MCDONALD POSTS TOP 25 PERFORMANCE IN FIRST CAREER EVENT

LEXINGTON, Ky. – After three days of battling frigid temperatures, Mississippi State women's golf freshman Ally McDonald carded a Top 25 performance in her first collegiate event.

McDonald shined early and maintained her composure to secure her spot on the leaderboard. Her three-round 20-over-par 236 earned her a share of 17th-place, just three strokes out of the Top 10 and six strokes out of the Top 5. She fired a team-best back-to-back 77's in the first two rounds.

The Lady Bulldogs narrowly missed turning in a Top 10 team card after a 973, 12th-place finish. MSU fought through the rough conditions for two days but struggled on day three, posting a 335.

Kentucky won it's own event posting a tournament-best 303 during the final round to secure the title at 924. Wildcat junior Ashleigh Albrecht was tops individually with a 9-over-par 225.

Freshmen Rica Tse and Elena Warren also gained invaluable experience in the event. The duo posted the second- (78, Warren) and third-best (79, Tse) rounds for the Maroon and White in Lexington.

Sophomore Mary Langdon Gallagher, MSU's most experienced player, carded the second lowest tournament score with a 244, while senior Perry Katherine Furr rounded out the MState leaderboard with a 258.

The Lady Bulldogs return to action on Oct. 10 at the Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational in Las Cruces, N.M. In last year's edition of the event, MSU posted the program's second-lowest 52-hole score (883), third-lowest 36-hole score (588), and fourth-lowest round (297).

LADY BULLDOGS CARD 10TH-BEST TOURNAMENT IN PROGRAM HISTORY

LAS CRUCES, N.M. – After a final-round 298, the Mississippi State women's golf team posted the 10th-best 52-hole score in the program's history with a 901 in the Price's "Give 'Em Five" Invitational.

Tournament-host New Mexico State's 900 won the battle for eighth-place over the Lady Bulldogs. 24th-ranked Baylor won the event with a 4-under-par 280, edging out Idaho with an 861.

For MSU individually, freshman Ally McDonald once again shined by sandwiching a 74 between an opening round, 2-under-par 70 and a final-round 72. She tied for the best par-5 scoring in the field with a 6-under, while her eighth-place finish is the first Top 10 card in her young career.

Just behind McDonald was Mary Langdon Gallagher with a 6-over-par 222. After stumbling out the gates with a 78, the experienced sophomore rebounded with a 71 and 73 to close out the event. Finishing tied for 17th earned Gallagher her third Top 25 card.

Newcomer Elena Warren posted a 229, bettering her previous tournament's score by 18 strokes. Her 10 birdies in Las Cruces was the second-most by any individual in the tournament.

Perry Katherine Furr and Elena Warren rounded out the field for the Lady Bulldogs with a 234 and 239, respectively. Furr knocked in one of only seven eagles at the event.

MSU returns to action at the talent-packed Pac 12/SEC Challenge hosted by Tennessee at the Holston Hills Country Club.

LADY BULLDOGS POST BEST ROUND OF TOURNEY, HELP SEC CLINCH WIN OVER PAC-12

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. – By chiseling 12 strokes off the team's opening-round total, the Mississippi State women's golf team help propel the SEC to a 896.08 to 898.82 victory in the second-annual SEC/PAC-12 Challenge at Holston Hills Country Club in Knoxville.

The conference competition featured 15 of Golf Stat's Top 25 teams in the nation, as well as seven of the Top 10 players. The Lady Bulldogs' 305 card in the final round was only eight shots more than second-ranked Auburn. No. 6 Alabama used a 1-over-par 292 to clinch the team title after finishing second a year ago.

Stephanie Meadow of Alabama jumped to the top of the leaderboard individually on day one with a 4-under-par 68 and never relinquished her spot. She finished with a 5-under-par 211 clip.

For MSU, freshman Ally McDonald's final-round 73 left her two strokes shy of a Top 25 finish. Her 4.50 scoring on par fives tied her for second overall in the tournament with Meadow.

Demonstrating the strength of this year's field, McDonald's 34th-place card tied her with Brooke Pancake of Alabama. Pancake is the fourth-ranked individual nationally.

