#### LEADING OFF

- Ole Miss took one of three last weekend against No. 18 Alabama at home.
- The Rebels took game two behind a 4-for-5 day from Will Furniss and a 3-for-4 day from Luke Hill.
- Furniss is now hitting .368 with three home runs and 10 RBI over his last 11 games.
- Luke Hill is riding a seven-game hitting streak during which he is hitting .407 with 5 RBI.
- Ole Miss is currently No. 3 in Strength of Schedule, having played one
  of the hardest schedules in the country.
- The Rebels are ranked 24th in the nation in strikeouts per nine, averaging 10.2 punchouts per game.
- Ole Miss is 21st in the NCAA in walks drawn (248), averaging 5.77 per game.
- The Rebels lead the SEC in sacrifice flies with 28.
- Jackson Ross' 43 walks this season are the second-most in a singleseason over the last four seasons, behind only Jacob Gonzalez's 50 in 2022.
- Ethan Lege is the fourth-hardest hitter to strike out in the SEC, striking out just 15 times in 153 at bats.
- Connor Spencer has six saves this season, second-most in the SEC.

PRACTICES/INTERVIEWS: The Rebels practice throughout the week at Oxford-University Stadium/Swayze Field, with practice typically occurring from 2-5 p.m. CT. All practices are open to the media. Media wishing to arrange interviews with coaches or players either in person or remotely should contact Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Birnbrauer. All interview requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Media availability for players is subject to the team's time management plan.

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials must be sent to Kyle Birnbrauer (kyleb@olemiss.edu) at least 24 hours prior to each game. Please only submit credential requests for games you are sure to attend. Priority will be given to media outlets and members who regularly cover Ole Miss baseball.

CREDENTIAL PICKUP/STADIUM ENTRANCE: Credentials can be picked up on gameday at the Oxford-University Stadium will call window to the left of the main gate. Gates open one hour prior to first pitch for midweek games and two hours prior to weekend games, including Thursday games of weekend series. Outside of ADA considerations, media members are not permitted to utilize the elevator or enter the Diamond Club area. Media members can access the press box using the stairs between Section M and N.

PARKING: Media parking will once again be in Lot A, adjacent to the Main Athletics Building off of Gertrude Ford Blvd. When you are approved for single-game credentials, you will also be added to the pass list for Lot A.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY: Still photographers may shoot from the film deck behind home plate or inside the camera wells down both base lines. Photographers are not allowed to shoot from within the dugout area. Any photographer not following the guidelines may have their credentials revoked at any time. Credentials must be clearly and properly displayed at all times. To request a credential, please contact Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications office.

VISITING RADIO: Please contact the Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications Office for credentials. The visiting radio booth is behind home plate on the first base side of the plate. Space for a crew of four is allowed for each broadcasting medium. As required by the SEC, Ole Miss provides phone lines for visiting radio.

**POSTGAME MEDIA:** Both team locker rooms are <u>CLOSED</u> to the media following the game, by facility policy. Selected players will be brought to the media down the first base line following a 10-minute cooling off period. Ole Miss head coach Mike Bianco will address the media approximately 10 minutes after the game following player interviews. On some occasions, the selected players and coach may also be requested for radio interviews with the Ole Miss Radio Network or national television, and will meet those obligations for interviews first.

**TELEVISION INFORMATION:** All Ole Miss home games not already scheduled for national television are broadcasted live on SEC Network+ via WatchESPN.com and the ESPN app. Links for these broadcasts are made available on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com, as well as in each week's preview. All other games scheduled on the ESPN family of networks can be found on the schedule page online.

LIVE STATS: Live stats are available for each Ole Miss baseball game. Links to follow will be made available online at OleMissSports. com, and can generally be found specifically in game previews or game notes. For all Rebel home games, live stats are available via StatBroadcast on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com or by visiting olemiss.statbroadcast.com.

FTP: Ole Miss offers free FTP downloads of game highlights and interviews with coaches and players for television stations to use during regularly scheduled news/sportscasts. #### **SCOUTING REPORT**

Chris Lemonis is in his sixth year as head coach for Mississippi State. In the Lemonis era, the Bulldogs captured their first national championship in 2021. Lemonis is the first Division I head coach to reach the College World Series in his first two full seasons as head coach of a program in the Super Regional era (since 1999).

