2023 Baseball Notes vs. Mississippi State

QUICK HITTERS:

- * North Alabama is on a three-game winning streak after sweeping a three-game road series at Kennesaw State over the weekend.
- * The Lions outscored the Owls 31-17 in the three-game set.
- * North Alabama is 12-36 overall and 6-21 in the ASUN Conference.
- * The Lions are 6-15 in non-conference games this season.
- * The wins at Kennesaw snapped an 11-game losing streak that dated back to a series sweep at Bellarmine from April 14-16.
- * North Alabama is 0-25 when scoring five runs or less and 12-11 when scoring six runs or more.
- * UNA has scored 10 runs in nine of its 12 wins this season.
- * The Lions are just 10-72 on the road the last three seasons - going 2-24 on the road in 2021, 1-28 last season and 7-20 in 2023.
- * The Lions have been outscored 64-19 in the first inning and 44-21 in the second for a total of 108-40 over the first two innings of games this season.
- * UNA pitching has allowed 10 or more runs in 14 games this season.
- * Walks are killing the Lions. UNA has walked 351 batters this season and hit another 99, while allowing 467 hits. That is 450 free bases to 467 earned hits. UNA has walked 10 or more batters in 12 games this season.
- * Weather has been brutal to the Lions scheduling this season. UNA has already played seven double-headers, including playing back-to-back double-headers at Cincinnati. The Lions also played three games at home against Miami (Ohio) in a less than 24 hour period.
- * The Lions have lost their last ten straight home games and their last 12 straight conference home games. UNA is 0-12 at home in the ASUN in 2023.

UNA VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE

- * North Alabama is 2-8 all-time against Mississippi State in baseball, with all 10 previous games having been played in Starkville. The first eight were while UNA was a Division II program.
- * The last meeting was last season, with the Bulldogs taking an 14-4 win.
- * The Lions wins over the Bulldogs came in 1990, 10-3, when Mississippi State was ranked 10th in the nation, and 1992, 3-2.

- * UNA has played five different SEC schools, having played 28 games against Alabama, 12 against Ole Miss, 10 against Mississippi State, four against Auburn and one against Vanderbilt.
- * UNA is 3-25 vs. Alabama, 2-10 vs. Ole Miss, 2-9 vs. Mississippi State, 0-4 vs. Auburn and 0-2 vs. Vanderbilt.
- * The Lions have two wins over nationally ranked SEC teams
 - April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3
 - April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6
- * UNA has five wins vs. SEC schools in its last 22 games against the league (5-17).

LIONS HAVE TWO WINS OVER RANKED SEC TEAMS

- * The Lions have two wins over nationally ranked SEC teams
 - April 19, 1990 over 10th ranked Mississippi State, 10-3 (while UNA was still in Division II).
 - April 2, 2019 over 18th ranked Ole Miss, 10-6

UNA 2023 Baseball Game Notes



UNA HEAD COACH JAD PRACHNIAK

- * 11th head baseball coach in North Alabama history.
- * Just the third head coach at UNA since 1984 (39 seasons).
- * He spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Delaware.
- * Prior to Delaware, he spent nine seasons as the head coach at Division II West Chester, leading the Rams to a 273-127-1 record that included two NCAA Division II National Championships.
- * He began his full-time coaching career in 2005 and spent six seasons at William and Mary, finishing his time there as recruiting coordinator and pitching coach.
- * Originally from Lincoln, R.I., he graduated from the University of Rhode Island in 2005.
- * As a player, he served as a co-captain for Rhode Island's school-record 35-win season in 2005, capturing the Atlantic 10 Eastern Division title.
- * His wife Kelly serves as General Manager of Corporate Partnerships for the UNA Athletic Department and they have a daughter, Emilia.
- * **285-163-1 record as a collegiate head coach.**

NORTH ALABAMA IN FIRST SEASON AS FULL DI MEMBER

- * North Alabama completed its four-year transition to full NCAA Division I status in 2022 and the Lions are now eligible to compete for NCAA post-season playoff for the first time on the Division I level.
- * The Lions competed in the NCAA Division II before going 16-38 in their first season in Division I in 2019. It was just UNA's second losing season in baseball in the last 36 years.
- * North Alabama has had only five losing seasons since 1984, with four of those coming in the last four years during the Division I transition.
- * The Lions were a combined 38-133 during the transition, going 16-38, 3-13, 7-40 and 12-41.

