2021 Baseball Notes vs. Mississippi State

NORTH ALABAMA IN THIRD YEAR OF DIVISION I TRANSITION

- * North Alabama is in its third year of a four-year transition to NCAA Division I.
- * The Lions competed in NCAA Division II in 2018 before going 16-38 in its first season in Division I in 2019. It was just UNA's second losing season in baseball in 36 years at the school.
- * The Lions were 3-13 in the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season and are 1-16 in 2021 for a combined 20-67 record on the Division I level.

UNA SERIES VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE

- * North Alabama is 2-6 all-time against Mississippi State in baseball, with all eight previous games having been played in Starkville and while UNA was a Division II program.
- * The last meeting between the two was in 1994.
- * The Lions wins over the Bulldogs came in 1990, 10-3, when Mississippi State was ranked 10th in the nation, and 1992, 3-2.

UNA VS. NATIONALLY RANKED SEC TEAMS

- * The Lions have two wins over nationally ranked SEC teams
- April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3, while a Division II team.
- April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6

- * North Alabama has a 6-39 all-time record against SEC schools in baseball.

THE ROAD IN DIVISION I HAS BEEN ROUGH ON THE LIONS

- * UNA has only played 26 of its 87 total games on the Division I level at home, and the Lions' record reflect that. North Alabama has an 11-15 record at Mike Lane Field in its Division I era, and a 9-52 record away from home during that same span.
- * UNA has a 766-258-5 record at home at Mike Lane Field since 1984.
- * The Lions were 571-156-4 at home under Mike Lane and are 195-102-1 at home under Mike Keehn.

MY HOME IS IN ALABAMA

- * The 39 players on the UNA squad come from 11 different states, with one player from Canada. There are 16 players from the state of Alabama and 23 players from outside the state. There are five from Tennessee, five from Florida, four from Georgia, two from Mississippi and one each from Texas, Ohio, Connecticut, Illinois, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

THE DOWN SIDE

- * North Alabama opened the season 0-6, marking the slowest start to a season in school history. The previous worst was three straight losses to open a season.
- * The current 1-16 record is also the worst start in school history through 17 games.
- * After UNA's six-game losing skid to open the season, the Lions picked up their lone win and are now on a 10-game losing streak.
- * The Lions have been outscored 132-36 through the first 17 games of the season and are averaging just 2.1 runs and 4.9 hits per game.

OF NOTE

- * Although UNA has limited hits in several games this season, the Lions have not been no-hit in a collegiate baseball game since Roger Mayo of Jacksonville State threw a no-hitter against UNA in 1975.
- * That means the Lions have at least one hit in their last 2,234 consecutive games (through March 21, 2021).



UNA'S THIRD SEASON OF DIVISION I BASEBALL

- * This will be North Alabama's third season as an NCAA Division I baseball program and as a member of the ASUN Conference.
- * The ASUN Conference has nine member schools in Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky and Virginia.

UNA VS. SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE SCHOOLS

* North Alabama has a 6-39 all-time record against SEC schools in baseball.

* UNA is 1-3 against SEC teams as a Division I program.

* UNA has played four different SEC schools, having played 26 games against Alabama, 10 against Ole Miss, eight against Mississippi State and one against Auburn.

* UNA is 2-24 vs. Alabama, 2-8 vs. Ole Miss, 2-6 vs. Mississippi State and 0-1 vs. Auburn.

* The Lions have two wins over nationally ranked SEC teams

- April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3

- April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6

* UNA has four wins vs. SEC schools in its last 14 games against the league (4-10).

* UNA has five SEC squads on its 2021 schedule, beginning with Mississippi State. The Lions will also play Ole Miss on March 30, Alabama on April 20, Vanderbilt on May 11 and Auburn on May 18.

UNA HEAD COACH MIKE KEEHN

* Mike Keehn has an overall 328-266-1 in his 13th season as head baseball coach at North Alabama.

* Keehn is in his 33rd season on the UNA coaching staff overall, having previously served 20 years as an assistant coach with the Lions under Mike Lane.

* Keehn's 33 combined seasons at UNA makes him the longest tenured baseball coach in school history. Mike Lane was at UNA for 25 years, all as head coach, and George Weeks was UNA's head baseball coach for 23 seasons.

* Keehn's 328 career wins make him the second winningest coach in UNA history, behind Lane.

* Keehn is a 1985 graduate of the University of Nebraska-Kearney. Previous UNA head coach Mike Lane was a 1974 Nebraska-Kearney graduate, meaning the Lions have had a head coach from UNK for the last 38 straight seasons.

PLAYER NOTES

* **Devne Daniel** is the only Lion hitting over .300 this season at .305.

