- Leading UAB into the 2024 season is Head Coach Casey Dunn in his 3rd season as head coach. Last year the blazers posted a 17-36 record after going 31-25 in Coach Dunn's first year.
- Casey Dunn enters his third year with the Blazers and his 20th season overall...Coach Dunn and staff added 16 new players to the 2024 roster. Despite Henry Hunter, Christian Hall, and Carson Meyers transferring to SEC programs, UAB added some important pieces to the already deep roster. Transfers Jake Smallwood and Tyler Harrington have impacted the team on day one as transfer students.
- UAB ranks 84th in the nation in stolen bases with 39 and only five caught stealings. The Blazers also have two shutouts on the season. Blayze Berry is nationally ranked in two categories including ERA and strikeouts. He is ranked 55th in strikeouts with 48. He is also ranked 45th in ERA with a 2.34 earned run average. Colin Daniel is ranked 54 in victories with a 4-1 record.

Casey Dunn was named the sixth head coach in program history on June 23, 2021.

Dunn joins the Blazers after a successful coaching stint at the helm of the Samford University program for the past 17 seasons. This past season, the Bulldogs made their third NCAA Tournament appearance in program history.

Dunn is the Samford's all-time winningest head coach, posting a record of 530-422 (.557). The team has played in the Southern Conference Tournament title game in six of the last eight years, winning the tournament title three times, including most recently in 2021.

"We are thrilled to welcome Casey Dunn into our UAB family," Ingram said. "His relationships in Birmingham and around the country, along with his track record of success made him an ideal choice. I am confident that UAB can be a dominant force in baseball if we provide the resources necessary for success. We have plans to invest in our facilities in a way that puts our coaches and student-athletes in a position to win championships."

"I am excited about the opportunity to be the next head baseball coach at UAB," Dunn said. Samford has and will always hold a special place in my heart. I look forward to the challenge of building a championship team in Conference USA. The vision that Mark has for baseball is one that excites me, and I look forward to working beside him to bring it to reality. To all the former players and supporters, it's time to get on board and help take UAB to new heights."

Under Dunn's guidance, the Bulldogs have posted seven-straight 30+ win seasons, including 13 of the last 15 full seasons overall. Dunn has coached 51 All-Conference student-athletes and four SoCon Freshman of the Year honorees.

In 2012, Samford recorded its first win in an NCAA Regional, beating Mississippi State twice in Tallahassee, Fla. The program's third NCAA Tournament win came in 2018 at Florida State.

The 2019 season saw the program's first regular-season conference title and tied the program record with 41 wins. Dunn was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year following that season.

The Bulldogs' baseball program saw a program-record seven players selected in 2012 Major League Baseball Draft, with nine players signing with major league teams. During Dunn's tenure at Samford, the Bulldogs have seen three players drafted in the first round of the MLB Draft.

Dunn played four seasons at Auburn (1996-99). As a senior, he earned All-American honors as a catcher after batting .379 with a Southeastern Conference-leading 81 RBI.

Following the conclusion of his collegiate playing career, Dunn played two seasons in the Kansas City Royals organization.

Dunn graduated from Auburn in 1999 with a degree in social science secondary education. He is married to the former Marty Goldthorpe and the couple has a son, Sam, and daughter, Linlee.

B.J. Green enters his first season as associate head coach for UAB. Green comes to The Magic City from Georgia Southern, where he served as the pitching coach since 2009.

In 2019, Georgia Southern's bullpen converted 16 save chances and went 35-24 to win the Sun Belt East Division. Junior Seth Shuman was named First Team All-Sun Belt with a

3.83 ERA and 114 strikeouts to lead the league. Shuman was selected in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Oakland.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Green served as the pitching coach at Alabama for seven seasons. During his 11-year career as a player and coach, Green helped the Crimson Tide to eight NCAA tournament appearances, three SEC Tournament Championships (1999, 2002 and 2003), two Super Regional appearances, and a 1999 College World Series appearance. Before he entered the coaching ranks, Green was a four-year letterman for the Crimson Tide from 1998-2001. He compiled an 18-4 (.818) career record and set the Alabama freshman record

with eight wins on the mound in 1998.

In 1999, Green led the team to a third-place College World Series appearance and SEC Tournament Championship.

A native of Gardendale, Ala., Green is a 2002 graduate from the University of Alabama with a degree in sports fitness management.