JUST FIVE LOSING SEASONS SINCE 1984

- * The 2022 season was just the fifth losing baseball season at North Alabama since 1984, with four of those coming during UNA's four-year Division I transition.
- * The Lions had a streak of 30 consecutive winning seasons from 1984-2013 before going 26-27 in 2014.
- * UNA followed with four more winning seasons before going 16-38 in 2019 in its first season in Division I.

DIVISION I ROAD WOES FOR THE LIONS

- * With a 6-5 win at Tennessee Tech on March 10, the Lions broke a 30-game road losing streak that had lasted a year and a day. It was UNA's first road win since a 9-5 win at Alabama on March 9, 2022. That win broke a 26-game losing streak in non-conference road games, dating back to an 8-4 win at Little Rock on February 28, 2020.
- * UNA was 2-24 on the road in 2021, 1-28 last season and 7-20 in 2023 - so 10-72 on the road the last three seasons.
- * North Alabama has a 31-51 home record in its Division I era and is 16-117 away from home.

JAD PRACHNIAK IN FIRST SEASON AT NORTH ALABAMA

- * Jad Prachniak (pronounced PRACK-knee-ak) became just the 11th head baseball coach in the 91-year history of the sport at UNA on June 23, 2022. He is only the third head coach of the Lions in the last 39 seasons (Mike Lane 25 years, Mike Keehn 14 years).
- * Prachniak spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Delaware. Prior to that, he spent nine seasons as the head coach at Division II West Chester, leading the Rams to a 273-127-1 record that included two NCAA Division II National Championships.
- * He began his full-time coaching career in 2005 and spent six seasons at William and Mary, finishing his time there as recruiting coordinator and pitching coach.
- * Prachniak is originally from Lincoln, R.I., and graduated from the University of Rhode Island in 2005 with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology and a teaching certificate in physical education. As a player, he served as a co-captain for Rhode Island's school-record 35-win season in 2005, capturing the Atlantic 10 Eastern Division title.

HITTER'S NOTES

Ethan Walker

- * Has 12 multi-hit games in 2023.
- * Hit in the leadoff spot in 20 of his 34 starts

Jackson Ferrigno

- * Has a current streak of reaching base in the last 24 straight games, which is a UNA Division I record.
- * Had a 17-game hitting streak end in the second game of the Jacksonville State series.
- * 47 starts this season with 15 at third base, 28 at shortstop and four at second base.
- * Went 4-for-5 at Stetson on April 2 with a run scored and four RBI, including a home run.
- * Went 4-for-5 in the first game at Jacksonville State with a run scored and a run batted in.
- * Nine multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games.
- * Leads the team with 15 RBI with two outs.

Jonathan Lane

- * 12 multi-hit games
- * Reached base on all five plate appearances in the first game of the North Florida series - a single, double, two walks and a hit-by-pitch - and was 2-for-5 in game two.
- * Lane went 3-for-4 in his first collegiate game on February 8, 2022 at Southern Miss.
- * Lane had a career-high four hits at home against Central Arkansas on April 3, 2022 - with two singles and two doubles.
- * Tied that four-hit game with four on April 2 of this season at Stetson (three singles and a double)
- * His father Chris Lane was the long-time team chaplain of the Florida Marlins before his retirement in 2021.

Kyle Machado

- * Machado leads UNA with eight home runs and 37 RBI.
- * He had reached base in the last 13 straight games before ending that streak in the second game of the ECU series.
- * Machado is the only Lion to hit two home runs this season in the same game - March 24 against FGCU at home.
- * Leads team with 17 multi-hit games in 2023.
- * Leads UNA with 10 multi-RBI games.
- * All 46 of his starts have been at first base.
- * Leads the team in total bases with 87.

Andrew Knight

- * Homered in each of UNA's three games against Bellarmine.
- * Reached base in 17 straight games earlier this season.
- * Leads the team with 18 doubles.
- * Third on team with 13 multi-hit games in 2023.

