Eleven SEC teams ranked in top-25

• A total of 11 SEC baseball teams are ranked in the top-25 of four major polls entering the first week of conference play. For the second consecutive week, 11 SEC teams are ranked in the USA Today Coaches Poll, the first time 11 teams from any conference have been ranked in the poll. SEC teams have compiled an .820 winning percentage. At this time last year, the SEC's winning percentage was .777.

• The top six national attendance leaders are from the SEC (LSU, Mississippi State, Ole Miss, South Carolina, Arkansas and Texas A&M). Ten SEC schools rank in the top-20 of the nation's attendance leaders.

• The SEC will implement a Centralized Replay System for its Conference games beginning this weekend. A Replay Official in the SEC Video Center located in the Conference Office will review plays in SEC vs. SEC games and will render decisions that will be communicated to the umpire staff via headsets on the field at stadiums. The system is consistent with the process used by Major League Baseball.

National Leaders

- Tennessee leads the nation with six shutouts.
- Vanderbilt is first nationally with 12.5 strikeouts per nine innings.
- Mississippi State's 0.92 WHIP leads the nation.
- Florida's Nolan Crisp has a nation-leading seven saves this season.

2019 Video Review

• In 2019, the NCAA has approved one set of Video Review Rules for all games: These rules can be used in both Conference and Non-Conference games, including the SEC Tournament. The Head Coach Challenge System and Crew Chief Initiated review after the 7th Inning of a 9 inning and 5th of a 7 inning scheduled contests remains in effect.

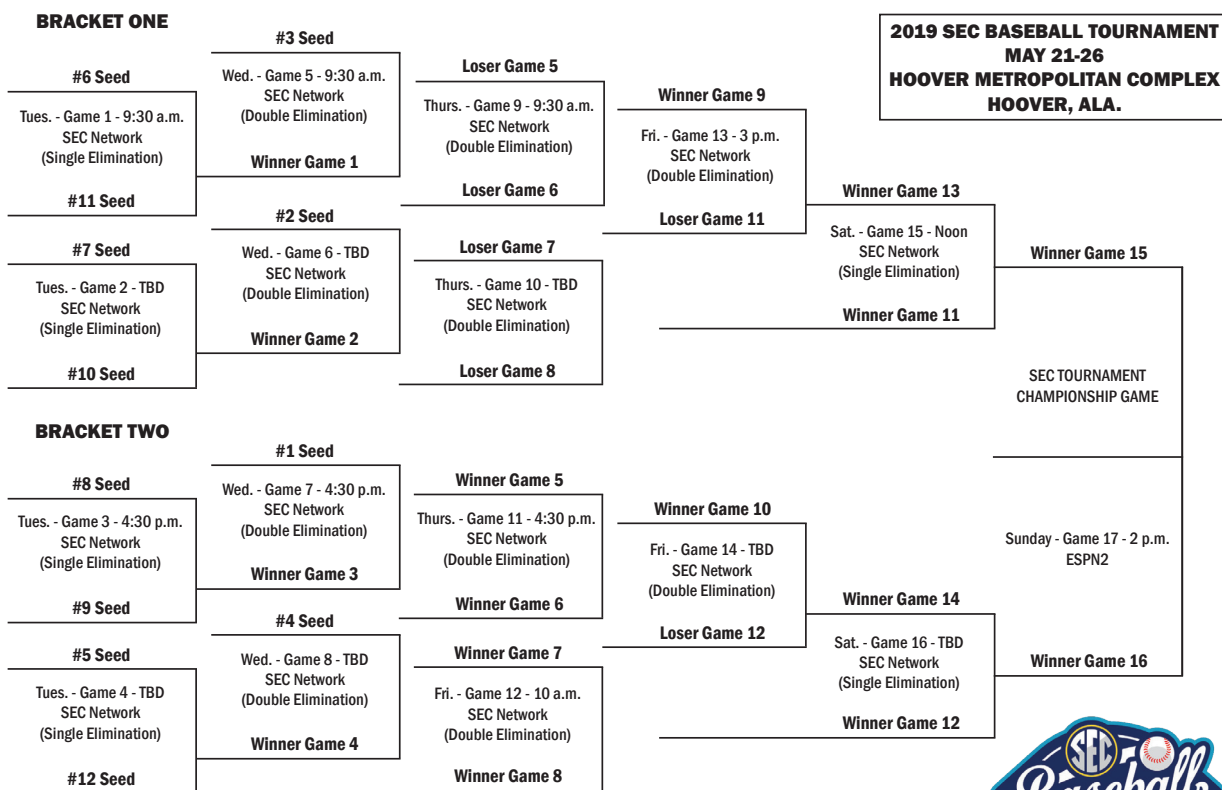

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
 - If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner
- Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.
 - If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
