QUICK LOOK AT THE AGGIES

- Head coach Trisha Ford is in her fourth season in Aggieland and 16th overall as a head coach.
- Texas A&M returns 15 letter winners from a 2025 squad that finished 48-11 and claimed the program's first SEC Tournament title.
- Six newcomers have made Davis Diamond their home, including three transfers and three freshmen.

WHERE THE AGGIES ARE NATIONALLY

- The Aggies rank No. 11 in ESPN/USA Softball and Softball America polls, while sitting at No. 12 in the NFCA and No. 13 in D1 Softball rankings.
- The pitching staff ranks eighth nationally with a 3.41 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 17th with a 1.23 WHIP, while the offense ranks seventh in on-base percentage (.459), 11th in batting average (.357), 16th in scoring (7.47) and 17th in slugging percentage (.602).
- Individually, Mya Perez ranks third nationally in on-base percentage (.621) and Micaela Wark is 12th in RBI (61). Wark also ranks 14th with 18 home runs and Perez is 25th in slugging percentage at .927. Sidne Peters is 11th with four saves.
- Wark was named the Louisville Slugger/NFCA Player of the Week on March 31, making her the first Aggie since Julia Cottrill in 2023 to receive the weekly honor. The graduate student batted .750 (9-for-12) with three home runs, eight RBI and five runs scored in four games, including three at No. 1 Texas. She slugged 1.500, reached base at a .786 clip, was 5-for-6 with runners in scoring position and a perfect 4-for-4 with two outs.

WHERE THE AGGIES ARE IN THE SEC

- Texas A&M is 11-4 in SEC play and are fourth in the standings entering the Mississippi State series. The Aggies have won four of five series this season including a road series in Baton Rouge for the first time in program history and a road sweep at Ole Miss, while claiming a pair of home series against Kentucky and Georgia.
- Against SEC opponents, the offense ranks second in the league in batting average (.331), on-base percentage (.429), OPS (.964) and doubles (22).
- In SEC play, Kennedy Powell leads the league with 24 hits and six doubles, while ranking second with 20 runs. Micaela Wark leads the conference with a 1.497 OPS and Mya Perez is first with a .638 on-base percentage.
- Mya Perez was named the SEC Player of the Week after the LSU series, marking the first weekly honor for Texas A&M this season. Perez slashed .833/.909/2.000 and reached base in 10 of her 11 plate appearances, going 5-for-6 with two home runs, a double, five walks, while adding six RBI and two runs scored.

BUILT FORD TOUGH

- Known for her blue-collar mentality, head coach Trisha Ford has instilled that attitude into her program, leading Texas A&M to its first national No. 1 national ranking and No. 1 overall NCAA Tournament seed in 2025.
- Ford became the third-fastest coach to guide a new program to No. 1 in the ESPN poll era, reaching the milestone in 159 games. Texas A&M has appeared in the top 25 in 54 of 59 weekly polls under her watch.
- In the Ford era, the Maroon & White have won 15 of 21 SEC series and have finished at least four spots higher than their pre-season projection in the SEC coaches poll each season.
- On May 5, 2025, USA Softball announced Ford was selected to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching pool for the 2025-28 quad. Coaches will assist with camps and training sessions leading up to the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles

WARK IT LIKE I TALK IT

- Micaela Wark is putting together a career-best season after transferring from Oklahoma State prior to 2026. The graduate student ranks among the top 25 nationally in home runs (18), RBI (61) and sacrifice flies (5). Friday's opener marks her 200th career start. She has appeared in 212 games and sits three home runs shy of 50 for her career.
- In SEC play, Wark leads the league with a 1.497 OPS. Her seven home runs are tied for the second-most in program history during conference play, trailing only Haley Lee (2022) and Tori Vidales (2015, 2016), who each recorded eight. The graduate student is slashing .425/.547/.950 against SEC foes with seven homers, 24 RBI and 11 runs.
- At Davis Diamond, Wark has been dominant, hitting .407/.521/.963. In 20 home games, she is 22-for-54 with 10 home runs, 30 RBI and 19 runs scored.
- A native of Frisco, Texas, Wark earned NFCA First Team All-Region honors and All-Big 12 All-Freshman Team recognition in 2023 after redshirting at Kansas in 2022. She later helped Oklahoma State reach the Women's College World Series and earned back-to-back NFCA All-Region honors.
- Wark's work ethic aligns with Ford's blue-collar mentality and emphasis on battling adversity. The fifth-year player has overcome multiple knee injuries dating back to her junior year of high school and is now as strong and healthy as she has been at any point in her career, as reflected in her numbers.

