Leading Off

The 98th Season: The 98th season of Southern Miss baseball is underway with the Golden Eagles holding a 10-1 record. Since 1986, the Golden Eagles have 39 winning seasons over the last 40. That span has now also included 38 campaigns of at least 30-win seasons and 16 seasons of at least 40 wins.

Nine-Straight 40 Win Seasons: With now nine-straight 40 win seasons to their credit, the Golden Eagles continue to have the longest current stretch in Division I baseball with 40 or more win campaigns (not including the 2020 season that was cut short due to COVID-19). USM first won 40 games in 1990. Southern Miss set its school record for victories in 2017 with 50.

Finish Tied Second for Wins: The 47 wins compiled in the 2025 campaign tied for the second most victories in school history, tying the 2003 and 2022 seasons. Southern Miss also hosted regionals those two seasons as well. The Golden Eagles also enjoyed their fewest losses in a year since 2017 when they were 50-16 that season.

NCAA Streak: Southern Miss appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the ninth-straight year and 21st time overall in 2025. The Golden Eagles made their first-ever appearance in the postseason in 1990, and also reached regional play in nine-straight seasons from 2003-11 - tying the school's longest consecutive streak. This also became the fourth time Southern Miss had hosted a regional, with the others coming in 2003, 2017 and 2022. Southern Miss also has played host to two super regionals (2022, 2023).

Top 10 Showdown: The game marks the first time since the 2023 NCAA Super Regional - the Golden Eagles played host to Tennessee - which will pit a pair of teams ranked Top 10 nationally at Pete Taylor Park. Southern Miss was No. 9 and Tennessee No. 8 in the Collegiate Baseball Poll (a publication which is no longer in print), while the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association poll had the Volunteers, No. 6, and the Golden Eagles, No. 10.

Oz Gets No. 100: Christian Ostrander registered his 100th victory for the Golden Eagles Sunday afternoon with a 6-2 victory over Louisiana Tech which concluded a three-game sweep of the Bulldogs. He did it in just 137 games in his career. Here is a listing on Golden Eagle head coaches and the number of games it took them to get to 100 wins in their careers – Pete Taylor (1959-83) – 163, Scott Berry (2010-23) – 165, Corky Palmer (1998-2009) – 168 and Hill Denson (1984-1997) – 230.

Since Joining the Sun Belt: The Golden Eagles finished their third Sun Belt regular season in 2025, and now own a 66-24 league record over that time. Southern Miss is 24-6 in SBC league series with 12 sweeps - finishing the 2025 league season by taking all three games from App State, Arkansas State, Louisiana and Troy - while not having been swept over that time. Since 1996, Southern Miss is 175-85 in league weekend series with 91 sweeps, having only been swept 16 times with five split series.

Breaking a Home Run Record: Southern Miss finished the 2025 campaign with a school record 106 home runs. The squad notched at least one round-tripper in 52 contests, going 16-6 when they hit one in a game and 25-5 when they hit two or more in a game. The squad had a streak of 21 straight games of hitting at least one home runs snapped in the regular season finale at Troy. With Ben Higdon's homer in the fourth inning of the 2025 Sun Belt title game, it marked the 96th long ball, helping break the old mark of 95 set in 1997. Southern Miss picked up where they left off last season, hitting 16 home runs through

the first 11 games.

Throwing Them in a Hat: Southern Miss used 36 different lineup combinations during the 2025 campaign and have already used 10 different starting nines to the start of the 2026 season.

Tied for Second Best 11-Game Start: The 2026 squad has registered the second-best tying 11-game start to the season since 1947. The 2004 squad also opened the year 10-1 while the 1995 Golden Eagles opened the year with an 11-0 start. That team opened the season by winning their first 13 games.

Getting Strikeouts: Golden Eagle pitching finished with over 500 strikeouts for the 11th time in 2025, and ended the year with 565, ranking fifth best in school history. Since Christian Ostrander has taken over the program's pitching duties in 2018, the Golden Eagles have gone over 500 strikeouts six times, including a school-record 746 in 2022. He also has both 600-plus strikeout seasons of 654 in 2023 and 602 in 2024. The Golden Eagles have fanned 117 in 96 innings to open this season.

