» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 19-5 at Plainsman Park this season, including 7-2 in SEC play.
- The Tigers have held league opponents to a .203 batting average at home while turning in a .308 average of their own.
- The team wrapped up a stretch of 20 of the last 24 games coming against ranked opponents with a 1-0 win vs. No. 21 Georgia Tech Tuesday.
- Auburn went 11-9 during the 20-game stretch and is 13-9 against ranked opponents this season.
- Samuel Dutton leads the SEC with a 2.43 ERA and is eighth with a 3.09 ERA in league play.
- In three SEC starts at Plainsman Park, he is 3-0 with a 0.90 ERA in 20.0 innings pitched.
- Ike Irish is hitting 23 points higher (.417) and slugging 166 points higher (.950) than any other player in the league in SEC play.
- He is also tied for the league lead with eight home runs in conference play.
- Auburn trails the all-time series against Mississippi State, 96-119-1, but the Tigers are 53-44 against the Bulldogs at home.

Butch Thompson enters his 10th season at the helm of the program in 2025, posting a record of 283-213-1 in his first nine seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last five postseasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his 10th season with the Tigers in 2025.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in his nine seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 283-213-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last seven postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last six years and two trips to the College World Series in the last five postseasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 48 all-conference performers. He has seen 24 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 18 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 42 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 17 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 3 freshman class in 2024, surpassing the 2017 signing class (No. 4) for the highest in program history.

In 32 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 23 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three postseasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history in 2022-23.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's nine seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 23 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail and Hayes Grady Moreman.

SAMFORD STADIUM-HITCHCOCK FIELD AT PLAINSMAN PARK

Auburn baseball's home for the past 75 seasons, an expanded and renovated Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park makes its debut for the 2025 season.

After completing a \$30+ million project that has spanned the last two seasons, the ballpark now features premium club areas including the Broadway Club at Plainsman Park located at the top of the stadium behind home plate and the 984 Club located down the first base line to go along with the pre-existing Hall of Fame Club located at field level behind home plate, which opened prior to the 2024 season.

Along with the premium club areas, Plainsman Park now features multiple expanded general admission areas. The renovated Tiger Terrace now includes three tiers of paved terrace space with the bottom tier featuring nine terrace boxes equipped with soft seating and drink rail viewing areas, Traeger pellet grills, refrigerators and more. Additional general admission areas include the two-tiered standing room space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field and the expanded Plainsman Patio at concourse level down the first base line.

The new and improved ballpark, which continues to feature the timeless elements inspired by Camden Yards, Wrigley Field and Fenway Park that were included in the initial renovation spearheaded by former head coach Hal Baird nearly 30 years ago, has a capacity of 7,189. The design continues to combine the look of old-time ballparks with academic buildings on the Auburn campus to create a facade of brick and painted steel.

Kickstarted by the completion of the Josh Donaldson Hitting Facility prior to the 2021 season, Auburn baseball's player development areas also continue to take a step forward. Along with the hitting facility, the program has a new state-of-the-art locker room, bullpen and pitching lab, weight room and nutrition center, and soon-to-be new coaches offices and team meeting space.

Plainsman Park, which has hosted six NCAA Regionals (1978, 1999, 2003, 2010, 2022, 2023) and also had the privilege of hosting President George W. Bush on Oct. 24, 2002, has twice been named one of the best facilities in college baseball. Baseball America initially voted it the best facility in the country prior to the 2003 season, and D1 Baseball named it one of the top venues in the nation in 2016.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Mississippi State enters the weekend with a 24-17 overall record and a 6-12 mark in SEC play. The Bulldogs are 3-6 in league play on the road, coming off a series win in its last road trip at Alabama.
- Offensively, Mississippi State is hitting .302 as a team, good for the fifth best mark in the SEC, and is second in the league with a .285 average in conference play. Senior infielder Gehrig Frei leads the team with a .388 average in 80 at-bats, while sophomore infielder Ace Reese leads the way with 13 home runs and 48 RBI.
- On the mound, the Bulldogs are turned in a 4.24 staff ERA with 456 strikeouts and 135 walks in 343.2 innings pitched. The team ranks fifth in the league in strikeouts and have allowed the fourth fewest walks.

GO MAD

- Auburn's mantra is to #GoMAD (Make A Difference).
- The idea is that concepts like running harder than any team in the country from home to first and throwing as many strikes as possible will bleed into other areas both on and off the field.

