- Mississippi State and Vanderbilt will meet for the second time this season, with both meetings coming in the postseason. VU took a 1-0 decision over MSU at the SEC Tournament.

- Mississippi State and Vanderbilt have met 119 times prior to Tuesday's meeting at the College World Series, with MSU owning a 69-49-1 edge on the all-time ledger.
- The meeting at the College World Series marks the fifth-straight meeting in the postseason for the two programs. The Bulldogs and Commodores met three times in the 2018 NCAA Nashville Regional, one in the 2019 SEC Tournament, before tonight's contest in Omaha.
- Head coach **Chris Lemonis** became the winningest first-year head coach in Southeastern Conference history versus South Carolina with his 45th win of the year, passing LSU's *Smoke Laval* (44, 2002).
- The trio of redshirt-junior **Ethan Small**, senior **Jake Mangum** and sophomore **Justin Foscue** each earned first-team All-America honors from the College Baseball Foundation, giving MSU 19 All-America honors this season.
- Senior **Jake Mangum** doubled to start a ninth-inning rally, marking his 72nd career two-bagger and etching his name atop the MSU career charts. Mangum now owns the MSU career records for;
 - Games played (260)
 - Hits (380)
 - At-bats (1,067)
 - Doubles (72)
- Mississippi State posted its 28th comeback win of the season in the opening round of the College World Series, a total that leads the nation. The top five in come-back wins are:
 - Mississippi State** 28
 - Texas Tech 25
 - FAU 24
 - North Carolina 23
 - Stanford 23
 - UCLA 23
- Senior **Peyton Plumlee** will make his 16th start of the season and was drafted by the Houston Astros in the 31st round of the 2019 MLB Draft.

- The Diamond Dawgs lead the NCAA in doubles (162) and hits (738) entering Tuesday's game versus Vanderbilt, while ranking No. 5 in runs scored (524).
- The quintet of **Jake Mangum** (23), **Tanner Allen** (22), **Justin Foscue** (22), **Jordan Westburg** (20) and **Elijah MacNamee** (20) have accounted for 107 of those doubles, a total that would rank tied for 75th nationally if they were their own team.
- Freshman **JT Ginn** owns two National Freshman of the Year honors, while becoming the 36th Freshman All-American in Mississippi State history.
- Redshirt-junior **Ethan Small** was named a first-team All-American and the National Pitcher of the Year by the College Baseball Foundation.
- Small currently leads the NCAA with 176 strikeouts, which are also the Mississippi State single-season record. With eight strikeouts against Auburn in the College World Series opener, Small passed **Eric DuBose** (174; 1996) for the MSU single season mark and a spot in the Southeastern Conference top-five.
- Sophomore **Tanner Allen** owns the longest active hitting streak on the squad at 12 games, while also owning the a career-best 19-game reached base streak.

- Sophomore **Jordan Westburg** is riding a career-long 18-game reached base streak, which is his fourth double-digit reached base streak of the season.

- Of the 13 losses in 2019 for the Diamond Dawgs, five of them have come in one-run games, with four of those against ranked opponents.
- Mississippi State improved to 11-5 overall in one-run games this season with its third walk-off win of the season against Auburn on Sunday evening to open the College World Series.

When Chris Lemonis stepped to the podium on June 25, 2018 at Dudy Noble Field to become the 18th head baseball coach in Mississippi State's storied history, a journey of nearly 40 years came full circle. The son of a 1973 State graduate, Lemonis resided in Starkville as a child and now returned to lead one of the perennial powerhouses in college baseball.

One of the top recruiters and player development coaches in the country, Lemonis has seen success at every coaching stop. After helping his alma mater, The Citadel, to five NCAA Regional appearances in 12 seasons as an assistant coach, Lemonis joined college teammate Dan McDonnell's staff at Louisville and quickly turned the Cardinals into a consistent Omaha contender. After helping Louisville to seven postseason berths in eight years, the 2013 American Baseball Coaches Association/Baseball America Assistant Coach of the Year headed to Indiana University to take his first head coaching job in 2015.

In his first season at the helm of Indiana, the Hoosiers found themselves in the NCAA Tournament and, after finishing third in the Big Ten standings during his second season, Lemonis became the first coach in program history to take IU to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in years three and four. The 2018 Hoosiers took the No. 2 seed into the NCAA Austin Regional, falling in the regional final to eventual College World Series participant Texas. Three of IU's eight appearances in the NCAA Tournament came under Lemonis' watch.

Overall, Lemonis enters his 25th season as a collegiate coach in 2019, making three College World Series appearances as a coach, earning 15 NCAA tournament berths and aiding in three 50-win seasons. His pupils have earned 25 All-America honors, 12 Freshman All-America laurels and 65 have signed professional baseball contracts, with 14 getting the call up to Major League Baseball.

Owning a head coaching record of 141-91-2, Lemonis was also a part of nearly 800 wins as an assistant coach. During his time at Indiana, Lemonis' teams averaged 35.3 wins per season, including a 40-win campaign during his final season in Bloomington. He averaged 39.2 victories per year during his career in an assistant role, bolstered by a 44.9 wins-per-season average at Louisville. The Cardinals were college baseball's winningest program during that eight-year span.

