- Mississippi State enters the week ranked as high as No. 23 in the national polls. FULL POLLS ON PAGE 4
- Mississippi State enters the week with a 7-7 overall record over the first 14 games of the season. The Diamond Dawgs are returning home after six straight games away from Dudy Noble Field and enter the weekend with a 5-3 record at home.
- The Dawgs rank 5th in the SEC and 33rd nationally in home runs with 17. Hunter Hines leads MSU with four home runs in 2022.
- MSU's pitching staff enters the week ranked 4th in the SEC and 13th nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (11.6).
- MSU RHP **Preston Johnson** is ranked 8th among SEC pitchers in hits allowed per nine innings (4.96). Johnson enters the week ranked 7th in the SEC in strikeouts (23).
- MSU first baseman Luke Hancock ranks 3rd in the SEC and 21st nationally in toughest to strikeout. He has only struck out twice in
- Sunday starter RHP Cade Smith is 2-0 following his first 3 starts, which ranks 4th in the SEC and 42nd nationally for most wins.
- Offensively, the Dawgs are hitting .260 as a team with 17 home runs, 17 doubles and 104 runs scored. MSU is out-scoring opponents 104-69 through 14 games.
- MSU ranks 17th in the country with a .985 fielding percentage.
- On the mound, MSU pitchers have combined for a 4.63 team ERA in 122.1 innings pitched. Opponents are hitting .235 against the

- Dawgs' pitching staff, while MSU pitchers have struck out 158 batters and walked 54 through the first 14 games of the season.
- State freshman **Hunter Hines** is leading the Dawgs at the plate with a .367 average and a team-best four home runs on the season. In the last five games, Hines is hitting .476 (10-for-21) with 3 home runs, 3 doubles and has driven in nine RBIs over that stretch.
- MSU catcher **Logan Tanner** has also paced the Dawgs in the last five games after going 6-for-18 (.333 BA) with a grand slam, a double and 8 RBIs. Tanner is slugging .556 with a .455 OBP in the last 5 games. He is second on the team with a .314 average on the
- Mississippi State's combined opening weekend attendance was 34,325, which ranked first in all of college baseball following the first weekend of the 2022 season.
- · LAST TIME OUT:
 - The Diamond Dawgs enter the weekend series versus Princeton following a two-game midweek series against Texas Tech that saw the two teams split at MGM Park in Biloxi.
 - In game one, Parker Stinnett struck out a career-high 12 batters and the Diamond Dawg offense posted a 9-run 4th inning to lead State to an 11-5 win over No. 11 Texas Tech.
 - On Wednesday, MSU fell, 7-2, to Texas Tech to split the midweek series with the Red Raiders. The Dawgs fell behind early after Texas Tech plated five runs in the top half of the second on a grand slam and solo home run.

INSIDE THE SERIES

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- Princeton is led by head coach Scott Bradley, who is in his 24th season with the Tigers. Princeton enters the week in search of its first win of the season following the first eight games.
- Five of Princeton's eight losses have come by three runs or less, including one-run defeats to Purdue twice (L, 3-4; L, 4-5), VCU (L, 1-2) and Richmond (L, 8-9).
- Princeton has yet to play a home game in 2022 after opening
 the year with four neutral site games versus Purdue followed
 by four straight road games. The Tigers are in the midst of an
 11-game road swing before opening lvy League play at home
 versus Yale on March 26.
- Princeton has not played a full season since 2019. The Tigers' 2020 season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, while the 2021 campaign was also canceled after the lvy League decided not to hold league competition last spring.

SERIES NOTES

- This weekend's series will mark the first time MSU and Princeton have met on the diamond.
- Mississippi State is 3-0 all-time against lvy League schools with two wins over Columbia in 2017 and a win over Yale in 1967.
- This weekend is the final non-conference series of the season for the Diamond Dawgs. Mississippi State will open SEC play next weekend on the road at Georgia (March 18-20).
- State will host Alabama in SEC play the following weekend at Dudy Noble Field on March 25-27.



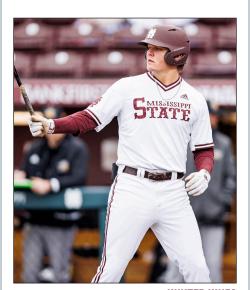



BIOGRAPHY

The largest on-campus facility in college baseball, Dudy Noble Field hosted its 55th season of Mississippi State baseball at the current site in 2021. With over 1,600 games played at the venue, the Diamond Dawgs own a .730 winning percentage at the facility, which recently received a \$68-million upgrade.

The field is named in honor of longtime MSU baseball coach, athletics director and ABCA Hall of Famer Clarke Randolph "Dudy" Noble. On April 27, 1998 the facility was renamed Dudy Noble Field, Polk-DeMent Stadium, honoring another ABCA Hall of Famer, former Bulldog skipper Ron Polk, and the late Gordon DeMent, a successful businessman and longtime fan of the Diamond Dawgs from Indianola, Mississispipi.

The Origin

From 1929 until 1964, Mississippi State hosted its baseball games at the original on-campus venue, Hardy Field, which was located several hundred yards to the south of the Bulldogs' home football venue, Davis Wade Stadium at Scott Field. The baseball field was closed following the 1964 season to make way for the construction of Dorman Hall and for the next two seasons the Diamond Dawgs played their home games at Redbird Park in Columbus, Mississippi, capturing SEC titles both seasons at their temporary home.