Rica Tse chased McDonald with a 229, tying her best tourney score in the freshman's young career. Her five pars were only second to McDonald's nine.

Mary Langdon Gallagher and Perry Katherine Furr improved their cards each round and both turned in a 77 on Sunday, while Elena Warren rounded out MSU's board with a 247.

Mississippi State returns to action Oct. 31 in Austin, Texas, at the Texas-hosted Betsy Rawls Invitational. This will be MSU's first appearance in the event.

LADY BULLDOGS WRAP UP FALL, MCDONALD POSTS FOURTH- PLACE FINISH

AUSTIN, Texas – With a final-round 307, the Mississippi State women's golf team concluded the fall season in the Betsy Rawls Longhorn Invitational at the University of Texas Golf Club.

After a 914 for the tournament, the team bettered its round average to 310, a full three strokes better than the 2011 Spring average.

Standout freshman Ally McDonald carded a 1-over-par 73 to finish at 217 for the event and finished tied with 42nd-ranked Grace Na of Pepperdine for fourth. She finished only three strokes back of tournament-winner Nicole Vandermade of Texas.

Her 217 tied the 11th-lowest tournament-score in program history, and with her season stroke average lowered to 74.33, McDonald is also on pace to finish second all-time in lowest season stroke average.

Perry Katherine Furr turned in her best tournament of her career with a 231. The senior is the most-experienced player and only upperclassman on the MSU roster. Her current stroke average (80.67) is also the second lowest of her career.

Newcomer Rica Tse trailed Furr after firing a 79 in the final round to end with a 233. Her 78.17 scoring clip ranks her second on the team behind McDonald.

Matching Tse's clip, Mary Langdon Gallagher rounded out the MSU leaderboard with a final-round 79.

Sophomore Esther Huffman notched 238 in her first event of the season after undergoing shoulder surgery during the summer.

No. 20 Texas claimed the event title with an 16-over-par 880.

The Lady Bulldogs return to action on Feb. 12 in the UCF Challenge at the Red Tail Golf Club in Orlando, Fla.

LADY BULLDOGS COMPLETE PLAY AT UCF CHALLENGE, MC- DONALD POSTS TOP 25 FINISH

ORLANDO, Fla. – During the highest scoring round of the tournament, the Mississippi State women's golf team managed to do what only three of the other 18 teams could, not post their highest round of the UCF Challenge.

Out of the 18-team field, 14 teams posted their highest rounds of the event during Tuesday's final round. The Lady Bulldogs turned in a 308, matching Sunday's opening round tally.

Freshman Ally McDonald used the Maroon and White's best round of the tournament to climb her way to her third Top 25 finish this season. McDonald's 6-over-par 222 ties her third-best event of her young career.

Just behind McDonald, sophomore Mary Langdon Gallagher turned in her second-best tourney score of the season with a 228. Her second round 74 is her best round since she carded a 73 in the final round of the Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational on Oct. 13.

Rica Tse finished just three strokes behind Gallagher with a 231, while Perry Katherine Furr and Elena Warren followed her with 235's. The 19-over card is Warren's best event of her career.

The Lady Bulldogs return to the Sunshine State on March 16 for their next action in the SunTrust Gator Women's Invitational.

MSU POSTS PROGRAM'S BEST GATOR WOMEN'S INVITATIONAL SCORE

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – In its 10th appearance in the SunTrust Gator Women's Invitational, the Mississippi State women's golf team posted the program's lowest score ever in the event with a 926.

The Lady Bulldogs' final-round 307 is the third-best round of the spring slate, while Friday's first-round 304 is the second-best.

Host-Florida edged No. 2 Alabama by one stroke to claim the team title while Florida State Seminole Maria Salinas carded a 4-under-par 66 on Sunday to claim the individual title.

After getting off to a shaky start, freshman Ally McDonald recaptured her focus and turned in a team-best 1-over-par 71 in the final round. She missed the Top 25 for only the second time in her young career.

Fellow freshmen Rica Tse and Elena Warren each turned in 232's in the event. The trio of freshmen is currently ranked ninth-best in the nation in GolfStat.com's Freshman Impact Rankings. This marks the first event the three freshmen have place first, second and third on the Maroon and White leaderboard.