Gehrig Frei

- * 48 starts this season with 15 at shortstop and the last 33 at third base. He is the only player to start all 48 games.
- * Leads the team in hits with 54
- * 15 multi-hit games - second on team.
- * Third on team with seven multi-RBI games

Drew Hudson

- * Senior Drew Hudson and Peyton Thomas are the only two members of the UNA baseball team who have been through the program's full transition to Division I. Both played significantly as freshmen in 2019 and are already four-year lettermen, including the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season.
- * He has 101 career runs scored.
- * Hudson has played in 191 career games with 180 starts at UNA. He has 665 at bats (7th), 166 career hits (13th), 101 runs scored and 74 runs batted in.
- * His 191 games played is tied for fifth in UNA history:

- * His first 41 starts this season were all at second base, before starting at shortstop the last two games of the UNF series and all three games at KSU. He previously had one start at shortstop as a freshman in 2019 and six at short in 2021.

Dominick McIntyre

- * Has UNA's only grand-slam of the season - on Feb. 26 against Miami (Ohio). It was his first career home run in three seasons with the Lions. He has since three additional home runs against Cincinnati, Jacksonville State and Kennebec State.
- * 120 career games played with 107 starts.

PRACHNIAK GETS FIRST WIN AS A LION

* UNA coach Jad Prachniak got his first win as head coach of the Lions on Sunday, February 19 with a 14-6 win over Milwaukee.

I LIKE MIKE

* Coach Jad Prachniak is the first head baseball coach at North Alabama not named Mike since 1979, when Gary Elliott was head coach for one season. In fact, four of UNA's last five head baseball coaches were named Mike: Mike Knight (1977-78), Mike Galloway (1980-83), Mike Lane (1984-08) and Mike Keehn (2009-22).

UNA BASEBALL SUPERLATIVES

* While in the NCAA Division II, the Lions won 10 Gulf South Conference Divisional crowns, five GSC Tournament Championships and played in 12 NCAA Division II Regional Tournaments. UNA won the 1999 South Central Regional and advanced to the Division II World Series.

* Among the UNA baseball alums who have played in the Major Leagues are Josh Willingham, who played in the 2014 World Series with the Kansas City Royals and hit 195 career home runs in an 11-year MLB career, and reliever Sergio Romo, who pitched for the San Francisco Giants in the 2010, 2012 and 2014 World Series.

TWO FORMER LIONS COMPETED IN 2014 WORLD SERIES

* Two former University of North Alabama baseball players found themselves on opposite sides of the 2014 World Series as Josh Willingham (1998-00) and the Kansas City Royals faced Sergio Romo (2004) and the San Francisco Giants.

FIVE FORMER LIONS HAVE PLAYED IN THE MAJOR LEAGUES

* Five former University of North Alabama baseball players have reached the Major Leagues:

WILLINGHAM HIT TWO GRAND SLAMS IN A SINGLE MAJOR LEAGUE GAME

* Former UNA Lion Josh Willingham is one of just 13 players in the history of Major League Baseball to hit two grand slams in a single game.

* On July 27, 2009, while playing for the Washington Nationals, Willingham hit two grand slams against the Milwaukee Brewers in a 14-6 win by the Nationals. He also tied a franchise record with eight runs batted in.

* The bat that he used to hit the two grand slams is on display in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y.

LIONS AT HOME AT MIKE LANE FIELD

* North Alabama has a 785-298-5 record at Mike Lane Field since 1984, the season that Lane arrived at UNA.

* UNA was 571-156-4 under Mike Lane at home for a 78.3 winning percentage.

* The Lions were 210-125-1 under Mike Keehn at home for a 62.6 winning percentage.

* North Alabama has a 31-54 record at Mike Lane Field in its Division I era and won an additional home game at Heiney Manush Field in Tusculumbia.

* UNA was 11-13 at home last season and 1-28 on the road.

* The Lions are 5-16 at home in 2023.

LIONS HAD BREAK-OUT SERIES AT BELLARMINE

* The combined 37 runs in the Bellarmine series is the most runs that UNA has scored in a three-game series on the Division I level, and in the ASUN.