In the 2023 season, Mississippi State had an overall record of 27-26 and 9-21 in SEC play. As for this season, the Bulldogs are 29-15 overall and 12-9 in conference play. MSU is coming off a 2-1 series win against Vanderbilt and is currently ranked No. 16 according to the DI Baseball Rankings.

In Mississippi State's lineup, Dakota Jordan, outfielder, is making noise, batting .362, earning 55 RBIs and 45 runs. The Canton, Mississippi, native boasts 16 home runs on the books as well. Contributing on the mound for the Bulldogs, is RHP, Khal Stephen. The junior has a 2.77 ERA through 65 innings pitched and has 73 recorded strikeouts for Mississippi State.

The in-state rivals have met 475 times with MSU holding a 256-216 advantage in the series. The foes last squared off earlier in the 2024 season at Swayze Field, where Ole Miss walked away with the 2-1 series win.

#### 1,000 WINS AND COUNTING

Ole Miss head baseball coach Mike Bianco became one of only 21 active NCAA DI coaches with 1,000 career wins on April 20, 2024 as the Rebels defeated Georgia in game two of a doubleheader in Athens. He is also now the 98th head coach in NCAA history to reach the mark.

On his road to 1,000 wins, Bianco has delivered 18 postseason appearances, including eight Super Regional berths, a pair of trips to the College World Series, and the first national championship in program history. He has racked up 902 victories at Ole Miss and holds a 1,002-605 (.624) overall record for

his career. His 902 wins at Ole Miss are the most in Rebel baseball history and rank third all-time among coaches in the SEC.

#### **WALKING TALL**

Jackson Ross' 43 walks this season are the secondmost in a single-season over the last four seasons. He trails only Jacob Gonzalez's 50 total walks in 2022. Gonzalez led the team in walks each of the last three seasons with 35 in 2023, 50 in 2022, and 38 in 2021.

The program record for walks in a single season was set by Thomas Dillard in 2019 when he had 61.

Ross is second in the SEC, trailing only Texas A&M's Braden Montgomery, and 13th in the NCAA in walks. He is currently averaging one free pass per game.

#### **CHANGE OF SCENERY**

Since moving to second base three weeks ago, Luke Hill has not made an error and has seen his batting average start to rise. In 12 games on the right side, Hill is hitting .319 (15-for-47) with nine runs scored, five RBI, and a home run. The sophomore is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak during which he is hitting .407 (11-for-27).

In 29 games at shortstop, Hill was hitting .250 with five errors and just 15 RBI.

#### **DOYLE RULES**

Liam Doyle has struck out eight or more batters in five of his eight starts this season. In each of those five starts, he has only issued one walk and worked through 4+ innings.

Doyle struck out 10 batters in each of his first two SEC starts, becoming the first Rebel since Dylan DeLucia in 2022 to post multiple double-digit strikeout games in a season. He is also the first Rebel since Doug Nikhazy in 2021 to have double-digit strikeouts in consecutive outings.

#### **GUN DAY: RELOADED**

Gunnar Dennis has allowed just three earned runs over his last four appearances, working 9.2 innings with 11 strikeouts and five walks. On April 20 against Georgia, he made his first start since March 31, working 4.1 innings and allowing one unearned run on four strikeouts.

In his previous four outings, the left-hander had allowed 20 earned runs and five walks over 9.2 innings of work.

#### STEALING YOUR HEART

The Rebels have stolen 45 bases so far this season, surpassing their entire season total from both 2023 and 2022. Since setting a new single-season program record in 2019 (93), Ole Miss had not stolen more than 44 bases in a season. They are currently averaging 1.05 stolen bases per game.

Ethan Groff has stolen 14 bases in 2024, having not been caught yet. Luke Hill is 11-for-12 in stolen base attempts.

#### **CAPTAIN CLUTCH**

Ethan Lege has been the Rebels' most clutch hitter, hitting .420 (21-for-50) with two outs in an inning. He has 18 two-out RBI, is hitting .297 with runners in scoring position, and is 8-for-13 when hitting with a runner on third base and less than two outs.

#### **GETTING THEIR STEPS IN**

Ole Miss has drawn the 21st-highest number of walks in the nation with 248 free passes in 43 games. The Rebels are averaging 5.77 walks per game and are one of four teams from the SEC in the top-25 (South Carolina, Texas A&M, Georgia, Ole Miss).

