- Samford and Mississippi State have met 50 previous times, with MSU holding a 39-11 series lead. The teams met last year in Starkville, Miss., with Mississippi State taking a 9-4 win over Samford.

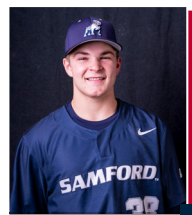
