Six SEC teams ranked in top-10 in polls released this week

• A total of six SEC teams are ranked in the top-10 in new polls released this week. LSU and Vanderbilt are ranked as high as No. 1 in five major polls, Florida is No. 3, Georgia No. 7, Mississippi State No. 9 and Ole Miss No. 10. A total of nine SEC teams are ranked in the top-25 of various polls.

• Three SEC teams enter the third week of the season with an undefeated record: LSU (7-0), Tennessee (7-0) and Georgia (6-0).

• The top four national attendance leaders are from the SEC (LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina and Texas A&M). Florida and Ole Miss are ranked sixth and seventh, respectively.

National Leaders

• SEC teams leading the country include: Tennessee with a 0.57 ERA, five shutouts, 7.42 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 0.62 WHIP; and South Carolina with 2.20 home runs per game.

• Florida's Nolan Crisp is tied for the national lead with four saves.

2019 Video Review

• In 2019, the NCAA has approved one set of Video Review Rules for all games: These rules can be used in both Conference and Non-Conference games, including the SEC Tournament. The Head Coach Challenge System and Crew Chief Initiated review after the 7th Inning of a 9 inning and 5th of a 7 inning scheduled contests remains in effect. The SEC will use a Centralized Replay system for Conference baseball games in 2019. A Replay Official in the SEC Video Center located in the Conference Office will review plays in SEC vs. SEC games and will render decisions that will be communicated to the umpire staff via headsets on the field at stadiums. The system is consistent with the process used by Major League Baseball.

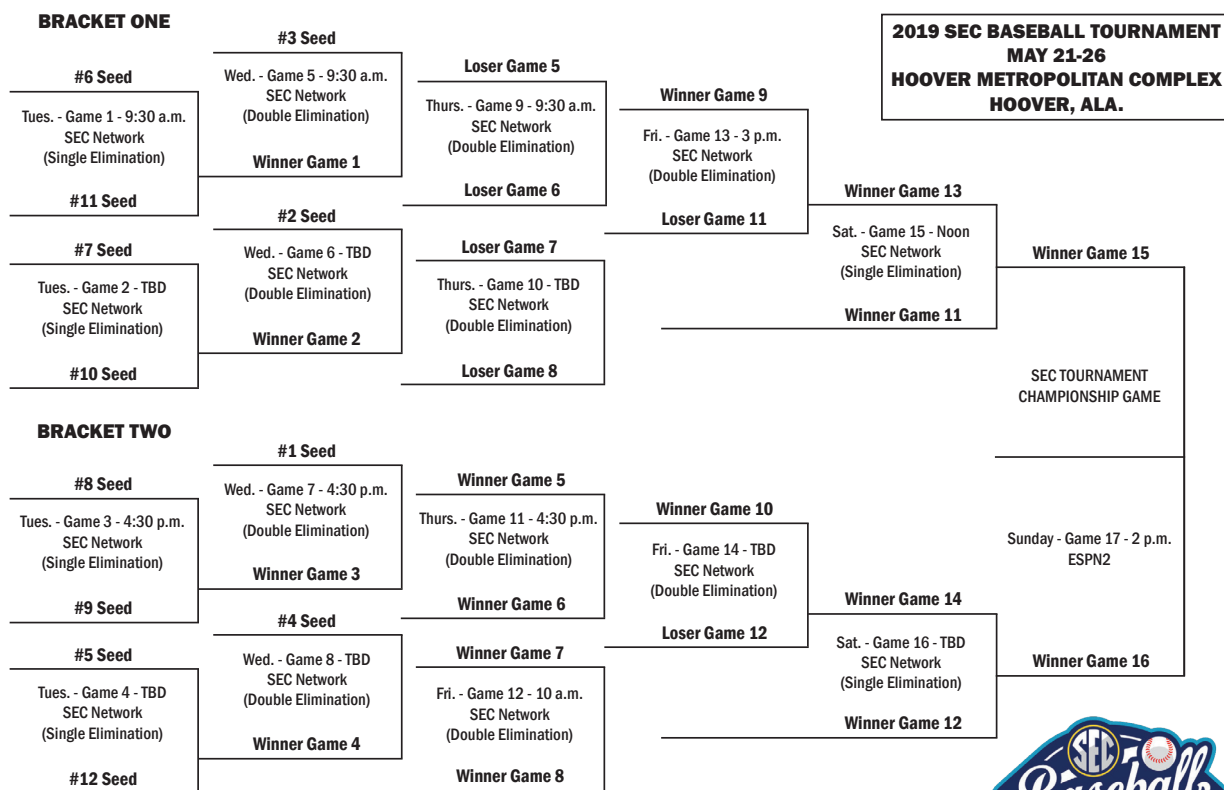

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
 - If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner
- Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.
 - If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
