Leading Off

The 97th Season: The 97th season of Southern Miss baseball opened last weekend when the Golden Eagles swept four games from the Lafayette Leopards at Pete Taylor Park. Since 1986, the Golden Eagles have 38 winning seasons over the last 39. That span has included 37 campaigns of at least 30-win seasons and 16 seasons of at least 40 wins.

The Mississippi State Bulldogs: Mississippi State opened its 2025 season with a three-game sweep of Manhattan over the weekend, outscoring the Jaspers 35-5 in a three-game set. The Bulldogs are under seventh-year coach Chris Lemonis, who took the program to its first national championship in 2021. This will be the first visit for the Bulldogs to Hattiesburg since the start of the 2018 season.

Eight-Straight 40 Win Seasons: With eight-straight 40 win seasons to their credit, the Golden Eagles continue to have the longest current stretch in Division I baseball with 40 or more win campaigns (not including the 2020 season that was cut short due to COVID-19). USM first won 40 games in 1990. Southern Miss set its school record for victories in 2017 with 50.

NCAA Streak: Southern Miss appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the eighth-straight year and 20th time overall in 2024. The Golden Eagles made their first-ever appearance in the postseason in 1990, and at one point reached regional play nine-straight seasons (2003-11). The team also has hosted three previous regionals in 2003 and 2017 and 2022, along with two super regionals (2022, 2023).

Ozzie Pratt Hitting Streak: Senior Ozzie Pratt extended his team-leading hitting streak to 10 games - dating back to last season - after going .500 (8x16) over the weekend against Lafayette with three doubles, a home run and seven RBI. Over his 10 game streak, he is hitting .370 (17x46) with 10 runs, seven doubles, three home runs and 16 RBI over that span.

First Trip For Bulldogs to Hattiesburg Since 2018: This year marks the return to campus sites for these two programs playing each other. Southern Miss and Mississippi State last met in Hattiesburg to open the 2018 season and the Golden Eagles swept that three-game series by the scores of 11-0, 7-4 and 5-2. The Golden Eagles then returned the favor the next season in Starkville by playing three games in the newly renovated Dudy Noble Field. Southern Miss won the opener 1-0 in 10 innings in a great pitching duel between Walker Powell and Ethan Small. The game-winner came courtesy of an RBI single by Charlie Fischer in the 10th inning. The Bulldogs then won the final two games of the series. Since then, the two programs have played once each season (except for the 2020 COVID year) in Pearl up until last year. The Golden Eagles will travel to meet the Bulldogs, March 4, in Starkville for their only other regular season meeting in 2025.

New Guys Off to Good Start: Four first-year starters for the Golden Eagles all made impressive showings during the opening weekend against Lafayette:

- Ben Higdon, a transfer from Kentucky, started all four games for the Golden Eagles and led off in the designated hitter spot. He is the first person to lead off in the DH position since Hunter LeBlanc did it on April 13, 2019, against FIU. He hit .353 (7x16) with a team-high seven runs, a double and two RBI.
- Drey Barrett, a true freshman, became the first freshman to start at third base on opening day since Danny Lynch in 2019 and responded with two hits and an RBI. He later homered off the scoreboard later in the weekend.
- Jake Cook, who saw limited action, last season, started in center field the first three games and had three hits, including a double, and drove in a run.
- Joey Urban, a All-BIG EAST transfer from Butler, had four hits in seven at bats over the weekend, with an RBI, after making his first start in center on Sunday.

Big Scoring Innings Galore in the Opening Series: Southern Miss enjoyed three big scoring innings over the weekend scoring eight runs in the eighth in the season opener, before scoring an eight- and seven-run frame in the nightcap of the doubleheader on Saturday. Last season, the Golden Eagles enjoyed only one, 10-run scoring inning and five, six-run frames.

