GAMEDAY NOTES

• The University of Evansville baseball team begins arguably its toughest stretch of non-conference play this week by traveling to one of the toughest environments in collegiate baseball by traveling to Mississippi State for a three-game series.

• UE will enter this weekend's series at 7-5 after winning three of four games against Purdue Fort Wayne last weekend. UE will play seven of its next eight games against Power Five competition (3x at Mississippi State, 3x at Michigan State, 1x at Kentucky) before opening MVC play on March 22.

• Evansville went 37-24 a season ago, advancing to the final game of the 2023 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament before falling 6-0 to 2023 Super Regional participant Indiana State. UE returns seven position starters and 10 pitchers from a season ago.

• Of the seven position starters returning this year for UE, five have earned all-MVC honors at some point in their UE career. Graduate 1B Chase Hug (.311/14/55) and senior INF/OF Kip Fougousse (.288/13/47) both earned first team all-MVC honors last season, while senior SS Simon Scherry (.267/3/23) earned honorable mention all-MVC honors.

• UE enters this weekend's action ranked in the NCAA's top 15 in five major offensive categories: doubles (2nd-41), hits (6th-152), average (9th-.345), on-base percentage (13th-.454), and scoring (13th-10.4).

• Graduate OF Mark Shallenberger paces the UE attack with an MVC-best .447 batting average. Shallenberger was limited to just 31 games last year due to injury (hitting just .209), but he has hit safely in 11-straight games this year while being healthy.

• Senior SS Simon Scherry (.405) and junior 2B Cal McGinnis (.404) also hit above .400 this year. Scherry is tied for ninth among active Division I players with 216 career hits.

• Mississippi State is 9-4 entering this weekend's series. The Bulldogs have won six-straight behind power pitching, as MSU ranks in the NCAA's top 20 in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4th) and strikeouts per nine (11th).

TEAM NOTES

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT

The 2024 roster features a very veteran group, featuring five graduate students, a fifth-year senior, and a group of five other seniors. Combined, the "Senior/Grad Class" has combined for nine all-MVC honors during the course of their UE careers.

POWER UP!

UE will face a challenging 2024 schedule this year, with 10 non-conference games scheduled against Power Five competition. Evansville is in a stretch of playing seven of its next eight games against Power Five competition. Also, four of UE's five non-conference weekend series are against teams which finished in the Top 100 in the RPI a year ago.

30 FOR 30

UE has posted back-to-back 30-win seasons for the first time since the 2006 (43 wins) and 2007 (35) seasons. Head coach Wes Carroll has now led UE to 28 or more wins in nine of his 15 previous seasons as head coach, including posting five 30-win seasons.

TAKING OFFENSE

UE's offense has been on fire to start the 2024 season, and the Purple Aces find themselves ranked among the NCAA's leaders in the following categories:

- Doubles: 2nd (41)
- Hits: 6th (152)
- Batting Average: 9th (.345)
- OB Percentage: 13th (.454)
- Scoring: 13th (10.4 runs/game)
- Runs: 18th (125)

WE PLEAD THE FIFTH

Evansville has feasted on the opposition in the fifth inning so far this year, as UE has outscored it opposition, 38-7, in the fifth inning. UE has scored at least one run in the fifth inning in seven of its 12 games so far, and it has scored three or more runs in the fifth inning six times.

DOUBLE VISION

UE has been seeing double so far this year offensively, as the Purple Aces enters the week-end second in the NCAA with 41 doubles. UE is nearly halfway to its doubles total of a year ago of 94, needing just six doubles this weekend to reach the halfway mark.

WE ARE UE

There are several ways to reference the University of Evansville. Generally, the first reference should always be "University of Evansville" or "Purple Aces". Later references to our team may be "Aces" as well as just using the word "Evansville".

Our school abbreviation is "UE". Under no circumstances is it acceptable to use "EU".

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

RANK & FILE

UE had two players ranked among D1Baseball.com's Top 100 players during the website's preseason positional rankings. Senior SS Simon Scherry ranked 22nd nationally at shortstop, while Chase Hug ranked 29th in collegiate baseball among first basemen. Scherry was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List last year as a nominee for the nation's top shortstop, and he led all of collegiate baseball in defensive runs saved on the infield last year at 12.7, according to 643 Charts & Synergy.

THE SUPER SMASH BROS.

Graduate OF Mark Shallenberger and senior SS Simon Scherry have put some video game-like numbers up so far this year, and that's not a surprise, because they are also part of UE's ESports team. Scherry & Shallenberger play the game "Super Smash Bros." on the first-year UE ESports team. They juggle over two-hour long ESports practices with baseball practice this semester. So far it has worked, as Shallenberger is hitting .447 this year, while Scherry is hitting .405.

STREAKING

Graduate OF Mark Shallenberger will bring a 28-game on-base streak dating back to last season into this weekend's series. Shallenberger battled numerous injuries last year, but reached base in 16-straight games to end the 2023 season. He has reached base in all 12 games this year, while hitting safely in 11-straight games. After starting the year 0-for-5, Shallenberger has hit .500 (21-for-42) since homering for his first hit of the year in the 5th inning of game two at Oral Roberts.

NINER

Senior SS Simon Scherry (nicknamed 'Niner' because of his uniform #9) will enter this weekend's series ranked ninth among active Division I players in both career hits (216) and doubles (47). He also ranks 23rd among active players in games played (184) and is third overall in at-bats (746).

HE'S MULTI-TALENTED

The hits have come in bunches this year for junior 2B/DH Cal McGinnis, as he will carry a .404 average into this weekend's series. Of the 10 games in which he has collected a hit, he has produced eight multi-hit games. He leads UE with eight multi-hit contests this year.

WE COULD USE A HUG

UE's offense has put up impressive numbers this year despite being without reigning first-team all-MVC first baseman Chase Hug for the most part. Hug has been sidelined since game two at Oral Roberts after straining a biceps on a swing in the eighth inning. He is listed as day-to-day.

KIP! KIP! HOO-RAY!!!

Like Mark Shallenberger, senior INF/OF Kip Fougousse will enter this weekend's series on an 11-game hitting streak. Since March 15 of last year, Fougousse has not gone more than two games without a hit for the Purple Aces.

ON WISCONSIN

To say that junior 2B Cal McGinnis and graduate LHP Donovan Schultz go way back is an understatement. McGinnis and Schultz started playing baseball together at age seven. The only time they haven't played together is the last two years, when McGinnis started his college career at Bradley.

COACH NOTES

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 16th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces have ushered in a new era of Evansville Baseball.
- Carroll earned his second MVC Coach of the Year honor in 2022 after leading Evansville to a second-place finish in the league standings with a 14-6 conference mark (32-24 overall). Carroll also earned MVC Coach of the Year honors in 2014 after guiding UE to the MVC regular-season title.
- Carroll currently ranks second all-time at UE in career coaching victories with 389, behind only his mentor and head coach Jim Brownlee.
- In July 2019, UE announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics which resulted in an impressive renovation to the Aces' baseball stadium, which is now known as "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations were a full AstroTurf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.
- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in nearby Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and former Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.
- Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-American in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
