered back from an 11-point deficit to the mighty Bulldogs to earn the team's sixth-ever victory over a ranked opponent and first since 2014 in front of an enthused home crowd in McKenzie Arena. In the second half, Mississippi State looked to put the Mocs away right from the jump as the Bulldogs would build up their largest lead of the day with 6:50 remaining in the third, leading the Mocs 41-30. From here, though, UTC's core of Jada Guinn, Raven Thompson and Addie Grace Porter turned up the heat on the 21st-best team in the nation. It wouldn't be long into the fourth quarter that Chattanooga would take its first lead since the 7:52 mark of the first quarter, as Guinn connected on the go-ahead bucket for the Mocs with 8:34 left to play. In the biggest moment of her young career, freshman Hannah Kohn delivered for the Mocs when they needed her most as the sharpshooter connected a three-pointer from way beyond the line to give UTC the lead, 51-48. The Mocs would not lose the lead for the remainder of the game.