Lemonis' 15 postseason appearances have spanned all three of his coaching stops, with five coming as an assistant at The Citadel, seven during his assistant coaching tenure at Louisville and three as the head coach at Indiana. The Cardinals advanced to the Super Regionals on four occasions, punching a ticket to Omaha three times.

Along with his success on the field, Lemonis has always held academics to the highest standard, as well. In his final season at Indiana, a program-record 16 baseball student-athletes were named to the Big Ten Spring Academic Honor Roll, while 26 Cardinal baseball student-athletes earned ACC Honor Roll selections during his final season in Louisville. Already at Mississippi State, Lemonis has shown his dedication to his student-athletes in the classroom, as the program posted a 3.04 GPA during the fall semester.

Lemonis not only understands what it takes to get to Omaha as a coach but also as a player. A 1992 graduate of The Citadel, Lemonis added a 1990 appearance in the College World Series as a student-athlete. The appearance makes the Bulldogs one of just three school in Southern Conference history (Duke, Wake Forest) and only current member of the conference to advance to Omaha.

A two-time All-Southern Conference honoree, Lemonis led The Citadel in home runs three times. During his senior season, Lemonis led the Bulldogs with a .367 average, 19 doubles, 52 runs, 10 home runs and 66 RBIs. A member of the 1993 All-Southern Conference Tournament team, Lemonis ranks among the top 15 all-time at The Citadel in RBIs (152), home runs (23) and slugging percentage (.538).

Lemonis' father, Thomas, was a 1973 Mississippi State graduate in electrical engineering, with Chris living in Starkville as a newborn during his father's time at State.

A native of Myrtle Beach, S.C., Lemonis and his wife, Jill, have two daughters, Marissa and Mackenzie.