* The Lions set three school Division I records against Bellarmine on April 15 -

Most Hits in a Game - 21

Most Total Bases in a Game - 34

Most Doubles in a Game - 7

* The four home runs hit in the April 16 Bellarmine game tied a school-record set earlier this year against FGCU.

WEATHER RELATED . . .

LIONS HAVE ALREADY PLAYED SEVEN DOUBLE-HEADERS

* On the Division I level, double-headers are few and far between. However, due to a rainy months of February, March and April, North Alabama has already played seven double-headers this season, including this past weekend against Eastern Kentucky in Florence. UNA even played two double-headers at Cincinnati to get in four games in two days.

LIONS PLAYED THREE GAMES IN LESS THAN 24 HOURS

* Having condensed a three-game weekend series into a less than 23 hour period, the North Alabama baseball team completed its sweep of the Miami Redhawks by taking both games of a Sunday double-header 14-9 and 10-9 at Mike Lane Field. The double-header was a seven and a half hour marathon that went from 1 p.m. until after 8:30 p.m. The two schools had played the first game of the weekend series beginning at 9:42 Saturday night and ending just before 1 a.m. Sunday with a 12-7 UNA win.

UNA 2023 Baseball Game Notes

FGCU HOME SERIES WAS UNIQUE

* UNA's ASUN series at home against FGCU on March 24-26 was very unique. On the Friday night after the opening game of the series, tornadoes hit Florence and caused major power outages. The hotel that FGCU was staying in was damaged and lost power and the Eagles were forced to switch hotels at midnight. The final two games of the series on Saturday and Sunday were played at a facility with NO power. No scoreboard, music, announcer, broadcast, etc. Just the crack of the bat. The power remained off to parts of the UNA campus for four days.

LIONS HAVE PLAYERS FROM 12 STATES

* The 34 players on the UNA squad come from 12 different states. There are 10 players from the state of Alabama and 24 players from outside the state. There are six from Georgia, three from Florida and Tennessee, two from Connecticut, Mississippi, Minnesota and Pennsylvania, and one from Illinois, Kansas, Washington and Wisconsin.

LIONS SHUTOUT TWICE IN 2023, FIRST TIME SINCE 2021

* UNA was shutout 5-0 by Milwaukee in the season-opener, marking the first time that the Lions had been shutout since 2021. It snapped a streak of having scored in 67 straight games following a 15-0 loss at Liberty on April 18, 2021.

LIONS HAVEN'T BEEN NO-HIT SINCE 1975

* The Lions have not been no-hit in a collegiate baseball game since Roger Mayo of Jacksonville State threw a no-hitter against UNA in 1975. That means the Lions have at least one hit in their last 2,359 consecutive games.

UNA IN ASUN CONFERENCE SERIES

* North Alabama has played 34 all-time ASUN Conference baseball series and UNA has a 24-77 overall record in ASUN play.

* The Lions are 14-36 at home in ASUN play and 10-41 on the road.

* UNA has won seven series, split one and lost the other 25.

* UNA has been swept in 21 of the 34 ASUN series and have swept four - including two this year.

NORTH ALABAMA WAS ABOVE .500 FOR FIRST TIME IN DIVISION I

* Entering a four-game series at Cincinnati, North Alabama was 4-3 record, which was the first time that the Lions had been above the .500 mark on the Division I level. UNA started the 2022 season at 5-5 with a win over Alabama, but never topped .500.

* The Lions have not won season-opening game during UNA's Division I era. North Alabama is 0-5 in its season-openers on the Division I level.

GOING THE DISTANCE

* North Alabama played the second longest game in school history and the longest game ever at home on March 28, 2021 against Lipscomb. The Lions 6-5 win over Lipscomb took 15 innings and five hours and five minutes to complete. Lipscomb held 4-0 and 5-1 leads in the game before UNA rallied. The Lions forced extra innings with a two-run RBI-single in the bottom of the ninth by Kylan Barnett. Neither team scored a run through the first five extra innings. In fact, UNA's bullpen held Lipscomb hitless and scoreless from the eighth inning on (eight total innings). In the bottom of the 15th, Dominick McIntyre drew a walk and later scored on a two-out, RBI-single by Reid Homan to win the game.