During their series against High Point, the Rebels set a new single-game program record for walks with 19 in game three.

#### **BOMB SOUAD**

The Rebels hit 10 home runs in their three-game series against High Point, doing something that has

only been done once before in the Mike Bianco Era. The last time an Ole Miss team hit 10 or more home runs in a three-game series was in 2020 against Princeton just before the season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Prior to 2020, the feat had not been accomplished since 1998.

#### **POWER CYCLE**

In their 25-2 win over High Point, the Rebels accomplished the incredibly rare feat of completing the home run cycle in just the first inning. Ethan Groff led off the inning with a solo home run followed by a grand slam by Will Furniss. With one out in the inning, Reagan Burford hit a two-RBI home run and then Jackson Ross completed the cycle with a two-out, three-RBI shot five batters later.

#### **RUNNING AWAY WITH IT**

Ole Miss scored 25 runs against High Point in the series finale, falling just three runs short of the single-game record set in 1989. Their 25 runs were the most scored in one game since March 20, 2019 against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (W, 25-0). It was just the sixth time in the last six seasons that the Rebels have broken the 20-run mark in a game.

They scored 11 runs in just the first inning of play, the most in a single inning since April 26, 2018 against LSU. In total, 15 hitters came to the plate, seven had hits in the inning, five drew walks, and five drove in runs.

#### **WELCOME TO THE SHOW**

Eight freshmen made their collegiate debut over the Rebels' opening weekend in Hawaii. Trenton Lyons, Drew Markle and Campbell Smithwick all tallied their first career hits at the plate. Seth Farni and Brayden Randle also saw action as pinch hitters for Ole Miss. On the mound, Patrick Galle, Wes Mendes and Austin Simmons combined for 4.1 innings without surrendering a hit. Mendes struck out four batters in 3.0 innings of work, picking up the save in Saturday's victory over the Rainbow Warriors. Simmons, a standout dual-sport athlete with the Ole Miss football team, pitched a perfect inning, striking out two of the three batters

#### **ALL-AMERICAN IN THE OUTFIELD**

Treyson Hughes was named a 2024 Preseason All-American by the NCBWA, making the Third Team in the outfield.

Hughes is a junior transfer who played his first two seasons at Mercer where he played in 115 games for the Bears. The Georgia native boasts a career .352 batting average with 105 total RBI and 127 runs scored over two seasons.

Last season, he hit .387 and set a new single-season runs scored record at Mercer, crossing the plate 74 times in 58 games. Hughes led the Southern Conference in on-base percentage and runs scored, earning 2023 First Team All-SoCon and SoCon All-Tournament team honors.

#### **BIG MAL IS BACK**

Josh Mallitz was named to the 2024 Stopper of the

Year Watch List, opening the season among the nation's best in the bullpen.

Malllitz returns to the mound this season after sitting out the entirety of the 2023 season recovering from injury.

In 2022, the Florida native was an integral part of the team's national championship run, posting a 1.45 ERA over 31 innings of work. He held opponents to a .171 batting average while racking up 48 strikeouts.

Mallitz made five appearances during the team's postseason run, allowing just one run while striking out 18 over 10.2 innings. In game one of the College World Series Final, Mallitz worked two innings and struck out four Sooners.

#### TRANSFER TO THE SIP

D1Baseball ranked Ole Miss' 2024 transfer class the No. 7 class in the country and No. 5 in the SEC back in January. Five new Rebels were ranked in the top-70

#### **WHAT SOPHOMORE SLUMP?**

Ole Miss has five sophomores ranked in D1Baseball's Top-100 2025 MLB Draft Prospects, something that no other program in the country can claim.

JT Quinn leads the way coming in at No. 27, followed by Luke Hill (No. 38), Andrew Fischer (No. 40), Grayson Saunier (No. 57), and Liam Doyle (No. 91).

#### **YOUNG GUNS**

220.2 innings (48 percent) of Ole Miss' innings on the mound in 2023 were thrown by freshmen. Seven freshmen pitched at least seven innings and five pitched 25 or more innings. JT Quinn lead the youngsters with 55.1 innings worked, followed by Grayson Saunier who pitched 46.

