BULLDOGS, MCDONALD POST FIFTH-PLACE CARD TO OPEN 2013-14 SEASON

HANAHAN, S.C. – After a challenging three days at the Yeamans Hall Club, the Mississippi State women's golf team welcomed its new season with a fifth-place finish in the Cougar Classic, while Ally McDonald began her junior campaign with a top-five card.

Ginger Brown-Lemm's squad notched to a 10-over-par 298 Tuesday and its 7-over-par 871 earned a school-record 12th-straight regular season top-10 card.

"Overall this was a very good tournament for us," Brown-Lemm said. "Obviously today was disappointing, but the greatest news is that if 298 is our worst day, we are headed for great things this year."

McDonald shot a final-round 3-over-par 75 to tally a 3-under 213 for the event en route to her seventh-career top-five finish. The Fulton, Miss., standout had a mishap on hole No. 4 with a double bogey but followed it up with a string of pars and a birdie on the eighth hole.

Senior Mary Langdon Gallagher ended the tournament with a 3-over-par 75 and a three-round 218, which placed her tied for 19th on the leaderboard. The top-20 finish is the third of her career and first since her freshman season.

Following the team's second-round low score of 71, Rica Tse finished tied for 37th with a 5-over-par 77 and 221 total for the Cougar Classic. Tse capped off her final round with a birdie-bogey-par-birdie final four holes giving her three birdies on the 18th hole for the event.

Newcomer Ji Eun Baik turned in a 79 in the second round but bounced back with MSU's best round of the day at even-par to end the tournament with a 9-over-par 225. After starting off the round with a birdie on hole No. 3, Baik add her second birdie on the 18th , placing her in the top 50 in her college debut. Freshman Jessica Peng rounded out the squad with a 4-over-par 76 and 228 overall.

The 14th-ranked Florida Gators won the event behind a final-round 7-under-par 281 performance and 859 for the tournament. Anna Young of Florida claimed the individual title with a 5-under-par 211.

The Bulldogs' next event will be on Friday, Sept. 20-22, in the Mercedes Benz Women's Collegiate Championship at Cherokee Country Club in Knoxville, Tenn.

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. – After the heavy rains ruled out play Saturday, the Mississippi State women's golf team finished tied for ninth place in the Mercedes Benz Collegiate Classic, while junior standout Ally McDonald claimed a share of eighth.

The 25-over-par 593 at Cherokee Country Club extended the school record of 13 consecutive regular season top-10 finishes.

"The girls really battled back today from a tough start," fourth-year head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "Each girl persevered and showed their mental toughness today to secure another top-10 finish."

McDonald also notched her sixth-consecutive top-10 finish after a 1-over-par 72 second round. The All-American fired her fifth career eagle along with two birdies to finish at even par for the tournament.

"I didn't play my best this weekend but I was still able to finish in the top 10," McDonald said. "I think everyone knows they could have played better but we are all looking forward to our home tournament next week."

Junior Rica Tse notched a 3-over-par 74 final round to finish tied for 25th overall, claiming her sixth-career top-25 finish. After bogeys on the first two holes, Tse bounced back to birdie hole No. 3 and close out the front nine with six straight pars.

Jessica Peng finished her 6-over round with a birdie on the final hole to land her at 10-over for the event. Mary Langdon Gallagher posted an 80 for her second round and tallied a 13-over-par 155 at the Tennessee-hosted event.

After an 81 in her first collegiate round, redshirt freshman Blaise Carabello made a four shot improvement in the second round to post a 6-over-par 77. Carabello finished the tournament with a 16-over 158.

No. 6 Arkansas won the event with a 3-under-par, while Emily Tubert of the Razorbacks was the individual champion after posting a 4-under-par for the tournament.

MSU will return to action on Monday, Sept. 30, as it hosts the second annual Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational at Old Waverly Golf Club in West Point.

RECORDS FALL AS MSU, MCDONALD WIN OLD WAVERLY BULLDOG INVITATIONAL

WEST POINT, Miss. – Numerous school records fell Wednesday at Old Waverly Golf Club as the Mississippi State women's golf team claimed the Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational team title by 21 strokes and Ally McDonald won top individual honors.