Highlights of Last Season: Here is a quick listing of the highlights for the 2024 season for the Golden Eagles:

- 43-20 overall, 20-10 Sun Belt Conference
- Finished second in the league's regular season
- Won the Sun Belt Tournament for second consecutive season
- Reached NCAA Tournament for 20th season overall and eighth consecutive year
- Won at least 40 games for eighth-straight year – Longest streak in Division I baseball
- Won at least 30 games for 22nd-straight year – Longest streak in Division I baseball
- Tied for most victories by a coach in his first season at his school (Wes Johnson – Georgia)
- Won 14 of of 15 games heading into the NCAA Regionals

Team Batting: The Golden Eagles batted .294 as a team, which ranked as the squad's highest batting average since 2018, when that team hit .301. The Southern Miss team batting average has increased each year since the 2020 season. The club also added 135 doubles, which is the most since they collected 140 in 2017 and seventh-most in school history. The Golden Eagles had the best batting average and doubles in Sun Belt Conference games a year ago.

Southern Miss Won Sun Belt Tournament for Second Straight Season: The Golden Eagles are a perfect two-for-two in Sun Belt Tournament baseball championships, after winning the event for the second time in their two-year history. Southern Miss rallied for five runs in the ninth for a 14-11 triumph over Georgia Southern in the championship game, allowing the Golden Eagles to capture their eighth league tournament title in their history.

Mr. Utility: Nick Monistere, who has played in 62 games last season with 61 starts, hit in the batting order in every starting spot but first and last, and started at more positions than any other Golden Eagle with 36 at second base, 13 at third base, six in center field, three in left field and three times in right field. The last Southern Miss player to start at five different positions was Michael Sterling in 2012 (2B – 8, 3B – 3, LF – 9, CF – 8, RF – 12). Monistere playing in right field was necessitated due to Carson Paetow being unavailable during the postseason due to a hand injury.

Winning at Home: Since utilizing Pete Taylor Park as its home facility in 1984, the Golden Eagles are 916-373-2 (.710) at the venue, having won now at least 20 or more home games in 34 of the 41 campaigns played at the park. During the 1985 and 1986 campaigns, Southern Miss played a handful of home games at Smokey Harrington Park, which is currently the home of Hattiesburg High School.

Remembering Corky: For the 2025 season, like the two previous seasons, the Golden Eagle baseball program will continue to honor the legacy of coach Corky Palmer, who passed away in August of 2022. The former Southern Miss catcher (1974-77), and two-time assistant coach, guided the program as head coach from 1998-2009, garnering 458 victories during his tenure. He took the school to its only trip to the College World Series in his final year in 2009. Coach Palmer's number will be stenciled on the baselines at Pete Taylor Park and his seat in the stadium, located on the first-base side, is painted gold. That seat will also be numbered as 44.

Walk-Off Victories Since 2017: Since the start of the 2017 season, Southern Miss has enjoyed 29 walk-off victories, including 25 at Pete Taylor Park/Hill Denson Field, two at Shuckers Ballpark in Biloxi, one at Alex Box Stadium in Baton Rouge and one at Riverfront Stadium in Montgomery. The latest came Saturday in the opening game of the doubleheader as Davis Gillespie's sacrifice fly in the 10th led the Golden Eagles to a triumph over Lafayette 7-6. Over this span, Matt Wallner (2017-19) and current baseball staff member Danny Lynch (2019-23) holds the most game-winning heroics over this time with three apiece. Bryant Bowen (2017-19), LeeMarcus Boyd (2017-18), Storme Cooper (2016-19), Cole Donaldson (2017-19) and Reed Trimble (2020-21) each had two apiece.

Average Attendance at The Pete Finishes in Top 10: Attendance at Pete Taylor Park/Hill Denson Field continues to rise each year and finished the 2024 season 10th nationally in average per game (5,317) and 13th overall (164,825). Only eight schools from the Southeastern Conference, and one from the then Big 12, had a higher average total going through the turnstiles in 2024, while eight SEC institutions, one from the Big 12, two from the Atlantic Coast Conference and one from the American Athletic had higher overall attendance during the year.

