MCDONALD TIES FOR THIRD, LADY BULLDOGS GRAB FOURTH IN THE WAVERLY

WEST POINT, Miss. – Picking up where her All-SEC Freshman season left off, Ally McDonald turned in a 4-under-par 212 to earn a share of third-place in the Inaugural Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational. The Fulton-native paced the Mississippi State women's golf team to a fourth-place 898 card.

McDonald's 212 tally matches her career low and ties for the second lowest 54-hole score in MSU women's golf history. The sophomore opened "The Waverly" with a 2-over-par 74 before firing back-to-back 69's to conclude the event. On Wednesday, she ignited the gallery by drilling home a 30-foot putt on No. 18 to save par.

"I'm so proud of the team's preparation and determination to grind out every shot," McDonald said. "It was an amazing start to the season, and I look forward to getting better and to the things that are ahead for this program."

The team's 898 card ties for the eighth-lowest tourney finish in Lady Bulldog laurels and third lowest in the Ginger Brown-Lemm era. At 34-over, it is the lowest opening-tournament score in program history.

"I'm so proud of the way the team came out and competed to begin the season," third-year coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "We were able to capitalize on a lot of opportunities this week and were able beat several teams ranked ahead of us. Ally had unbelievable second and third rounds. Our two freshmen also came out and showed the potential they have. We have areas we must improve on before our next event. This is only the beginning!"

Following McDonald, sophomore Rica Tse notched a 228, highlighted by an opening-round 73. In her career debut, Gabi Oubre' turned in a 230 behind a first-round 74. Mary Langdon Gallagher and Elena Warren rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with a 233 and 236, respectively.

Competing as individual, freshman Logan Chaney turned in a 230.

SEC-foe Kentucky claimed the top of the leaderboard with an 878, while Gemma Dryburgh of Tulane finished tops individually with an 8-under-par 208.

"The Waverly" was the first regular season home golf tournament hosted by the Lady Bulldogs. After an exciting week with some of the best rising teams from around the southeast battling on the course, plans for the 2013 Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational are already underway.

"We couldn't have had such a great event with out the support of Old Waverly, the Bryan family, and all of our volunteers," Brown-Lemm said. "I want to thank everyone who came out and supported the team in this great event. See you next year!"

The Lady Bulldogs return to action on Oct. 1 at the Johnie Imes Invitational in Columbia, Mo.

TSE LEADS LADY BULLDOGS' CLIMB UP LEADERBOARD DURING FINAL ROUND

Columbia, Mo. – Sophomore Rica Tse's final-round 1-under-par 71 propelled Mississippi State's late climb up the leaderboard of the Johnie Imes Invitational at The Club at Old Hawthorne on Monday.

MSU turned in a team tournament-best 10-over-par 298 during the final round. After sliding as low as 10th on the front nine, Ginger Brown-Lemm's squad recovered to turn in a seventh-place finish.

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. - Behind a final-round 12-over-par 300, the Mississippi State women's golf team captured its third-consecutive Top 10 finish to open the season at the Mercedes-Benz Women's Collegiate Championship.

Hosted by Tennessee at Holston Hills Country Club in Knoxville, the event featured 18 teams, 11 of which were represented in an NCAA Regional last spring. State's 10th-place, 903 card is a commanding 29 strokes better than last year's squad posted in this event.

Rica Tse, Gabi Oubre' and Mary Langdon Gallagher all posted 228 cards for the three-day event, while Logan Chaney rounded of the Lady Bulldogs' leaderboard with a 244.

Paula Reto of Purdue claimed the top spot individually, firing a 5-under par 211. Mary Michael Maggio from Texas A&M was the top SEC-finisher at 3-under.

MCDONALD CLAIMS SHARE OF LAS VEGAS COLLEGIATE SHOWDOWN TITLE

LAS VEGAS, Nev. - Behind a final-round 3-under-par 69 performance, Ally McDonald claimed a share of the Las Vegas Collegiate Showdown title hosted at the par-72, 6,261-yard Stallion Mountain Golf Club.

