- ▶ Alabama closes out its three-game homestand on Thursday when it welcomes the fourth-ranked Mississippi State Bulldogs to town. The game will be part of the SEC's annual We Back Pat week, which is focused on bringing awareness and recognition to The Pat Summitt Foundation, a fund of East Tennessee Foundation, and its fight against Alzheimer's disease.
- ▶ Junior Meoshonti Knight leads three in double figures with 13.1 points per game. She is followed by sophomore Shaquera Wade (12.0 ppg) and junior Hannah Cook (11.2 ppg). Wade averages a team-best 6.6 boards per game, while freshman Jordan Lewis has dished out a team-high 4.3 assists per contest.
- ▶ Freshman Ashley Knight has 46 blocks on the year, which ranks No. 1 in the Southeastern Conference and 13th in the nation. She currently stands at No. 7 on Alabama's single-season top 10 list and is two blocks away from tying Leslie Payne at No. 6. Yolanda Watkins holds the Crimson Tide record at 68 blocks, which she achieved during the 1993-94 season.
- ▶ Junior Ashley Williams is 73 points away from reaching 1,000 for her career.

- Mississippi State is off to its best start in program history at 19-0. The Bulldogs are also 5-0 in Southeastern Conference play heading into Thursday's contest.
- Mississippi State is led by junior Victoria Vivians, who averages a team-high 17.3 points per game. She is joined in double figured by fellow junior Morgan William at 11.1 points per contest. William is the team's leader in assists at 4.1 per game, while senior Chinwe Okorie is responsible for a team-best 6.4 rebounds per outing.
- ▶ Last time out, the Bulldogs topped Ole Miss, 73-62. Mississippi State allowed only eight Rebel points in the first quarter while scoring 22. Vivians finished with a game-high 23 points, while senior Dominique Dillingham added 16.
- Mississippi State is led by fifth-year head coach Vic Schaefer. He led the Bulldogs to the 2016 NCAA Sweet 16 after reaching the second round of the tournament in 2015. Schaefer was voted SEC Coach of the Year in 2015 and was a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year that season. He is currently 109-46 in Starkville and 189-156 overall as a head coach.

With the loss, the Crimson Tide moves to 14-4 on the season and 2-3 in Southeastern Conference play, while the win brings the Razorbacks to 12-6 overall and 1-4 against league opponents.

Alabama had three finished in double figures, led by junior Ashley Williams, who had 13 points to go along with six rebounds. She was followed by sophomore Shaquera Wade with 11 points and junior Meoshonti Knight with 10 points. Junior Hannah Cook pulled down a team-high eight rebounds, while freshman Ashley Knight tallied four blocks. Five of the eight that played for Arkansas finished in double figures, including freshman Jailyn Mason, who had a game-high 15 points.

After a back-and-forth start, Arkansas went on a 6-0 run to lead 12-7 at the 5:59 mark. The Razorbacks went ahead by eight minutes later, but consecutive baskets for Alabama made it a four-point game with 2:48 to go. Arkansas would close out the period with 10 unanswered points to lead 29-15.

Both teams were quiet offensively to start the second with only three points scored in nearly five minutes. From there, the Razorbacks outscored the Tide 9-2 down the stretch to lead by 22, 40-18, at the half

Arkansas put up six of the first eight points of the third quarter to pull in front by 26, its largest lead of the game, but Alabama responded with a 14-4 run to cut its deficit to 16 with 34 seconds remaining in the frame. The Razorbacks chipped in the final three points to lead 53-34 heading into the fourth.

The Tide pulled within 17 over the final 10:00 but was unable to get any closer.

For the game, Alabama made 30.9 percent (17-55) of its attempts, while Arkansas was 45.0 percent (27-60) from the floor, including 75 percent (12-16) in the first quarter. The Razorbacks outrebounded the Tide, 47-31, and had 22 bench points compared to Alabama's 10.