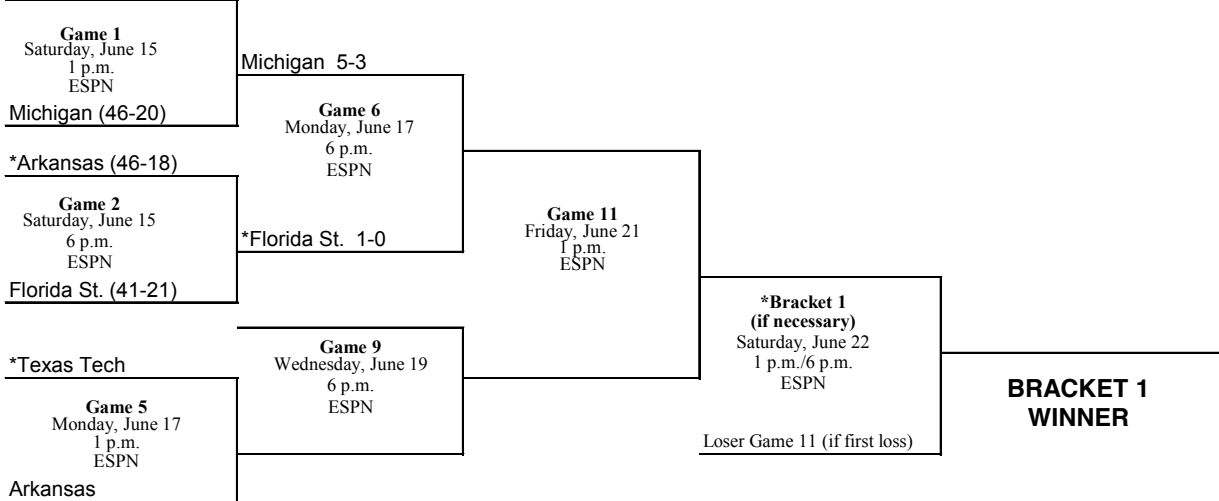

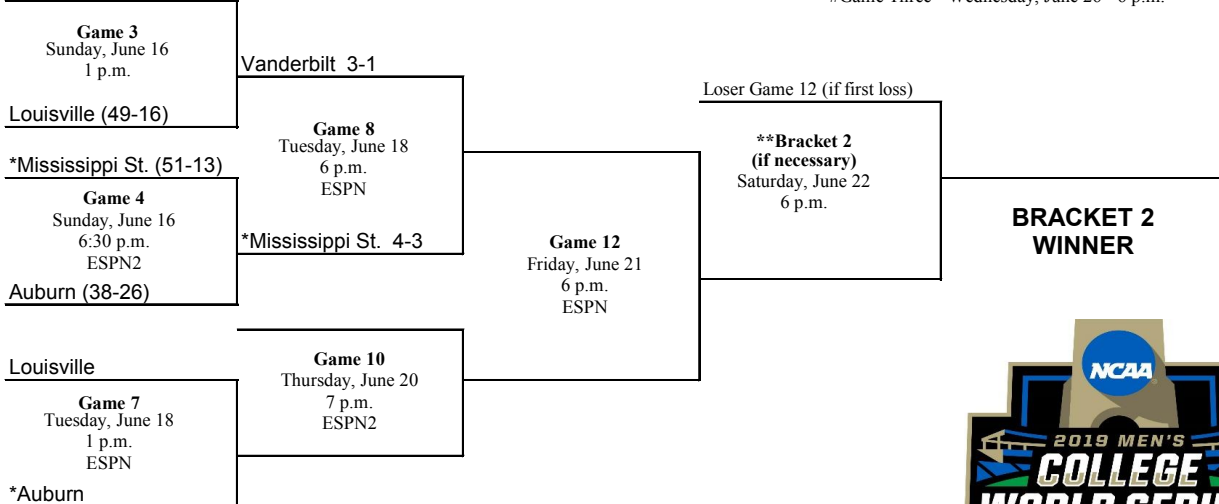

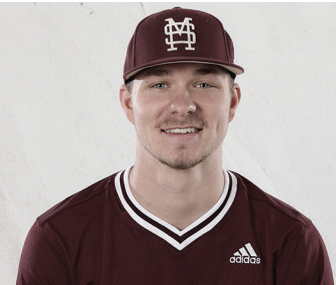

Omaha Tidbits

Omaha Over the Years

- Mississippi State made its first appearance at the College World Series in 1971 and the Diamond Dawgs have made the pilgrimage from Starkville, Mississippi to Omaha, Nebraska in each decade since.
- MSU is one of only five programs in the country to make a trip to the College World Series in each of the last five decades.
- State's 11 CWS appearances have come in 1971, '79, '81, '85, '90, '97, '98, 2007, '13, '18, '19.
- The back-to-back appearances mark just the second time in program history that MSU had reached college baseball's biggest stage in two-straight seasons.

Familiar Foes

- The meeting with Auburn will mark the sixth time in program history that Mississippi State met a current member of the SEC at the College World Series.
- MSU is 2-4 in those contests with victories coming against Florida to open the 1998 event and Auburn in the 2019 opener.
- The Diamond Dawgs met South Carolina (1981) and Arkansas (1985) at the College World Series prior to them joining the SEC in 1991.
- The Diamond Dawgs will add another SEC opponent to the College World Series record books with their meeting versus Vanderbilt in the second round.
- This is the third time in 11 appearances that MSU has met multiple SEC opponents in the same CWS. In 1997, Alabama handed MSU both of its losses, while in 1998, the Diamond Dawgs defeated Florida in the opener and lost to LSU in the second round.

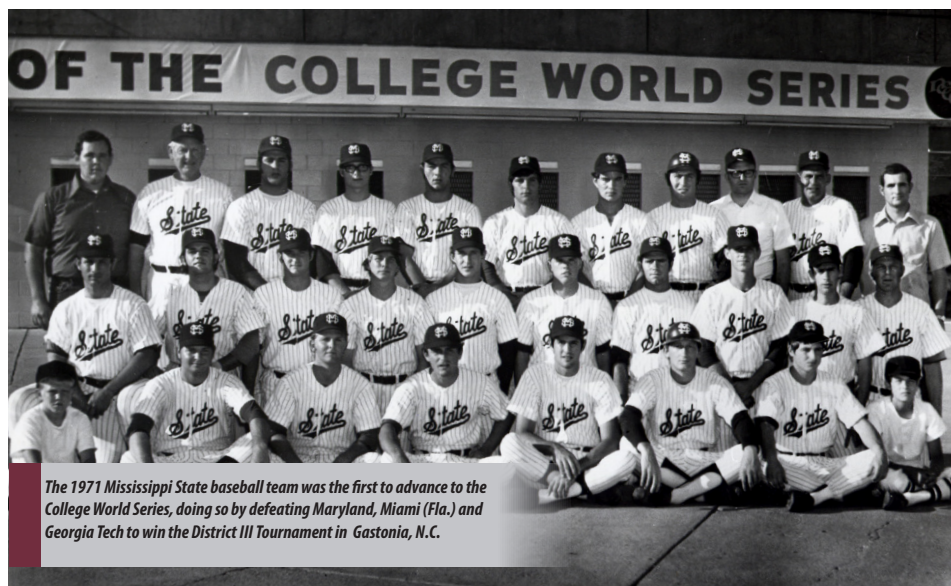
Doubling Up

- Mississippi State has met just four opponents in multiple College World Series appearances, however, the 2019 event has another opportunity in Bracket Two.
- With Louisville still alive at the 2019 CWS, MSU could add them to the list of two-time opponents at the event.
- Other two-time opponents at the College World Series are North Carolina (2007 & 2018), Oregon State (2013 & 2018), Texas (1979 & 1985) and UCLA (1997 & 2013).

Omaha x11

- Mississippi State is one of just 18 programs with double-digit appearances at the College World Series.
- The 11 appearances are tied for No. 13 all-time in Omaha with North Carolina and South Carolina.
- MSU is one of just six teams with double-digits appearances, without winning the event, with Florida State (23), Clemson (12) and North Carolina (11) the only with more appearances and no title.

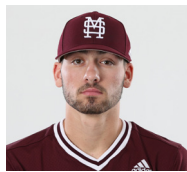

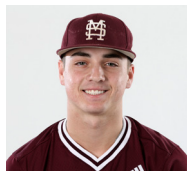