McDonald opened the event with a 1-under-par 71 Sunday before carding a 74 during Monday's second round. After bogeying her third hole of the day on Tuesday, the Fulton, Miss., native slid to third on the leaderboard. McDonald regrouped to post eagle-par-birdie on holes No. 13-15 and overtake the top spot. Elizabeth Tong of Indiana posted back-to-back birdies on No. 13 and 14 to tie McDonald.

The win is the first of McDonald's young career, while her 2-under-par 214 ties for the fourth-lowest tourney card in MSU history. She is the second Lady Bulldog to tie for a win under third-year head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm

"It was not only a great tournament for me but also for the team," McDonald said. "We all ended the semester with something positive, and I'm excited I could end it with my first win!"

Mississippi State used a season-best 6-over-par 294 during Tuesday's final round to climb into seventh-place. With another Top 10 finish, the Lady Bulldogs have posted four straight Top 10's to open a season for the first time since 2005.

"The team played extremely well today," Brown-Lemm said. "Coming into the tournament we wanted to maintain our scoring average, and we managed to accomplish our goal. The girls had tremendous dedication and focus battling the windy conditions on the course, and our ability to rebound from a bad shot this tournament was outstanding. I'm excited for what the spring holds for this young team that gets better and better each week."

Rica Tse notched six birdies en route to a 2-under-par 70 performance that propelled her into the Top 10. Her ninth-place finish is the highest of the fall slate, while her 222 matches her best of the season.

Junior Mary Langdon Gallagher turned in a pair of 77's sandwiched around an 80 for a three-round 234, while freshman Gabi Oubre' chased her with a 235. Elena Warren rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with a 248.

With the fall slate complete, the Lady Bulldogs currently own the eighth-best scoring average in the SEC (300.92) and most Top 10 finishes (4), while McDonald is fifth in the conference with a 72.16 average scoring clip.

WOMEN'S GOLF POSTS FOURTH-PLACE FINISH IN WESTBROOK INVITATIONAL

PEORIA, Ariz. – Following a grueling 36-holes on Sunday, the Mississippi State women's golf team rebounded to match a season-best 9-over-par 297 in the final round of the Westbrook Invitational in Peoria, Ariz. The Lady Bulldogs' tournament card of 903 tied No. 50 Indiana for fourth-place.

"Today was a very competitive round as there were several of us under or around par," third-year MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "We, as a team, stumbled a bit with a few bogeys coming in, but it worked out for us to get a tie for fourth."

The fourth-place sitting falls behind three Top 15 teams: No. 15 Texas Tech, No. 7 Arkansas and No. 9 Washington. MSU's 903 ties its second-best card of the year behind the Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational's 898 and matches the sixth-lowest tally in the Brown-Lemm era.

Sophomore standout Ally McDonald notched a 72 during Monday's round, while her 6-over-par 222 earned her a share of 13th. It is her third Top 25 this year and 11th in 15 career events.

Elena Warren turned in a final-round 76 to post a 227, just one stroke shy of her first-career Top 25 finish. Rica Tse regrouped after opening with a 79 and 78 during Sunday's first two rounds to post a final-round 1-over-par 73.

Gabi Oubre' and Mary Langdon Gallagher rounded of the Lady Bulldogs' leaderboard with a 231 and 233, respectively.

Gabriela Lopez of Arkansas garnered the individual crown with an 8-under-par 208. Her third-round 6-under-par 66 broke a three-way tie for the lead.

LADY BULLDOGS RALLY FOR SECOND-PLACE FINISH, MCDONALD TIES FOR SECOND

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – A final-round 5-over-par 293 vaulted the Mississippi State women's golf team to a second-place finish in the JMU/Eagle Landing Invitational at the Eagle Landing Golf Club in Jacksonville. Sophomore standout Ally McDonald also tied for second individually.

"I am thrilled with our final round today," third-year MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "In our team meeting, we discussed how many times we have seen a team behind by as many as 10 shots come back and shock the field with a great round, moving way up the leaderboard. I told them we could be that team. We were eight back of second and that was the goal."

Entering Sunday's final round, the Lady Bulldogs were in sixth-place and eight strokes behind second-place Elon. Behind the team's 11-birdie performance, MSU climbed the leaderboard and recorded its best tournament finish since claiming second a year ago in the John/Kirk Panther Intercollegiate.