Urban Stays Hot: Joey Urban, the Sun Belt Player of the Week announced on Tuesday, Feb. 24, hit .462 (6x13) with two runs, a triple, a home run and seven RBI, driving in at least one run in all four games last week. He currently leads the team in hitting with a .463 batting average to go along with a team-best four home runs and a club high 16 RBI. He has also drawn a team-best 11 walks. He collected the longest hitting streak of last season for the team at 13 games late in the campaign and since May 4 of last year has hit safely in 24 of his last 27 contests. Since being named SBC Player of the week last Tuesday, Urban hit .471 with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI and also walked six times in four games last week.

Granny Power: The Golden Eagles blasted two grand slams against Alabama (2/24), one by Ben Higdon and one by Kyle Morrison, as Southern Miss defeated the Crimson Tide 14-4 in eight innings. It was the first two grand slam game by the team since Danny Lynch hit a pair versus Louisiana on senior day, May 20, 2023.

The Current Longest Hitting Streak Belongs to: Kyle Morrison currently has the team's longest hitting streak at seven games. He is batting .476 (10x21) with nine runs, two homers and nine RBI. Along with his grand slam against Alabama (2/24), he added a three-run homer in the opener at LA Tech (2/27).

Remembering Corky: For the 2026 season, like the three previous seasons, the Golden Eagle baseball program will continue to honor the legacy of coach Corky Palmer, who passed away in August of 2022. The former Southern Miss catcher (1974-77), and two-time assistant coach, guided the program as head coach from 1998-2009, garnering 458 victories during his tenure. He took the school to its only trip to the College World Series in his final year in 2009. Coach Palmer's number will be stenciled on the baselines at Pete Taylor Park and his seat in the stadium, located on the first-base side, is painted gold. That seat is also numbered as 44.

Walk-Off Victories Since 2017: Since the start of the 2017 season, Southern Miss has enjoyed 35 walk-off victories, including 30 at Pete Taylor Park/Hill Denson Field, two at Keesler Federal Ballpark in Biloxi, one at Alex Box Stadium in Baton Rouge, one at Riverfront Stadium in Montgomery and the latest coming at Dell Diamond in Round Rock, Texas. The latest came when Drey Barrett doubled home Davis Gillespie to beat Purdue 5-4 in the opening game of the Round Rock Classic. Over this span, Matthew Russo holds the most game-winning heroics over this time with four, followed by Matt Wallner (2017-19) and Danny Lynch (2019-23). Bryant Bowen (2017-19), LeeMarcus Boyd (2017-18), Storme Cooper (2016-19), Cole Donaldson (2017-19), Reed Trimble (2020-21), and Davis Gillespie, each have two.

Opening Home Series Draws Series Record Crowds: Over the first three home games of the season against UC Santa Barbara, Southern Miss drew 16,518 fans to Pete Taylor Park. That mark broke an opening weekend attendance record at the facility, besting the previous opening weekend mark of 16,302 drawn for three dates against Lafayette last season. Southern Miss added 5,538 in its home game versus Alabama.

Round Rock Classic: Southern Miss recorded three victories in the Round Rock Classic, defeating Purdue (5-4) on a Drey Barrett walk-off double in the ninth, homering twice with Joey Urban and Davis Gillespie hitting long balls in a 9-4 victory over No. 11 Oregon State, before Seth Smith had three hits and drove in two in a 5-1 victory over Baylor. Urban, Gillespie, reliever Camden Sunstrom and designated hitter Caleb Shelly were named to the all-tournament team.