MY-OH-MYA

- Mya Perez entered the 2026 season as one of the nation's premier hitters following a breakout sophomore campaign that earned Second Team All-America honors, along with NFCA All-Region Second Team and First Team All-SEC recognition.
- Perez has slashed .467/.639/1.133 in 20 true home games this season, while she is averaging .382 at the dish and boasting a 1.256 OPS against conference foes. Perez is first in the SEC and third nationally with 42 walks. She has been walked in 28 games, including 12 of 15 SEC games. Her 23 walks in SEC play rank first in the conference and have set a program record.
- The junior is the only Aggie to have reached base in each game this season as she enters the Mississippi State series with a 46-game on-base streak, marking the second longest active streak in the nation.
- Perez was recently named the SEC Player of the Week for the first time this season and third time in her career. She went 3-for-3 with a double, a home run, walk and three RBI in game one and followed going 2-for-3 with a home run and three RBI in game two to help Texas A&M clinch its first road series at LSU in program history. Perez was walked in all four plate appearances in game three.
- In 2025, the Corona, California, native broke a 43-year-old Texas A&M single-season record with 73 RBI, while posting a .424 batting average (third in program history) and a .804 slugging percentage (sixth). She ranked top 20 nationally in on-base percentage (.561) and RBI (73).
- Perez stayed active over the summer representing the Mexican National Team, earning Player of the Day honors at the Pan American Women's Championship and winning the MLB Home Run Derby X as a member of Team Dodgers.

OL' RELIABLE

- Senior Kennedy Powell has been a fixture at the hot corner, starting every game this season at third base. Since joining the Aggies in 2024, she has appeared in 160 games with 159 starts. Her 150 career runs in the Maroon & White rank eight most in program history.
- In her collegiate career, she has appeared in 219 games, making 204 starts. She recently eclipsed 200 career hits and 50 career stolen bases, making her just one of 13 active players nationally to achieve the accomplishment.
- The run-scoring catalyst ranks second in the SEC in league play with 20 runs, just four runs shy of her program record. She leads the conference with 24 hits and six doubles. Nationally her 64 hits rank No. 18 and her 53 runs rank No. 21.
- In the team's last 10 games she is averaging .400 going 16-for-40 with four doubles, one triple and eight runs. Powell was the lone Aggie to register multiple hits in each game of the road series sweep at Ole Miss.
- Powell successfully stole 42 consecutive bases, an NCAA-leading active streak dating to February 2024, before she was caught attempting to swipe second base in game two of the Cotton Holdings Lone Star Showdown series.
- As the team's primary leadoff hitter, Powell led the Aggies with 63 runs scored in 2025, setting a program single-season record. She also tied the Texas A&M record with 24 runs scored in SEC play, ranking second in the conference in stolen bases and third in runs. Texas A&M went 36-5 in games she scored.

ALOHA MADDIE

- Freshman Maddie Sauni has emerged as a reliable pinch hitter, batting .500 (6-for-12) with one home run, two doubles and five RBI, while striking out just once.
- Sauni recently hit her first career pinch-hit home run against Baylor, becoming the first Aggie to record a pinch-hit homer since 2024.
- She has reached base in five consecutive pinch-hit appearances, highlighted by a two-out RBI single in the sixth inning that lifted Texas A&M to a 3-2 win over No. 11 Georgia in the series opener.
- A native of Laie, Hawai'i, Sauni is easily a club house favorite and one that always make the 12th Man smile whether from watching her pregame dancing or celebrating after a clutch at-bat.

OFFENSIVE PROWESS

- The Aggies have homered in all but 10 games this season and have recorded multiple home runs in 17 games. The Maroon & White have recorded at least one extra-base hit in all but one game this season, with the lone exception coming in game two at Texas, which snapped a 68-game streak. Since 2023, the Aggies have been held without an extra-base hit just 18 times.
- A&M is 19-3 in games when scoring in the first inning and are 28-1 this season when leading after the fourth inning.
- The Aggies have scored 10 or more runs in 12 games, winning each time and have recorded double-digit hits and runs in 10 games this season.

