LEADING OFF

- ◆ Jackson State is in the midst of an eight-game road swing that started at the beginning of March with a trip to New Orleans. The road swing has covered a 6,932 round trip, including today's game against Mississippi State.
- ◆ Today's game was originally scheduled for a 6 p.m. first pitch, however, due to the winter weather hitting the state of Mississippi this week, the first pitch was moved to 4 p.m. to avoid colder temperatures during the evening hours.
- ◆ **Omar Johnson** coached for USA Baseball in the 2025 Collegiate National Team Training Camp. The staff was split into two teams – Stars and Stripes – for its annual Stars vs. Stripes series, which was held June 29 to July 3 at various locations across North Carolina. Following Training Camp, which featured 56 of the premier non-draft-eligible collegiate players in the country, the Stars staff led Team USA at the 45th USA vs. Japan Collegiate All-Star Championship Series from July 8-13 at various venues across Japan. The Stripes staff guided select players on a Collegiate National Team Prospects squad in a Fourth of July match-up with the Appalachian League Select Team in Kannapolis, North Carolina.
- ◆ **Wilbert Perez** was named Preseason First Team All-Conference by the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). However, the power hitting first baseman missed the first 19 games of the season before returning against Texas Southern in Houston, playing in two games.
- ◆ **Tyree Reed** is leading the team in hitting through the first 21 games, hitting .400 while also finding himself in the midst of a 12-game hitting streak.
- ◆ Junior **Diego Melendez** is one of 100 shortstops featured on the 2026 watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, which was released Wednesday by the College Baseball Foundation. The award honors the nation's top shortstop and will be presented by the College Baseball Foundation later this year. It is named for former Texas Tech shortstop Brooks Wallace, who played for the Red Raiders from 1977 to 1980. Wallace died of leukemia at the age of 27. The top 100 shortstops in the country are led by several players putting up tremendous offensive numbers. But because the award is reflective of more than just offense, there are numerous players putting up solid defensive numbers as well.
- ◆ **Omar Johnson** reached 600 career victories when Jackson State defeated Mississippi Valley State. He now stands at 605 victories at Jackson State, trailing on Robert "Bob" Braddy who finished his career with 823 wins.
- ◆ Mississippi State will be the highest-ranked team on Jackson State's schedule this year.

MELENDEZ NAMED TO BROOKS WALLACE AWARD WATCH LIST

Junior **Diego Melendez** is one of 100 shortstops featured on the 2026 watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, which was released Wednesday by the College Baseball Foundation.

The award honors the nation's top shortstop and will be presented by the College Baseball Foundation later this year. It is named for former Texas Tech shortstop Brooks Wallace, who played for the Red Raiders from 1977 to 1980. Wallace died of leukemia at the age of 27. The top 100 shortstops in the country were announced Wednesday, led by several players putting up tremendous offensive numbers. But because the award is reflective of more than just offense, there are numerous players putting up solid defensive numbers as well.

The Brooks Wallace Award is one of four weekly awards presented by the College Baseball Foundation. The CBF also awards the John Olerud Two-Way Player, National Pitcher and Buster Posey Collegiate Catcher of the Week.

FORMER TIGER, EARL SANDERS, NAMED TO COLLEGE BASEBALL HALL OF FAME

Jackson State's **Earl Sanders** was inducted into the College Baseball Hall of Fame the day before Opening Day as part of the 2025 class. The 18th induction class will be honored Thursday at the 2026 Night of Champions in Overland Park, Kansas, the home of the College Baseball Hall of Fame. The event will serve as the ceremonial start to the 2026 college baseball season. Each year, more than 200 representatives nationwide vote on the College Baseball Hall of Fame induction class. The voting body is comprised of national and regional college baseball media, active and retired coaches, former players, former inductees, college baseball historians and members of the Society for American Baseball Research (SABR) collegiate baseball committee.

Sanders starred at Jackson State for three years before he was drafted in the first round of the 1986 Major League Baseball Draft by the Toronto Blue Jays. While at Jackson State, Sanders was named the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Hitter of the Year and the Pitcher of the Year. Before he was drafted, Sanders hit .432 with 17 homers and 60 RBI in 1986 leading the team to the NCAA Regionals hosted by LSU and a SWAC championship.

He becomes the second selection from Jackson State, joining former head coach **Robert Braddy** who was inducted in 2016.

