WEEKEND RECAP

UNT opened its 26th season at the Trojan Invitational in Troy, Ala., and finished 4-1 with wins over Troy and Samford along with two victories over Central Michigan. The 4-1 mark matches the second-best start in UNT history, behind only 2023 when the team opened with a 7-0 record. On Sunday, head coach Rodney DeLong secured his 200th program win at UNT and became only the fourth head coach, in any sport, to hit the milestone with the Mean Green. He joined soccer's John Hedlund (400-158-47; 1995-present), women's basketball's Tina Slinker (241-287; 1989-2009) and men's basketball's Pete Shanda (224-258; 1935-59) as members of the elite club at North Texas.

Senior RHP Skylar Savage made four appearances with 15 strikeouts and a 2.14 ERA over 16 1/3 innings. She tallied a 1-0 record with two saves and spun a seven-inning complete-game victory against the Trojans. Offensively, Kailyn Bearpaw led the team with seven hits, two home runs, eight RBI and 14 total bases. She slashed .438/.875/.526 with three walks and collected her first career stolen base.

UPCOMING MILESTONES

Senior IF Cierra Simon currently ranks within the top-10 for seven career records.

- She ranks second in program history with 47 career stolen bases, three shy of tying the program record of 50 and needs four for sole possession of first
- She is tied for the UNT career triples record with eight
- She needs five hits to break into the UNT career top-10 list
- Simon is tied for fourth in program history with 38 double plays turned, the only non-primary first baseman inside the top five
- Since opening day of 2022, Simon has started every UNT game (168) and owns the fifth-longest consecutive starts streak in program history

RHP Skylar Savage enters the season as the only senior in a seven-player bullpen.

- She ranks seventh in career history with 262 strikeouts, needing eight for sixth
- Savage has made 101 appearances in the circle for sixth-most in program history, only two shy of sole possession of fifth place

Senior Rylee Nicholson ranks third on the team with 151 career games played.

- She has collected 47 of her 74 career hits at UNT, 26 shy of No. 100

RHP Mackenzie Childers ranks top-five in career strikeout per seven innings rate.

- She has tallied 155 career strikeouts, only 27 shy of cracking the top-10

Transfer Kailyn Bearpaw boasts 151 games played, ranked second behind Simon.

- Bearpaw holds a seven-game hitting streak, two shy of her career-best mark

AAC PRESEASON POLL

UNT enters its second season in the American Athletic Conference after a third-place regular season finish and semifinals run at the AAC Championship last season. The Mean Green were voted to finish third in the preseason coaches' poll, only two points behind regular season co-champions Florida Atlantic, and collected three first-place votes.

THE RESURGENCE IS HERE

After losing 12 letter winners last season, head coach Rodney DeLong added eight high school freshmen and three transfers for a total of 11 newcomers to the roster. Aside from the inaugural 2004 team, this season marks the second-largest influx of newcomers to a UNT roster behind only 2021 when DeLong added 13 new players. Eleven newcomers matched marks from 2016 and 2007.

Senior OF Kailyn Bearpaw and sophomore P/UT Anneca Anderson come to UNT from American rival Tulsa while junior IF Riley McNemar transferred from Auburn. IF Ausha Moore and OF Taylor Platt highlight the incoming freshman class.

THE AMERICAN DREAM

Head coach Rodney DeLong enters the 2025 season as the winningest head coach in UNT history at 196 wins. Since 2019, he also owns highest winning percentage (.667; 196-98) among current AAC member programs and is trailed by South Florida's Ken Eriksen (.6461; 199-109) and Wichita State's Kristi Bredbenner (.6458; 190-105-1). Additionally, DeLong ranks 25th among qualified active Division I head coaches with a .657 career winning percentage (341-178-1) which includes three seasons at Cameron University (2014-16) and one at Austin Peay (2018).

TO BE THE BEST...

In 2025, the Mean Green will square off with seven teams that earned bids to last year's NCAA Tournament including a home-and-home series with Oklahoma State who have made the Women's College World Series in each of the past five seasons. The slate contains seven matchups against NFCA preseason ranked teams including a home opener against No. 13 Texas Tech at Lovelace Stadium on Feb. 18 with a road contest scheduled with the Red Raiders on April 22. In addition to Texas Tech, the Mean Green will face No. 24 Mississippi State, No. 20 Baylor and No. 4 OSU before it opens conference play with AAC champions Charlotte at home on March 7-9. Fifteen of the 28 unique opponents UNT will face this season finished inside the top 100 in NCAA RPI, including seven teams from The American.

PARTY AT THE LACE

The Mean Green began playing its home games at Lovelace Stadium in Denton, Texas in 2007. Since its inaugural season, Lovelace has hosted nearly 400 UNT softball games and 95,000 fans. Dating back to DeLong's first season in 2019, UNT has recorded a winning home record in six-consecutive seasons and holds a record of 82-26. Last season, the Mean Green hosted 11,026 fans at Lovelace Stadium with an average attendance of 424, both second-place marks in program history. This includes the third and sixth highest single-game crowds in UNT softball history and three of the top-five tournament session attendance marks.

