LEADING OFF

Texas A&M wraps up the regular-season home slate when they host the Mississippi State Bulldogs in a three-game series on Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park. The Aggies look to win their sixth consecutive weekend series. The last time the Maroon & White ripped off six consecutive SEC series wins was 2016 when they bested Georgia, No. 8 Mississippi State, Alabama, Arkansas, No. 5 Vanderbilt, No. 8 South Carolina and No. 6 Ole Miss during a seven-series tear to end the regular-season.

VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

The Aggies are 11-4 this season against teams ranked in the USA Today Coaches Top 25, including 7-3 against teams in the top 10. Most recently, Texas A&M won 2-of-3 in a road series at then-No. 22 Vanderbilt. The prior week, the Aggies won 2-of-3 in a home set against then-No. 3 Arkansas. The Maroon & White took 2-of-3 in road series at then-No. 8 LSU and then-No. 10 Georgia. They also claimed a road midweek win against then-No. 8 Texas. The Aggies won home midweek games against then-No. 15 Texas State and No. 25 Dallas Baptist.

Texas A&M has outscored ranked opponents 123-76, slashing .299/.417/.501 in the 15 games with 28 doubles, three triples and 24 home runs. **AUSTIN BOST** is batting .439 (25-for-57) with 12 walks, 16 runs, three doubles, three homers, 11 RBI and a .543 on-base percentage. **JACK MOSS** is hitting .412 (28-for-68) with 13 runs, six doubles, one triple, two homers and 15 RBI. **DYLAN ROCK** is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with 20 runs, three doubles, six home runs and 17 RBI. **LOGAN BRITT** and **RYAN TARGAC** each have four home runs and **TROY CLAUNCH** has added a team-high 19 RBI.

THE ROCK

The Aggies boast one of the nation's most experienced hitters in **DYLAN ROCK**. The UTSA transfer ranks 23rd among active NCAA Division I players with 816 at-bats. He ranks fourth among active players in runs (197), 11th in doubles (56), 12th in hits (262), 12th in total bases (416), 22nd in games played (220) and 26th in RBI (152).

Rock was named SEC Co-Player of the Week five weeks ago - leading the league in on-base percentage (.600), runs (8) and walks (6) on the week and ranked second in combined runs and RBI with 12, helping the Aggies win three games - two against Kentucky and one versus No. 8 Texas State. He reached base in 12-of-20 plate appearances, including 10-of-15 against Kentucky. He batted 5-for-10 against the Wildcats with five walks, six runs, one double, one triple, one home run and four RBI.

This year, Rock leads Texas A&M in runs (50), home runs (12), stolen bases (13), slugging (.639) and on-base percentage (.483). Rock also has 11 doubles and one triple on the year. He ranks in the top 10 in the SEC in on-base percentage (2nd), stolen bases (5th), runs (6th), walks (6th) and slugging (9th).

After 24 league games, Rock leads the SEC with 32 runs. He ranks second in on-base percentage (.496), third in walks (24), sixth in total bases (64) and slugging percentage (.711) and seventh in RBI (24).

SEPARATION SIXTH

The Aggies have made the most hay in the sixth inning when the Maroon & White are outscoring opponents, 53-13. Texas A&M is hitting .297 in the sixth inning with a .409 on-base percentage and .474 slugging percentage. **JACK MOSS** is hitting .600 (12-for-20) with a .625 on-base percentage, two walks, one HBP, three doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI in the sixth and **BRETT MINNICH** is batting .450 (9-for-20) with 10 runs, five walks, one HBP, a .577 on-base percentage, one double, two home runs and seven RBI. The pitching staff owns a 2.15 ERA in the sixth, holding foes to a .171 batting average (28-for-164), including just seven doubles and one triple as the lone extra-base hits in 46.0 innings. The Maroon & White are also outscoring foes 58-24 in the fifth inning, for a combined 111-37 in the fifth and sixth frames.

