Tough 13 Game Stretch: Southern Miss opens the month of March with a tough 13-game stretch that includes six games against teams that reached NCAA play last season beginning with defending national champion Mississippi State. The stretch includes a three-game set at Louisiana (3/4-6) this weekend, midweek home games with South Alabama (3/8) and Tulane (3/9), followed by another road weekend series at Dallas Baptist (3/11-13). The 13-game span ends with a home tilt versus Alabama (3/15) before opening up C-USA play at home versus Florida Atlantic (3/18-20).

Against the Bulldogs: Mississippi State leads the overall series 84-43, but Southern Miss has won four of the last seven meetings dating back to the start of the 2018 season. This will be the second time the two teams have played at Trustmark Park since 2017, after the two teams played three-game sets at each other's home park in 2018 and 2019.

Southern Miss swept the Bulldogs in Hattiesburg to start the 2018 campaign and took one of three in Starkville in 2019. Charlie Fischer provided a 10th-inning, run-scoring single in the opening-game win at Dudy Noble Field which was the only run of the game. MSU won last year's return to Pearl 4-1.

Starting Pitcher: Sophomore right-hander Tanner Hall will make his second consecutive midweek start when he faces the Bulldogs. He went five innings last Tuesday in a no decision at home versus South Alabama in which he allowed four runs (two earned) on five hits with a walk and six strikeouts. This will be Hall's third career start for the Golden Eagles. In his career, he has posted a 1-1 record with a 4.63 career ERA over 21 appearances. His career includes 35 innings and fanned 40 with eight walks.

Ewing Off to Hot Start: Junior outfielder Reece Ewing has enjoyed a strong start to the season, having hit safely in all seven contests to open the season. Ewing collected two-hit contests in each of his first five games and currently leads the team with a .500 batting mark with 2 HRs and 6 RBI.

Pitching Has Led the Way in 2022: Pitching has led the way for the Golden Eagles this season as they have posted a 1.88 team earned run average. The staff has fanned 84 batters, while walking 13. Through Tuesday's games, the Golden Eagles rank first in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.46) and walks per nine innings (1.75), No. 11 in WHIP (0.93) and No. 15 in earned run average.

Returning to Trustmark: Tonight's game marks the 34th scheduled appearance for the Golden Eagles at Trustmark Park with Southern Miss holding a 17-16 record there, including a 4-6 mark versus the Bulldogs. Southern Miss participated in the 2011 and 2012 Conference USA Tournament at the facility and its first ever game goes back to April 4, 2006, at the home of the Double A Atlanta Braves affiliate, the Mississippi Braves. Southern Miss defeated Ole Miss that day, 13-6.

Winning at Home: Since utilizing Pete Taylor Park as its home facility in 1984, the Golden Eagles are 839-349 (.706) at the venue, having won at least 20 or more home games in 31 of the 38 campaigns played at the park. During the 1985 and 1986 campaigns, Southern Miss played a handful of home games at Smokey Harrington Park, which is currently the home of Hattiesburg High School.

Back to the NCAAs: Southern Miss appeared in the Oxford Regional last June and it was the school's fifth-straight NCAA appearance and 17th overall. The Golden Eagles' first-ever postseason appearance came in 1990 with a trip to Baton Rouge, and at one point reached regional play nine-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2003-11. Southern Miss also appeared in its lone Super Regional and College World Series during the 2009 campaign.

Consecutive 30 Win Seasons: The Golden Eagles clinched their 19th consecutive 30-win season in 2021. They are one of only three Division I programs to collect at least 19-straight, 30 or more wins seasons. Clemson's had a string of 45-straight 30-win seasons and North Carolina had a 22-season streak ended in 2021. Here is a look at the top four programs that have won 30 or more games in a season:

Five-Straight 40 Win Seasons: The Golden Eagles are one of two Division I baseball programs that have accumulated 40 win seasons in at least each of the last five seasons (not including the 2020 season that was cut short due to COVID-19). The Golden Eagles have won 40 or more games 13 times in their history. USM first won 40 games in 1990. Southern Miss set its school record for victories in 2017 with 50, surpassing the previous best of 47 in 2003. Here is a look at those schools heading into the 2022 season:

Two Wins Against Nationally Ranked Teams in the Same Day: Southern Miss defeated both Florida State and Ole Miss last June 6 to mark what is believed to be the first time that they have defeated two nationally ranked teams on the same day.