Both Quinn and Saunier, along with Brayden Jones, Sam Tookoian, and Mason Morris return to the staff this season and will play integral parts on the Rebels' pitching staff.

### MISSISSIPPI MADE

Of the 44 players on Ole Miss' roster in 2024, 17 of them hail from the state of Mississippi (38.6 percent). Overall, 16 different states are represented on the roster, ranging from California to New Hampshire.

#### **REBS ON THE NATIONAL STAGE**

The Rebels are scheduled to appear on SEC Network eight times, ESPNU twice, and ESPN2 once during the 2024 campaign. Ole Miss' first game on national TV will be March 16 as they host South Carolina for game two of their three game series. The Rebels can then be seen on the national stage five times in April and five times in May.

## MIKE BIANCO

Ole Miss named Mike Bianco head coach of the Rebel baseball program on June 7, 2000. Since then, Bianco has become the winningest coach in program history, led the Rebels to the only national championship in program history and established Ole Miss as one of the premier programs in college baseball.

In 23 seasons leading the program, Bianco has delivered 18 postseason appearances, including eight Super Regional berths and a pair of trips to the College World Series. He has racked up 879 victories, holding a 879-514-1 (.631) record. Those wins are the most in Rebel baseball history and rank second all-time among coaches in the SEC. He also stands as the winningest and longestactive coach in the SEC among the sports of baseball, men's basketball and football. The Rebels have reached the 30-win plateau in all but one of Bianco's 22 full seasons, including 10 40-win campaigns, proving that the Rebels don't rebuild under Bianco—they reload.

To become the all-time winningest coach in Ole Miss history, Bianco passed Rebel legend Jake Gibbs with his 486th win on March 9, 2013, against Lipscomb in nonconference action. When his Rebels defeated Texas A&M 13-3 on Friday, April 26, Bianco won his 739th game as the head coach in Oxford, moving him to third all-time in SEC history ahead of South Carolina's Ray Tanner.

A road SEC win at Texas A&M on May 8, 2021 gave Bianco A road SEL win at lexas A&M on May 8, 2U21 gave bianco 900 for his career, including 800 in a Rebel uniform to become one of 16 active head coaches with 900 career victories and one of just two in the SEC alongside LSU's Paul Mainieri and Arkansas' Dave Van Horn. The SEC's winningest active coach joined Ron Polk and Skip Bertman set the apple coaches in conference history with 800 wins as the only coaches in conference history with 800 wins.

The winning tradition has led to a wealth of success in the nation's strongest baseball conference. Under Bianco, the Rebels have won four SEC Western Division titles, two SEC Tournament titles and one SEC regular-season championship, coming in 2009. Ole Miss captured the SEC Tournament title in 2006 and again in 2018. The Rebels also won the SEC West crown in 2018, becoming just the second in program history to win both a divisional and tournament title in the same season.

#### **National Champion Rebels**

In a career that has been filled with memorable seasons, the pinnacle without a doubt came during the 2022 campaign. Once sitting at 7-14 in the SEC and left for dead by fans and media across the country, Bianco's Rebels responded with one of the most miraculous turnarounds in college baseball history to not only right the ship, but finish on top.

Ole Miss finished 7-2 over its last three SEC series, including its first-ever sweep over LSU in Baton Rouge, to bolster its resume and ultimately garner the very last bid into the NCAA Tournament.

Despite Rebel captain Tim Elko's warning of "don't let the Rebs get hot," the college baseball world did just that. Once in the postseason, the Rebels never looked back, cruising through three-straight wins to claim the Coral Gables Regional and topping Southern Miss in the Hattiesburg Super Regional to advance to Omaha for the second time under Bianco.

Even at the College World Series, the Rebels couldn't be cooled down as Ole Miss defeated Auburn and took down Arkansas twice to advance to the championship series against Oklahoma. After Bianco's bunch eased past the Sooners in game one, an eighth-inning rally sealed the deal, securing the program's first national championship.

Following the triumphant season, the longtime Rebel skipper was tabbed the National Coach of the Year by D1Baseball, USA Baseball, the ABCA, and Collegiate Baseball. It was the second season in which Bianco was named the national coach of the year, receiving the honor from Collegiate Baseball after leading Ole Miss to a 16-1 start to the 2020 season prior to the halting of play due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### MLB Rebs

The excellence on the field has not gone unnoticed over the past 22 seasons under Bianco. The Rebels have seen 126 Major League Baseball draft picks in that time, including a combined 27 in the past five seasons.