Strong 2025 Schedule: Seven teams on this year's slate ended the previous season ranked in the Top 50 in the final NCAA RPI. An additional six finished in the Top 100. Those top 50 schools include Mississippi State (No. 19), Alabama (No. 28), Louisiana Tech (No. 33), Ole Miss (No. 36), UNCW (No. 38), Louisiana (No. 41) and TCU (No. 42). Rounding out the Top 100 opponents are No. 59 Troy, No. 69 Nicholls, No. 70 South Alabama, No. 72 App State, No. 79 Old Dominion, and No. 82 Tulane.

Southern Miss AD Serves on Baseball Committee: Southern Miss Director of Athletics Jeremy McClain will help determine collegiate baseball tournament fields after being appointed to a four-year term on the NCAA Division I Baseball Committee. McClain will be a part of the 10-person committee that selects the annual 64-school tournament field. His four-year tenure on the committee began on Sept. 1, 2024, and continues through Aug. 31, 2028. The NCAA Division I Baseball Committee is responsible for selecting, seeding and bracketing the entire 64-team tournament field, which currently includes the automatic qualification of 30 conference champions with the remainder of the field selected as at-large choices by the committee. The committee also has oversight on the operation of the Division I baseball championship in general. In addition, they discuss and make recommendations regarding legislation regarding sport-specific issues, but the primary role is oversight of the championship.

- That there are two freshmen on the roster that were chosen Mr. Baseball for their respective classes in the state of Mississippi in 2024: Tyler Long (4A, Ripley HS) and Cole Richardson (5A, South Jones HS)
- Freshman Micah Wascom's brother, Camden, signed to play baseball at Louisiana Tech next season
- JB Middleton registered a win and a save on consecutive days against Marshall (3/16-17) last season on a total of seven pitches over those two games

Plain and simple, Christian Ostrander had to fill some big shoes when he was named the Southern Miss baseball coach in the summer of 2023. In his first season, Ostrander not only filled those shoes, he may have in fact help enlarge them.

Ostrander, widely regarded as one of the nation's top pitching coaches in the country, became the 14th head baseball coach at Southern Miss when he was elevated to the Golden Eagles' top spot. Ostrander became only the fifth coach to lead the program since 1959, following Pete Taylor (1959-83), Hill Denson (1984-1997), Corky Palmer (1998-2009) and Scott Berry (2010-2023).

In his first year at the helm of the Golden Eagles baseball program, he led the team to a 43-20 record, finishing second in the Sun Belt Conference regular season standings while capturing the league's tournament title. His victory total tied Wes Johnson of Georgia for the most wins by a rookie Division I head coach.

The program won 14 of 15 games heading into what was the school's 20th NCAA Tournament appearance and ninth consecutive berth. In the process, the Golden Eagles kept their string of consecutive 30-plus win (22) and 40-plus win seasons (8) alive - both of which are the longest in Division I baseball.

Behind the second longest hitting streak in school history of 36 games, Slade Wilks earned All-America third-team honors by two different organizations, while also collecting first-team Academic All-American.

The Golden Eagles had five players named all-conference including Wilks and pitcher Billy Oldham, collecting first-team honors. Pitcher Niko Mazza, shortstop Ozzie Pratt and outfielder Dalton McIntyre all collected second team honors.

Before taking the top job, Ostrander served as the associate head coach for the previous two seasons and had been with the program for six years overseeing the pitching staff for the Golden Eagles.

During his six years as an assistant, Ostrander has helped lead the Golden Eagles to five NCAA regional berths, mentoring one National Pitcher of the Year, two Dick Howser and Golden Spikes national semifinalists, two Ferriss Trophy winners for top player in the state of Mississippi, five different All-Americans, one Freshman All-American and four conference Pitchers of the Year in Nick Sandlin (2018), Walker Powell (2021) and Tanner Hall (2022, 2023) twice. For the third time in its C-USA history, the program enjoyed three first-team C-USA pitchers picked in 2022.