POSTSEASON RESUME

- Auburn is currently No. 3 in the RPI - trailing Georgia and Texas - with the No. 1 strength of schedule in the country.
- The Tigers have played 20 quad one games - home games vs. 1-25, neutral games vs. 1-40 and away games vs. 1-60 - and are 11-9 in those contests.

A LEAGUE OF ITS OWN

- The SEC has the No. 1 conference RPI and has posted a 311-58 record (.843) against non-conference opponents.
- The next closest conference (ACC) is 251-75 (.770) against non-conference opponents.

GOING THROUGH A GAUNTLET

- Auburn has played nine ranked teams this season, including five in the top 10.
- Each of the first six and eight of 10 SEC series are against ranked teams, including the stretch of four straight vs. top-10 teams that the Tigers just completed at Texas.
- Starting with the weekend at Georgia (Mar. 28-29), Auburn's four-week stretch was against the No. 2, No. 8, No. 3 and No. 1 teams in the country.
- The Tigers just completed a stretch of 20 of the last 24 games coming against ranked opponents and went 11-9 in the span.

OPPONENT WIN PERCENTAGE

- Auburn's 10 SEC opponents have a combined record of 98-82 (.544) in league games.
- The .544 league winning percentage is the second highest in the league behind Missouri (100-80, .556).
- The Tigers have six of the top seven teams in the current standings on their schedule.

HAVING SUCCESS AT HOME

- Auburn is 19-5 at home this season, including 7-2 in SEC play, and has won six of its last seven home games, with five of those wins coming against top 10 teams.
- The Tigers have outscored opponents 177-98 and have out-hit them .319 to .220 at home this season.
- In nine SEC home games, the team is hitting .308 with a .376 ERA, outscoring the opponent 56-35 during the span.

RACKING UP (RANKED) WINS

- Auburn enters the weekend 13-9 against ranked opponents, including 9-2 against ranked teams at Plainsman Park.
- The Tigers have already surpassed last season's overall (28) and SEC (9) win totals.

FINDING A WAY

- The Tigers are 9-3 in one-run games this season after going 4-9 in such games last year.
- Eight of the team's last 11 games have been decided by two runs or fewer (6-2).

IKE'S ON ANOTHER LEVEL

- After missing six games from Mar. 9-18 with a fractured scapula, Ike Irish is hitting .405 (32-for-79) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs and 23 RBI in 20 games since his return.
- Irish homered four times in three games at Texas, becoming the first Auburn player since Cooper McMurray in 2023 to homer four times in a SEC series (Mississippi State, Apr. 21-23).
- His multi-homer game Friday at Texas marked his third of the season, all coming since Mar. 22, and fourth of his career.
- He leads the SEC by 23 points with a .417 average in SEC play and by 166 points with a .950 slugging percentage while also tying for the league lead with eight home runs despite missing SEC Opening Weekend.
- Irish enters the weekend with 192 career hits, including 43 doubles and 31 home runs, and 145 RBI in 140 games played.

DOUBLE DIGIT DINGERS

- Cooper McMurray has hit double digit home runs in back-to-back seasons with 14 apiece in 2023 and 2024 and is second on the team with eight long balls this season.
- With two more home runs, McMurray would become just the fourth player in program history to have hit 10+ home runs in three straight seasons.

 - Hunter Morris (2008-10)
- McMurray enters the weekend ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in career home runs (45), RBI (160) and walks (144).

NEWCOMERS MAKING A NAME

- Five of Auburn's top six hitters through six weeks of SEC play are newcomers.
 - Chase Fralick: .317 (20-for-63)
 - Chris Rembert: .304 (17-for-56)
 - Bristol Carter: .302 (13-for-43)
 - Bub Terrell: .288 (19-for-66)
 - Lucas Steele: .268 (11-for-41)
- Five of the team's nine SEC wins have also been earned by newcomers in Samuel Dutton (3), Cade Fisher (1) and Andreas Alvarez (1), while Ryan Hetzler has earned all four saves.

HURT SO GOOD

- Despite missing two weeks with a shoulder injury, Cade Belyeu has been hit by 16 pitches in 96 at-bats this season, including two in Tuesday's game vs. Georgia Tech, marking the third time this season he had been hit by two pitches in a game.
- He leads the team with a .473 on-base percentage, drawing 18 walks to go along with the 16 hit by pitches.
- In 68 career games played and 191 at-bats, the sophomore outfielder has been hit by 29 pitches, tied for the fourth most in program history.

BUSTED OUT THE BROOMS

- Auburn's sweep of LSU last weekend marked the program's first against the Bayou Bengals since 1988.
- It also marked the team's first sweep against a top-five team since sweeping No. 5 Florida at Plainsman Park from Mar. 17-19, 2017.