"The conditions were actually the toughest of the three days and we were focused on our game," Brown-Lemm added. "We struggled on the front as a team and played the back very well. When we made the turn at five-over, I knew we had a great opportunity to tear up the back. We played the back even par. It was a great feeling for our young team to come back in the final round and finish well."

Over the three rounds, State played the front nine at 23-over but managed to dominate the back nine at only 4-over.

The runner-up finish improves MSU's overall record to 59-28-1 on the year, which is the most wins for a Lady Bulldog squad since the 2006 NCAA postseason-qualifier team posted 79 wins. The 2013 Dogs still have four events remaining.

The 293 ties for the ninth-lowest round in MSU history, while State's three-round 891 ties for fifth-best all-time and second-best in the Brown-Lemm era.

McDonald turned in par for the final round and earned a share of second-place individually. She took control of the golf course during the first round with a 3-under-par 69 before carding a 74 for the second. The Fulton, Miss., native claimed her third Top 3 finish this season and fourth of her career.

Fellow sophomore Rica Tse reclaimed her groove with a final-round 1-under-par 71. Her three-round 6-over-par 222 earned the New Zealand native a share of 13th-place, her fourth Top 25 card of the season.

Junior Mary Langdon Gallagher posted a tournament personal-best 2-over-par 74 on Sunday to tally 228 for the tournament, narrowly missing a Top 25 finish.

Freshman Gabi Oubre' and sophomore Elena Warren rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with a 231 and 233, respectively.

Freshman Logan Chaney also competed in the tournament as an individual and turned in a 24-over-par 240.

No. 36 Campbell claimed the JMU/Eagle Landing Invitational title with a 6-over-par 870, while East Carolina finished just behind MSU in third-place with a 33-over-par 897.

F. Gustafsson Spang garnered the individual crown with a 4-under-par 212. She matched McDonald's opening-round 69 and secured her spot atop the leaderboard with a second-round 2-under-par 70.

MSU BEATS NO. 18 BAYLOR, TIES NO. 6 UNC FOR EIGHTH BEHIND MCDONALD'S 69

Gainesville, Fla. – Wrapping up a twelve-day, two-tournament spring break trip, the Mississippi State women's golf team posted a final-round 15-over-par 295 in the SunTrust Gator Invitational to earn a share of eighth-place, beating No. 18 Baylor and tying No. 6 North Carolina.

The Lady Bulldogs opened the event tying a season-best with a 13-over-par 293. Following a second-round 304 Saturday, they slid into a tie for ninth. The final-round 15-over moved MSU into a tie for eighth, only two shots shy of No. 49 Florida State.

"I could not be prouder of the way the girls battled this weekend," MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "This is a challenging course and an even tougher field. We came out focused on our routine and proved we can compete with some of the top teams in the nation. Beating number 18 Baylor is a good accomplishment in itself, but to tie a Top 10 team like North Carolina shows these girls the progress they've made at Mississippi State."

The three-round 892 ties for the seventh-lowest tourney card in MSU history; the second time in as many tournaments MSU has entered a Top 10 lowest tournament clip into the record book.

No. 3 Alabama claimed the SunTrust Gator Invitational title following a 25-over-par 865, while No. 4 Oklahoma (868) and No. 5 Florida (870) round out the Top 3.

Sophomore standout Ally McDonald posted her fifth 69 of the season in the final round to climb into a tie for fourth-place with sixth-ranked Stephanie Meadow of Alabama. Her 4-over-par 214 ranks as the fifth-lowest tourney total in MSU history. The Fulton, Miss., native garnered her fifth Top 5 of the season and dropped her season scoring average to 72.24.

Gabi Oubre' used a final-round 4-over-par 74 to post a career-best 222, securing her first-career Top 25 tally. The freshman lowered her average scoring clip 76.52, the lowest among MSU newcomers.

Sophomore Elena Warren missed her first-career Top 25 by only a single stroke for the second event in a row. Her final-round 4-over-par 74 produced a career-best 223.