MSU recorded a school-record 275 in the final round to finish the three-round event with a 20-under-par 844 that bettered the previous top tournament score by the 1999 squad at the Lady Seminole Invitational. The Bulldogs also improved the school record for lowest 36 hole score by three strokes.

Ginger Brown-Lemm's squad shattered the previous team best tournament record by 20 strokes to claim the program's first tournament title since the 2004 Wildcat Fall Invitational.

"Today was an awesome day," head coach Brown-Lemm said. "Our girls work so hard every day and this was their tournament to win. Breaking the records we did today and winning our home tournament makes this a great day for our program."

Entering Wednesday one shot behind teammate Jessica Peng for the lead, McDonald fired seven birdies, including one on No. 18, to card a 5-under-par 67 and win the tournament by one shot with a 9-under 207 that came one shy of matching her school record set in last season's NCAA Central Regional.

The All-American bounced back from a bogey on No. 8 to post five birdies through her final 11 holes. The victory placed her third in career victories, one behind Carri Wood for second.

Peng also made her mark on the record books, firing a 3-under 69 Wednesday to finish runner-up with an MSU freshman record 8-under-par 208. Peng posted consecutive birdies on holes five and six and 14 and 15, and she narrowly missed a birdie putt on No. 18 that would have forced a play-off with her teammate.

After struggling early in her final round, Ji Eun Baik closed the front nine with three-straight birdies and added two more on the back nine shoot a 3-under-par 69 to finish the tournament tied for fourth overall with a 3-under 213.

Senior Mary Langdon Gallagher used back-to-back birdies on 15 and 16 to shoot her best round of the tournament, a 2-under-par 70. Gallagher made a four-shot improvement Wednesday to secure a tie for eighth with an even par 216.

Junior Rica Tse rounded out the MSU lineup with a 12-place tie. She shot an even par 72 for the final round to finish the 54-hole event with a 3-over 219.

In only her second collegiate appearance, redshirt freshman Blaise Carabello notched a 2-under-par 70 in the final round to tie for 10th place. Carabello, playing as an individual in the event, used five birdies on Wednesday to secure the first Top 10 finish of her career.

Izel Pieters had a strong finish to the Old Waverly Bulldog Invitational, firing a single-round freshman record 4-under-par 68 to tie for 24th in her collegiate debut. The Mpumalanga, South Africa, native recovered from two bogies in her first four holes with five birdies over the next eight holes to finish the event with a 224.

Logan Chaney made a five-stroke improvement from Tuesday to set a new career-low round of 1-under-par 71 on Wednesday. The sophomore fired her first career eagle on hole 15 to finish in a tie for 30th with a 227. Gabi Oubre' fired a 75 Wednesday finish in 46th with a three-round 235.

Brown-Lemm takes her squad to her alma mater, the University of Texas, Oct. 13-15 to compete in the Betsy Rawls Invitational.

MSU CLAIMS THIRD PLACE IN REGULAR SEASON FINALE

ATHENS, Ga. – After splitting the two matches on Saturday, the Mississippi State women's golf team won the third-place medals by winning the tiebreaker against No. 26 North Carolina State in the final round of the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic Sunday.

"Incredible Performance," said MSU head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm. "We learned a lot about ourselves playing in the stroke/match play format. We have some work to do, but everything is coming together for SEC championships and the NCAA Championships."

Notching the only victory for MSU was freshman Ji Eun Baik, who defeated Lindsay McGetrick 1-up. Baik birdied on the final hole to win the hole to register her second victory of the weekend. She was one of two Bulldogs to record multiple victories.

Rica Tse followed up her two triumphs from the first two rounds of match play by finishing all square with Vivian Tsui. Tse won the 17th hole to get back to even in the matchup to end the tournament with 2.5 points, most of any MSU player.

Also ending their final matchups all-square were Ally McDonald and Jessica Peng as they tied Brittany Marchand and Augusta James, respectively. Peng was also able to produce a victory on hole 17 to end her tournament with a win and two draws.

