LEADING OFF

Dynamic Deano

- » Tuesday starter Blake Dean, a transfer from Kansas State, put together a few of the best performances as a Wildcat against Top 10 teams.
- » In four career relief appearances against Top 10 teams, Dean has pitched 9.1 innings with nine strikeouts and just one earned run.
- » Dean pitched an inning without an earned run at #10 Clemson as a freshman, and pitched 2.2 scoreless innings with two K's at #6 North Carolina last season before going 3.2 scoreless with 5 strikeouts against #5 Arkansas and 2.0 innings with one earned run and two strikeouts against #2 LSU.

Flashing Back

- » Last season, the Trojans went into Starkville for their second midweek contest of the season and topped the #15 ranked Bulldogs 6-5.
- » It was the long ball that got the Trojans the victory despite striking out a school-record 20 times. Vicksburg, Miss., native Shane Lewis hit two, while Steven Meier tattooed a 3-0 Ben Davis fastball to right field to put Troy ahead in the top of the ninth. Meier also added an RBI single in the fifth inning.

Portal Power

- » Troy welcomes in 23 newcomers to just 13 returners for the 2026 season, including four freshmen, six juco transfers, and 13 transfer portal additions.
- » Troy's transfer portal haul was ranked No. 19 nationally, according to 64Analytics.
- » Headlining the position players are NCBWA Preseason First Team All-American DH Nico Azpilcueta (Stony Brook), Perfect Game Preseason All-Sun Belt shortstop Aaron Piasecki (Central Michigan), and former All-Big Ten third baseman Josh Pyne (Indiana).
- » While Troy only returns 21% of its innings pitched from a season ago, the Trojans' nine transfer portal pitchers have combined for 586.1 innings pitched in their careers.

TEAM NOTES

New Heights

- » Head coach **Skylar Meade** has elevated the Troy program into a national name in his four seasons at the helm.
- » In Meade's second season in 2023, his Trojans finished with a 40-22 record and reached the Tuscaloosa Regional, defeating Boston College in the regional opener. It was both Troy's first 40-win season and first regional appearance since 2018.
- » The 2024 campaign saw Troy reach a No. 21 national ranking by D1Baseball after the Trojans went into Conway, S.C., and swept No. 13 Coastal Carolina. It was Troy's first time in the Top 25 since 2013, and the first time in program history the Trojans had swept a ranked ranked.
- » Troy's 2025 season began with a No. 25 national ranking by D1Baseball, the program's first time being ranked in the preseason Top 25. Although Troy was the first team left out of the NCAA Tournament field, the Trojans were the only team in the country to win each of their first 13 weekend series and had their longest streak of consecutive weeks in the Top 25 (Preseason - Week 14) in program history.
- » Weeks 12 and 13 saw that Trojans ranked No. 14 by Baseball America, the highest national ranking in program history.
- » Troy defeated national runner-up Coastal Carolina in a three-game game series in March, the only team to do so until LSU defeated the Chanticleers in the College World Series Championship Series.

Do I Care if its a Walk or a Hit?

- » Associate Head Coach **Ben Wolgamot** has transformed the Troy offense into one of the toughest outs in college baseball since taking over as Troy's hitting coach in 2022.
- » Troy's last three seasons sit atop the Troy record book for walks, including a No. 3 finish nationally in 2024. Wolgamot's offenses have four of the top six seasons for HBP's in Troy history, and ranked 15th nationally in HBP's last season. Troy was also one of two teams, along with Rhode Island, to rank in the Top 25 nationally for both walks and HBP's in 2025.

The Gauntlet Awaits

- » To increase its RPI opportunities, Troy will play a total of 28 road games and two neutral site games, it's most road games since also playing 28 during the 2007 regular season.
- » Troy faces a gauntlet of a non-conference schedule, with their first four midweek games being trips to SEC foes Mississippi State, Georgia, Vanderbilt and Alabama. They'll make a second midweek trip to Georgia and will host Alabama later in the season as well.
- » The Trojans opening series is against a Mercer club that finished in the top 75 of the RPI last season, while the LeClair Classic will pit them against a preseason Top 25 East Carolina team.
- » Troy's two non-conference home series come against Campbell, a Top 130 RPI club from a season ago, and Big Ten power Maryland.