JOHNS ISLAND, S.C. – After battling cold and windy conditions, the Mississippi State women's golf team persevered to post its eight-consecutive Top 10 card in the Briar's Creek Invitational. MSU posted a final-round 10-over-par 298 to tally 933 for the two-day, three-round event.

With wind gusts topping 40 miles-per-hour and multiple players battling health issues during the first round, the Lady Bulldogs posted a 322, their worst round of the year. "We had every opportunity not to play well and to quit but we never did. We've preached all year to focus on the routine and be 'one-shot warriors.' The girls did a tremendous job of controlling what they could and were rewarded with another Top 10."

Freshman Gabi Oubre' led the way for the Lady Bulldogs, posting career second-best 72. The Mobile, Ala., native notched her second-consecutive Top 25 card. During Monday's rough conditions, Oubre' managed an 81 but improved her card over the next two rounds, posting a 77 and 72, respectively.

Ally McDonald finished atop the Maroon and White leaderboard with a three-round 12-over-par 228, earning a share of 13th-place. It is the sophomore's eighth Top 20 of the season and 14th Top 25 in 18 career events.

After a pair of 80's to begin the Briar's Creek Invitational, fellow sophomore Rica Tse bounced back with a 3-over-par 75 in the final round, while Elena Warren and Mary Langdon Gallagher rounded out the MSU board with a 241 and 243, respectively.

MCDONALD TIES SCHOOL RECORD WITH 6-UNDER-PAR 210 IN REBEL INTERCOLLEGIATE

Oxford, Miss. – Building off an opening-round 4-under-par 68, No. 44 Ally McDonald fired a school record-tying 6-under-par 210 for a third-place finish in the M&F Bank Rebel Intercollegiate. The Mississippi State women's golf team's 24-over 888 garnered a share of sixth-place along with No. 29 LSU.

McDonald carded a 1-under-par 71 Sunday to tie Beth Irwin's school record 210 set during the 2004 Chrysler ACC/SEC Challenge. Her first-round 68 also tied for the second-lowest round in MSU history.

Entering the weekend, the sophomore owned the Southeastern Conference's fifth-best scoring average (72.71), but with her stellar play this weekend has lowered her average to 72.41, which is now third in the SEC and on pace to break State's all-time season mark by two strokes.

After turning in a program second-best 289 during Friday's first round, the Lady Bulldogs tallied a 299 and 300 during the final two rounds. The three-round 888 matches the fourth-lowest tournament tally in MSU history and second lowest in the Brown-Lemm era.

With the sixth-place finish the Lady Bulldogs also tied a school record with their ninth-consecutive Top 10 finish. MSU will have a chance to break the record in the upcoming SEC Championship.

State also recorded wins against a pair of SEC opponents for the first time this season. Ole Miss turned in a 28-over-par 892, while Missouri's 36-over-par 900 earned it 10th-place.

Individually, freshman Gabi Oubre' turned in a final-round 2-over-par 74 Sunday for a three-round 9-over-par 225. She finished tied for 34th in the 96-player field.

Mary Langdon Gallagher posted a 5-over-par 77 Sunday for a three-round 10-over-par 226. It is the junior's best tournament since she carded a 222 in last season's Price's Give 'Em Five Invitational.

Elena Warren (77-74-78) and Rica Tse (75-79-79) rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with a 13-over-par 229 and a 17-over 233, respectively.

No. 49 Coastal Carolina won the M&F Bank Rebel Intercollegiate firing a 1-under-par 863. 24th-ranked Baylor and 20th-ranked Tulane rounded out the top three with an 872 and 878, respectively.

Jessica Alexander of Coastal Carolina claimed in individual crown with an 8-under-par 208, while No. 13 Hayley Davis of Baylor finished second at 7-under.

MSU MATCHES BEST SEC FINISH WITH TIE FOR SIXTH, MCDONALD TIES FOR THIRD

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – Tying the program's best finish in the SEC Championships, the Mississippi State women's golf team posted a 58-over-par 922 at Greystone Country Club to earn a share of fifth-place along with No. 34 Kentucky.

After notching an 18-over 306 during Friday's first round, the Lady Bulldogs posted a 303 for the second round and climbed to second entering the final round. MSU managed a 313 on Sunday to hold onto its Top 5 card.