In Conference USA Play: Southern Miss played its 25th season of Conference USA in 2021 - the 2020 schedule was canceled due to COVID-19 - and the Golden Eagles have posted a 430-247 (.635) record and are 143-77-5 in league series over that time. The Golden Eagles have won 20 league games now eight times, including in each of the last five years.

Pitching Dominance: The 2021 Southern Miss pitching staff led the league in ERA (3.74), opponent's batting average (.236) and strikeouts (560) and finished with the fewest walks (138) since the 1982 season (137). The staff recorded eight complete games and eight shutouts, the most they blanked an opponent since 2015. The Golden Eagles were 23-0 this season when they allowed 2 or fewer runs and 34-9 when they allowed five runs or less. The staff had one no hitter and a nine-inning shutout with no decision to its credit (that game went 10 innings). The staff also registered over 500 strikeouts for only the seventh time.

Montenegro Overcame Slow Start to Enjoy Solid Offensive 2021 Season: After overcoming a 10-for-55 start (.182) over the first 16 games, Gabe Montenegro rebounded and collected a .383 batting average over the final 45 games (72x183). During that stretch, Montenegro enjoyed the team's longest hitting streak of the year at 15 games and was the team's leader in doubles with 24, which ranked in the Top 20 nationally.

Homer Happy: Southern Miss finished No. 17 in the country in home runs with 83. The Golden Eagles belted 36 home runs over the final 16 games, including a season-high of six coming against both SEMO (6/5) and Ole Miss (6/7) in the Oxford Regional. Those six homers tied a Southern Miss NCAA record for most homers in a game. Here is the Top 5 home run totals for the Golden Eagles in a season:

Offense Showed Improvement over Season: After starting the first 19 games as a team hitting just .208, the Golden Eagles collected a .303 batting average over the last 42 games and seen their offensive numbers increase as the season has progressed. Here is a look at a breakdown of offensive stats from the first 19 games to the last 42:

Tough Non-Conference Slate: Of the 11 non-conference opponents, four - South Alabama (Sun Belt), Dallas Baptist (Missouri Valley), Southeastern Louisiana (Southland) and Ole Miss (SEC) have been chosen to win their respective league or division. In fact, eight of the opponents are expected to finish in top four of their respective leagues: Sun Belt - South Alabama (1st), Louisiana (T-3rd); Atlantic Sun - Jacksonville State (4th), North Alabama (12th); Southland - Southeastern Louisiana (1st) and New Orleans (3rd); American - Tulane (2nd); SEC - Miss. State (T2nd), Ole Miss (T2nd in division, but to win league) and Alabama (5th).

Scott Berry Head Coach 13th Year (Southwest Missouri State, 1986)

The Southern Miss baseball program continues to thrive under Scott Berry, who is in his 13th season at the helm of the program.

Under Berry's tutelage, Southern Miss has captured four Conference USA tournament titles, registered four league regular-season crowns, obtained seven NCAA Tournament appearances and the Golden Eagle head coach has won the league's Coach of the Year Award three times.

Last spring, Berry led his young club to the NCAA Oxford Regional final as the program collected its fifth straight 40-win season, currently only behind Dallas Baptist for consecutive 40-win campaigns as they have registered seven. The 2021 Golden Eagles started the year at 4-5 before going 36-16 down the stretch to finish 40-21 as they went to the NCAA Tournament for the fifth-straight time and 17th time overall.

The Golden Eagles used a strong pitching staff and a young offensive club, overcoming a schedule that had the squad playing four league games each weekend due to COVID protocols, that continued to get better each month during the year and fell to host Ole Miss 12-9 in the regional final.

Six different players, catcher Blake Johnson, first baseman Christopher Sargent, second baseman Will McGillis, third baseman Danny Lynch, as well as outfielders Reed Trimble and Gabe Montenegro earned all-regional performers. The six players were the most ever to make an NCAA all-regional squad in school history. Trimble, along with pitchers Walker Powell and Hunter Stanley, each made All-America honors.