CLAUNCH EARNS NO. 12

TROY CLAUNCH has earned the right to wear the revered No. 12 for the 2022 campaign, Texas A&M baseball head coach **JIM SCHLOSSNAGLE** announced leading up to the season.

"The number 12 obviously is very near and dear to Texas A&M," Schlossnagle said. "I thought it would be appropriate to only award number 12 to someone who truly defines the core values of our university and Aggie baseball - Respect, Excellence, Leadership, Loyalty, Integrity and Selfless Service. This will be something that we attempt to do each year as we move the program forward.

"Troy has earned the respect of his teammates, our coaching staff and all of our support staff. Although we have several players that have tremendous character, Troy has stood out as the player who has earned the privilege of wearing 12 for the 2022 baseball season."

Claunch is in his first season at Texas A&M after a brilliant four-year career at Oregon State. He earned All-Pac 12 First Team in 2021, batting .305 with 26 runs, seven doubles, four home runs and 30 RBI. He played 124 games for OSU including 92 starts, batting .290 with 46 runs, 13 doubles, 10 home runs and 62 RBI. He was a member of the Beavers' 2018 national championship squad.

"The number 12 is an integral part of the rich history of this university," Claunch said. "Being given the honor to wear 12 this season is a great privilege that I take very seriously. Every day I put that jersey on will be a reminder to live up to the traditions and core values of Texas A&M. I am eager to uphold the legacy of the number and make Aggieland proud."

NEW STAFF

JIM SCHLOSSNAGLE, a two-time National Coach of the Year, brings an 811-393 (.674) mark to Texas A&M, including five College World Series appearances. He guided TCU to their Omaha debut in 2010 and four consecutive CWS trips from 2014-17. Schlossnagle earned National Coach of the Year honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association in 2010 and Baseball America in 2016.

Renowned pitching coach and 2017 D1Baseball Assistant Coach of the Year **NATE YESKIE** is in his first season in Aggieland as associate head coach. He arrives in the Brazos Valley after two seasons on Jay Johnson's staff at Arizona, including the 2021 CWS campaign. He also coached 11 seasons at Oregon State with his tenure culminating in a College World Series title in 2018.

New assistant coach **NOLAN CAIN** is nationally recognized as one of the top recruiters in the nation. Three of his last four recruiting classes at LSU were ranked in the Top 5, including a No. 1 rating by Baseball America for his 2020 class. During Cain's eight season the LSU staff, the Tigers earned five NCAA Tournament national seeds, two CWS appearances and four SEC crowns.

Hitting coach **MICHAEL EARLEY** has built a reputation for developing hitters with his most notable work being the rise of Spencer Torkelson to the No. 1 overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft. In the 2020 draft, four of Earley's hitters were selected as Arizona State.

TEXAS A&M/MISSISSIPPI STATE SERIES NOTABLES

Texas A&M and Mississippi State have met 39 times with the Bulldogs taking the 20-19 advantage in the series with last year's sweep in Starkville. The programs first took the field against each other in 1907 with the Aggies taking a 1-0 decision. The Maroon & White started hot, winning the first five games before the series took a 74-year hiatus. Since A&M joined the SEC for the 2013 campaign, Mississippi State owns a 14-11 edge in the series.

MORE ON MISSISSIPPI STATE

The Bulldogs enter the fray with a 25-24 overall mark, including a 9-15 SEC ledger. The 2021 National Champions have stumbled through the 2022 campaign, lingering around the .500 mark for much of the season. Mississippi State heads into the weekend with a six-game losing streak, including dropping the last two games at Missouri, a sweep at home against Florida and Tuesday's loss to Samford.

Mississippi State is slashing .278/.377/.478 with 84 home runs and 35 stolen bases in 49 games. Four batters hitting over .300 lead the attack. Logan Tanner is hitting .317 with 34 runs, eight doubles, seven home runs and 38 RBI. RJ Yeager is batting .316 with 35 runs, 13 doubles, 16 home runs and 50 RBI. Brad Cumbest is hitting .303 with 35 runs, 11 doubles, 12 home runs and 30 RBI. Kamren James is batting .303 with 41 runs, eight doubles, eight home runs, 31 RBI and 12 stolen bases.