One to Watch

- » While Troy is not ranked in any of the five major polls, the Trojans were listed as one of D1Baseball's 12 teams that just missed the cut.
- » Additionally, the Trojans received votes in both the Coaches Poll and the NCBWA rankings in the Preseason.

Road to Omaha

- » The Trojans are projected to make the NCAA Tournament according to both D1Baseball, Baseball America, and The Athletic's Preseason Field of 64.
- » D1Baseball has Troy slotted as the 3-seed in the Auburn Regional along with No. 9 national seed Auburn, 2-seed Wake Forest, and 4-seed Samford.
- » Baseball America has Troy slotted as the 3-seed in the Fort Worth Regional along with No. 9 national seed TCU, 2-seed Florida, and 4-seed Lamar.
- » The Athletic has Troy slotted as the 3-seed in the Oxford Regional along with No. 13 national seed Ole Miss, 2-seed NC State, and 4-seed Samford.
- » D1Baseball polled coaches from 279 schools on who their Omaha Sleeper is, and Troy was the second-most picked team with 20 votes, trailing only Dallas Baptist with 24 votes.

TEAM NOTES

Perfectly Balanced

- » One of Skylar Meade's top needs when building his 2026 roster was the addition of some right-handed hitters in order to have a more balanced lineup.
- » In 2025, Jimmy Janicki was the only right-handed hitter in the Troy lineup to record more than 150 plate appearances, while graduating senior Jakob Wax was the only other righty with over 100.
- » This season, the Trojan lineup looks to be more balanced. From the left side, Troy returns starters Sean Darnell, Blake Cavill, Steven Meier, Houston Markham and Gavin Schrader and add Central Michigan transfer Aaron Piasecki to the mix.
- » From the right side, Janicki is back and they've added a crop of proven transfers in Stony Brook's Nico Azpilcueta, Indiana's Josh Pyne and Mount St. Mary's' Nolan Book. Juco transfer Jabe Boroff and freshmen Caden Reeves and Brady Richardson could also factor in to Troy's right-handed hitting group.

Ball Magnet

- » Troy centerfielder **Steven Meier** has earned the reputation as one of the most fearless hitters to step in the box across college baseball, drawing 54 hit-by-pitches since the start of the 2024 season, the second-most in college baseball during that span.
- » During his 2024 campaign at Old Dominion, Meier set the Monarchs' single-season record with 24 HBP's on the season.
- » Upon transferring to Troy for the 2025 season, Meier claimed the Trojans' single-season HBP record, drawing 29 on the season

American Pi

- » Former Central Michigan infielder **Aaron Piasecki** was a major win for Troy in the transfer portal this offseason, as the Chippewas' second baseman was ranked No. 47 in D1Baseball's Top 50 transfer hitters, the top ranked transfer in the Sun Belt Conference.
- » Ahead of his first season with the Trojans this spring, Piasecki was a Preseason All-Sun Belt pick at shortstop by Perfect Game.
- » Following a standout juco career at Kellogg CC that saw him earn First Team All-America honors as a sophomore, Piasecki was one of the college baseball's toughest outs in 2025, ranking third in the MAC and 57th nationally in strikeout-rate (8.5%) among hitters with 200+ plate appearances.
- » Over the summer while playing with the Traverse City Pit Spitters of the Northwoods League, Piasecki led the league with a .406 batting average, drawing 36 walks to just nine strikeouts across 50 games.
- » After the Muskegon, Mich., native hit .329 in 2024 and .406 in 2025, he finished his Northwoods League career with a .366 career average, the highest in league history.