THE LONG ROAD TO AGGIELAND

- Ariel Kowalewski made her Aggie debut after sitting out the 2025 season due to SEC midyear transfer rules. She leads the team with 15 doubles and is one of three Aggies to average .400-plus at the dish this season. Kowalewski is fourth on the team with seven home runs and 33 RBI.
- After starting the first 19 games in right field, the versatile defender has started the last 24 games at catcher. During that span she has averaged .429 going 30-for-70 with three homers, eight doubles, 18 RBI and 20 runs, while showcasing her arm strength behind the dish with a game ending pick off throw to second in Game 2 at Ole Miss to secure the series victory.
- Kowalewski is second on the team with 16 multi-hit games and fourth with eight multi-RBI games, while she is leading the team with a 10 game hitting streak entering the Mississippi State series.
- She has been nearly unstoppable in the last 10 games slashing .484/.556/.677 with one homer, three doubles, seven RBI and 10 runs, while striking out just twice in 31 at-bats.
- As a freshman at Florida in 2024, she started 56 games at third base, batting .308 with eight home runs and 33 RBI.
- Originally from Richmond, Texas, she was a multiple-time District MVP at Travis High School, a 2022 PGF Futures All-American and a 2017 USA Softball All-American.

ONE CIRCLE, ONE STANDARD

- Sydney Lessentine leads the staff and has not issued more than two walks in each of her 28 appearances. The sophomore has shown her versatility as of late earning two saves in her last three appearances.
- Lessentine has appeared in 14 of 15 SEC games with a 5-2 ledger and two saves. She has totaled 48.0 innings of work with 38 strikeouts.
- Sidne Peters leads the team at home with a 1.23 ERA and a 7-1 record with two saves in 13 appearances in 40.0 innings of work totaling 50 strikeouts. Against SEC foes, she owns a 4-1 record with a 3.28 ERA and four saves in 11 appearances, striking out 42 batters in 32.0 innings pitched.
- Lessentine led the 2025 staff in ERA (2.85), WHIP (1.18) and batting average against (.179).
- Peters posted a 7-0 record with a 1.75 ERA in 36.0 innings in 2025, striking out 43 and walking 10 while holding opponents to a .221 average.

PERFECTO

- Kate Munnerlyn tossed the program's first perfect game in 21 years in an 8-0 run-rule win over Kennesaw State.
- The sophomore faced the minimum 15 batters, striking out three while throwing 51 pitches, including 38 strikes.
- It marked the first perfect game of the Trisha Ford era and the eighth no-hitter under Ford.

MISSISSIPPI STATE SERIES

- Texas A&M holds a 17-12 advantage in the all-time series, including a 9-3 mark at home. The Aggies last hosted Mississippi State in 2023, sweeping the series and outscoring the Bulldogs 16-3.
- The teams met last season in Starkville, where Texas A&M won the series by taking the first two games before dropping the finale, 6-5.

HOME OF THE 12TH MAN

- The Aggies own a 182-56 (.765) record at Davis Diamond since it opened on April 27, 2018 and are 17-3 at home this season. The 12th Man set a Davis Diamond attendance record at 2,880 in the fourth home game of the season on Feb. 7. and ranks sixth nationally with an average attendance of 2,044.
- Texas A&M finished the 2025 season 28-8 at home and averaged 2,136 attendance per game, the highest in Davis Diamond history. A&M ranked No. 5 in the nation and No. 4 in the SEC.

AUSL IN AGGIELAND

- Davis Diamond will host the 2026 Athletes Unlimited Softball League postseason, including the play-in game and championship series, July 23-27.
- Game 1 of the AUSL Championship will air on ABC, marking the first professional softball game broadcast on network television.
- Texas A&M has strong ties to the league. Tori Vidales '18 has been a foundational figure in Athletes Unlimited since its 2020 launch, serving three years on the Player Executive Committee. She also hit the first home run in AUSL Championship history while helping lead the Talons to a title. Jami Lobpries '08 is the general manager for the Portland Cascade and Amanda Scarborough '08 continues to serve as a lead analyst on AUSL broadcasts. Emiley Kennedy '25 begins her second professional season after being selected seventh overall in the 2025 draft by the Chicago Bandits.

HOW TO FOLLOW

- The series begins Friday at 6 p.m., on SEC Network+ with Chelsea Reber (analyst) and Giovanni Heater (play-by-play) in the booth. Game 2 is Saturday at 11 a.m. and the series finale is slated for 1 p.m. on Sunday, with Donna Conrad (analyst) and Will Johnson (play-by-play) on the call.
- Fans can also listen on the 12th Man Mobile app or locally on Willy 1550 AM, with Matt Simon calling the action in his 12th season as the voice of Texas A&M softball.



HEAD COACH TRISHA FORD

Trisha Ford, a 16-year head coaching veteran and four-time conference coach of the year, is in her fourth season leading the Texas A&M softball program. She was named the Aggies' 10th head coach on June 7, 2022, following previous coaching stops at Arizona State, Fresno State, Stanford and Saint Mary's. On May 5, USA Softball announced Ford was selected to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching pool for the 2025-28 quad.