ALABAMA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

2016 ALABAMA MISS BASKETBALL JASMINE WALKER SIGNS WITH THE TIDE

Jasmine Walker, the former Jefferson Davis High School standout and one of the nation's top recruits in the 2016 class, signed with Alabama on Tuesday, Jan. 17. Walker, who began her collegiate career at Florida State, is enrolled in classes this semester but will sit out from competition for one calendar year due to NCAA transfer rules.

Walker, a 6-3 forward from Montgomery, Ala., was rated the No. 23 overall prospect and No. 5 post by ESPNW in the 2016 signing class. She earned every state player of the year award including 2016 Alabama Miss Basketball, Gatorade Player of the Year and Class 7A Player of the Year. Walker made history by becoming the first student from a Montgomery public school to be named Alabama Miss Basketball, and was only the second selection ever from Montgomery, joining former Crimson Tide forward Leslie Claybrook. Walker was also a two-time state tournament MVP, three-time all-state selection, a two-time Advertiser All-Metro Player of the Year and was named to the Naismith High School All-America Watch List and a McDonald's All American Game nominee.

Walker finished high school with 1900 points and 908 rebounds and guided Jeff Davis to a 102-26 record throughout her career, where she was a four-year starter for coach LaKenya Knight. Walker led the Lady Vols to back-to-back Class 7A titles in 2015 and 2016. During her senior season, she averaged 19.6 points, 7.9 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game while collecting 13 double-doubles. In the 2016's title game against McGill-Toolen, Walker recorded 18 points and six rebounds. During the 2015 matchup between the two teams in the state championship, she poured in 23 points, setting her season average at 15.9 points to go along with 8.1 rebounds.

BOLTON AMONG ALABAMA'S TOP 10 IN CAREER BLOCKS

With her 15 blocks thus far this season, junior NeNe Bolton moved into Alabama's top 10 in career blocks. Heading into Thursday's game she has 81 total, which is tied for eighth with DeeDee Davis (1983-87). Bolton is one block away from tying Tausha Mills (1996-99) for seventh place and 10 blocks away from the No. 6 spot currently held by Nikki Hegstetter (2012-16).

ALABAMA FRESHMEN TAKE HOME FOUR SEC FoW HONORS

Alabama has won four Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week honors already this season, which is just two shy than it has won in its program history overall heading into the year. Point guard Jordan Lewis picked up the league honors on Nov. 15, Dec. 27, and most recently on Jan. 10, making her the only freshman in program history to earn weekly honors three times. Ashley Knight has also been recognized, earning her award on Dec. 20.

WIN AT MIZZOU MARKS FIRST SEC ROAD VICTORY SINCE 2014

Alabama's 59-58 victory at Missouri on Sunday, Jan. 8, marked the Crimson Tide's first win in a Southeastern Conference road game since it defeated Vanderbilt, 66-62, on Feb. 23, 2014.

MEO KNIGHT POURS IN 29 TO LEAD ALABAMA OVER OLE MISS

Junior Meoshonti Knight scored a career-high 29 points in the win over Ole Miss on Thursday, Jan. 5. Her 29 points were the most scored by an Alabama player since Ashley Williams scored the same amount against Alabama A&M on Nov. 26, 2014.

SHOT-BLOCKING SENSATION

Freshman Ashley Knight has been stellar thus far defensively in the paint. She already has 46 blocks on the season, for an average of 2.6 rejections per game. Her 2.6 block average ranks the Austin, Texas native first in the Southeastern Conference and 19th nationally, while her 46 overall blocks is 13th in the country. Knight is also seventh on the Alabama single season top 10 list and is 32 away from the Tide's career top 10 list.

WATCHING WADE

Shaquera Wade's production all over the court has nearly doubled in every category from a season ago. The sophomore is averaging 12.0 points, a team-high 6.6 rebounds, 1.9 steals and 1.6 assists. As a freshman, she finished with averages of 6.0 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 1.0 assists. Wade also has three double-doubles this season, the most of anyone on the team.