The University of North Texas named Rodney DeLong as its fifth head softball coach, University President Neal Smatresk and Director of Athletics Wren Baker announced June 13, 2018.

DeLong's sixth season marked the end of an era with 10 seniors, including UNT cornerstones Kailey Gamble, Kalei Christensen, Mikayla Smith, Lexi Cobb and Molly Rainey, putting their final stamp on the program's history. The Mean Green posted 32 wins en route to the fifth-consecutive conference tournament semifinals appearance. The overall wins total was the fifth-best mark in program history and was the fourth-consecutive season with 30-plus wins.

In 2023, DeLong led the Mean Green to its fifth consecutive winning season and first home win over a top-10 ranked team in program history. North Texas mounted a late-season charge with wins in 10 of its final 11 games to place the team in its second-consecutive conference championship final.

DeLong became the winningest coach in UNT softball history on May 10, 2023, after a first-round win at the CUSA Championship. UNT led CUSA with seven all-league selections, including three first-team members: Kailey Gamble, Ashley Peters and Cierra Simon. The group was the second-largest in program history.

UNT continued its ascension in 2022 when it made its first NCAA Regionals appearance after capturing the CUSA tournament title. Five players were named all-conference selections with three players earning CUSA Championship All-Tournament honors, including MVP Molly Rainey. The team posted program-best marks in batting average (.290), slugging percentage (.512), runs scored (297), home runs (71), RBI (274) and total bases (707).

Year three of the DeLong experience in Denton featured more improvement, leading the team to its highest win total in program history with 38 as he earned CUSA Coach of the Year honors for the second time. The Mean Green won its first outright conference championship, with three players earning conference superlative awards and nine players named to all-conference teams.

During a shortened second season, DeLong continued to elevate the program to new heights. UNT started the season 13-2, which was the best 15-game start in program history and finished with a 19-5 record. The Mean Green set program and school history on Feb. 29 when it knocked off No. 5 Oklahoma on the road. The victory marked the first win in UNT Athletics history over a top-five ranked team on the road. Duly, DeLong captured his 50th career win for the Mean Green over OU, making him the fastest coach in program history to reach the 50 wins.

In DeLong's first season with the team, he was named CUSA Coach of the Year as the Mean Green broke or tied six school records including wins (35), runs scored (279), RBI (257), walks taken (207), doubles (78) and shutouts (8). The biggest success came on May 5, 2019, when the Mean Green captured its first Conference USA regular season championship. During year one of the DeLong era, the Mean Green earned four All-Conference selections.

A 14-year coaching veteran, DeLong came to North Texas after leading Austin Peay to a program-record 39 wins in 2018, snapping a 24-year streak of losing seasons. The 39-19 record in his first season with the Governors marked a 22-win improvement, the largest in NCAA Division I softball this year. APSU won a program-record three games on its way to a school-best third-place finish at the Ohio Valley Conference tournament, and the Governors earned an at-large bid into the National Invitational Softball Championship.

Prior to Austin Peay, DeLong was an assistant coach at Georgia Tech and served as the hitting instructor and infielders coach. During the 2017 campaign, the Yellow Jackets showed improvement in 11 different offensive categories and finished the season ranked 18th nationally in home runs per game (1.02), nearly doubling their average from 2016. Georgia Tech's defense ranked 59th nationally in double plays per game (0.40).

In his first collegiate coaching stop, DeLong compiled a 106-61 (.635) record at Cameron University and led the Aggies to consecutive NCAA Division II Softball Tournament appearances for the first time in program history. Under his tutelage, Cameron had 18 all-conference honorees, nine named all-region and two selected as All-Americans.

In his final season, the Aggies went 33-21 and 18-14 in the Lone Star Conference, good for a program-best third-place finish in conference. The 2015 squad posted a school-record 41 wins, including a program-record 17-game winning streak, and reached the South Central Regional final. In his inaugural season, DeLong led the program to its first winning season since 2009 with a 31-21 record.

Once considered one of the top high school softball coaches in Oklahoma, DeLong amassed a 211-64 (.767) record at Cache High School (2008-10; 2012-13) and Lawton MacArthur High School (2011). While at Cache, he led the Bulldogs to the 2013 state championship, as well as four regional championships and five district championships.

A two-year letter winner on Cameron's baseball team, DeLong played shortstop for the Aggies, starting in 79 games and finishing with 54 career RBI. He began his collegiate career at Northern Oklahoma-Tonkawa, earning second-team all-region honors after batting .390 with 10 home runs and 56 RBI as a sophomore.

The Lawton, Oklahoma native graduated from Cameron University in 2006 with a bachelor's degree in history before receiving his Masters of Education in sports administration at East Central University in 2013. Rodney and his wife Meghann have two children, their son Ryker and daughter Kaiya.

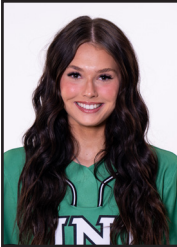

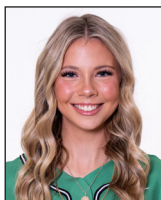