Not only did the share of fifth place tie the best conference finish from the 2000 championships, but it also broke the school record for consecutive Top 10 finishes as State has posted a Top 10 card in all 10 events it has appeared in this season.

Second-ranked Alabama ran away with the conference championship claiming a 14-stroke victory against second-place No. 18 Georgia. The Crimson Tide were the only team to post a sub-300 card, a 293 in the second round.

Entering the SEC Championship, MSU was 2-10-1 against the SEC on the season but posted an 8-4-1 ledger against the conference this weekend.

"I could not have asked for more from the team this weekend," third-year MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "All season we have preached focusing on one shot at a time and sticking to a routine and this weekend each and everyone of the girls accomplished that.

"We went toe-to-toe with the defending national champions and did not back down. I cannot express how proud I am of these girls, this program and Mississippi State. They never gave in throughout the whole season and kept working and fighting. I'm so glad they were able to see the benefits of all that hard work this weekend.

"Other schools and recruits are starting to recognize where this program is going and what we can accomplish here. We will enjoy our successes this weekend, but tomorrow starts a new week. We will be back at work preparing for our next step."

No. 34 Ally McDonald posted a 7-over-par 79 to secure a share of third place after posting a 77 and 70 during the first two rounds. It is the standout sophomore's second-consecutive Top 3 finish and fifth Top 5 tally in the last seven events.

"Ally is the epitome of a Bulldog," Brown-Lemm said. "She grinds it out every tournament and can compete with the best in the nation. I'm very proud of her and the way she played. Ally will win the conference title one day. She is too talented and too determined not to."

State also had two other Top 25 cards from Rica Tse and Mary Langdon Gallagher. Tse used a 1-over-par 73 Sunday to climb into a share of eighth place, her best finish of the season.

Gallagher stormed out of the gates during the opening round, posting a 3-over-par 75 and leading MSU on the leaderboard. After notching a 75 and 82 during the final two rounds, the junior secured a share of 19th place, which is also a season-best for her.

Sophomore Elena Warren (77-84-80) and freshman Gabi Oubre' (81-80-84) capped the Lady Bulldogs' leaderboard with a 241 and 245, respectively.

No. 2 Stephanie Meadow of Alabama claimed the individual crown with a 216, while Sarah Harris of Kentucky posted a 225 for runner-up honors.

WOMEN'S GOLF ADVANCES TO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY

NORMAN, Okla. – History was made, records were broken and the Mississippi State women's golf team is headed to the NCAA Championships at the UGA Golf Course in Athens, Ga.

Unranked and seeded 19th out of 24 teams, MSU was a heavy underdog in the NCAA Central Regional hosted at the par-72, 6,298-yard Jimmie Austin OU Golf Club.

After posting a 4-over-par 292 and 299 during the first two rounds, the Lady Bulldogs entered Saturday's final round tied for sixth, with only one shot separating them and the end of their season. Facing the most important round of the year, they fired a 7-under-par 281 and climbed into third place with a three-round 8-over-par 872.

The 281 is the second-lowest round in program history, while the 872 is the second-lowest tournament card in history.

"It's kind of surreal still," third-year MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "We met in the parking lot before today's round and we talked about that this was just another final round of a golf tournament. It was about today's round and one shot at a time. The only thing that mattered is the next shot."

This marks the first time MSU has advanced to the NCAA Championships as a team. Before this season, MSU's best postseason finish came with a 12th-place card in the 2002 NCAA East Regional.

"You know I expected (to make the NCAA Championships) but maybe not this soon," Brown-Lemm said. "I'm elated that all of the girls were firing on all cylinders on the same round. It is something we haven't been able to enjoy yet."

The NCAA Championships will be hosted at the UGA Golf Course in Athens, Ga., on May 21-24. The event will be a four-round stroke-play tournament, as opposed to the normal three-round events.

No. 29 Ally McDonald also claimed the NCAA Central Regional title, firing a school record 10-under-par 206. She claimed a dominating five-stroke victory over a trio of second-place finishers.