He leads UNA with five multi-hit games and has one of just two multi-RBI games for the team this season. He is also the only UNA player to start all 17 games this season. 11 in left field and four in right.

* **Harris Kain** had UNA's longest hitting streak this season at six games (not current).

* **Austin Thrasher** reached base in a team high eight straight games earlier this season.

* Entering the season, **Kevin Brenning** was felt to be UNA's top offensive threat, but he is hitting just .087 (4-for-46) and has struckout 21 times. He did have a game-winning home run in UNA's only win, a 6-4 victory over Little Rock. Brenning hit a two-run shot in the bottom of the eighth to break a 4-4 tie.

JUST SECOND LOSING SEASON IN LAST 36 YEARS

* The 2019 season was just the second losing season for a North Alabama baseball team in the last 36 years. The Lions had a streak of 30 consecutive winning seasons from 1984-2013 before going 26-27 in 2014. UNA followed with four more winning seasons prior to 2019. UNA went 16-38 in 2019 in its first season in Division I.

UNA'S 2021 SCHEDULE IS FORMIDABLE

* The Lions face a tough road in 2021 with a 45-game slate that includes 21 ASUN Conference games and 24 non-conference games against 16 different opponents.

The Lions open ASUN Conference play this weekend, on March 12, with a three-game series at Liberty. UNA then play at Belmont before hosting its next four conference series at home against Lipscomb, Kennesaw State, Liberty and Bellarmine. The final ASUN series is at Lipscomb before the Lions play North Florida and Jacksonville in an ASUN crossover event in Nashville.

UNA's non-conference slate includes multi-game series against , Stetson, Little Rock, Louisiana Lafayette and Davidson, along with single games at Southeastern Conference opponents Alabama, Auburn, Ole Miss, Mississippi State and Vanderbilt. There are additional midweek games against Tennessee Tech, Belmont, Austin Peay and Alabama State.

UNA 2021 Baseball Game Notes

LOOK BACK AT 2019

- * UNA rebounded from a 3-19 start to its first season in Division I by going 13-19 in its last 32 games.
- * UNA played 39 of its 54 games last season on the road.
- * The Lions went 8-7 in their 15 home games but were 8-31 away from home.
- * The Lions picked up some quality wins:
 - Took the final game of an ASUN series with defending conference champion Stetson, 6-2.
 - Pulled one of the biggest upsets in program history when they knocked off #18 Ole Miss 10-6 in Oxford. The Lions had a season-high 14 hits in the game against the Rebels.
 - UNA then knocked off ASUN Conference leader Liberty 6-3 in the middle game of a three-game series in Florence.
 - Won an ASUN series at Jacksonville, taking the first two games of that three-game series.
 - UNA downed North Florida 8-4 to split a two-game set with the Ospreys.

UNA BASEBALL SUPERLATIVES

- * The UNA baseball program has had just two losing seasons in the last 36 years.
- * While in the NCAA Division II, the Lions won 10 Gulf South Conference Divisional crowns, five GSC Tournament Championships and played in 12 NCAA Division II Regional Tournaments.
- * UNA won the 1999 South Central Regional and advanced to the Division II World Series.
- * Among the UNA baseball alums who have played in the Major Leagues are Josh Willingham, who played in the 2014 World Series with the Kansas City Royals and hit 195 career home runs in an 11-year MLB career, and reliever Sergio Romo, who pitched for the San Francisco Giants in the 2010, 2012 and 2014 World Series.

TWO FORMER LIONS COMPETED IN 2014 WORLD SERIES

- * Two former University of North Alabama baseball players found themselves on opposite sides of the 2014 World Series as Josh Willingham (1998-00) and the Kansas City Royals faced Sergio Romo (2004) and the San Francisco Giants.

FIVE FORMER LIONS HAVE PLAYED IN THE MAJOR LEAGUES

- * Five former University of North Alabama baseball players have reached the Major Leagues:
 - Cedric Landrum (Cubs, Mets),
 - Terry Jones (Rockies, Expos),
 - Jim Czajkowski (Rockies),
 - Josh Willingham (Marlins, Nationals, A's, Twins, Royals)
 - Sergio Romo (Giants, Dodgers, Rays, Marlins, Twins).

WILLINGHAM HIT TWO GRAND SLAMS IN A SINGLE MAJOR LEAGUE GAME

- * Former UNA Lion Josh Willingham is one of just 13 players in the history of Major League Baseball to hit two grand slams in a single game.
- * On July 27, 2009, while playing for the Washington Nationals, Willingham hit two grand slams against the Milwaukee Brewers in a 14-6 win by the Nationals. He also tied a franchise record with eight runs batted in.
- * The bat that he used to hit the two grand slams is on display in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y.