Bulldogs pitchers own a .554 ERA, .252 opponent batting average and 538 strikeouts in 430.2 innings.

Mississippi State 61 former members to go on and play in the Major Leagues. The most notable are a pair of six-time MLB All-Stars. Will Clark racked up 2,176 hits, 284 home runs and 1,205 RBI during a 15-year career. Jonathan Papelbon recorded 368 saves to go with a 41-36 record and 2.44 ERA during his 12-year career. Rafael Palmeiro made four All-Star Game appearances during a 20-year career in which he racked up 3,020 hits, 569 home runs and 1,835 RBI.

MOSS THE BOSS

JACK MOSS has been the Aggies most consistent hitter, batting a team-high .370 to go with a .425 slugging percentage and .521 on-base percentage. He has reached base in 43 of the 46 games this season. In 2022, he has a team-high 24 multi-hit games. In addition to batting average, he leads the team in hits (71) and doubles (12) and ranks third in on-base percentage (.425) and slugging percentage. Moss leads the SEC in hits per game (1.54). He ranks second in the SEC and 37th in the nation with 71 hits, trailing only Auburn's Blake Rambusch (73) on the league chart.

CYCLES

The Aggies have a pair of cycles on the season with **JACK MOSS** recording one at No. 8 Texas on March 29 and **RYAN TARGAC** adding one 12 days later against Kentucky.

Moss had a 5-for-5 game, hitting for the Aggies' first cycle since 2018 in A&M's 12-9 win at Texas. He singled in the first and fourth innings, smashed a two-run home run in the third and roped a double in the sixth. Moss legged out a triple in the eighth to seal the cycle. He also accounted for one of the team's two grand slams on the season, launching the four-ribbie dinger against Rice.

Targac batted 4-for-5 in the series finale, logging three runs and five RBI. The switch-hitter logged two hits from each side of the base. He hit a single (4th inning) and double (8th inning) from the right side of the plate. He homered (5th inning) and tripled (6th inning) from the left side.

STREAKING

DYLAN ROCK has reached base in 37 consecutive games and 44 of the 45 games he has played this season, three times reaching base with a pinch-hit in his only at-bat of the game.

WINNING TRADITION

With their 30-16 overall record, the Aggies have post their 16th consecutive winning season. Texas A&M has registered a winning record in 60 of the last 62 campaigns.

BATTING WITH RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION

AUSTIN BOST, **TROY CLAUNCH** and **JACK MOSS** are the Aggies top hitters with batters in scoring position in 2022. Bost is batting .321 (17-for-53) with four doubles, two home, nine walks, five HBP, five sac flies, a .431 on-base percentage and 23 RBI with RISP. Claunch is swinging .300 (21-for-70) with three doubles, 32 RBI, seven walks, three HBP, one sac bunt and five sac flies. Moss is hitting .298 (17-for-57) with four doubles, three home runs, seven walks, one HBP, five sacrifice flies and 33 RBI. **RYAN TARGAC** and **DYLAN ROCK** are hitting .291 and .289, respectively, with on-bae percentages of .403 and .414 with RISP.

NEW, BUT EXPERIENCED, BLOOD

The Aggies hit the transfer portal to find eight Division I transfers to fill spots for departed players. The list includes four hitters and three pitchers. In the field, infielders **KOLE KALER** (Hawaii) and **JACK MOSS** (Arizona State), catcher **TROY CLAUNCH** (Oregon State) and outfielder **DYLAN ROCK** (UTSA) give the coaching staff four veteran starters to bolster the lineup. On the mound, **MICAH DALLAS** (Texas Tech), **XAVIER LOVETT** (Mississippi State) and **JACOB PALISCH** (Stanford) provide a young group of returners with valuable experience to lean on.