Productive Pyne

- » Troy third baseman **Josh Pyne** was one of the most decorated players to enter the transfer portal this offseason following his four-year career at Indiana.
- » During his time at IU, Pyne was named to the All-Big Ten Freshman Team and a Second Team Freshman All-American in 2022 before landing on the All-Big Ten Third Team in 2023.
- » Pyne started 183 games for the Hoosiers from 2022-24 before suffering a season-ending injury five games into his senior season in 2025. He finished his time in Bloomington ranked fifth in program history for doubles (58) and 16th in RBIs (152).
- » His 22 doubles in 2024 were second in the Big Ten and tied for the fourth-most in a single-season in Indiana history.
- » Pyne's 225 career hits are the most among active NCAA hitters and his 58 career doubles are the second-most.

Jimmy Two Bags

- » Troy sophomore **Jimmy Janicki** arrived on campus in fall of 2024 as one of the most heralded recruits in program history, as D1Baseball tabbed him as the No. 16 freshman in the country ahead of the 2025 season.
- » While recruited as a catcher, Janicki took a back seat to 2x All-Sun Belt backstop Brooks Bryan and played third base instead. Despite playing out of position, Janicki put together one of the most productive freshman seasons in Troy history at the plate.
- » The Downers Grove, Ill., native tied the Troy record for doubles by a freshman (12) while finding his way into the top ten in batting average (.9th - .280), hits (4th - 56), RBIs (4th - 32), walks (5th - 21), HBP's (3rd - 7), and on-base percentage (8th - .367).
- » Now with Bryan gone to the pros after being selected in the 8th round by the Royals, Janicki will kick behind the plate and enters the season with lofty expectations. The Sun Belt Coaches voted him to the Preseason All-Conference Team at Utility, while Perfect Game picked him as their Preseason All-Sun Belt catcher.
- » Scouts are also high on Janicki as a 2027 MLB Draft Prospect, as the sophomore comes in at No. 18 in Baseball America's 2027 rankings.

Thunder from Down Under

- » Troy first baseman **Blake Cavill**, a Sydney, Australia, native, has quickly become a fan favorite since joining the Trojans last season and his journey to playing college baseball at Troy is rather unique.
- » Cavill represented Team Australia in multiple international events throughout high school - in addition to lettering in rugby, cricket and volleyball - but was not recruited by any American colleges. Looking for a school to play at, he googled, "best American junior colleges", and sent an email to the coaches at Northwest Florida State. Two weeks later, Cavill had a spot on the Raiders' roster and he packed his bags for the panhandle.
- » Cavill's stock rose quickly with an All-Conference sophomore 2023 season. Troy heavily pursued, but he ultimately chose Western Kentucky. After a productive 2024 with the Hilltoppers, Cavill entered the transfer portal and gave Troy a second chance.
- » In his first season with the Trojans, Cavill was an All-Sun Belt First Team selection, leading the team in batting average (.320) while tying the program record for walks in a single season (65), ranking third nationally. Cavill's .516 on-base percentage was also the second-highest in Troy's history as a Division-I program (since 1994).
- » Cavill enters 2026 as the unanimous Preseason Sun Belt Player of the Year (Coaches, D1Baseball, Perfect Game) and an Preseason Third Team All-American (NCBWA).
- » Cavill reached base in all 58 games played in 2025, one of two players in college baseball to reach base safely in every game played along with Tennessee's Andrew Fischer.
- » Cavill entered the 2026 season with the longest active reached base streak in college baseball - 65 games dating back to the 2024 season - though it was snapped on opening day with an 0-for-5 day at the plate.

- » Although he made just 99 plate appearances, the Iowa native swung at just 8.4% of pitches outside the strike zone, which was the 13th-best chase rate in all of college baseball.

RIDDLE-PACE FIELD

The site of Riddle-Pace Field began holding Troy Baseball games in 1931 and now is home to one of the most beautiful ballparks in all of college baseball.

The facility underwent a \$12 million renovation project immediately following the 2022 season and the Trojans officially moved into their new stadium prior to the 2024 season. The newest update to Riddle-Pace Field includes new coaches' offices, team meeting rooms, a state-of-the-art video room, a new RBI Club seating option with access to an indoor club area, chairback seating throughout the facility and a concourse area for fans featuring concession stands and a team shop.