In 2022, Ostrander was also named the C-USA Assistant Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season helping him become the only coach to ever win that award twice in his history.

Despite losing 12 pitchers off last year's roster, Ostrander helped assemble another outstanding staff in 2023 that helped the Golden Eagles win 46 games as the program earned its seventh-straight NCAA Tournament berth. Led by Hall, who has posted an 12-4 record, Southern Miss led the Sun Belt Conference in earned run average (4.51), opposing batting average (.240), innings pitched (580 1/3), strikeouts (654) and wins (46). They also collected second in saves (19).

In 2022, Ostrander also earned Conference USA Assistant Coach of the Year honors for the second consecutive season - the only coach in the history of the award to win twice - as the Golden Eagles finished with a school record 746 strikeouts, betting the previous top total by 163. The Golden Eagles also ranked No. 2 nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.12), WHIP (1.16), strikeouts per nine innings (11.3) and ERA (3.29). No 3 in walks per nine innings (2.73). No. 4 in shutouts (8) and No. in hits allowed by nine innings (7.73).

The year, which had the Golden Eagles reach the NCAA Super Regionals after defeating LSU two of three games to capture the Hattiesburg Regional, saw the program register its first season since 1993 with two pitchers reaching 100 strikeouts during the year.

The success of 2022 cam on the heels of being ranked No. 1 nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.06), No. 2 in walks per 9 innings (2.24), No. 3 in shutouts (8), No. 6 in WHIP (1.17) and 20th in earned run average (3.74). His top two starting pitchers, Hunter Stanley and Walker Powell, each merited All-American accolades during the 2021 campaign.

The Golden Eagles led the league in ERA, opposing batting average (.236) and batters struck out (560). They also finished second in the conference by allowing just 138 walks, which was the fewest given up by the squad since allowing 137 in 1982. In his four full seasons, not counting 2020, the program has put together at least seven shutouts each year including eight in each of the last two seasons.

Under his tutelage, the Golden Eagles posted their second no-hitter in the last three seasons in 2021 when Powell blanked Middle Tennessee on May 8, and the team's strikewent total last spring (560) was the second most in school history.

Despite a shortened season in 2020, the Golden Eagle pitching staff performed well as Ostrander blended some veteran leadership pitching along with a bunch of newcomers. The results encompassed a 12-4 record by the squad that saw the pitching staff post 172 strikeouts with only 46 walks in 140 1/3 innings.

The shortened season also saw Ostrander's group enjoy some accolades as reliever Stanley earned third-team All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball, while the publication also tabbed Ben Ethridge a Freshman All-America selection.

In his second year with the program in 2019, Ostrander oversaw a pitching squad that posted the school's fourth-straight 40-win season. Entering the year, he had to retool a pitching staff that suffered the loss of the previous year's Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Year, Nick Sandlin.

Still, he mentored Powell into becoming a first-team All-Confer-

ence USA selection, who also earned three Conference USA weekly awards during the year as well as a spot on the league's all-tournament team. Redshirt freshman Gabe Shepard also garnered a spot on the C-USA all-tournament team on the basis of throwing seven innings in the school's first no-hitter since 2004. Shepard, along with two Golden Eagles, blanked Rice 6-0 to help the Golden Eagles advance to the championship game for the fourth consecutive year.

Shepard, who was limited on a pitch count for much of the year due to a previous injury, was nurtured along by Ostrander, who became a big reason for the Golden Eagles late-season run, including his win in the opening game of the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional against Arizona State.

The pitching staff threw seven shutouts during the year and enjoyed 479 strikeouts from the staff against just 207 walks during the season.

In his first year with the program, Ostrander overcame losing four starting pitchers from the previous season and made great strides with the Golden Eagle pitching staff.

