### NORTH ALABAMA SERIES VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE

- \* \* North Alabama is 2-7 all-time against Mississippi State in baseball, with all nine previous games having been played in Starkville. The first eight were while UNA was a Division II program.
- \* The last meeting was last season, with the second ranked Bulldogs taking an 18-1 win.
- \* The Lions wins over the Bulldogs came in 1990, 10-3, when Mississippi State was ranked 10th in the nation, and 1992, 3-2.

### KEEHN ANNOUNCES HIS RETIREMENT AT END OF SEASON

- \* UNA head baseball coach Mike Keehn announced on Saturday that he will be retiring at the end of the season. With 34 years at North Alabama, Keehn is the longest tenured coach in any sport in the history of UNA athletics, which dates back to the 1930s. He served 20 seasons as assistant baseball coach at UNA and the last 14 as head coach.

\* Keehn has coached UNA to:

- 1,066 total wins (720 as assistant, 346 as head coach)
- 29 winning seasons in the last 34 years
- 9 NCAA Tournament teams
- 43 players went on to play professional baseball
- 3 players who reached the Major Leagues (Terry Jones, Josh Willingham, Sergio Romo)
- 18 All-Americans and three Academic All-Americans

### DIVISION I ROAD WOES FOR THE LIONS

- \* The Lions have lost their last 21 straight road games since a 9-5 win at Alabama on March 9. That win broke a 26-game losing streak in non-conference road games, dating back to an 8-4 win at Little Rock on February 28, 2020.
- \* UNA was 2-24 on the road in 2021 and is 1-24 so far this season - so 3-48 on the road the last two seasons.
- \* UNA has only played 64 of its 166 Division I games at home since its Division I transition began in 2019. The Lions are 26-38 in those home contests and 12-90 record away from home during that same span.

### NORTH ALABAMA IN FINAL YEAR OF DIVISION I TRANSITION

- \* North Alabama is in its final year of a four-year transition to NCAA Division I.
- \* The Lions competed in the NCAA Division II before going 16-38 in their first season in Division I in 2019. It was just UNA's second losing season in baseball in the last 36 years.
- \* The Lions were 3-13 in the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, were 7-40 in 2021 and 12-37 this season for a combined 38-128 record on the Division I level during the transition.
- \* North Alabama will be eligible to compete as a full-fledged member of the NCAA Division I in 2023.

### UNA HISTORY VS. SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE SCHOOLS

- \* North Alabama has a 7-46 all-time record against SEC schools in baseball.
- \* UNA is 2-10 against SEC teams as a Division I program.
- \* UNA has played five different SEC schools, having played 28 games against Alabama, 12 against Ole Miss, 10 against Mississippi State, two against Auburn and one against Vanderbilt.
- \* UNA is 3-25 vs. Alabama, 2-10 vs. Ole Miss, 2-8 vs. Mississippi State, 0-2 vs. Auburn and 0-1 vs. Vanderbilt.
- \* The Lions have two wins over nationally ranked SEC teams
  - April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3
  - April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6
- \* UNA has five wins vs. SEC schools in its last 21 games against the league (5-16).



### UNA'S FOURTH SEASON OF DIVISION I BASEBALL

- \* This will be North Alabama's fourth season as an NCAA Division I baseball program and as a member of the ASUN Conference.
- \* The ASUN Conference has 12 member schools in Alabama, Arkansas, Tennessee, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky and Virginia.

# UNA 2022 Baseball Game Notes



## UNA HEAD COACH MIKE KEEHN

- \* Mike Keehn has an overall 346-329-1 in his 14th season as head baseball coach at North Alabama.
- \* Keehn is in his 34th season on the UNA coaching staff overall, having previously served 20 years as an assistant coach with the Lions under Mike Lane.
- \* Keehn's 34 combined seasons at UNA makes him the longest tenured baseball coach in school history. Mike Lane was at UNA for 25 years, all as head coach, and George Weeks was UNA's head baseball coach for 23 seasons.
- \* Keehn is also the longest tenured coach in any sport ever at UNA.
- \* Keehn's 343 career wins make him the second winningest coach in UNA history, behind Lane.
- \* Keehn is a 1985 graduate of the University of Nebraska-Kearney. Previous UNA head coach Mike Lane was a 1974 Nebraska-Kearney graduate, meaning the Lions have had a head coach from UNK for the last 39 straight seasons.