Despite an abbreviated season in 2020, the Golden Eagles jumped out to a 12-4 record and a Top 40 RPI ranking, before the season was shut down due to COVID-19.

The 2019 season, saw the Golden Eagles compile a 40-19 record as the team reached the NCAA Tournament for the fourth-straight year and 16th time overall. The Golden Eagles finished second in the regular season, but went on to defeat Florida Atlantic 4-0 in the C-USA title game for the second-straight year, to give the Golden Eagles their third league tournament triumph over the last four seasons.

All-American Matt Wallner enjoyed a stellar junior season as he tied a single-season record for home runs (23), while shattering the career mark (58) in only three seasons. Wallner went on to be the highest-ever drafted player in school history during the June MLB First-Year Player Draft, going to the Minnesota Twins in the Competitive Balance Round A.

In 2018, the Golden Eagles posted a 44-18 record en route to winning the league crown by 2 1/2 games in the regular season and upended Florida Atlantic 14-3 in the C-USA title game as the squad reached the NCAA postseason.

Junior pitcher Nick Sandlin led the way for the program as a consensus first-team All-American as well as the Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Year, the Boo Ferriss Trophy Winner, as well as the C-USA Pitcher of the Year, before getting drafted in the second round by Cleveland.

Luke Reynolds, who captured the league's Player and Newcomer of the Year honors, also earned All-America honors as did 2017 National Freshman of the Year Matt Wallner.

Berry led the Golden Eagles to arguably its best season in the program's 90-year history in 2017 with the school's first-ever 50-win season, another Conference USA regular season crown and the hosting of the school's second regional.

For his accomplishments, Berry was named the C-USA Coach of the Year for the second time in his tenure, and the accolades for his program included the league's Player of the Year (Dylan Burdeaux) - the first in the school's time in the league - Freshman of the Year (Matt Wallner) and Assistant Coach of the Year (Chad Calleit).

Wallner also earned a spot on almost every All-American and Freshman All-American squad and became the first Golden Eagle to capture the Baseball America National Freshman of the Year and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Freshman Hitter of the Year. In all, four different Golden Eagles enjoyed All-America status including Braley, Burdeaux, Nick Sandlin and Wallner. The program also enjoyed their first Academic All-Americans since 2011 with Kirk McCarty (second team) and Sandlin (third team) collecting those awards.

The 2016 team battled for the C-USA regular season title up until the final weekend before snaring their first league tournament title since 2010 by winning four-straight games at Pete Taylor Park, including a 3-2 championship game victory over perennial favorite Rice.

The Golden Eagles enjoyed a league-high five first-team all-league selections including first baseman Tim Lynch, center fielder Jake Sandlin, right fielder Dylan Burdeaux, catcher Chuckie Robinson and pitcher Kirk McCarty.

With the C-USA tournament title, the Golden Eagles returned to the NCAA Tournament after a four-year absence making their first appearance in Tallahassee, Fla., in a quarter of a decade since both teams were member of the old Metro Conference.

Berry's squad produced yet a couple more All-America selections as Tim Lynch garnered third-team honors by D1Baseball.com and Nick Sandlin collected Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America accolades.

In 2015, Berry's baseball Golden Eagles tallied a 36-18-1 record. What made 2015 so special for the Golden Eagles included the fact that the team went 4-0 against Southeastern Conference foes, including 2-0 against Ole Miss, while also beating Mississippi State and Alabama in the two schools' only meeting of the year. In addition, Southern Miss also swept Tulane and South Alabama during both of its meetings during the year. The team also won its last 10 league games to capture 19 C-USA contests during the year.

Senior pitcher James McMahon became only the second Golden Eagle to win the Ferriss Award for top collegiate player in the state.

His 2014 club finished 10 games over .500 and reach the bracket final of the C-USA Tournament, finished 35-25 overall and 19-11 in league play. The 19 wins in C-USA play was the most since the 2005 club tallied 20.

In 2013, the Golden Eagles tied with Rice for the second time in the three seasons as the conference's regular-season champion. The program reached the C-USA title game for the second time under Berry, dropping the contest in 11 innings to Rice at Reckling Park in Houston. The Golden Eagles had previously defeated Rice in the 2010 C-USA title matchup, a victory that sent Southern Miss to the postseason in Berry's first year as head coach. The team finished 30-27 in 2013.