Southern Miss AD Serves on Baseball Committee: Southern Miss Director of Athletics Jeremy McClain will help determine this year's collegiate baseball tournament field as he currently enjoys his second year of his four-year term appointment on the NCAA Division I Baseball Committee. McClain will be a part of the 10-person committee that selects the annual 64-school tournament field. His four-year tenure on the committee began on Sept. 1, 2024, and continues through Aug. 31, 2028. The NCAA Division I Baseball Committee is responsible for selecting, seeding and bracketing the entire 64-team tournament field, which currently includes the automatic qualification of 30 conference champions with the remainder of the field selected as at-large choices by the committee. The committee also has oversight on the operation of the Division I baseball championship in general. In addition, they discuss and make recommendations regarding legislation regarding sport-specific issues, but the primary role is oversight of the championship.

Did You Know?: Here are some things you might not know about the Golden Eagles:

- Coach Christian Ostrander is one of 39 Division I head coaches entering their third season (Eric Valenzuela is in his second stint at Saint Mary's) and has the most wins over that time of any coach (90) and the second-best winning percentage (.714). He trails only Wes Johnson of Georgia in winning percentage (.717) heading into the 2026 campaign.

- Southern Miss boasts three players whose dads played in the Major Leagues, including Cade Durbin (Chad played for 2008 Philadelphia World Series champions), Jace Norton (Greg) and Seth Smith (Jason).

- The Fall 2025 semester featured the second highest team GPA on record at 3.462, dating back to 2009. It was the 11th consecutive semester of the team recording at least a 3.000 overall GPA and only trails the Spring 2025 semester, in which that total was 3.467.

Attendance Figures: Southern Miss ranked No. 12 nationally in average attendance (5,038), trailing just 10 schools from the Southeastern Conference and one from the Atlantic Coast Conference. The 177,807 overall attendance at Pete Taylor Park ranked No. 13 behind 10 schools from the SEC and two from the ACC.

In two seasons at the helm of guiding the Southern Miss baseball program, Christian Ostrander has done more than any previous Golden Eagle head coach has been able to accomplish over that time.

Ostrander, widely regarded as one of the nation's top pitching coaches in the country, became the 14th head baseball coach at Southern Miss when he was elevated to the Golden Eagles' top spot. Ostrander became only the fifth coach to lead the program since 1959, following Pete Taylor (1959-83), Hill Denson (1984-1997), Corky Palmer (1998-2009) and Scott Berry (2010-2023).

In two seasons, Ostrander has garnered more wins than any of his predecessors over that time - 90 - and has led the program to two NCAA Regional finals.

During the 2025 campaign, Ostrander guided the Golden Eagle baseball program to a 47-16 record, tying the second-most victories at the school for a season. The team went on a school-best winning streak that lasted 18 games, helping them earn their fourth hosting berth of an NCAA Regional in its history. In the process, the Golden Eagles kept their string of consecutive 30-plus win (23) and 40-plus win seasons (9) alive - both of which are the longest in Division I baseball. They also tied their longest consecutive streak of NCAA Tournament appearances at nine, while earning their 21st overall berth.

Southern Miss finished second during the Sun Belt regular season with a 24-6 record, while reaching the league's tournament championship game for the third-straight season. The Golden Eagles fell to Coastal Carolina in the final, 7-5. In addition, he mentored the school's fifth Ferriss Trophy winner, JB Middleton, which also marked the fourth pitcher to win the award from the school.

Middleton, who also earned first team All-America honors, led seven Golden Eagles to make All-Sun Belt honors as he earned a first team nod along with the league's Player of the Year Nick Monistere, Carson Paetow, who also earned the league's Tony Robichaux Leadership Award, and Colby Allen, with Matthew Russo, Ozzie Pratt and Jake Cook collecting second-team honors.

In his first year at the helm, he led the team to a 43-20 record, finishing second in the Sun Belt Conference regular season standings while capturing the league's tournament title. The program won 14 of 15 games heading into the NCAA Tournament. Behind the second longest hitting streak in school history of 36 games, Slade Wilks earned All-America third-team honors by two different organizations, while also adding a first-team Academic All-America nod.

The Golden Eagles had five players named all-conference including Wilks and pitcher Billy Oldham, collecting first-team honors. Pitcher Niko Mazza, shortstop Ozzie Pratt and outfielder Dalton McIntyre all collected second team honors.