At least three Rebels have been selected in each of the past 18 full seasons of the Bianco Era. Prior to Bianco's arrival, Ole Miss eclipsed four draftees just three times.

In the Bianco Era, Rebel pitchers have accounted for 71 selections in the MLB Draft, including three first-rounders. Drew Pomeranz was selected fifth overall in 2010, becoming the highest-selected Rebel ever, part of a class becoming the highest-selected Rebel ever, part of a class that featured five Ole Miss pitchers taken in the top 100 picks. Ryan Rolison joined Pomeranz as a first-round selection in 2018 when he was taken 22nd overall by the Colorado Rockies. Gunnar Hoglund became the third Rebel pitcher coached by Bianco selected in the first round, earning the No. 19 pick from the Toronto Blue Jays.

Bianco has also tutored 19 catchers who have gone on to sign professional contracts. In 2018 and 2019, three Rebels were drafted as catchers in the top six rounds. Nick Fortes signed with the Miami Marlins after they chose him in the fourth round in 2018, while Thomas Dillard (5th Round - Milwaukee Brewers) and Cooper Johnson (6th Round - Detroit Tigers) were quickly taken off the board in 2019. Hayden Dunhurst added to the recent run of Rebel backstops drafted highly in 2022, being selected in the sixth round by the Kansas City Royals.

In his 28 years as either an assistant or head coach at Northwestern State, LSU, McNeese State and Ole Miss, Bianco has coached 166 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts. Among those 166 players, 32 have made Major League rosters, including 21 Rebels in the past 22 seasons.

T.J. Beam (New York Yankees) was the first player from the Bianco Era to be called up in 2006, followed by Seth Smith (Colorado) in 2007 and Matt Tolbert (Minnesota) in 2008. Chris Coghlan (Florida) was named the 2009 National League Rookie of the Year, while Matt Maloney (Cincinnati) made his MLB debut that same season. Alex Presley (Pittsburgh) became the sixth Bianco-coached Rebel to get the call to the majors in 2010.

Right-hander Lance Lynn (St. Louis), shortstop Zack Cozart (Cincinnati) and left-hander Drew Pomeranz Cozart (Cincinnati) and left-hander Drew Pomeranz (Colorado) became the next crop of player to make their Major League debuts, getting the call to the big leagues in 2011. Those call ups gave the Rebels eight players active in the Majors in the 2011 season, the second most of any Southeastern Conference team that season. Seven players appeared on Major League rosters in the 2013 season, including the call up of right-hander Phillip Irwin (Pittsburgh) that year. Right-hander Aaron Barrett (Washington) made his Major League debut on March 31, 2014.

Matt Tracy was called up to the big leagues by the New York Yankees, April 11, 2015, and made his debut later that day Just over one month later, another former Rebel pitcher made his Major League debut as David Goforth began pitching out of the bullpen for the Milwaukee Brewers. In 2016, Mike Mayers (St. Louis) became the 14th Bianco-coached Rebel to see his big league dream come true, earning a start for the Cardinals against the Los Angeles Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball

Johnny Bench Award winner Stuart Turner saw his dream

come true when he made the Cincinnati Reds roster to start the 2017 season. Less than a month into the season, the Oakland Athletics called up Bobby Wahl as the next Rebel to make his MLB debut. Braxton Lee earned MLB Reb when he earned a spot on the 2018 Opening Day roster for the Miami Marlins. Two more Rebels added their names to the MLB ranks in 2019 as pitchers Chris Ellis (Kansas City) and Jacob Waguespack (Toronto) toed the rubber in the bigs and former backstop Nick Fortes reached the majors in 2021, clobbering a home run in his debut with the Marlins. Chad Smith became the latest Rebel to make it to the "big leagues" in 2022, debuting for the Colorado Rockies.

Award-Winning Rebels
On the field, Bianco has established a tradition of developing some of the nation's top players, as the Rebels have seen a combined 92 selections to All-America and Freshman All-America teams over the past 22

Three Rebels received All-American nods during Ole Miss' national championship campaign in 2022. College World Series Most Outstanding Player Dylan DeLucia was named a Third Team All-American by Baseball America, while three-time Rebel captain Tim Elko landed on the NCBWA's Third Team All-America squad. Rookie hurler Hunter Elliott received three different Freshman All-American designations, receiving plaudits from Collegiate Baseball, Perfect Game and D1Baseball.