In 2012, a young Southern Miss squad went through growing pains but still captured 32 wins during the campaign.

In 2011, Berry earned C-USA Coach of the Year Honors as he led the program to its ninth-consecutive NCAA postseason as Southern Miss captured a share of the Conference USA regular season title en route to a 39-19 mark and a berth in the 2011 NCAA Atlanta Regional. The 2011 season produced many awards for Berry's squad. Outfielder Tyler Koelling became the school's first recipient of the Ferriss Trophy, awarded to the top collegiate baseball player in the state of Mississippi.

The Golden Eagles also excelled off the field as Bourgeois was named the program's first Academic All-American since 2009, earning first-team honors at designated hitter. He was named the C-USA Scholar-Athlete of the Year for the sport and also spearheaded a group of three players - himself, Todd McInnis and Adam Doleac - that made the league's All-Academic Team.

In Berry's first season as head coach, 2010, he was able to continue the success that he helped build while an assistant. That season, the Golden Eagles compiled a 36-24 record and won their first Conference USA tournament title since 2003 when they defeated nationally-ranked Rice 7-4 in the championship game, a win that earned the program its eighth-straight NCAA Tournament appearance. Southern Miss boasted two All-Americans that year, pitcher Scott Copeland and shortstop B.A. Vollmuth.

Berry's initial success as the top man in the program came on the heels of a magical 2009 season in which Berry, as associate head coach to Corky Palmer, helped lead the program to its first Super Regional. In that round of the postseason, Southern Miss swept Florida in Gainesville and earned an inaugural visit to the College World Series. The team finished with a No. 8 final ranking in three different polls.

Prior to his appointment as the Golden Eagles' top man on May 7, 2009, Berry spent the previous six years as the associate head coach and the three seasons prior to that as an assistant coach on the Southern Miss baseball staff.

Berry oversaw the Golden Eagles pitching staff, worked with the catchers, had recruiting responsibilities and assisted with the program's camps and clinics from 2003-2009. Prior to the 2003 season, he served as the team's hitting coach and worked with catchers and outfielders.

After completing an unbelievable four-year stint as the head coach at Meridian Community College from 1997-2000, including two trips to the National Junior College World Series, Berry rejoined his mentor, Corky Palmer, at Southern Miss prior to the 2001 season.

A native of Neosho, Mo., he compiled an impressive record of 185-58, including two seasons of 50 wins or more. During his four-year tenure at Meridian, Berry's squad spent the entire time in the top 10 of the national polls. He had more than 25 players sign NCAA Division I scholarships and had, at that time, nine former players in the professional ranks.

Berry's most successful professional player was Cliff Lee, who studied under Berry at in 1999 and 2000 at Meridian Community College. Lee was honored after his eighth year in the major leagues with the 2008 American League Cy Young Award.

For his efforts, Berry was honored as a three-time Region 23 Coach of the Year, three-time district coach of the year, three-time Louisville Slugger Coach of the Year Award and two-time Diamond Sports ABCA Region Coach of the Year.

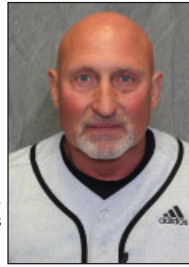
On January 24, 2010, MCC recognized Berry's accomplishments and retired his jersey number (40).

In 2000, Meridian finished fifth in the nation with a 46-19 record and took its second trip under Berry to the National Junior College World Series. The program made its first trip under Berry to the college world series in 1998, when they posted a 52-12 record and ended the season as the No. 5 team in the nation.

For his outstanding service at Meridian, Berry was inducted in the Mississippi Junior College Hall of Fame in the spring of 2014. He completed his bachelor's degree in secondary education with an emphasis in physical education from Southwest Missouri State University in 1986 and also received his master's degree from SMSU in 1989 with a degree in secondary education with an emphasis in administration.

His collegiate career began at Crowder College, where he was a two-time all-region selection as a catcher and was named the team's most valuable player as a sophomore. Berry was forced to end his playing career early with a back injury. He spent the last two years of his undergraduate tenure as a student assistant at SMSU.
