### SEC Champions Back In Action Thursday At SEC Tournament

\*SEC Champion Georgia (43-12, 23-7 SEC), ranked as high as No. 4 nationally, enters the SEC Tournament as the top seed with a double bye to Thursday's quarterfinals.

\*Georgia became the first school in SEC history to win all five of its road series against top 25 foes, beating No. 4 Auburn, No. 5 Miss. State, #14 Arkansas, #17 Ole Miss and #21 Texas A&M.

\*The Bulldogs clinched the SEC title in week nine and won the league by 3.5 games. The 23 wins for a champion ranks as the fourth best in SEC history since 1996 when the league went to 30 games

\*Georgia set a school record with 23 SEC wins, going 12-3 at home and 11-4 on the road.

\*While Georgia's firepower is well documented, it's worth noting that the Bulldogs won 10 SEC games when it held their opponent to a pair of runs or less.

\*Georgia's 43 regular season wins is a school record for a 56-game slate. The only Bulldog squad to post more came by the 1990 national champions that entered the postseason 44-15 and went 52-19.

\*SEC Tournament History: Georgia is 31-52 at the event, and it's best finish is second in 1985, 1986 and 1989. Georgia's last win in Hoover came in 2021 when it beat LSU 4-1 and went 1-2.

\*Georgia's quarterfinal opponent will be either No. 8 seed MSU, No. 9 seed Ole Miss or No. 16 seed Missouri. This season, Georgia went 3-0 at MSU, 2-1 at Ole Miss and 3-0 versus Missouri in Athens.

### Georgia's SEC Road Series Firsts This Season

\*First Series win at #4 Auburn since 2019; 2nd top five series win of the season

\*Swept #5 MSU for the first time since 2004 and first-ever top 5 SEC road sweep in school history.

\*First Series win ever at #21 Texas A&M (Bulldogs were 2-10 all-time there since 2013)

\*First Series win at #14 Arkansas since 2008 (Bulldogs were 2-10 there since 2010)

\*First Series win at #17 Ole Miss since 2011

### Bulldogs Lead Nation In Home Runs And SEC In Batting Average

\*Georgia leads the NCAA with 147 Home Runs and ranks second with a .621 Slugging Percentage and fourth in Scoring at 9.4 runs/game. The Bulldogs have an SEC-best .325 Batting Average that ranks fourth nationally. Also, Georgia has a .983 Fielding Percentage, which is seventh nationally.

\*Georgia is averaging an NCAA-leading 2.67 Home Runs per Game (HR/G). The 2024 team averaged 2.52 HR/G when it set a school record with 151 home runs.

\*Georgia's first game in 2026 that it didn't hit a home run came on March 29th against USC, and it still won 9-7. Before that, the last time Georgia scored at least nine in a win without a home run came in 2024, a 10-0 (7inn./rr) over UNC Asheville.

### Daniel Jackson Joins Elite 25-25 Club, Aims For 30-30

\*Georgia junior catcher **Daniel Jackson**, a National Player of the Year candidate, is one of just six players (and first catcher) in NCAA Division 1 history to have 25 home runs and 25 stolen bases in a season. J.D. Drew (FSU) is the only D1 player to ever have a 30-30 season when he posted a 31HR-32SB year in 1997. Jackson is the first SEC player to have a 25-25 season. Also, note Farleigh Dickinson sophomore OF Hunter Ray has 28 HR and 24 SB this year.

### All-SEC Trio of Jackson, Phelps and Lujo Headline Offense

\*Junior All-SEC C **Daniel Jackson** (.394-27-77, 25 SB) ranks in the top five nationally in Home Runs (27), Total Bases (178), RBI (77), Slugging Percentage (.836) and Runs Scored (74). He is a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award, the Dick Howser Trophy and the Buster Posey Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award. In SEC action, Jackson batted .392-11-33. Jackson has been named the SEC Player of the Year and 1st Team All-SEC by the league coaches. Jackson could become the third straight Bulldog to lead the SEC in batting, joining Charlie Condon (.433 in '24) and Ryland Zaborowski (.370 in '25). The only schools to do that in SEC history are Tennessee (1974-76) and Auburn (1988-90).

\*All-SEC junior 3B **Tre Phelps** (.372-18-53), a semifinalist for the Dick Howser Trophy, bats leadoff with a .490 on base percentage and ranks second in the nation with a school record 30 Hit-By-Pitches.

\*Sophomore All-SEC CF **Rylan Lujo** (.359-9-37) led the league with a .394 batting average in SEC games, and he had a .661 slugging percentage in SEC action too.

### Pitching Plans: TBA

\*Georgia's SEC rotation during the regular season featured junior right-handers **Joey Volchko** (8-2, 4.22 EA) and **Dylan Vigue** (4-1, 3.57 ERA) in the first two games while the game three starter of late has been graduate right-hander **Caden Aoki** (8-1, 4.12 ERA, 3 SV). The top relievers have been senior RHP **Matt Scott** (6-0, 3.86 ERA, 4 SV), redshirt sophomore RHP **Paul Farley** (7-1, 4.99 ERA, 1 SV), redshirt junior RHP **Justin Byrd** (3-2, 4.56 ERA, 6 SV) and junior RHP **Zach Brown** (2-0, 3.30 ERA, 1 SV).