During the 2021 campaign, Doug Nikhazy became the



program's fourth two-time All-American and its third unanimous All-American. Taylor Broadway and Jacob Gonzalez joined Nikhazy on the All-American teams, Gonzalez being just the second true freshman in program history, alongside Stephen Head, to be named an All-American. Gonzalez was also tabbed as a freshman All-American along with TJ McCants, giving Ole Miss two or more Freshman All-Americans for six consecutive seasons, a total of 14 in that span a total of 14 in that span.

Ole Miss also became the first school to produce two different finalists for the Johnny Bench Award in consecutive seasons when Stuart Turner and Will Allen were named as finalists in 2013 and 2014, respectively. Turner claimed the award in 2013, becoming the first catcher in program history to be tabbed as the national catcher of the year. Nick Fortes and Hayden Dunhurst carried on the tradition in 2018 and 2021, earning Johnny Bench Award semifinalist nods.

Grae Kessinger added to the award-winning tradition in 2019. The Rebel legacy was named the Brooks Wallace Award Winner, given annually to the nation's top shortstop, becoming the first player in program history to win the award.

Another Rebel shortstop made history in 2021 when Jacob Gonzalez became the program's first National Freshman of the Year, bestowed by D1Baseball.

The Rebels have totaled 73 All-SEC nods under Bianco. Most recently, Gonzalez was the shortstop selection on the All-SEC First Team, while Elko's final collegiate season landed him on the All-SEC Second Team. Giving opposing hitters problems from the left side all season long, Hunter Elliott earned a Freshman All-SEC nod.

Bianco's Rebels have brought home a number of awards from the league office as well, including Stephen Head's SEC Player of the Year laurel in 2004, Drew Pomeranz earning SEC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2010 and the Rebels' trio of SEC Freshman of the Year winners: Seth Smith in 2002, Head in 2003 and Jordan Henry in 2007. In 2021, Tim Elko became the program's first SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Bianco has also coached five C Spire Ferriss Trophy winners, given annually to the best college baseball player in Mississippi. Head won it in 2004, followed by Brian Pettway in 2005, Scott Bittle in 2008, Pomeranz in 2010 and Auston Bousfield in 2014.

The Rebels have also celebrated great academic success under Bianco. Five of his Rebels have been named CoSIDA Academic All-District. The SEC's First-Year Academic Honor Roll has included 93 Bianco-coached Rebels, while 251 student-athletes have been selected to the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

#### **National Treasure**

Bianco's on-field accomplishments have been recognized nationally, as the Rebel skipper was tapped as the manager of the USA Collegiate National Team before the start of the 2022 season. Under Bianco, the boys in Red, White and Blue earned the Bronze Medal at Honkbalweek in Haarlem, Netherlands.

Three Rebel players joined Bianco on the Collegiate National Team, with Jacob Gonzalez and Hunter Elliott making the travel squad that competed in The Netherlands and Mason Nichols earning a spot on the initial Collegiate National Team training camp roster that competed in the Stars vs. Stripes intrasquad series in North Carolina.

Ole Miss has a strong history with Team USA. 12 Rebels have competed internationally for USA Baseball in the Bianco Era. Seth Smith and Stephen Head both competed for the 2003 edition of the Collegiate National Team. Zack Cozart made the national squad in 2006, and Cody Satterwhite and Lance Lynn kept that going in 2007.

Drew Pomeranz became the sixth Rebel to sport the American flag uniform in 2009, followed by Bobby Wahl in 2012 and Dallas Woolfolk in 2017. Parker Caracci carried on the tradition in 2018, earning a spot on the Team USA roster, where he posted a perfect 0.00 ERA with two saves and opposing batting average of .094 in 9.2 innings of work. Doug Nikhazy made it three straight seasons with a Rebel arm wearing the Stars and Stripes, earning a spot on the 24-man roster for the 2019 summer.

#### Top Recruiter

Not only have fans and the media covering college baseball noticed Ole Miss' resurgence under Bianco, some of the top talent in the country is also taking a close look at the Rebels.

