SEC teams enter second week of 2019 season

• Week two of the 2019 college baseball season features the first midweek games of the year. SEC teams compiled a 34-7 record during opening weekend for an .829 winning percentage.

• Eight SEC teams are ranked in the top-25 of various national polls this week. LSU is ranked No. 1 in three of the major polls, while Vanderbilt is No. 1 in two others. Florida is as high as No. 3, Georgia and Mississippi State as high as No. 9, Ole Miss No. 10, Arkansas No. 12 and Auburn No. 18.

• A total of 164,712 fans attended games in SEC stadiums during opening weekend. LSU led the nation with 35,463 fans (11,821 per game) attending its three home games.

National Leaders

• Tennessee leads the country with a 0.00 ERA. The Vols did not allow a run in their three-game sweep of Appalachian State.

• Kentucky's Carson Coleman is tied with five others players with two wins.

• Florida's Nolan Crisp is among a group of players tied for first nationally with a pair of saves.

2019 Video Review

• In 2019, the NCAA has approved one set of Video Review Rules for all games: These rules can be used in both Conference and Non-Conference games, including the SEC Tournament. The Head Coach Challenge System and Crew Chief Initiated review after the 7th Inning of a 9 inning and 5th of a 7 inning scheduled contests remains in effect. The SEC will use a Centralized Replay system for Conference baseball games in 2019. A Replay Official in the SEC Video Center located in the Conference Office will review plays in SEC vs. SEC games and will render decisions that will be communicated to the umpire staff via headsets on the field at stadiums.

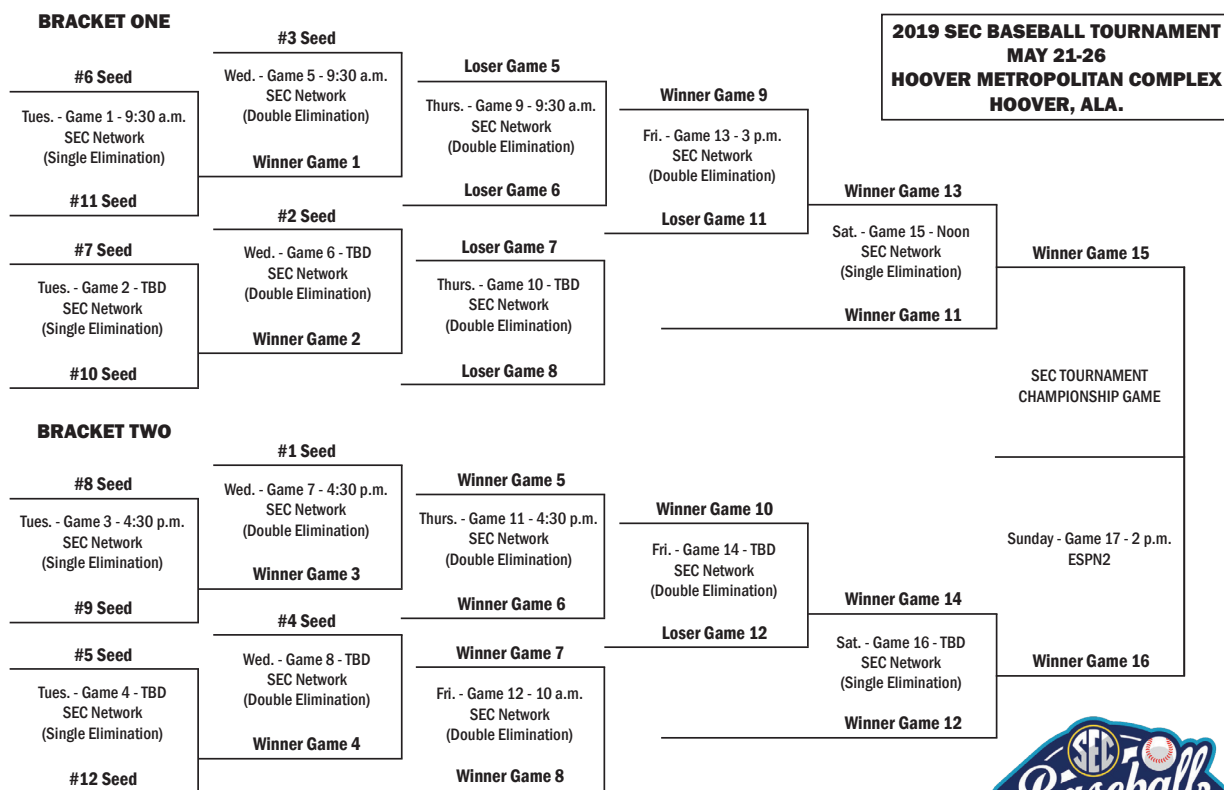

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
 - If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner
- Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.
 - If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