## UNA VS. SEC IN 2022

- \* This will be North Alabama's third game against an SEC opponent in 2022.
- \* The Lions February 22 game against Vanderbilt was cancelled due to rain and has not been rescheduled yet.
- \* The Lions defeated Alabama 9-5 in Tuscaloosa back on March 9.
- \* UNA lost 20-3 at Ole Miss on March 29.

## HOME SUCCESS

- \* UNA is 11-13 at home this season and 1-21 on the road.
- \* UNA was 4-8 at home last season in ASUN Conference play.
- \* North Alabama has a 26-38 record at Mike Lane Field in its Division I era.
- \* UNA has a 781-281-5 record at home at Mike Lane Field since 1984.
- \* The Lions were 571-156-4 at home under Mike Lane and are 210-125-1 at home under Mike Keehn.
- \* UNA has only played 64 of its 166 Division I games at home since its Division I transition began in 2019. The Lions are 26-38 in those home contests.

## JUST FIFTH LOSING SEASONS SINCE 1984

- \* The 2022 season will be just the fifth losing baseball season at North Alabama since 1984.
- \* The Lions had a streak of 30 consecutive winning seasons from 1984-2013 before going 26-27 in 2014.
- \* UNA followed with four more winning seasons before going 16-38 in 2019 in its first season in Division I.
- \* In the Division I era, UNA has gone 18-36, 3-13, 7-40 and 12-37.

## UNA IN ASUN CONFERENCE SERIES

- \* UNA swept its ASUN series last weekend against Bellarmine with three wins in Florence - 15-5, 5-4 and 12-10. It was just the Lions second series sweep in three seasons of ASUN play.
- \* Prior to last weekend, UNA had been swept in its last five ASUN Conference series and the Lions had lost their last 16 straight league games.
- \* North Alabama has played 22 all-time ASUN Conference baseball series and UNA has an 18-53 overall record in ASUN play.
- \* The Lions are 14-24 at home in ASUN play and 4-29 on the road.
- \* UNA has won five series, split one and lost the other 17.
- \* UNA has been swept in 13 of the 24 ASUN series.

## QUICK HITTERS . . . LION NOTES

### Individual

- \* Catcher **Luke Harper** has a current streak of having reached base in the last 27 straight games. He also had a 19-game hitting streak in that stretch and has a hit in 25 of the 27 games in that streak.
- \* Through 49 games, **Luke Harper** leads UNA with a .380 batting average. The highest single season batting average by a Lion in the Division I era is .294 by Kevin Brenning in 2019. **Austin Thrasher** is at .349.
- \* Second baseman **Drew Hudson** hit for the cycle on Sunday against Bellarmine, becoming just the fourth Lion player to do so, and the first since 2004. Hudson homered in the first inning, tripled in the second, singled in the fourth and doubled in the sixth. He also drew a walk in the eighth. He drove in four runs and scored two.
- \* UNA's first home run of the season was an inside the park homer by second baseman **Drew Hudson** against Austin Peay on March 2 in Florence.
- \* **Devne Daniel** reached base in UNA's first 22 consecutive games this season to set a UNA Division I era record. He did not play in the Lions' March 29 game at Ole Miss, then went 0-for-4 in the series opener at home against Central Arkansas to end the streak. He has reached base in 41 of the 44 games that he has played in this season.
- \* **Luke Harper** went 4-for-5 at Alabama on March 9 with two doubles, two runs scored and three runs batted in, in a 9-5 UNA win.
- \* Two Lion players have started all 49 games this season at the same position: **Drew Hudson** at second base and **Reid Homan** at shortstop.
- \* True freshman third baseman **Jonathan Lane** started the first 47 games of the season at third base before being hit in the face by a pitch in Friday's game against Bellarmine. He will miss the remainder of the season. He had a 12-game hitting streak end at Eastern Kentucky.

## Team

\* North Alabama has equalled its longest winning streak of its DI era at three games, coming off a sweep at home of Bellarmine. Its is the Lions second three-game winning streak of the season.

\* After a 5-5 start to the 2022 season, North Alabama has gone 7-32 in its last 39 games.

\* The Lions have not been no-hit in a collegiate baseball game since Roger Mayo of Jacksonville State threw a no-hitter against UNA in 1975. That means the Lions have at least one hit in their last 2,311 consecutive games.