Seventeen of Bianco's 22 recruiting classes at Ole Miss have garnered top-20 national rankings, including 10 that have placed in the top-10. His first recruiting class was rated as one of the nation's 10 best by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America, including a No. 6 ranking by Collegiate Baseball.

The 2003 recruiting class was ranked No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball, while the 2011 class was ranked third nationally by Collegiate Baseball and fifth by Baseball America. It marked the first top-5 recruiting class for Bianco at Ole Miss. In the fall of 2016, Rebel Baseball earned the No. 1 ranking in national recruiting rankings by both Baseball America and D1Baseball.com. The top ranking was the first No. 1 recruiting class in the history of not only the baseball program but all of Ole Miss athletics.

Just when that 2016 class cycled through, the Rebels reloaded with another elite class. The 2019 Ole Miss class ranked No. 2 in the nation, highlighted by four prospects who were taken in the MLB Draft but chose instead to play in Oxford. The 2019 group included four of Perfect Game's top 50 prospects—the only class in the country of its kind. Bianco brought in another top-five class in 2022 with Perfect Game's No. 4 ranked recruiting class.

#### Foundation of Success

Bianco's winning ways can be traced back to his playing days. After spending two seasons at Indian River (Fla.) Community College, he played two seasons for Skip Bertman at perennial national-power LSU in 1988 and 1989. He was the starting catcher and team captain for the Tigers' 1989 team that finished third at the College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. He homered in LSU's 6-3 win over Miami (Fla.) in the 1989 CWS to help advance the Tigers to the semifinals.

While working behind the plate for LSU, Bianco caught major league pitchers Ben McDonald, Russ Springer, Curtis Leskanic, John O'Donoghue, Chad Ogea and Paul

His time behind the plate as a player would later benefit him as he served as LSU's pitching coach during three World Series championship teams in the 1990s. Bianco also worked with the pitchers during his three years as head coach at McNeese State, and continues to serve in that same capacity with the Rebels.

Omaha Experience
Following his playing career, he joined Jim Wells' (former head coach at Alabama) coaching staff at Northwestern State, where he served two seasons from 1991-1992 as a graduate assistant. He helped coach Northwestern State to a 1991 Southland Conference (SLC) championship and an appearance in the 1991 NCAA South I Regional.

He then returned to Baton Rouge where he joined Bertman's staff at LSU. In five seasons at LSU (1993-1997), the Tigers advanced to the College World Series four times and claimed three national championships. LSU also won three Southeastern Conference crowns and two SEC Tournament titles in that five-year span.

After the Tigers' 1997 College World Series title run, Bianco was named the head coach at McNeese State in July of that year.

#### Bianco Earns Head Coaching Experience

After seven seasons as an assistant at Northwestern (La.) State and LSU, Bianco received his first head coaching opportunity, taking over the reins of McNeese State.

He quickly displayed his abilities to develop a competitive program. In his first season with the Cowboys in 1998, he engineered an 11-game improvement from 1997, posting a 30-26 record - the first of three 30-win seasons. The

1998 season also saw the Cowboys rise to third in the conference standings and qualify for the SLC Tournament.

Following a 31-25 campaign in 1999, Bianco's 2000 team produced one of the most successful seasons in McNeese State history. The Cowboys finished 39-20, including winning a school-record 20 SLC games en route to claiming their first conference title since 1988, and making their third-ever appearance in the NCAN Regionals. In recognition, Bianco was named the SLC's Coach of the

Bianco's 2000 McNeese State team raked in the individual postseason awards. Four Cowboys were named to the SLC's first team, including the conference's Hitter and Newcomer of the Year in Chris Williamson, and the SLC's Pitcher of the Year in Chris Howay.

Power hitting was the Cowboys' trademark under Bianco, as they hit 212 home runs in his three seasons, including a school-record 81 in 1999. His 2000 team batted .305 and set a new school standard for hits in a season with

#### Personal Background

Bianco, 55, was born May 3, 1967, and is a native of Seminole, Florida. He is married to the former Camille Marguette, and the couple has five children: sons, Michael, Benjamin, Andrew and Samuel, and one daughter, Catherine.

Bianco was inducted into the Indian River Community College Hall of Fame in 2003. He was also named to the All-Alex Box Omaha Era Team by LSU in 2008. In 2010, Bianco was inducted into the Seminole High School Hall of