PEREZ NAMED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE, TIGERS PICKED FIFTH

Senior first baseman **Wilbert Perez** was named Preseason First Team All-Conference by the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC), while the Tigers were picked to finish fifth announced by the conference. Perez finished 2025 hitting .324 in 49 games, finishing the season with 60 hits in 185 official at-bats. He also collected 12 doubles, one triple, and eight home runs; while recording a .945 OPS. The senior also scored 32 runs and knocked in another 48, all while recording a slugging percentage of .530 and an on-base percentage of .415. He also walked 19 times, was hit by a pitch 11 times, and recorded five stolen bases.

Meanwhile, Jackson State was picked to finish fifth in the conference preseason poll with 141 points, and was picked to finish behind defending champion Bethune-Cookman (209), Florida A&M (185), Alabama State (178), and Grambling State (143).

TIGERS RETURN THEIR ENTIRE INFIELD FOR 2026

Jackson State (30-21 last season) returns several pieces offensively for the 2026 season including preseason All-Conference selection **Wilbert Perez** (.324/.945/.530/.415) at first base. The senior returns after collecting 60 hits in his first season at Jackson State including 12 doubles, one triple, and eight home runs. He also scored 32 runs and knocked in a team-high 48. He is joined by returning second baseman **Ledy Alvarez** (.309/.790/.383/.407) who finished the season with 10 extra base hits and 42 runs scored; while **Tyson Patty** (.276/.794/.382/.412) returns at third base after a year that he collected eight extra base hits and scored 36 runs.

Robert Tate Jr. (.269/.723/.369/.354) returns for his third season at shortstop after collecting 10 extra base hits in 34 games last season, while also scoring 27 runs and was perfect in stolen bases with eight. A pair of student-athletes return at catcher including **Hederick Torres** (.346/.847/.408/.439) who finished with 29 runs scored last season, and **Pierre Cabral** (.273/.799/.414/.385) - who also doubles as a designated hitter.

JOHNSON REACHES 600 VICTORIES, WITH WIN LAST SEASON

Omar Johnson reached 600 career victories when Jackson State defeated Mississippi Valley State. He now stands at 605 victories at Jackson State, trailing on Robert "Bob" Braddy who finished his career with 823 wins.

FIRST HOME GAME

Jackson State opened the season with a pair of tournaments - MLB HBCU Power Series (Pearl, Miss.) and the Andre Dawson Classic (Vero Beach, Fla.) - before playing its first home game of the season, a doubleheader against Tougaloo (Feb. 24). The Tigers will play 10 home series this season.

AN EIGHT GAME ROAD SWING ENDS TODAY

Jackson State ends its eight game road swing tonight against No. 3 Mississippi State, a road swing that started on March 3 in New Orleans, and included stops in Seattle, at Nicholls, and in Houston to face Texas Southern. The Tigers are 3-4 during the swing with a pair of wins over Seattle and one over Texas Southern.

HIGHEST-RANKED TEAM TO DATE

Today's game against No. 3 Mississippi State will be the highest ranked opponent the Tigers will have faced this season after dropping a game to then-No. 16 Ole Miss on the road.

IN-STATE FOES

Jackson State has already face have already faced four in-state foes heading into this matchup, having played Alcorn State, Mississippi Valley State, Tougaloo, and Ole Miss. The Tigers are 3-3 against those opponents with a win over Alcorn State and a pair over Tougaloo.

EXPLOSIVE NIGHT FOR THE TIGERS IN FEBRUARY

Jackson State combined for 34 runs in a doubleheader sweep of Tougaloo and held the Bulldogs to four hits in the two games including a combined no-hitter by four Jackson State pitchers in the nightcap.

Jackson State won game one, 19-1, and followed that up with a 15-3 victory in the nightcap at Braddy Field.

Kade Walker (1-1) earned the win in the opener, working the first three innings allowing just one run on a pair of hits with three strikeouts. Kevin De Los Santos came on for 3.0 innings in relief allowing one hit, before Corey Richardson came on for the seventh. At the plate, the Tigers pounded out 20 hits led by Robert Tate Jr. and Troy Wilson Jr. each picking up four hits, with Tate picking up three RBI from the leadoff spot and Wilson knocking in five RBI from the ninth spot. Meanwhile, Payton Boines finished 3-for-4.

In the nightcap, Jayden Lopez (1-0) picked up the win for Jackson State (5-4) working the first 4.0 innings with six strikeouts and allowed one run. He gave way to Talmadge Davis who worked the fifth, Darius Dampier the sixth, and Caleb Gallant the seventh to combine on the no-hitter. At the plate, Jackson State collected 12 hits led by Pierre Cabral who went 3-for-4 with four RBI, while Tyree Reed and Boines each picked up a pair of hits in the win.