LEADING LEWIS

Freshman Jordan Lewis has started every game at the point guard position for Alabama and has shown poise and confidence running the offense beyond her years. She is currently averaging a team-best 4.3 assists per game, ranking her fifth in the Southeastern Conference behind three seniors and a junior. Lewis has also scored double-digit points nine times, led the team in steals five times and rebounding three times.

WILLIAMS CLOSING IN ON 1,000 POINTS AND 500 REBOUNDS

Junior Ashley Williams is 73 points away from becoming Alabama's 25th 1,000 point scorer in program history. Should she reach that number this season, she would be only the 13th Crimson Tide student-athlete to reach the milestone in three years or less. She is also 16 rebounds away from 500 boards for her career.

WILLIAMS EARNS UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

Junior Ashley Williams completed her undergraduate degree in criminal justice in December and will begin work on her master's degree in January. Her jersey now has an SEC Graduate patch to signify her accomplishment.

CURRY COACHES IN GAME No. 100 AT ALABAMA

Alabama's game against Kansas was head coach Kristy Curry's 100th game on the sidelines at Alabama. She enters today's contest with a 56-55 (.505) overall mark in her four seasons with the Tide, which includes a 41-14 (.745) record against non-conference opponents.

LIMITING POINTS

Alabama has held its opponents to 15 points or fewer in 44 of 73 periods played this season. Even more impressive is that in 16 of those 73 quarters, the Tide opposition has put up 10 points or fewer and in four quarters five points or fewer.

TIDE GETS BOOST FROM BENCH

Alabama has one of the most productive benches its had in the last several years, and that has been evident in both minutes and production on the stat sheet. Through 18 games, the Tide's reserves have accounted for 380 points (21.1 ppg), 230 rebounds (12.8 rpg), 59 assists (3.3 apg), 61 blocks (3.4 bpg) and 35 steals (1.9 spg).

ALABAMA LEADS IN POINTS IN THE PAINT

Through 18 games, Alabama has outscored its opponents 634-430 in points in the paint. That averages out to 11.3 more points in the paint (35.2-23.9) for the Crimson Tide per game than the opposition.

GETTING TO THE LINE

Alabama finished the 2015-16 season ranked 73rd in the nation in free throw attempts (615) and 77th in free throws made (430) while averaging 69.9 percent made per game. The Crimson Tide is making another strong showing this season getting to the line a total of 448 times, 194 more times than its opponents (254). Alabama ranks first in the SEC and second nationally in free throw attempts.

FIRST HALF POINTS

Alabama has scored 610 points in the first half of games this season, while its opponents have put up 465. That averages out to 33.9 points at the half for the Tide compared to 25.8 for the opposition, a difference of 8.1 points.

FAB FROSH

Alabama's freshmen, Ashley Knight and Jordan Lewis, have made an immediate impact in the Tide's lineup. Lewis, who has started at point guard, leads the team, and ranks fifth in the Southeastern Conference, in assists (4.3 apg) and is fourth on the team in scoring (9.2 ppg). Knight, the 6-5 post, averages a team and league-best 2.6 blocks per game while adding 7.5 points and 5.8 rebounds per contest.

BALANCED OFFENSE

One of Coach Curry's team goals for the season is to have at least four in double-figure points each outing. The Crimson Tide reached that goal in 10 of its 18 games this season as five recorded 10 or more points four times and four did so on six occasions. Alabama was just shy in its games against Georgia Southern, as three finished in double figures and one had eight, and Alcorn State, where three had double figures and two had nine points.

