Top Five Showdown In Starkville Begins Thursday Night

Georgia (24-6, 7-2 SEC), ranked as high as No. 4 in the national polls this week, travels to Starkville, Miss., for a top five showdown with No. 5 MSU (25-4, 7-2 SEC). Georgia, MSU and Texas are tri-leaders in the SEC at 7-2. Thursday's first pitch will be at 7 pm ET and be available on the SECN+ and the Georgia Bulldog Sports Network.

MSU is 18-0 at home this year and just swept No. 18 Ole Miss in Oxford and posted a run-rule win over Grambling this past Tuesday in Starkville. MSU leads the Georgia series 52-48 dating to 1916. Under Ike Cousins head baseball coach Wes Johnson, Georgia is 1-2 against MSU after visiting Dudy-Noble Field in 2024. Prior to that, Georgia won a series in Athens 2-1 in 2022. The teams did not face each other in 2023.

Georgia is coming off an SEC sweep of South Carolina in Athens, and a thrilling 14-9 win over Ga. State that featured an eight-run eighth after the Panthers had struck for six in the top half of the frame. With the sweep, Georgia claimed a series lead over USC at 72-71 that dates to 1896. The Bulldogs surged ahead thanks to a pair of sweeps in the past two series (2024 in Columbia).

In its first SEC roadtrip this year, the Bulldogs went to No. 21 Texas A&M and registered their first ever series win in College Station (2-1). The Aggies were 14-0 at home before the series with the Bulldogs. Georgia hit .283 with 11 home runs during the Texas A&M series. Georgia opened SEC play with a 2-1 series win over No. 21 Tennessee in Athens.

Georgia Leads Nation In Home Runs And Slugging Percentage

Georgia has an NCAA-leading 87 Home Runs and .649 SLG% plus is fifth in Fielding (.986). Also, the Bulldogs rank fourth in runs (289), fifth in OB% (.456), 10th in HPB (69) and ninth in scoring per game (9.6) and batting average (.326). MSU is batting .336 with 47 home runs and fielding .981. They average 9.8 runs per game.

Georgia junior C **Daniel Jackson** leads the team with 16 home runs (including three grand slams) followed by senior SS **Kolby Branch** with 13, junior 3B **Tre Phelps** with 12 and senior 1B/C **Brennan Hudson** with 11. Branch ranks tied for seventh in Georgia history with 43 home runs and has 49 for his career counting the six he had for Baylor in 2023.

*Georgia is averaging an NCAA-leading 2.90 Home Runs per Game (HR/G) in 2026. The 2025 squad averaged 2.40 HR/G while the 2024 team averaged 2.52 HR/G. Georgia's past two squads ranked 1-2 in school history in HR. Last season, the Bulldogs had a school-record eight players with double-digit HR as the team finished with 144. In 2024 when Georgia set a school mark with 151 HR, the Bulldogs had six players with 10+ HR including an NCAA-best 37 by Golden Spikes Award winner Charlie Condon who was the third overall pick in the MLB Draft that year (Colorado Rockies).

This past Sunday marked Georgia's first game of the season that it didn't hit a home run, and it still won 9-7. The last time Georgia scored at least nine runs in a win without a home run came in 2024, a 10-0 run-rule in seven innings over UNC Asheville.

With their penchant for home runs, the Bulldogs are 1-0 without one, 1-3 when they hit just one big fly this season and 22-3 when they hit two or more. In 2025, Georgia was 2-4 when it didn't homer, 9-6 when it had just one and 32-7 with two or more. In 2024, the Bulldogs were 2-6 without hitting one, 6-3 when they had only one and 35-8 when they smashed two or more.

*The Bulldog trio of **Caden Aoki**, **Matt Scott** and **Justin Byrd** have been elite in SEC action. Aoki is 0-0, 0.90 ERA in 10 IP, Scott is 3-0, 1.50 ERA in 12 IP and Byrd is 2-1, 2.19 ERA, 2 SV in 12.1 IP. *MSU has a 3.14 ERA with 329 strikeouts and 94 walks. Opponents are hitting .205.

Jackson Named To Midseason Player of the Year Watch Lists

*Junior C **Daniel Jackson** (.412-16-47, 14 SB) ranks in the top 10 nationally in Home Runs, SLG% (.904), RBI (47) and Total Bases (103). He delivered a grand slam in last Friday's win over USC plus clutch RBI-hits in Sunday's series sweep. He posted a .545 mark (6-for-11) and seven RBI in the USC series. Earlier this year, he had a career-best 21-game hitting streak.

*Junior 3B **Tre Phelps** (.423-12-31) ranks fifth nationally in hit-by-pitches (20) and sixth in runs scored (43). Against USC, he batted a team-best .556 (5-for-9) with five runs scored, three HBP and two late defensive highlights to preserve Bulldog leads. He was 3-for-4, 2 HRs, 4 RBI Tuesday.