PITCHING ON POINT

- Auburn defeated Georgia Tech 1-0 on Tuesday, marking the program's first 1-0 win since defeating Mercer 1-0 in the Tallahassee Regional on May 30, 2015.
- The game marked the pitching staff's fourth shutout this season, tied for the most shutouts in a season since racking up five shutouts in the shortened 2020 season.
- The game also marked the fifth time this season the Tigers have held the opponent to two hits, marking the most games holding the opponent to two hits or fewer since 2016.

GOING LOW

- Auburn has held the opponent to four runs or fewer in the last four home games, including two runs of fewer three times, posting a 2.00 ERA with a .161 average against.
- The team's 2.67 ERA in the series vs. LSU was the lowest in a SEC series since holding Tennessee to a 1.33 ERA in a three-game sweep to open the 2019 SEC season.

DUTTON IS DEALING

- Through his first 10 starts in an Auburn uniform, Samuel Dutton leads the SEC with a 2.43 ERA and ranks top 10 in innings pitched (55.2) and strikeouts (64).
- In his last three starts against top 10 opponents he is 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with 19 strikeouts and four walks in 18.2 innings.
- In three SEC home starts, Dutton is 3-0 with a 0.90 ERA with 19 strikeouts and five walks in 20.0 innings.

- Senior Carson Myers turned in a season-long 4.2 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts in the series finale at Georgia on Mar. 29.
- His 10 strikeouts were a career high and the most by an Auburn reliever since Cole Lipscomb struck out 10 against Florida State in the 2017 Tallahassee Regional.
- Myers struck out seven straight batters to end his outing, and the last nine outs he recorded were via the strikeout.
- In seven appearances and 14.2 innings in SEC play, Myers leads the team with a 2.45 ERA, allowing four runs on 11 hits with two walks and 24 strikeouts.

CADE IS COMING ALONG

- Cade Fisher has turned in a 3.72 ERA in his last five starts and 19.1 innings pitched.
- He has turned in a 3.38 ERA with 10 strikeouts and three walks in 8.0 innings in his last two SEC home starts.

FRALICK CAN FLAT OUT HIT

- Heading into the 11th weekend of the season, Chase Fralick ranks second on the team with a .333 average and 48 hits and is third in doubles (9) and RBI (30).
- Fralick ranks second on the team with 14 multi-hit games, six of which have come in SEC play, highlighted by a four-hit effort in the series opener vs. Alabama.
- He is hitting .370 overall at home, including .433 (13-for-30) in SEC home games.
- He ranks second on the team with a .317 average and 12 RBI in his first 17 SEC games.

REMBERT RAKES

- Chris Rembert was named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Week on Mar. 3 after hitting .385 with two home runs and 10 RBI in four games from Feb. 25-Mar. 2.
- Rembert ranked tied for second in the league with 10 RBI during that week and drove in a run in all four contests.
- Rembert is hitting .304 in SEC play, good for third on the team, including .406 (13-for-32) in league games at home.
- He has multiple hits in seven of the last 14 games, good for the most on the team, and is second on the team with a .340 average during the span.

BUB CAN PLAY SOME BALL

- Bub Terrell was named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Week after hitting .368 with two homers and seven RBI in five games from Feb. 18-23.
- Terrell scored the walk-off run in the 9th inning vs. Troy and drove in the go-ahead run in the 6th inning vs. North Alabama the next day.
- He went on to hit the first three homers of his Auburn career in a span of four games vs. Wright State (Feb. 21-23) and Samford (Feb. 25).
- Terrell is hitting .288 in SEC play, including .361 (13-for-36) in league games at home.

DYNAMIC DUO

- Preseason All-SEC honorees Ike Irish (first team) and Cooper McMurray (second team) combined to hit 28 homers with 115 RBI last year.
- Only two returning duos in the league can claim higher home run and RBI production - Jace LaViolette and Gavin Grahovac at Texas A&M (52 homers, 144 RBI); Slate Alford and Kolby Branch at Georgia (34 homers, 127 RBI).

CREAM OF THE CROP

- Auburn's 2024 signing class was ranked as high as No. 3 in the country, marking a new program record for highest ranked recruiting class - surpassing the 2017 class that was previously ranked No. 4.
- On top of the freshman class, the Tigers also brought in the No. 4 ranked transfer class.

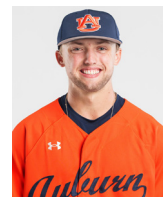