OUCH

AUSTIN BOST tied a school single-game record when he was hit by a pitch three times in the Aggies' game at Rice. It equaled the mark set by Mitchell Nau in a Texas A&M home win against UT-Pan American in 2015. On the season, Bost has been hit by pitch on 10 occasions, along with drawing 21 walks. He sports a .361 batting average .455 on-base percentage.

FIRST SEC TEAM TO 2,800 WINS

In the Aggies' 23-9 victory over Georgia on April 16, Texas A&M became the first SEC team to reach the 2,800-win mark. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .639 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools. The Aggies' are the 11th NCAA Division I program to reach the 2,800-win plateau and they enter Tuesday action with a 2,806-1,573-43 all-time mark.

BULLPEN NUGGETS

JOSEPH MENEFEE ranks fourth in strikeouts per nine innings (13.63) among active NCAA Division I pitchers with at least 100.0 innings of work in their career. Menefee also ranks 15th in fewest hits allowed per nine innings (6.47) and 45th in relief appearances (71). For his career, 10-6 with one save, a 4.17 ERA, .198 opponent batting average, 1.35 WHIP and 160 strikeouts in 105.2 innings. This season, he is 3-2 with a 5.79 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 32.2 innings.

JACOB PALISCH ranks 15th in pitching appearances among active NCAA Division I players with 93. The graduate also ranks 14th among active players with 86 relief appearances and 60th in pitching wins with 15. For his career, Palisch is 15-6 with 10 saves, a 3.43 ERA and 160 strikeouts in 176.0 innings. This season, the Stanford-transfer is 4-3 with four saves, a 3.11 ERA and 47 strikeouts in 37.2 innings.

Since March 29, Palish allowed just two earned runs in 10 appearances, scattering 18 hits and three walks while striking out 28 over 20.0 innings for a 2-0 record, four saves and 0.90 ERA.

A TOAST TO BOST

AUSTIN BOST has emerged as the Aggies top hitter the last 16 games as the Maroon & White have rolled to a 12-4 mark, their best stretch of the season. Since the Aggies' series finale against Kentucky, Bost has raked to the tune of a .475 batting average (28-for-59) with a .562 on-base percentage and .780 slugging percentage. Over the span, Bost has 19 runs, six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, and 12 walks. He has hits in 15 of the 16 games, including nine multi-hit efforts. The stretch includes a four-hit game and two three-hit performances. During the run, Bost's batting average has ballooned from .299 to .361.

On the season, Bost is hitting .361 (60-for-166) with 36 runs, nine doubles, two triples, six home runs, 27 RBI and a .450 on-base percentage.

In 24 league games, Bost ranks third in the SEC with a .383 batting average. He also leads the SEC in hits (36) and ranks seventh in on-base percentage (.455) over the first eight weekends of league play.

WALKS AS GOOD AS A HIT

KOLE KALER ranks fourth in the SEC and 25th in the nation with his 41 walks. His clip of 0.89 walks per game also ranks fourth in the SEC and 28th in the nation. Kaler has also been hit by two pitches and he's batting .242 (44-for-182) with 37 runs, plus seven doubles, two triples, two home runs, 24 RBI and nine stolen bases. He sports a .383 on-base percentage.

DYLAN ROCK tied a Texas A&M record for walks drawn in a game with five in the series opener against South Carolina. His tally equaled a mark set by Blake Kopetsky against Northwestern State in 2016. on the season, Rock ranks sixth in the SEC and 49th in the nation with 37 walks. Rock has been hit by a pitch on a team-high 12 occasions. His .483 on-base percentage ranks second in the SEC and 48th in the country.

TAR-GOTCHA

RYAN TARGAC stepped up his play in league action. Sporting just a .213 batting average with two doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI in 20 non-conference games, Targac has gone boom in league play. In 24 SEC games, Targac leads the conference with 34 RBI. He boasts a .313 batting average with three doubles, two triples and nine home runs in the first eight weeks of league play. Overall, Targac leads the team with 45 RBI and shares the Aggie homer lead with Dylan Rock with 12 dingers.