\*Georgia's team ERA is 5.05 with 570 strikeouts and 245 walks in 467.1 innings. Opponents are hitting .243 against the Bulldogs.

## Wes JOHNSON

*Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach  
 3rd Season at UGA  
 (Arkansas Monticello '94)*



In year three of the Wes Johnson era, the Bulldogs are SEC Champions for the first time since 2008, a consensus top five team, and on track to be a national top eight seed for the third straight year. He earned 2026 SEC Coach of the Year honors after the league coaches predicted Georgia to finish ninth.

In his first two seasons at the helm, Johnson led the Bulldogs to a combined 86 wins and a pair of NCAA Tournaments as a national top eight seed. On May 21, 2025, it was announced UGA and Johnson had agreed to a contract extension through 2031.

Johnson, a renowned pitching coach, was named the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 5, 2023. At the press conference announcing his hire, UGA's J. Reid Parker Director of Athletic Josh Brooks noted Johnson had a proven track record of developing student-athletes and that his teams at every level had achieved impressive results. Brooks added he was confident Johnson would make Georgia Baseball one of the premier programs in the country.

Johnson made an immediate impact. In his first year, he directed the Bulldogs to their most successful season since reaching the College World Series (CWS) Finals in 2008. The 2024 Bulldogs earned a No. 7 National Seed for the NCAA Tournament, captured the NCAA Athens Regional, hosted an NCAA Super Regional and came within one game of reaching the CWS.

Georgia posted a 43-17 record (17-13 SEC) as Johnson established school records for most overall wins and most SEC wins by a first-year baseball coach, and Georgia finished with a top 10 national ranking for the first time in a full season since 2008. He became the first Georgia baseball coach to host and win an NCAA Regional in his first season along with serving as a Super Regional host. In a preseason poll, SEC coaches projected Georgia to finish sixth in the Eastern Division and instead the Bulldogs placed third and had the fifth best mark in the 14-team league.

In 2024, Georgia featured one of the nation's elite players in All-American Charlie Condon, a first round selection of the Colorado Rockies and the third overall pick in the MLB Draft, the highest in school history. He earned the Dick Howser Trophy, and USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award as the nation's top amateur player. Condon received a then record \$9.25 million signing bonus. Also, sophomore Kolten Smith and freshman Tre Phelps received invitations to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp. Corey Collins joined Condon as an All-American and became the first SEC player to lead the NCAA in on base percentage, posting a .574 mark.

In 2025, Georgia raced out to another impressive start that featured a 17-game winning streak and a program-best 28-2 mark through 30 games. The Bulldogs were a consensus top 10 ranked team, including reaching as high as No. 1 during the season. They captured seven SEC series in going 18-12 in league play and entered the NCAA Tournament with the nation's No. 2 RPI and the No. 7 overall national seed. The Bulldogs played host to their second straight NCAA Regional and concluded the season with a 43-17 mark. The Bulldogs blasted an NCAA-best 144 home runs and finished second nationally in On Base Percentage at .411. A total of 10 Bulldogs were selected in the 2025 MLB Draft.

For the second consecutive season, the Bulldog pitching staff established a school record for strikeouts and lowered the team ERA. Also, the Bulldogs set a school record with a .983 fielding percentage. Robbie Burnett and Ryland Zaborowski were named semifinalists for the Dick Howser Trophy plus Burnett was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Trophy. Four Bulldogs earned All-SEC honors in first team third baseman Slate Alford and second team pitcher Brian Curley plus Burnett (outfield) and Zaborowski (utility). For the second year in a row, Georgia produced the SEC batting champion as Zaborowski hit .370 after Condon led the SEC and NCAA in 2024 with a .443 clip. Five Bulldogs made the CSC Academic All-District team including Burnett who became the first Bulldog to be named a first team Academic All-American.

Johnson and his wife Angie, have three children: Ryan, Anna and Ava.

\*Georgia is in its third season under the leadership of Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Wes Johnson**. He became the fastest in school history to reach 100 baseball wins, needing just 137 games. David Perno is the only other UGA baseball coach to earn 100 wins in his third season in 2004 (175th game).

\*Georgia's 2026 roster has 15 returnees, five freshmen, one hitter from junior college and 20 players from the portal. Georgia had 17 players from 2025 sign pro contracts including 10 draft picks.

## Excellent Progress In The Johnson Era

\*Georgia has made an impressive jump in its performance at the plate and on the mound era with the arrival of **Wes Johnson** and his staff in 2024. Johnson serves as the the pitching coach while assistant head coach **Will Coggin** and **Nick Ammirati** direct the offense and **Brock Bennett** is the recruiting coordinator. Georgia has posted strong starts and kept that momentum going into SEC play. In 2025, Georgia entered conference with a 19-1 mark and on a 16-game winning streak. In 2024, the Bulldogs were 17-1 when SEC play began. Both teams finished 43-17.

In 2026, Georgia was 15-3 at the start of league play and clinched the SEC with four games left in the season. Georgia entered postseason 43-12 (23-7 SEC).

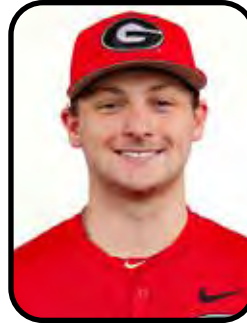