Before taking the top job, Ostrander served as the associate head coach for the previous two seasons and had been with the program for six years overall overseeing the pitching staff for the Golden Eagles.

During his time as an assistant, Ostrander helped lead the Golden Eagles to five NCAA regional berths, mentoring one National Pitcher of the Year, two Dick Howser and Golden Spikes national semifinalists, two Ferriss Trophy winners for top player in the state of Mississippi, five different All-Americans, one Freshman All-American and four conference Pitchers of the Year in Nick Sandlin (2018), Walker Powell (2021) and Tanner Hall (2022, 2023), who did it twice. For the third time in its CUSA history, the program enjoyed three first-team pitchers in 2022.

In 2022, Ostrander was also named the CUSA Assistant Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season, helping him become the only coach to win that award twice in its history.

Despite losing 12 pitchers off the previous year's roster, Ostrander helped assemble another outstanding staff in 2023 that helped the Golden Eagles win 46 games. Led by Hall, who posted a 12-4 record, Southern Miss led the Sun Belt in earned run average (4.51), opposing batting average (.240), innings pitched (580 1/3), strikeouts (654) and wins (46). They also were second in saves (19).

In 2022, Ostrander also earned CUSA Assistant Coach of the Year honors for the second consecutive season as the Golden Eagles finished with a school record 746 strikeouts, besting the previous top total by 163. The Golden Eagles also ranked No. 2 nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.12), WHIP (1.16), strikeouts per nine innings (11.3) and ERA (3.29). No. 3 in walks per nine innings (2.73), No. 4 in shutouts (8) and No. in hits allowed by nine innings (7.73).

The year, which had the Golden Eagles reach the NCAA Super Regionals, saw the program register its first season since 1993 with two pitchers reaching 100 strikeouts during the year.

The success of 2022 came on the heels of being ranked No. 1 nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.06), No. 2 in walks per 9 innings (2.24), No. 3 in shutouts (8), No. 6 in WHIP (1.17) and 20th in earned run average (3.74). His top two starting pitchers, Hunter Stanley and Walker Powell, each merited All-American accolades in 2021.

The Golden Eagles led the league in ERA, opposing batting average (.236) and batters struck out (560). They also finished second in the conference by allowing just 138 walks, which was the fewest given up by the squad since allowing 137 in 1982.

Under his tutelage, the Golden Eagles posted their second no-hitter in the last three seasons in 2021 when Powell blanked Middle Tennessee on May 8, and the team's strikeout total last spring (560) was the second most in school history.

Despite the shortened season in 2020, the Golden Eagle pitching staff performed well as Ostrander blended some veteran leadership pitching along with a bunch of newcomers. The results encompassed a 12-4 record by the squad that saw the pitching staff post 172 strikeouts with only 46 walks in 140 1/3 innings. That year also saw Ostrander's group enjoy some accolades as reliever Stanley earned third-team

All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball, while the publication also tabbed Ben Ethridge a Freshman All-America selection.

In his second year with the program in 2019, Ostrander oversaw a pitching squad that posted the school's fourth-straight 40-win season. Entering the year, he had to retool a pitching staff that suffered the loss of the previous year's Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Year, Nick Sandlin.

Still, he mentored Powell into becoming a first-team All-Conference USA selection, who also earned three CUSA weekly awards during the year as well as a spot on the league's all-tournament team. Redshirt freshman Gabe Shepard also garnered a spot on the CUSA all-tournament team by throwing seven innings in the school's first no-hitter since 2004. Shepard, along with two Golden Eagles, blanked Rice 6-0 to help the Golden Eagles advance to the championship game for the fourth consecutive year. The pitching staff threw seven shutouts during the year and enjoyed 479 strikeouts from the staff against just 207 walks during the campaign.

In his first year with the program, Ostrander overcame losing four starting pitchers from the previous season and made great strides with the Golden Eagle pitching staff.

One of the biggest moves in his first season in 2018, was switching Sandlin, a relief pitcher up until that point, into a starter and he oversaw his progress to being the CUSA Pitcher of the Year, the 2018 Ferriss Trophy winner and a second-round draft pick to Cleveland.