All home games during the regular season will have a video stream via the SECN+ and ESPN+ platforms. Matt Stewart and Jason Jacobs return again to call the action for games not televised on linear TV.

Wes JOHNSON

*Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach
 3rd Season at UGA
 (Arkansas Monticello '94)*

CURRENT RECORD: 110-40 (42-27 SEC)

In his first two seasons directing the University of Georgia baseball program, Wes Johnson has led the Bulldogs to 86 wins and a pair of NCAA Tournaments as a national top eight seed. On May 21, 2025, it was announced UGA and Johnson had agreed to a contract extension through 2031.

Johnson, a renowned pitching coach, was named the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 5, 2023. At the press conference announcing his hire, UGA's J. Reid Parker Director of Athletic Josh Brooks noted Johnson had a proven track record of developing student-athletes and that his teams at every level had achieved impressive results. Brooks added he was confident Johnson would make Georgia Baseball one of the premier programs in the country.

Johnson made an immediate impact. In his first year, he directed the Bulldogs to their most successful season since reaching the College World Series (CWS) Finals in 2008. The 2024 Bulldogs earned a No. 7 National Seed for the NCAA Tournament, captured the NCAA Athens Regional, hosted an NCAA Super Regional and came within one game of reaching the CWS.

Georgia posted a 43-17 record (17-13 SEC) as Johnson established school records for most overall wins and most SEC wins by a first-year baseball coach, and Georgia finished with a top 10 national ranking for the first time in a full season since 2008. He became the first Georgia baseball coach to host and win an NCAA Regional in his first season along with serving as a Super Regional host. In a preseason poll, SEC coaches projected Georgia would finish sixth in the Eastern Division and instead the Bulldogs placed third and had the fifth best mark in the 14-team league.

In 2024, Georgia featured one of the nation's elite players in All-America Charlie Condon, a first round selection of the Colorado Rockies and the third overall pick in the MLB Draft, the highest in school history. He earned the Dick Howser Trophy, which is widely considered the Heisman Trophy of college baseball, and USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award as the nation's top amateur player. Condon received a then record \$9.25 million signing bonus. Also, sophomore Kolten Smith and freshman Tre Phelps received invitations to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp. Corey Collins joined Condon as an All-American and became the first SEC player to lead the NCAA in on base percentage, posting a .574 mark.

In 2025, Georgia raced out to another impressive start that featured a 17-game winning streak and a program-best 28-2 mark through 30 games. The Bulldogs were a consensus top 10 ranked team, including reaching as high as No. 1 during the season. They captured seven SEC series in going 18-12 in league play and entered the NCAA Tournament with the nation's No. 2 RPI and the No. 7 overall national seed. The Bulldogs played host to their second straight NCAA Regional and concluded the season with a 43-17 mark. The Bulldogs blasted an NCAA-best 144 home runs and finished second nationally in On Base Percentage at .411. A total of 10 Bulldogs were selected in the 2025 MLB Draft.

For the second consecutive season, the Bulldog pitching staff established a school record for strikeouts and lowered the team ERA. Also, the Bulldogs set a school record with a .983 fielding percentage. Robbie Burnett and Ryland Zaborowski were named semifinalists for the Dick Howser Trophy plus Burnett was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Trophy. Four Bulldogs earned All-SEC honors in first team third baseman Slate Alford and second team pitcher Brian Curley plus Burnett (outfield) and Zaborowski (utility). For the second year in a row, Georgia produced the SEC batting champion as Zaborowski hit .370 after Condon led the SEC and NCAA in 2024 with a .443 clip. Five Bulldogs made the CSC Academic All-District team including Burnett who became the first Bulldog to be named a first team Academic All-American.

*Georgia is in its third season under the leadership of Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Wes Johnson**. He became the fastest in school history to reach 100 baseball wins, needing just 137 games. David Perno is the only other UGA baseball coach to earn 100 wins in his third season in 2004 (175th game).

*Georgia's 2026 roster has 15 returnees, five freshmen, one hitter from junior college and 20 players from the portal. Georgia had 17 players from 2025 sign pro contracts including 10 draft picks.

Excellent Progress In The Johnson Era

Georgia has made an impressive jump in its performance at the plate and on the mound era with the arrival of **Wes Johnson** and his staff in 2024. Johnson serves as the the pitching coach while assistant head coach **Will Coggin** and **Nick Ammirati** direct the offense and **Brock Bennett** is the recruiting coordinator. Georgia has posted strong starts and kept that momentum going into SEC play. In 2025, Georgia entered conference with a 19-1 mark and on a 16-game winning streak. In 2024, the Bulldogs were 17-1 when SEC play began. Both teams finished 43-17. In 2026, Georgia was 15-3 at the start of SEC.