Additionally, Riddle-Pace Field received a new outfield LED video display prior to the 2024 season measuring more than 21 feet high by nearly 71 feet wide; the largest in the Sun Belt Conference. It features a 15HD pixel layout to deliver crisp, clear imagery with wide-angle visibility to appeal to fans in every seat. It also features industry-leading environmental protection, ensuring it operates as expected in the Alabama weather.

Integrated into the video and scoring system is a Sportsound® 1500HD audio system in center field within the backdrop of the batter's eye. It supplements live events with a booming audio experience. It delivers full-range sound reproduction while providing clear, intelligible speech from announcers.

Riddle-Pace Field is a beautiful facility constructed of red brick and exposed steel beams, which complement the attractive architecture already found on the Troy University campus. The stadium was designed to ensure outstanding sightlines and comfort for fans, as well as meet the needs of the country's finest college baseball players.

The addition of the Lott Baseball Complex in 2008 included locker room facilities for the Trojans, coaches offices, a new scoreboard with additional advertising opportunities, a covered batting cage and a new outfield wall. The coaches offices were transformed into a state-of-the-art meeting space for the team with the 2022 renovation project.



Skylar Meade enters his fifth season as Troy's head coach in 2026, following a 2025 campaign that saw the Trojans achieve a No. 14 national ranking, the highest in program history.

The Trojans have accumulated 148 wins during Meade's tenure, the most wins in the first four seasons by a head coach in program history. Troy is coming off three consecutive 37-plus win seasons for the first time since 1996-98.

Meade took over Troy's head coaching role in 2022 following four seasons as the pitching coach at South Carolina.

2025

Meade's fourth season began with a No. 25 national ranking, marking the first time the program had received a preseason ranking. With a 39-21 record, Troy was ranked each week from the preseason through Week 14, the longest stretch in the program's Division-I history that the Trojans have been ranked. Additionally, Troy was the only team in college baseball to win each of its first 13 weekend series. The Trojans defeated national runner-up Coastal Carolina in a three-game set and added a marquee win on the road at No. 15 Mississippi State.

Troy finished third in the Sun Belt Conference with an 18-12 record, boasting one of the league's most potent offenses. The Trojans ranked second in the Sun Belt in on-base percentage (.403) and walks (323) and fourth in runs per game (7.0) and OPS (.837). Additionally, the Trojans set a school record for hit-by-pitch (122) and were the only team in college baseball to finish the regular season in the top 20 nationally for both walks and hit-by-pitch.

Individually, Troy placed three players on the Sun Belt All-Conference teams, with first baseman Blake Cavill leading the way on the first team and catcher Brooks Bryan and starting pitcher Garrett Gainous landing on the second team.

Cavill made an impression on the Troy record book, ranking third nationally in walks (65), which tied Jorge Soto in 1999 for the most in program history. Cavill's .516 on-base percentage was 13th nationally and the second-best by a Trojan in the program's Division-I era. Additionally, Steven Meier drew a Troy record 29 hit-by-pitches.

On the mound, Garrett Gainous and Grayson Stewart became the newest members of the 250-strikeout club. Gainous finished his playing career ranked third in Troy history for strikeouts (262) with Stewart finishing his career ranked fifth (251). Reliever Jay Dill led the team with 70 strikeouts and posted a Sun Belt-best 12.86 strikeouts per nine innings.

Under Meade's leadership, Troy saw five players earn opportunities in professional baseball, its most since 2007. Brooks Bryan (8th round - Kansas City Royals), Noah Edders (15th round - Chicago Cubs) and Jay Dill (18th round - Athletics) were each selected in the MLB Draft, while Adam Falinski (Minnesota Twins) and Coby Frieda (New York Mets) struck free agent deals.

2024

Meade's third season saw the Troy program reach new heights with a No. 21 national ranking, its highest since 2013. With a 37-22 record in 2024, Meade's 109 career wins are the most-ever in the first three seasons by a Troy head coach. In addition, the Trojans won 77 games across the 2023 and 2024 seasons, which were Troy's most in a two-year span since 2006-07.

The Trojans were one of the most prolific offenses in the Sun Belt Conference in 2024, drawing a school record 382 walks to rank third nationally while leading the conference and ranking eighth in the country with a .424 on-base percentage. Additionally, the Trojans scored 516 runs on the season, which were the second most in the Sun Belt and 14th in the nation.

