

### SAMFORD VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE

- Samford and Mississippi State are meeting for the 17th time in series history with Miss State holding a 14-2 series lead.
- Samford defeated Miss State 3-2 last season on a walk-off Olivia Shaw double.
- Mississippi State is off to a 9-1 start with multiple top-25 wins and their lone defeat coming against #7 Duke.
- The Samford Bulldogs have the second-best offense in the SoCon so far this season averaging 7.1 runs per game.
- Samford has four qualified hiters batting over .400, led by Katie Campbell who is carrying a 1.264 OPS.

### SAMFORD QUICK LOOKS

- The Bulldogs are coming off a 24-32 season in 2024 where they went 12-9 in Southern Conference which put them third in the league standings.
- Samford had a conference-high five players named to the SoCon All-Conference team. Logan Champion and Olivia Shaw were named first team members while Jordyn Partain, Sarah Squillace, and McKayla Cothran were named to the second team.
- The heart of the order returns for the Bulldogs as their top seven hitters return from last year's team that was second in the conference in scoring and average.
- In the circle, the Dogs return Jordyn Partain who threw a team-high 150 innings last year. Samford will have to replace 140+ innings from pitchers who are no longer on the roster.
- On the national stage, Katie Campbell ranked top 100 nationally in home runs (15/60th) and RBIs (56/38th) last season for the Bulldoas.
- Head coach Megan Curry is in her first season as head coach of the Bulldogs after a four-year playing career where she was named SoCon Player of the Year in 2016. She has had coaching stops as an assitant at Samford and as a head coach at Asbury and Birmingham-Southern.