Since her arrival in Aggieland, Ford has guided the Maroon & White to three NCAA Tournament appearances and the program's first national No. 1 overall seed in 2025. Her tenure has produced four NFCA All-Americans, 16 NFCA All-Region selections and 13 All-SEC honorees. Texas A&M has made 44 weekly top-25 appearances under her watch, including its first-ever No. 1 ranking in both the NFCA and ESPN polls. Ford became the third-fastest coach to lead a new program to the top spot in the ESPN poll era, reaching the milestone in just 159 games.

The 2025 season marked a historic campaign, as Ford led A&M to a 48-11 record, the most wins since 2008 and fifth-most in school history. The Aggies finished second in the SEC regular season standings at 16-7, their highest placing since joining the league in 2013, and were declared SEC Tournament Co-Champions. Despite a weather-shortened bracket, A&M set tournament records in batting average (.418), runs (26) and RBI (25), while posting a 14-2 semifinal run-rule win over Texas, the largest margin of victory in SEC Tournament history. The season also saw school records set in runs (432), RBI (416), doubles (99) and run-rule victories (20). The Aggies collected a program-best seven SEC weekly honors and seven NFCA All-Region selections, the most since 1982. Mya Perez and Mac Barbara earned NFCA All-America Second Team accolades, becoming the first Aggie duo to earn All-America honors in the same season since 2013. Perez was also named a College Sports Communicators Academic All-American, the first Aggie since 2008 and only the fourth in the program's history.

Known nationally as a pitching guru, Ford continued to develop All-American Emiley Kennedy, who became the first Aggie to earn All-SEC First Team honors in consecutive seasons and just the 10th pitcher in program history to reach 500 career strikeouts. Sydney Lessentine set a single-game program record with 19 strikeouts and led the team in ERA (2.85), WHIP (1.18) and opponent batting average (.179).

In 2024, Texas A&M posted a 44-15 record and went 27-2 at Davis Diamond, the best home winning percentage (.931) since 2011. The Aggies hosted an NCAA Regional and advanced to the Super Regionals for the first time since 2018. They finished third in the SEC at 15-9, won six-of-eight conference series and reached the SEC Tournament semifinals. Kennedy earned NFCA Second Team All-America honors after setting program records in SEC play for innings pitched (100.1) and strikeouts (86).

Ford's debut season in 2023 saw A&M finish 35-21 overall and 12-12 in SEC play. The Aggies earned a No. 2 seed in the Austin Regional, extending their NCAA postseason streak to 21 seasons. Ford was one of only three Division I head coaches, and the only one from a Power 5 program, to lead her team to the NCAA Tournament in her first season. The Aggies appeared in all four major national polls for the first time since 2019, spending 15 straight weeks in the D1 Softball rankings and climbing as high as No. 13. The pitching staff lowered its ERA from 3.71 in 2022 to 2.70 in 2023 and tossed three no-hitters. Julia Cottrill earned NFCA Third Team All-America honors and was joined by Rylen Wiggins, Amari Harper and Koko Wooley in earning All-SEC and NFCA All-Region recognition.

Over her head coaching career, Ford owns a 524-273-1 (.657) record, including a 212-89 (.704) mark at Arizona State. She was named Pac-12 Coach of the Year in 2018 and 2022, guiding the Sun Devils to their first Pac-12 title since 2011 and a Women's College World Series appearance in 2018. Her six-year tenure in Tempe produced five All-Americans and 20 All-Conference selections.

Before arriving at Arizona State, Ford served as head coach at Fresno State from 2013 to 2016, earning Mountain West Coach of the Year honors in 2015 and 2016 after leading the Bulldogs to back-to-back 40-win seasons and conference titles. Her 2016 team finished 42-12-1 with a 22-1 mark in league play and a school-record 23-game win streak.

Ford also spent nine seasons at Stanford from 2004 to 2012, including four as associate head coach, helping the Cardinal compile a 385-155 record during the most successful era in program history. She began her head coaching career at her alma mater, Saint Mary's, where she also starred as a player. The only female student-athlete in school history to have her jersey retired, Ford was inducted into the Saint Mary's Hall of Fame in 2007. A native of Fremont, California, she and her husband, Eddie, have two children, Emma and EJ.

A&M SCORIGAMI NOTES

- There have been 182 unique score combinations, including 107 unique winning scores and 75 losing unique scores.
- In the Trisha Ford era, there have been 14 scorigami occurrences, including a school record 25-0 win against East Texas A&M (formerly Texas A&M-Commerce) on Feb. 12, 2023.
- Four of the five most common scores are wins, with the exception of losing 1-0 (91 times).

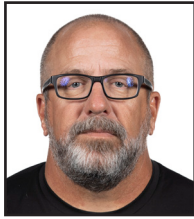