PUTTING UP RUNS

Jackson State is putting runs on the board, having scored 160 runs so far this season, averaging 7.6 runs per game through the first 21 games this season. The Tigers have scored double digit runs five times this season including 17 against Texas Southern on the road in their last game. In that game, Jackson State scored 10 runs combined in the eighth and ninth innings to rally for a 17-12 victory over Texas Southern at MacGregor field in Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) action.

Jackson State (10-11, 1-2 SWAC) trailed 12-7 through seven before erupting for five runs in the top of the eighth inning with two of its five home runs including a two-run home run by Tyshon Patty before Tyree Reed added a solo shot. They were able to take the lead in the top of the ninth inning with a triple by Robert Tate Jr., a bunt single from Reed, and a home run by Pierre Cabral. The Tigers collected 16 hits including a pair of home runs from Tate and Patty, while Reed and Cabral each hit one.

TEAM NOTES

PEREZ RETURNS TO ACTION FOR THE FIRST TIME THIS SEASON

Wilbert Perez returned to the lineup for the first time this season over the weekend in Houston against Texas Southern after missing the first 19 games of the season. The senior first baseman finished 3-for-10 in the series, including going 2-for-5 in his first game on Saturday.

Year after year, Omar Johnson continues to make Jackson State baseball one of the top programs in the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

Since taking the helm of the program prior to the 2007 season, Johnson has led JSU baseball to a winning season every year with 15 30-win campaigns in 17 seasons. In 2022, Johnson earned his 500th win as JSU head coach, joining former JSU head coach and former Athletics Director Robert "Bob" Braddy as the only coaches in program history to surpass 200, 300, 400, and 500 wins. He followed that up with his 600th win during the 2025 season. Under Johnson's leadership, Jackson State has finished with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or better every season.

The current Dean of Southwestern Athletic Conference baseball coaches at one school in his 20th season, Johnson's Tigers have averaged nearly 32 wins per season, winning seven SWAC Eastern Division titles and two SWAC Championships.

In his first season at the helm of the Tigers program (2007), Johnson posted a 33-23 record, the first of four consecutive 30-win seasons. The following season, 2008, his Tigers recorded 37 wins, at the time the fourth-highest single-season total in program history. During the 2009 season, Johnson became the first JSU baseball coach to reach the 100-win plateau within his first three years.

Johnson led JSU to another string of 30+plus win seasons, as the Tigers posted eight consecutive 30-win seasons from 2012-19. Johnson captured back-to-back Southwestern Athletic Conference titles in 2013 and 2014, going undefeated in the conference tournament and earning NCAA Tournament berths after each title.

During the 2014 NCAA Tournament, JSU knocked off the No. 1 ranked Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns 1-0 to mark the programs' and Jackson State's first Division I NCAA postseason win and the program's first victory over a No. 1 ranked NCAA team. In 2018, Johnson led JSU to 38 wins, tied for the third highest win single-season win total in program history (52 - 1978; 42 - 1977; 38 - 1981).

In 2021, JSU baseball was ranked the No. 1 team in Black College Nines (BCN) HBCU Baseball large school top ten poll and received votes in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Top 30 poll. Jackson State became only the second conference baseball team to go 24-0 in SWAC play, advancing to the SWAC Tournament finals and finishing the season 34-9.

During the 2022 season, Johnson led the Tigers on the brink of another 30 win season. On April 23, 2022, Johnson posted his 500th career win in a victory of Alabama State. Last season, despite finishing fourth in the East Division, Jackson State made a run in the conference tournament and finished as the runner-up in the tournament with a 36-20 regular season record.

Prior to coaching at Jackson State, Johnson worked at the University of North Alabama for four years. In 1999, for the first time in university history, the University of North Alabama won the South Central Regional Championship and appeared in the 1999 NCAA II College World Series. In 2008-2010, Johnson served on the German national team coaching staff, competing in the World Baseball Challenge, World Cup, and European baseball championship, where he received a bronze medal. In 35 years of international competition, this was the first time the German national team placed and in the WBC defeating team USA. Johnson has had the privilege of coaching numerous players who have played professional baseball.

In the summer of 2004, Johnson traveled to serve as a coach with Major League Baseball Envoy program. The Envoy Program sends baseball coaches to teach the fundamentals of the game to players and coaches in countries throughout the world. Johnson says his mission as a head coach is twofold: 1) to win games and 2) to prepare young men to contribute to their families and society positively.

Johnson and his beautiful wife, Kira, have been married for 18 years. They have one lovely daughter, Olivia.
