KEY NOTES

PLAYER/TEAM NOTES

- Of Memphis' 25 players on the 2026 roster, 13 are returners, with the 12 newcomers composed of 4 freshmen and 8 transfers.
- Two Tigers have international team experience as Angelo State transfer **Paris Brienesse** joined the Swedish Senior National Team after playing at the U18 and U22 levels and freshman **Taylor Caton** is a member of the 18U Canadian National Team.
- **Paris Brienesse** is also the 2nd international player in program history, with the first being Ellen Roberts (2011-14) from Australia.
- Senior pitcher **Rylee Dugar** enters the season with the 5th-most appearances (94), 7th-most starts (56) and 10th-most innings pitched (313.2) in program history.
- The Tigers return 4 of 6 players that started at least 40 games last season (**Kennedy Semien**, **Kayla Clement**, **Ariel Davis**, **Neely Taylor**).
- A Memphis pitching staff that utilized 4 arms last season is expected to have 7 pitchers available, including multiple two-way players in RHP/DP **Taniyah Brown**, RHP/OF **Mya Clark**, RHP/INF **Taylor Caton** and RHP/INF **Avery Stutts**.

A NEW STANDARD IN YEAR TWO

- Memphis enters year two of the **Trena Prater** era with a steep increase in nonconference competition. During the 2026 season, the Tigers will play 10 games against Power Four opponents, including six games against teams from the SEC. A total of 16 games will be played against teams that played in an NCAA Regional in 2025, including two games against 2025 Women's College World Series teams (Oklahoma, Ole Miss). The slate features four teams (Oklahoma, Ole Miss, LSU, Mississippi State) who were in the end-of-season NFCA Top 25.
- Joining the staff for the 2026 season is **Pat Grant**. Grant has had a successful coaching career at the prep level and was also a student manager at Mississippi State during Vann Steudemann's time as the head coach. Steudemann is currently the head coach at fellow American Conference school, UTSA.
- The Tigers reloaded during the offseason, bringing in 8 transfers, 6 of which come from D1 schools. **Zereniti Sousa** (Utah State), **Jasmine Mack** (George Mason), **Jazmine Chavez** (UNLV), **Mya Clark** (Iowa), **Deana Cunningham** (UCF) and **Isabella Hune** (Texas A&M-Corpus Christi) all join the Tigers with playing experience at the D1 level.
- Memphis also gains international experience with the addition of **Paris Brienesse** from Angelo State. Brienesse, a native of Stockholm, Sweden, recently made her debut for the Swedish Senior National Team in the 2025 WBSC European Championships.
- Head Coach **Trena Prater** is also establishing a new feel for the program as the 2026 season will be Memphis' first ticketed season in its now 21-year program history.

Prater joined the Tigers in August 2024, becoming the fourth head coach in program history. She comes to Memphis after leading Campbell University to a 79-39-1 record with a Big South Championship and an NCAA Regional appearance in 2023.

In her first season at the helm in 2025, Prater led the Tigers to their highest level of success in nearly half a decade. Memphis' 5 American wins were the most since 2018 and the 19 overall wins were the most since the 2019 season. Under Prater, Memphis also recorded its third-ever American Conference Tournament victory with a 6-5 win over seventh-seeded UAB, which was also the first tournament win since 2018.

Memphis also set top-10 marks in program history in 14 different single-season statistics, highlighted by the second-most runs scored (257) in program history and top-five marks in stolen bases, doubles, triples, RBI and sacrifice flies. The pitching staff also saw its team ERA drop by 1.27 in the first season of the Prater era.

In 2024, Campbell Softball thrived in its first season in the Coastal Athletic Association, with Prater being named the 2024 CAA Coach of the Year. Under Prater, the Fighting Camels secured a regular-season conference title, while setting a conference record with 22 wins in CAA play.

That season, Prater's Fighting Camels took home multiple CAA honors, including Isabella Smith as CAA Pitcher of the Year, Alyssa Henault as Player of the Year and Lindsay Lumsden as Rookie of the Year.

In her first season at Campbell in 2023, the Fighting Camels secured their third-ever NCAA Regional win with a 7-1 triumph over George Mason in the Durham Regional. Nine players were named to the Big South All-Conference Team that year, with Smith earning the first of her two Pitcher of the Year honors, and Madilyn Gillespie earning Big South Freshman of the Year. Campbell's 42 wins in 2023 under Prater

are tied for the second-most in a single season in Campbell history.

From 2019-2022, Prater served as an assistant coach at Iowa, also being named the associate head coach for the 2022 season. While with the Hawkeyes, Prater helped head coach Renee Gillespie compile 93 wins.

As an assistant coach with UCF in 2018, Prater helped the Lady Knights reach 34 wins. This was also where she met Assistant Coach, Cassady Brewer, who played 52 games in her junior season with UCF and carried a .338 batting average.

Prater served as the head coach at the University of Buffalo from 2013-2017. In her first season, she led the Bulls to a 30-22 record and the best conference winning percentage in the MAC East Division. Her 2014 Buffalo team had three First-Team All-MAC selections in Tori Speckman, Sammi Gallardo and Holly Luciano.

Prater's first experience as a head coach came at Hampton University, where she led the Pirates to 35 wins in 2013. She additionally had stops as an assistant coach at Mississippi Valley State, Maryland and George Washington.

Prater was also a standout player at LSU from 1999-2002. She earned Southeastern Conference Player of the Year honors in 2002 while also being a semifinalist for the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award. As a Tiger, Prater was a three-time All-SEC selection and an Easton First-Team All-American and NFCA Second-Team All-American in 2002.

At LSU, Prater holds the records for single-season triples (14, 2002), career triples (27) and is tied for most career games started (273). She led the Tigers to a third-place finish in the NCAA Women's College World Series in 2001 and helped LSU to a 230-45 record as a player.

Prater also played professionally for the Akron Racers (2004, 2008-09), New York Juggernauts (2005), Chicago Bandits (2006) and the Philadelphia Force (2007) in the National Pro Fastpitch League.