Moore enters his first season with the Blazers after serving seven years as Head Coach at Oneonta High School in Oneonta, Ala. During his tenure, Moore's teams compiled a 144-58 record and saw 11 players sign scholarships to play baseball at the collegiate level.

Before coaching at the high school level, Moore spent over 20 years playing professional baseball. As a player, he reached the Minor League Baseball Triple-A level before retiring

and becoming an instructor.

Moore served as an instructor in the Chicago White Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates and Kansas City Royals organizations. His main duties revolved around instructing the hitters and infielders daily.

First Season

Head Coach Casey Dunn named Brad Moss as the Recruiting Coordinator in July of 2023.

For the past five years, Moss was an assistant coach with Samford University. During this time, he worked with the catchers, hitters, and served as the first base coach. Also, he was in charge of on-campus recruiting under Head Coach Casey Dunn for three years, and Moss took over all recruiting duties after the departure of Coach Dunn in 2021.

As a member of the Samford University staff, Moss helped the program to four championships in five years, winning the regular season twice and SoCon Tournament twice. The Bulldogs went on to compete in the Starkville Regional in 2021 and the Auburn Regional in 2023. During his time at Samford, Moss tutored eight Power 5 transfers and four MLB draft picks: Colton Ledbetter (2nd), Sonny Dichiara (5th), Branden Fryman (21st), Anthony Mulrine (25th). Samford's 2023 offense broke the school record for home runs with 103. Moss began his coaching career by spending two years as an assistant at University of Montevallo under Chandler Rose. In 2016, Falcon hitters hit .312 with 108 doubles and 72 home runs. He coached DII All-Southeast Region selection, Taylor Walker as well as MLB draft picks Dane Hutcheon (Twins, 29th) and Tyler Krabbe (Astros, 19th). During his time at Lawson State CC, he was the recruiting

coordinator, hitting and catching coach. Moss mentored Jackson Tate who would go on to play for the Crimson Tide and get drafted in the 32nd round to the Seattle Mariners.

A graduate of Calhoun HS, Moss was a catcher at Samford (2009-12), where he ranks up at the top of the list in games played as well as being the single season and career sacrifice bunts leader. As a senior, he batted .321 with 44 RBI and 48 runs scored plus a team-high 44 walks. In 2012, Moss led Samford to their first SoCon Championship and the program's first NCAA tournament. He was selected to the Johnny Bench Award Watch List. He earned a degree in Exercise Science from Samford. After his collegiate career, Moss signed a Free Agent contract with the San Francisco Giants.

Moss is married to the former Arica Dykes, They have two children, Emma Kathryn (3) and Maddie Claire (born March 23, 2023).

Parker Curry Director of Pitching Development First Season

Casey Dunn named Parker Curry as the Director of Pitching Development in July of 2023.

Curry joins the UAB coaching staff after spending the 2023 season as the Director of Baseball Operations for Samford.

During his playing career, Curry was a member of the Samford baseball team for four years. Despite contributing more on the mound, he was a two-way player as an infielder each

year as well and got his at-bats when he wasn't pitching. Curry spent time finding success as a starting pitcher, relief pitcher, and closer during his career. Curry was a multi-time winner of the So-Con Pitcher of the Week and a 1st Team All Southern-Conference starting pitcher his senior season.

After his career at Samford, he signed an undrafted free agent deal with the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2016 and was in the organization for the duration of his rookie contract until the fall of 2022. Curry spent his first summer working at their spring training facility going through a derivative of the Driveline program that the Dodgers had transformed more into their own. From 2017-2019, he spent time at all four full-season minor league levels, starting 28 games and appearing in 69 others as a reliever. Curry also pitched in Major League spring training games in both 2018 and 2019, including an appearance in the

exhibition Freeway Series against the Los Angeles Angels.

After no minor league baseball in 2020 due to COVID, Curry unfortunately suffered an elbow injury during his last spring outing in 2021 that ultimately led to Tommy John surgery later that season, forcing him out for the 2022 season as well. Now fully healthy and a coaching season under his belt, he is prepared and excited to assist however he is needed to better the program.

Curry met his wife, Megan, during their time at Samford where she was a record-breaking player for the softball program, notching the Southern Conference Player of the Year in 2016. They welcomed their first child, Lauren, last year. Parker is a native of the area and he and his family are thrilled to be in Birmingham.
