TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ The 18th-ranked Bulldogs (14-3) open SEC play Friday with No. 24 Miss. State (11-7) at Foley Field where Georgia is 11-1 this season. Georgia has won five in a row while MSU has four straight. MSU leads the series with the Bulldogs 49-45 in available records. On Friday during batting practice, Georgia will wear special warm-up SEC shirts to commemorate the 50th anniversary of Title IX.



◆ Georgia is batting .304 with 19 home runs on the year while posting a 3.36 ERA and a .974 Fielding Percentage. Graduate CF **Ben Anderson** (.373-3-12) and graduate SS **Cole Tate** (.372-1-9) lead the regulars. Anderson has reached base in 15 straight games as he ranks among the SEC leaders with a .548 OB% plus a team-high 16 walks. Tate ranks

among the SEC leaders with 28 hits. Sophomore C/DH **Corey Collins** (.352-6-15) is tied for third in the SEC with six home runs and is sixth in the league with a .796 SLG%. He enters SEC play with a 15-game on base streak including a seven-game hitting streak.

◆ Junior RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (3-1, 2.39 ERA) headlines the pitching staff and leads the SEC with 26.1 innings pitched. Sophomore LHP **Luke Wagner** is the national leader in victories at 5-0. A key member of the bullpen, he has notched a victory in all five of his relief appearances while posting a 0.73 ERA in 12.1 innings with 17 Ks. Sophomore LHP **Liam Sullivan** (2-1, 3.68 ERA) has served as the No. 2 starter. Sullivan will miss his turn in the rotation this Saturday to rest. Wagner will fill that spot.

◆ Georgia has lost starting pitchers **Dylan Ross** and **Will Childers** for the season. In their last appearance, both left the mound after pitching one inning. Ross, who began the year as the No. 3 starter, was 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA in two starts while Childers (0-0, 9.00 ERA) was a candidate to replace Ross in the rotation after missing the 2021 season after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Meanwhile, redshirt sophomore RHP **Garrett Brown** (0-0, 5.40 ERA) is getting a look at filling the No. 3 spot after he recovered from the same surgery that caused him to miss last year. Meanwhile freshmen RHP **Chandler Marsh** (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 5.2 IP) and **Coleman Willis** (1-0, 2.45 ERA, 7.1 IP) have seen their roles increased.

◆ The back end of the bullpen looks to be solidified now with sophomore LHP **Jaden Woods** (0-0, 3.94 ERA, 16 IP), sophomore LHP **Collin Caldwell** (1-0, 1.42 ERA, 1 SV, 6.1 IP) and senior RHP **Jack Gowen** (0-0, 1.50 ERA, 2 SV, 6 IP) seeing most of the action in high-leverage situations. The trio have all made six appearances on the year.

◆ Redshirt senior starting INF **Josh McAllister** will wear a facemask in the field and a batting helmet with a face guard after being struck in the left cheek by a pitch against Ga. Southern on March 8. He missed just two games and returned to action this past Sunday for a doubleheader. Currently, he has a nine-game hitting streak and is batting .333-2-11.

◆ Curious Stats So Far: Georgia's pinch hitters this year are batting .318 (7-for-22) while opponents are just 2-for-17 (.118). With runners in scoring position, the Bulldogs are batting .322 (64-for-199) while the opponents are at .161 (24-for-149).

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 9TH SEASON AT UGA; 18TH OVERALL

Now in his ninth year at the helm, Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. In April of 2021, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally as it had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall). Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in ERA during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins. He graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (19) who attends UGA, and Keaton (14), and a son, Cale (17).

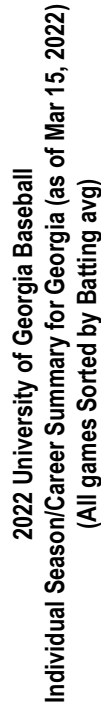