Ostrander's success cannot solely be tied to Sandlin's success. In addition, Southern Miss posted a 3.70 earned run average which was the lowest team ERA in three seasons while putting together eight shutouts and limiting opponents to just 152 walks. The walks surrendered were the fewest since allowing just 137 in 1982. The program finished in the Top 10 nationally in three different categories: second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.40), third in shutouts and fourth in walks allowed per nine innings (2.49). In addition, the staff enjoyed 27 quality starts.

Ostrander came to Southern Miss after spending the two seasons at Louisiana Tech as their associate head coach and pitching coach. During those two years, the Bulldogs posted a 78-40 record and went to an NCAA Tournament. Serving as the pitching coach for Louisiana Tech, Ostrander's pitching staff shattered the record books leading the Bulldogs to 42 wins his initial season - the most for any LA Tech team since 1988. Under the guidance of Ostrander, four Bulldog pitchers (Adam Atkins, Braden Bristol, Phillip Diehl and Nate Harris) were selected in the last two Major League Baseball First-Year Player Drafts.

In 2016, LA Tech's pitching staff recorded a school-record 496 strikeouts, besting the previous school-record of 452 which was set twice. Of the 42 Bulldog wins, which ranked first in CUSA, 10 wins were over top 25 schools, and 11 wins were over top 50 RPI schools.

Prior to LA Tech, Ostrander spent seven years as the head coach at Jones County Junior College in Ellsville. In addition to his head coaching duties at JCJC, Ostrander oversaw the pitching staff.

Ostrander led the Bobcats to two MACJC state championships in 2011 and 2014 and helped guide Jones County to four division titles in seven years. He also led JCJC to two 40-win seasons and set the school record for wins in a season on four separate occasions. In seven seasons at Jones County, Ostrander compiled a 255-109 overall record with the Bobcats, good for a .701 winning percentage.

In 2015, Ostrander and the Bobcats put together a successful season with Jones County posting 30 wins with an appearance in the MACJC State Playoffs for the seventh consecutive season.

In 2014, JCJC enjoyed enormous success with a 46-11 record and a No. 6 ranking in the final NJCAA Division II poll. The 46 wins by the Bobcats matched the single season record for victories in a season. The Bobcats were ranked No. 1 in the nation for most of the season and captured the 2014 state title at the end of the campaign. That season, JCJC led MACJC and Region 23 and were ranked seventh in the nation with a 2.92 team ERA.

Ostrander led the team to a second-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series in 2011. The 2011 Bobcats posted a 46-17 record, won the MACJC state championship and its first ever Region 23 title. In his first season at JCJC, Ostrander led the Bobcats to a 36-16 overall record, a third-place finish in the MACJC South Division and a berth in the MACJC State Tournament. It marked the first time the Bobcats advanced to postseason play since winning a state title in 2002.

A year later, Ostrander led the Bobcats to their first-ever MACJC South Division regular season title, a 38-12 record and the host role in the MACJC State Tournament. Prior to his stint at Jones County, Ostrander previously served as recruiting coordinator and pitching coach at Arkansas State from 2002-06 and led Gulfport High School to the Class 5A playoffs in two seasons as the head coach for the Admirals.

Ostrander also served the pitching coach, recruiting coordinator and camp coordinator at Delta State from 1999-2002. DSU posted a 189-43 record during his four seasons, winning the Gulf South Conference West Division championship all four years and the South Regional championship in 2001 and 2002. In his final two seasons at Delta State, the Statesmen competed in the Division II College World Series in both 2001 and 2002.

He earned a bachelor's degree in education from Delta State in 1996 and his master's of education in administration from DSU in 1998. Ostrander has been a member of the American Baseball Coaches Association since 1998.

In the fall of 2019, Ostrander earned induction into the Jones College Hall of Fame.

Ostrander is a native of Monroe, La. He and his wife, Amy, have two daughters, Caitlin and Allie.