The 2024 season saw the Trojans rack up numerous key wins, winning nine games against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. The Trojans earned series victories at Indiana and against No. 18 Louisiana while sweeping No. 13 Coastal Carolina on the road to go along with wins at Southern Miss and against James Madison. Troy finished the regular season as the No. 3 seed in the SBC Tournament.

Under Meade's leadership, Brooks Bryan rewrote the Troy record books with a school-record 85 RBIs. Bryan was a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist, Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist, All-Sun Belt First Team and ABCA All-Region First Team while being selected to compete on the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.

Troy's six selections on the Sun Belt All-Conference teams were the most in the league. Bryan was named to the First Team while Luke Lyon, Will Butcher, Ethan Kavanagh, Kole Myers and Kyle Mock were all named to the Second Team.

Myers heard his name called by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the ninth round of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Dodgers, while Clete Hartzog signed a free agent deal with the Chicago White Sox.

Following the 2024 season, Meade was selected to serve as the pitching coach for the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Friendship Series, where he helped lead Team USA to a five-game sweep of Chinese Taipei.

2023

Skylar Meade's second season saw the Trojans skyrocket beyond expectations as he led the program to its first 40-win seasons since 2018 and fifth in the last 20 years. He also led the Trojans to an at-large berth in the NCAA Tuscaloosa Regional, where they defeated Boston College, 11-10, in the Regional opener.

Meade and the Trojans dominated on the mound leading the Sun Belt Conference and ranking 11th in the country in strikeouts per nine innings at 10.6 – the second straight season where the Trojans set a program record. On the offensive side, Troy recorded 19 triples to lead the league and rank 20th in the nation. Additionally, Troy ranked in the top three in walks (third – 306), double plays (second – 51), double plays per game (third – 0.82), home runs (second – 108), home runs per game (third – 1.74), runs (second – 476), triples per game (second – 0.31).

The 2023 season saw key victories by Meade and the Trojans, including his first win over an SEC opponent at Auburn, in addition to series sweeps over Marshall, ULM, USC-Upstate, Stony Brook and Evansville. Under the guidance of Meade, the Trojans entered the SBC Tournament as the No. 3 seed.

Meade's leadership also propelled two players, Zach Fruit (Baltimore Orioles) and William Sullivan (St. Louis Cardinals), to be selected in the MLB Draft, while Caleb Bartolero and Ben Thompson signed with the Los Angeles Angels.

Shane Lewis earned Sun Belt Player and Newcomer of the Year honors after hitting a program record 27 home runs. Lewis was a Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist, All-Sun Belt First Team, Collegiate Baseball All-American Third Team and ABCA / Rawlings All-American Third Team. Troy raked in the accolades with three

2022

In his first season at the helm of the Trojans, Meade led Troy to a 32-win season and an appearance in the semifinals of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The 32 wins in 2022 were the most by a Trojan team since 2019. Under the pitching expertise of Meade, the Trojans led the Sun Belt Conference in strikeouts, totaling 520. In addition, they led the conference in strikeouts per nine innings at 9.5, which was the most in program history, as Meade has now been a part of a strikeout record at every program he's coached at. Meade became the fourth coach in program history to win at least 30 games in his first season.

Meade earned his first win as head coach of the Trojans on Feb. 18, 2022, in a 2-1 win over Holy Cross. More history was made when Meade led the Trojans to their first-ever sweep over Louisiana and swept Big Ten program, Indiana. The Trojans saw a nine-game win streak during the 2022 season, which was the fourth-longest in the country at the time and the longest in program history since 2006.

Rigsby Mosley earned Sun Belt all-conference recognition for the first time in his storied career as a pitcher under the direction of Meade after five years having only played outfield.

Prior to Troy

A 14-year coaching veteran, Meade has previous stops at South Carolina, Michigan State, Middle Tennessee and Eastern Illinois following a standout playing career at Louisville, where he pitched in the College World Series. Meade has seen 35 players selected in the MLB Draft, including six during his first four seasons at Troy.