The sophomore notched back-to-back 3-under-par 69's during the first two rounds before firing a career-best 68 for the final round.

McDonald traded a birdie-bogey start Saturday and finished the front nine with birdies on three of her last five holes. After holing out with an 8 iron from 139 yards for an eagle on the 394-yard, par-4 16th, she moved to 6-under. The Fulton native stumbled coming in with a double bogey on the par-5 18th as her third shot landed in a bunker short of the green.

"Surprisingly, I just felt very relaxed," McDonald said. "Most of my shots were fairly consistent. I didn't have very many big misses, obviously, besides the last hole. I kind of stumbled coming in but the eagle on 16 kind of canceled that double out. Things happen for a reason. It was all around a good round."

Sophomore Rica Tse and junior Mary Langdon Gallagher each notched 221's for the regional, which were season-best cards for each.

Tse turned in back-to-back 76's in the first two rounds but fired a 69 on Saturday, which tied her career-best. The New Zealand native birdied five of six holes from No. 8 to No. 13 and finished with seven birdies on the day.

After an opening-round 76, Gallagher fired a second-round 72 followed by a final-round 1-over-par 73. The Greenwood native birdied No. 9 and moved to 1-under at the turn. She managed a 2-over on the back to finish tied for 30th.

Elena Warren fired her second 71 of the regional during the third round. The 1-under matches her career-best, while the sophomore's three-round 225 was only two strokes off her career-low.

Freshman Gabi Oubre' rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with three-round 233 behind a final-round 75, which is the second-lowest postseason round in freshman history.

Third-ranked Duke finished atop the leaderboard, firing a tournament-best 12-under-par 276 Saturday. The Blue Devils' three-round 851 claimed a six-stroke victory over No. 4 Oklahoma, the tournament host.

MCDONALD FINISHED T10TH, MSU CAPS PROGRAM'S MOST SUCCESSFUL SEASON

ATHENS, Ga. – Adding to the program's most successful season in its history, the Mississippi State women's golf team completed play in the NCAA Championships and No. 6 Ally McDonald finished tied for 10th at the par-72, 6,372-yard UGA Golf Course.

McDonald's top 10 finish is her ninth of the season and 13th of her career. After a final-round 81, she finished with a four-round 2-over-par 290 (70-69-70-81).

The sophomore from Fulton, Miss., paced the youngest squad in the championships field to a 24th-place finish in the program's first NCAA Championships appearance.

"I couldn't be more proud of this team – the records we broke this season and just hanging in there," McDonald said. "Nobody thought we'd come to nationals. Conditions were extremely tough out there, but we battled. We weren't able to pull in what we wanted to pull in, but it's an experience we won't forget. We're going to hold our head high and we're going to be back."

After posting a team tournament-best 4-over-par 292 during the third round, MSU battled windy conditions and fast greens to post a final-round 327. State finished with a 72-hole 69-over 1,221.

MSU ends the season having posted top 10 cards in 11 of its 12 events, while also notching a 300.89 average round and a 901.09 54-hole average. All of which are school records.

"We had a fantastic year," third-year MSU coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "We refuse to let our last 18 holes dictate our satisfaction level for our year. We broke most existing records, placed fifth at SEC's and 24th at the NCAA Championships. We will use this experience and get our young squad even stronger for next year's postseason play"

Sophomore Elena Warren finished second on the MSU board with a 24-over 312 (76-82-72-82). Her best round tally came during Thursday's third round as she posted par.

Mary Langdon Gallagher notched an 84 Friday and finished at 25-over (78-74-77-84=313), while Rica Tse posted a final-round 85 and finished at 26-over (76-78-75-85=314).

Freshman Gabi Oubre' rounded out the Lady Bulldog leaderboard with a 318 (82-81-75-80). The freshman birdied her last hole of the day to tie McDonald's freshman birdie record (73) set a season ago.

The No.1-ranked USC Trojans ran away with the national title, behind an NCAA Championships-record second round of 12-under-par 276. Their 72-hole 19-under-par 1,113 also set the NCAA record by 15 strokes. Annie Park (USC) also ran away with the individual title as her 10-under-par 278 was six strokes clear of the field.