\* UNA has not been shutout so far this season through 49 games, and has scored in its last 63 straight games overall, dating back to a 15-0 loss at Liberty on April 18, 2021.

\* UNA has not won a game when trailing after three innings (0-26).

\* North Alabama has only hit 21 home runs this season through 49 games. UNA pitchers have allowed 79 homers. In UNA's loss at Tennessee Tech on March 22, the Lions' pitching staff gave up 10 home runs to the Golden Eagles.

\* UNA has only faced seven left-handed starters this season and is 3-5 against them. The Lions are 9-32 against right-handers.

\* UNA has allowed 10 or more runs in 20 of its 37 losses.

\* North Alabama has only out-hit its opponent 14 times this season and is 9-5 in those games.

\* The Lions' 10 runs in a 10-1 win over Eastern Kentucky marked the first time this season that UNA had scored double-digit runs. The Lions had gone 26 games without scoring 10 or more runs, dating back to a 16-15 loss at Austin Peay on April 27, 2021. The Lions followed with 10 runs at home against Memphis on April 5 in a 10-0 win and scored in double-digits twice in the weekend series against Bellarmine.

## **MY HOME IS IN ALABAMA**

\* The 33 players on the UNA squad come from nine different states. There are 13 players from the state of Alabama and 20 players from outside the state. There are seven from Georgia, three from Florida and Tennessee, two from Connecticut and Illinois, and one from Minnesota, Wisconsin and Mississippi.

## **UNA BASEBALL SUPERLATIVES**

\* The UNA baseball program has had just four losing season in the last 38 years.

\* While in the NCAA Division II, the Lions won 10 Gulf South Conference Divisional crowns, five GSC Tournament Championships and played in 12 NCAA Division II Regional Tournaments. UNA won the 1999 South Central Regional and advanced to the Division II World Series.

\* Among the UNA baseball alums who have played in the Major Leagues are Josh Willingham, who played in the 2014 World Series with the Kansas City Royals and hit 195 career home runs in an 11-year MLB career, and reliever Sergio Romo, who pitched for the San Francisco Giants in the 2010, 2012 and 2014 World Series.

## **TWO FORMER LIONS COMPETED IN 2014 WORLD SERIES**

\* Two former University of North Alabama baseball players found themselves on opposite sides of the 2014 World Series as Josh Willingham (1998-00) and the Kansas City Royals faced Sergio Romo (2004) and the San Francisco Giants.

## **WILLINGHAM HIT TWO GRAND SLAMS IN A SINGLE MAJOR LEAGUE GAME**

\* Former UNA Lion Josh Willingham is one of just 13 players in the history of Major League Baseball to hit two grand slams in a single game.

\* On July 27, 2009, while playing for the Washington Nationals, Willingham hit two grand slams against the Milwaukee Brewers in a 14-6 win by the Nationals. He also tied a franchise record with eight runs batted in.

\* The bat that he used to hit the two grand slams is on display in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y.

- \* The Lions have not been no-hit in a collegiate baseball game since Roger Mayo of Jacksonville State threw a no-hitter against UNA in 1975. That means the Lions have at least one hit in their last 2,311 consecutive games.

## FIRST DI AND ASUN SWEEPS FOR LIONS IN 2021

- \* UNA's three-game sweep of a series against Lipscomb on March 26-28, 2021 marked the Lions' first sweep of a three-game series on the Division I level, as well as the first sweep of an ASUN Conference series.
- \* The Lions won two ASUN series in 2019, both 2-1, against Jacksonville and NJIT. There were no conference series in 2020.

## GOING THE DISTANCE

- \* North Alabama played the second longest game in school history and the longest game ever at home on March 28, 2021 against Lipscomb. The Lions 6-5 win over Lipscomb took 15 innings and five hours and five minutes to complete. Lipscomb held 4-0 and 5-1 leads in the game before UNA rallied. The Lions forced extra innings with a two-run RBI-single in the bottom of the ninth by Kylan Barnett. Neither team scored a run through the first five extra innings. In fact, UNA's bullpen held Lipscomb hitless and scoreless from the eighth inning on (eight total innings). In the bottom of the 15th, Dominick McIntyre drew a walk and later scored on a two-out, RBI-single by Reid Homan to win the game.