Meade's final season with South Carolina in 2021 saw six Gamecock pitchers selected in the MLB Draft, which was tied with Arkansas for the most pitchers selected from any one school. Brett Kerry earned D1 Baseball and NCBWA All-America honors while Will Sanders was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team, was a Freshman All-American selection by two organizations and was selected as a member of USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Additionally, Jack Mahoney earned Freshman All-America honors from Perfect Game.

The Gamecocks posted the fourth-best ERA in the Southeastern Conference in 2021, while South Carolina's staff totaled 624 strikeouts in just 507 innings pitched. South Carolina hosted an NCAA Regional and picked up an in-season sweep of No. 5 Florida.

Meade joined the South Carolina staff before the 2018 season and during his four seasons 14 Gamecock pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft. Seven of those picks came in the top 10 rounds, including Carmen Mlodzinski, who was selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates with the 31st overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft.

He made an immediate impact in his first season with the Gamecocks as they held opponents to a .243 batting average and posted 542 strikeouts in 553.1 innings of work. In the shortened 2020 season, South Carolina pitchers combined for a 2.81 ERA with 184 strikeouts in just 144 innings pitched. In 2019, Kerry began his rise up the national pitching ranks under Meade's guidance as he was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team and a Freshman All-American by three different organizations.

Meade joined the South Carolina staff following three seasons as the pitching coach at Michigan State. Under his watch, a Spartan pitcher led the Big Ten in ERA in each of his last two seasons on staff (Walter Borkovich in 2017; Dakota Mekkes in 2016). Additionally, the Spartans posted their top three strikeout totals in school history his final three seasons with 409 strikeouts in 2015, 466 in 2016 and 420 in 2017.

Michigan State led the Big Ten in ERA (2.75), opponent's batting average (.234) and runs allowed (199) in 2016. That ERA also was third in the nation and fifth lowest in school history. Meade helped Mekkes earn NCBWA All-America honors after finishing the season with the best strikeout per nine innings (15.16) and hits per nine innings (4.11) ratios in the nation. In his first season, Meade helped Joe Mockbee to a 1.78 ERA, the lowest by a Spartan since 1974.

Prior to his stint at Michigan State, Meade spent two years as the pitching coach at Middle Tennessee. The Blue Raider pitching staff lowered its team ERA in each of his two seasons including posting the program's lowest mark in 13 years during his final year on staff.

Meade also mentored Zac Curtis, who was selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks, and Daniel Palo, a Colorado Rockies draftee.

Prior to joining the staff at Middle Tennessee, Meade spent five seasons at Eastern Illinois, first as a graduate assistant before being elevated to an assistant coach in 2009. EIU posted one of the Ohio Valley Conference's best rotations during his time at the school. The Panthers sported the best team ERA in the OVC in four of his five years - 2008, 2010, 2011 and 2012 - while finishing second in 2009.

Meade helped lead the Panthers to the 2009 OVC regular season championship and the 2008 OVC Tournament title; the berth in the 2008 NCAA Tournament was just the second in school history.

During his tenure at EIU, Meade saw a number of his pitchers rack up All-OVC accolades in addition to being selected in the MLB Draft. In 2010, Josh Mueller was drafted in the 13th round of the MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies. Tyler Kehrer, who led the OVC in strikeouts and opponent batting average in 2009, became the highest-drafted EIU player since 1988, as he was taken 48th overall by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in Compensation Round A.

Meade joined the coaching staff at EIU following his playing career at Louisville. Meade anchored a pitching staff that helped lead Louisville to an appearance in the 2007 College World Series. The southpaw recorded nine wins and limited opposing batters to a .247 average during the Cardinals' run to the College World Series, and was on the hill for the final out of the Cardinals' victory over Mississippi State in Omaha.

A native of Louisville, Ky., Meade earned his bachelor's degree in sports administration from Louisville in 2007 and completed a master's degree in kinesiology and sports studies (sports management) in the summer of 2009 from EIU.

Meade and his wife, Jesse, have two children, Kasen and Mikah.