The tin-roofed grandstand and 2,000-seat bleachers from the original Dudy Noble Field were transported to the stadium's present site, which became playable for the 1967 campaign. Since that time, facility enhancements have followed at a steady pace to make the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball" one of the finest all-around facilities on the road to Omaha. Among with numerous upgrades, the current site has seen two complete demolitions and reconstructions, the latest occurring during a three-year span (2017-19) and opening prior to the start of the 2019 campaign.

Leading the Attendance Boom

With a laundry list of legendary names on its all-time roster, it comes as no surprise that Mississippi State ranks among the nation's attendance leaders year in and year out. The Dudy Noble Field faithful have sold out the reserved seating allotment every season since 1987.

Along with routinely hosting some of the largest crowds in the SEC, ten of the last 12 three-day Super Bulldog Weekend series have drawn more than 25,000 fans.

MSU eclipsed the 200,000 mark in paid attendance at Dudy Noble Field for six-straight seasons between 2012-17, marking the first such occurrence in the program's history. In 2013, the Diamond Dawgs' five-millionth fan walked through the turnstiles at Dudy Noble Field. Since home attendance figures were charted starting in 1976, the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball" has seen 6,720,459 fans rush through the gates.

In 20 of the last 21 seasons, Mississippi State has averaged 6,000 fans per game, including a record average of 8,899 during the 2019 campaign. Overall, State has eclipsed the 200,000-fan mark 12 times since 2002, with a school-record 373,784 viewing the 2019 home schedule.

Of the top 25 all-time college baseball on-campus attendances, Dudy Noble Field finds itself on the list 19 times, most notably owning the all-time on-campus attendance record of 15,586 on April 12, 2014. The Bulldogs own 15 of the top 16 marks in NCAA on-campus history and are the only NCAA baseball program to boast on-campus attendances of 14,000 or more. The five largest NCAA Super Regional crowds have all assembled in Starkville, Mississippi, as well.

From April 11-13, 2014, the Bulldog faithful flooded the gates at Dudy Noble Field to the tune or 39,181 fans for a three-game series versus Ole Miss. The nearly 40,000 fans on the weekend set an NCAA on-campus attendance record for a three-game series.

Dudy Noble Field has ushered in crowds of 10,000 or better 61 times, including 2007 NCAA Super Regional-record draws of 13,715 and 12,620 for nationally-televised, late-morning games against Clemson. In 2019, the first season of the "New Dude," the Diamond Dawgs garnered crowds of 10,000-plus a school-record 10 times.

Mississippi State has hosted 26 postseason events at the facility, including three NCAA District III Tournaments (1973-75), five SEC tournaments (1979, 81, 83, 88 & 95), 16 NCAA Regionals (1979, 84-85, 87-89, 90, 92, 97, 2000, 03, 13, 16, 19 & 21) and four NCAA Super Regionals (2007, 16, 19 & 21).

The Left Field Lounge

The aura of Mississippi State baseball at Dudy Noble Field is certainly not confined to the loyal legions in the impressive grandstand, pro-style luxury sky suites or luxurious Left Field Lofts.

In fact, some of the more highly-prized seats at Bulldog baseball games are found beyond the outfield fence in the Left Field Lounge™. Waiting lists greet those seeking to purchase one of the 96 outfield lounges in the iconic two-level outfield tailgate.

Once a colorful assortment of pickup trucks, motor homes, and trailers — most equipped with grills — lined the outfield fence, completing a circle of humanity at Dudy Noble Field. Now, the permanent lounge spaces are connected to the concourse, allowing everyone to stroll through and experience the iconic lounge culture.

What began in the late 1960s as a popular gathering spot for baseball-loving MSU supporters now forms college baseball's largest tailgate party.

The "New Dude"

The second demolition at the current site occurred following the 2017 season and the \$68 million facility opened its gates for the 2019 campaign. Architect Wier Boerner Allin, along with consultants Populous and farned stadium architect/State alum Janet Marie Smith designed the project, while construction manager ICM and general contractor JESCO Construction, Inc. oversaw the construction.

Covering 12 acres of land on the Mississippi State University campus, the 230,000 square foot facility carries on Dudy Noble Field's legacy as the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball." Installation of the second largest scoreboard in college baseball, measuring 43 feet wide by 60 feet high, started the project in 2017. The board, which was the largest in college baseball upon instillation, is larger than boards owned by three Major League Baseball teams. The addition of 96 permanent Left Field Lounge rigs encircling the outfield followed during the fall of 2018.

The concourse and lower-level grandstands were in place for the 2018 season, with the Diamond Suites, upper-deck reserved seating area and three unique club areas – Farm Bureau Triple Crown Club, Charlie and Dana Stephenson Omaha Club and The Rooftop Club – were completed prior to the 2019 campaign. The newest version of Dudy Noble Field also features increased restroom facilities and concession points of sale.

The player spaces also received an upgrade, expanding to cover 18,000 square feet underneath the facility. The fully-equipped Bruce and Julie Martin Locker Room includes an embedded equipment room, houses 40 wooden lockers and features an oversized, dimensional halo-lit '85 Script Mississippi State sign suspended overhead in the middle of the room.

The more spacious locker room includes an attached training room with whirlpool and fully-functional fueling station. The Mitch Moreland Hitting Tunnel, which is equipped with HitTrax, and Turner & Gloria Wingo Team Lounge are easily accessed from the home dugout, with the eye-popping player entrance and Hassell H. Franklin Omaha Room greeting players as they enter the facility. The Pat McMahon Pitching Lab is also housed under the stadium, featuring arm care and conditioning equipment, one oversized turfed mound with three pitching rubbers and state of the art video equipment.