Sophomore Mary Langdon Gallagher and senior Perry Katherine Furr turned in a 238 and 245, respectively, to complete the Lady Bulldogs' card.

Mississippi State returns to action March 26 in the John Kirk/Panther Intercollegiate at Eagles Landing Country Club in Stockbridge, Ga. In last year's event, Gallagher posted a 3-over-par, fifth-place finish, while the team notched a Top 10 card.

BULLDOGS FINISH SECOND, MCDONALD AND TSE POST TOP 5 CARDS

STOCKBRIDGE, Ga. – With the program's best finish since 2006, the Mississippi State women's golf team turned in a second-place 891 card in the John Kirk/Panther Intercollegiate, while freshmen Ally McDonald and Rica Tse turned in a pair of Top 5 finishes individually.

The 27-over 891 clip ties for the fifth-best tournament score turned in by a Lady Bulldog squad and the second-place finish is the best since the 2006 Maroon and White group's second-place card in the Pinehurst Challenge.

For the first time since the 2004-05 and 2005-06 seasons, the Lady Bulldogs have posted Top 3 finishes in back-to-back years. Ginger Brown-Lemm's team shared a third-place finish at the 2010 Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational.

"It is very exciting to see us mature out there," Brown-Lemm said. "Ally and Rica played exceptionally well. They never gave up and played their last four holes today 3-under. Finishing and fighting until the end is how you beat teams ranked 35 spots better than you nationally. I hope it is a glimpse of things to come."

The second- and fourth-place finishes notched by McDonald and Tse marks the first time two Lady Bulldog freshmen have turned in Top 5 finishes in the same event.

McDonald's 4-under-par is the second-best 54-hole score in State's history and becomes the first freshman to issue back-to-back-to-back under-par rounds for the Lady Bulldogs.

Tse turned in the best event of her young career with a final-round 70 to pull even for the event at 216. With her first-round 69, she becomes the second player in the Brown-Lemm era to finish 18 holes in under 70 strokes. Erika Thornton turned a 69 in the 2010 Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational.

"We will start a 'Dawgs in the 60's Club' for individuals that shoot in the 60's, and Rica Tse will be our inaugural member!"

MSU's third freshman Elena Warren narrowly missed handing in her best tournament. Her first round 72 highlighted the Austin, Texas, native's 236.

Entering the week, the freshman trio was ranked as the ninth-best freshman class in the nation according to Golfstat.com's Freshman Impact Rankings.

Battling an injured should, Mary Langdon Gallagher persevered to post a 4-over-par 76 during Tuesday's final round. The sophomore, who finished fifth in this event a year ago, carded a 234.

Senior Perry Katherine Furr finished a 76-81 in the final two rounds after having her first-round card disqualified because it was not signed.

LADY BULLDOGS POST PROGRAM'S BEST FINISH FOR REBEL INTERCOLLEGIATE

OXFORD, Miss. – Notching the program's best finish in the Rebel Intercollegiate, the Mississippi State women's golf team turned its second-consecutive Top 10 card with a 902, sixth-place finish. Freshman standout Ally McDonald also carded her second straight Top 10 finish individually.

"I can't say that I'm not disappointed, but overall we still beat teams ranked ahead of us," MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "When we were up to fifth-place during the round today, the wheels came off and we made several bogeys in a row. Minnesota had a good round today with a 291 and took our fifth-place."

McDonald's 3-over-par 219 garnered a share of sixth-place. She becomes the first Lady Bulldog freshman to post back-to-back Top 10 finishes and first overall since Amanda Mathis accomplished the feat in 2006.

Fellow freshman Elena Warren matched McDonald's final-round 76 while Rica Tse turned in a 77. The freshman trio is currently ranked as the sixth-best freshman class in the nation by GolfStat.com's Freshman Impact Rankings.

Sophomore Mary Langdon Gallagher was 3-over through the first two rounds but struggled during Sunday's final round. She finished with tied with Warren at 14-over, while Perry Katherine Furr notched a 236.

"When your No. 1 player has an off day you know you're in trouble," Brown-Lemm said. "We have a long way to go, but we are lowering our scoring average, setting records for our program and beating better-ranked teams. We are on our way."