Closing out the Maroon and White lineup was senior Mary Langdon Gallagher, who slipped to a narrow 1-up defeat to Ana Menendez. The four rounds in Athens place Gallagher in a tie for fourth all-time for most career rounds played by a Bulldog at 113.

No.1 Southern California were crowned winners of the tournament after beating No. 4 Arkansas 3-2 in the championship match.

Brown-Lemm's squad will begin postseason play when it returns to action in the Southeastern Conference Championships on April 18-20, in Birmingham, Ala., at Greystone Country Club.

BULLDOGS SHOOT LOWEST ROUND, MCDONALD IN TOP 15 AT SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – Playing on Easter Sunday, the Mississippi State women's golf team produced the third-best final round of any team at the Southeastern Conference Championship, while Ally McDonald clinched a top-15 finish.

With a 36-hole score of 621 entering the third round, MSU carded an 8-over-par 296 for its final round to move up two spots in the final standings at Greystone Golf & Country Club. The Bulldogs Sunday round was a mere 25-strokes less than their opening round on Friday.

"I'm proud of the resolve our student-athletes showed to get back to the play we are used to," MSU head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "Our play today was inspirational. We were committed to getting a few shots back and finishing as high as possible. We learned some hard lessons from that first day and used them today."

Entering the day with a share of 24th, McDonald posted her best round of the tournament with an 1-over-par 73 to move into a tie for 14th at 8-over-par 224 for the event. McDonald notched back-to-back birdies on holes 1 and 2 and then a third on the seventh hole to secure her eighth top-25 scorecard of the season.

Senior Mary Langdon Gallagher turned in the lowest round of any Bulldog on the weekend with an even-par 72 round on Sunday. The four-time SEC Championship participant bounced back from consecutive bogeys on her last two holes on her front-nine with two birdies and seven pars on her last nine holes to complete a nine-shot-turnaround from her first to final rounds.

"I'm so excited for Mary Langdon and proud of her critical contribution to this program over the last four years," Brown-Lemm said. "Now we await our assignment for NCAA Regionals."

Rica Tse and Jessica Peng each notched 4-over-par 76 rounds on Sunday as they both ended the tournament with final scores of 232. Rounding out the Maroon and White lineup was Ji Eun Baik who shot her lowest score in Birmingham with a 3-over-par 75 in her final round.

No. 13 Vanderbilt held on to its lead going into the final round to win the SEC Championship at 15-over-par 879. The Commodores were led by individual champion Simin Feng, who finished with a 7-under-par 209 tournament score.

Brown-Lemm's squad will now wait to hear its fate on which NCAA Regionals the Bulldogs will be attending on May 8-10. MSU was selected to the NCAA Central Regional in Norman, Okla. last season, where Ally McDonald won the individual title and MSU finished third to secure its first ever appearance in the NCAA Championships.

MSU WOMEN'S GOLF BOOKS RETURN TRIP TO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

STILLWATER, Okla.— For the second consecutive season, the Mississippi State women's golf team is heading to the NCAA Championships.

The Bulldogs tied their finish from a season ago by placing in third-place at 29-over-par 893 at the NCAA Central Regional at Karsten Creek Golf Club. MSU battled the windy conditions to fire the second-lowest score of the final round at 9-over-par 297 on Saturday, including a 3-under-par with eight birdies on the back-nine to secure its place in the Tulsa, Okla., championships on May 20-23.

“What a team! I am so impressed with the resilience and patience they showed this week,” head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. “This course was the most difficult we played all year, in windy conditions as well. We are proud to go to back-to-back National Championships, and we have set the bar high for the future Bulldogs to chase. Now, back to work in preparations for Tulsa.”

Posting the best round of the day at 2-under-par 70, All-SEC performer Ally McDonald turned in a 1-under-par 215 final score to earn fourth place at the event. McDonald led the Bulldogs surge up the leaderboard with three consecutive birdies on holes 13, 14 and 15 to claim her fifth top-5 scorecard of the campaign.

The Fulton, Miss., native McDonald showed great perseverance to bounce back from her bogey on hole three to notch a birdie-par-birdie stretch en route to shooting her lowest round and tallying 11 total birdies at the regional.