One of the biggest moves in his first season in 2018, was switching Sandlin, a relief pitcher up until that point, into a starter and he oversaw his progress to being the C-USA Pitcher of the Year, the 2018 Ferriss Trophy winner and a second-round draft pick to the Cleveland Indians.

Ostrander's success cannot solely be tied to Sandlin's success. In addition, Southern Miss posted a 3.70 earned run average which was the lowest team ERA in three seasons while putting together eight shutouts and limiting opponents to just 152 walks. The walks surrendered were the fewest since allowing just 137 in 1982.

The program finished in the Top 10 nationally in three different categories: second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.40), third in shutouts and fourth in walks allowed per nine innings (2.49). In addition, the staff enjoyed 27 quality starts.

Ostrander came to Southern Miss after spending the last two seasons at Louisiana Team as their associate head coach and pitching coach. During those two years, the Bulldogs posted a 78-40 record and went to an NCAA Tournament.

Under the guidance of Ostrander, four Bulldog pitchers (Adam Atkins, Braden Bristo, Phillip Diehl and Nate Harris) were selected in the last two Major League Baseball First-Year Player Drafts.

In 2016, LA Tech's pitching staff recorded a school-record 496 strikeouts, besting the previous school-record of 452 which was set twice. Of the 42 Bulldog wins, which ranked first in Conference USA, 10 wins were over top-25 schools and 11 wins were over top-50 RPI schools.

Prior to LA Tech, Ostrander spent seven years as the head coach at Jones County Junior College in Ellisville.

Ostrander led the Bobcats to two MACJC state championships in 2011 and 2014 and helped guide Jones County to four division title in seven years. He also led JCJC to two 40-win seasons and set the school record for wins in a season on four different occasions. In seven seasons at Jones County, Ostrander compiled a 255-109 overall record with the Bobcats, good for a .701 winning percentage.

In 2015, Ostrander and the Bobcats put together a successful season with Jones County posting 30 wins with an appearance in the MACJC State Playoffs for the seventh consecutive season.

In 2014, JCJC enjoyed great success with a 46-11 record and a No. 6 ranking in the final NJCAA Division II poll. The 46 wins by the Bobcats matched the single-season record for victories in a season. The Bobcats were ranked No. 1 in the nation for most of the season and captured the 2014 state title at the end of the campaign. That season, JCJC led MACJC and Region 23 and were ranked No. 7 nationally with a 2.92 team ERA.

Ostrander led the team to a second-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series in 2011. The 2011 Bobcats posted a 46-17 record, won the MACJC state championship and its first ever Region 23 title.

In his first season at JCJC, Ostrander led the Bobcats to a 36-16 overall record, a third-place finish in the MACJC South Division and a berth in the MACJC State Tournament. It marked the first time the Bobcats advanced to postseason play since winning a state title in 2002.

A year later, Ostrander led the Bobcats to their first-ever MACJC South Division regular season title, a 38-12 record and the host role in the MACJC State Tournament. Prior to his stint at Jones County, Ostrander previously served as recruiting coordinator and pitching coach at Arkansas State from 2002-06 and also led Gulfport High School to the Class 5A playoffs in two seasons as the head coach for the Admirals.

Ostrander also served the pitching coach, recruiting coordinator and camp coordinator at Delta State from 1999-2002.

DSU posted a 189-43 record during his four seasons, winning the Gulf South Conference West Division championship all four years and the South Regional championship in 2001 and 2002. In his final two seasons at Delta State, the Statesmen competed in the Division II College World Series in both 2001 and 2002.

He earned a bachelor's degree in education from Delta State in 1996 and his master's of education in administration from DSU in 1998. Ostrander has been a member of the American Baseball Coaches Association since 1998.

In the fall of 2019, Ostrander earned induction into the Jones College Hall of Fame.

Ostrander is a native of Monroe, La. He and his wife, Amy, have two daughters, Caitlin and Allie.