SIX GAMES ... SIX DIFFERENT LEADING SCORERS

Head Coach Kristy Curry has multiple options when it comes to scoring this season. In its first six games, Alabama has had six different leading scorers. In the opener, junior Meo Knight led the way with 18 points. Freshman Jordan Lewis put up 21 in the Tide's second game, while junior Hannah Cook posted 13 to pace Alabama offensively in game No. 3. Junior Ashley Williams scored 19 in the win over Georgia Southern and sophomore Shaquera Wade chipped in a career-best 22 to lead the Tide over Alabama A&M. Against Alcorn State, junior NeNe Bolton and Knight each added 18 points.

UA GOES UNDEFEATED IN NOVEMBER FOR SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON

Alabama closed out its first month of the 2016-17 with a perfect 5-0 record, marking the second straight season the Crimson Tide has gone undefeated in November. In 2015, Alabama posted a 6-0 mark, which was the best start since the 2002 season.

VETERAN LEADERS PROPEL TIDE TO WIN OVER GEORGIA SOUTHERN

Alabama trailed for the first time at the half this season in its game against Georgia Southern on Nov. 22. The Crimson Tide's veteran leaders made a statement coming out of the locker room and scored all 21 of Alabama's third quarter points, led by junior Meoshonti Knight, who finished the frame with eight points, hitting all of her attempts. For the game, UA's juniors scored 53 of its 66 points.

ALABAMA ADDS AMBER RICHARDSON TO ROSTER

Amber Richardson, a 6-0 guard out of Garner, N.C., has signed with Alabama and will begin classes and practicing with the team this semester. The NC State transfer must sit for one calendar year due to NCAA transfer rules, making her eligible in December.

"We are excited to welcome Amber to our family," said Curry. "She gives us size and the ability score on the perimeter. Having her join the program now will give her the chance to learn our system, develop her game and be ready to play for us next December."

Richardson played in 33 games over the past two seasons for the Wolfpack, finishing with 80 points, 49 rebounds, 12 assists, nine steals and four blocks. As a freshman, she scored a career-high 11 points against Davidson, paced by a 3-for-5 performance from beyond the arc.

Richardson played for Southeast Raleigh High School, helping her team to a 26-4 overall record as a senior and a state runner-up finish. She was a 2015 McDonald's High School All-America nominee and earned first team honors from the All-Greater Neuse River Conference. As a junior, Richardson was named to the News & Observer's All-Metro Team and the Greater Neuse River Player of the Year after leading Southeast Raleigh to a conference championship.

Richardson earned a scout grade of 95 from ESPNW, ranking as the No. 9 wing and No. 72 overall recruit in the class.

TIDE SIGNS ARIYAH COPELAND TO 2017 CLASS

Ariyah Copeland, one of the top-rated post prospects of the 2017 class, has signed with Coach Kristy Curry and the Alabama women's basketball program.

"Ariyah is one of the top 2017 post players in the country and will be a great addition to our front court," said Curry. "She is a legitimate interior scoring threat that can face up and hit the mid-range jumper or score with her back to the basket. Ariyah will bring a physical presence on both ends of the floor."

Copeland, the 6-3 4/5 post from Columbus, Ga., is rated No. 50 overall by Prospects Nation and No. 72 overall by All Star Girls Report. Prospects Nation also has her as the No. 7 post, while HoopGurlz espnW ranks Copeland No. 14 at her position.

As a junior, Copeland averaged 15.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.7 assists per game for Columbus High School. She helped lead the Blue Devils to the 2016 AAAAA quarterfinals after winning the region 1-5A championship, where she had 17 points.

Copeland was named honorable mention all-state by the Atlanta Journal Constitution at the conclusion of last season and was also named to the Ledger-Enquirer All-Bi-City Team. She was awarded MVP honors at the 2016 All-Star Game, featuring players from Harris and Muscogee counties, and was selected to participate in the 2016 Valley All-Star Underclassmen Game.

On May 31, Alabama women's basketball announced it would be returning to Coleman Coliseum starting with the 2016-17 season. The Crimson Tide has played primarily at Foster Auditorium following the building's renovation in 2011.