Jessica Peng and Rica Tse each owned 3-over-par 75 third round scores to narrowly miss the top-25 by one shot at 9-over-par 225. The All-Freshman team selection Peng made a 7-shot-turnaround from her first nine holes to her back nine holes, including a birdie on the 18th to go along with her eagle and birdie on the hole from her earlier rounds.

Tse also made an impressive turnaround on her back-9 by improving by five shots to shoot a 1-under-par with a birdie on her last nine holes.

Freshman Ji Eun Baik recorded three birdies in her 5-over-par 77 final round to end the event in the top-50 at 229. Baik recovered from her bogey on hole 10 to register a par-birdie-par-birdie sequence to better her front-nine score by three shots on the back-nine.

MSU's only senior Mary Langdon Gallagher moved up into a tie-for-second in school history with 116 career rounds played. Gallagher fired consecutive birdies on holes 8 and 9 to post a 232 tournament score.

WOMEN'S GOLF COMPLETES BANNER SEASON WITH TOP 10 FINISH IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

TULSA, Okla. – Making only its second appearance, the Mississippi State women's golf team capped off a record-setting season by securing its first ever top-10 scorecard at the NCAA Championship on Friday, with Ally McDonald placing in the top-5.

Entering the final round fresh off the school's best ever NCAA Championship round at 283, the Bulldogs fired a 7-over-par 287 to claim sixth place with a final tournament score of 37-over-par 1,157. The 1,157 championship score is 64-shots better and 18 spots higher up the leaderboard than last season's performance in the event.

"We set goals at the beginning of the season, and we very meticulously go through what it takes on a daily basis to attain them," MSU head coach Ginger Brown-Lemm said. "We give our effort to the daily dedication to excellence, and it has paid off for us here with a sixth-place finish at the National Championship."

Brown-Lemm's squad finishes as the highest Southeastern Conference school, while also beating four top-10 and 13 top-25 schools.

"Our efforts as coaches are supported by many: Midge Davis, Scotty Johnson, Brian Neil, Brian Cain, other coaches who I quiz to get better at my trade, mentors of mine, Bill Rice, my husband Floyd, children Parker and Paige, Starkville Country Club and Old Waverly Golf Club. They support what Coach (Leigh) Phillips and I do. We could not do it without them," Brown-Lemm said.

All-SEC member Ally McDonald notched a 3-under-par 67 in her final round to rise up the leaderboard into a tie for fourth at 1-under-par 279. McDonald went on to post the lowest single-season stroke average in the program's history at 71.48, while also registering the most birdies in a single-campaign at 114.

The Fulton, Miss., native used consecutive birdies on holes 12 and 13 and again on her final two holes of the day to pick up her sixth top-5 scorecard of the campaign. McDonald was one of only six golfers at the championship to have a tournament score of even-par or better.

"It feels good to play well and finish fourth," McDonald said. "I'm so proud of this team and the way we have played all year. We accomplished everything we wanted and more. I can't wait for next year."

Stringing together two impressive rounds to conclude her tournament, Rica Tse shot an even-par 70 with three birdies to post a 1-under-par 139 over her last two rounds. Tse chiseled off 16 shots from her opening two rounds to her final two rounds to record the second-best Bulldog score.

The fabulous freshman duo of Jessica Peng and Ji Eun Baik each turned in 5-over-par 75 Friday rounds to complete their debut seasons. Peng closes the book on the top freshman-season in Bulldog history, posting the best stroke average (73.71), most birdies (74), most par or better rounds (11) and most rounds in the 60s (3). Baik totaled the second-most birdies by an MSU golfer with 11 at the championship.

Rounding out the Maroon and White lineup in her final collegiate round was Mary Langdon Gallagher, who had an 80 on the day. The team's only senior, Gallagher leaves Starkville after competing in the second-most rounds in program-history with 120, just two shy of the top spot.

No. 3 Duke held onto first to win the National Championship at 10-over-par 1130. Doris Chen of No. 1 Southern California took home the individual crown at 6-under-par 274.
