STORYLINES

MSU Seeks To Bounce Back Against Northwestern State

Mississippi State (1-1) seeks to bounce back from its SEC-opening loss to LSU as the Bulldogs host FCS and Southland Conference opponent Northwestern State (0-2) at 3 p.m. Saturday.

• MSU nearly overcame a 21-6 deficit in the fourth quarter against No. 14 LSU but the Bulldogs fell 21-19 as a potential game-tying two-point conversion came up short and a 52-yard **Devon Bell** field goal missed wide right as time expired. **Dak Prescott** fired a single-game school record 34 completions (breaking his old record of 33) and was 14-of-20 for 161 yards in the fourth quarter.

• **Dan Mullen**, the 2014 Maxwell Football National and SEC AP Coach of the Year, is in his seventh season as head coach. At 47-32, he is in third place in MSU all-time wins. Mullen owns the highest winning percentage as a coach at MSU since College Football Hall of Famer Allyn McKeen from 1939-48 (.764). Prior to Mullen's arrival, MSU was 21-42.

• MSU leads the all-time series with Northwestern State, 2-0, and the two are meeting for the first time since Nov. 16, 1946 when the Bulldogs won 27-0 in Starkville.

• **Dak Prescott**, who is up for five national awards, owns a 15-7 record as a starter and he has shattered 20 school records. For his career, the senior has scored 36 TDs (33 rush, 3 receiving) and been responsible for a school-record 77 TDs (44 passing, 33 rushing). For the season, Dak is 56-of-90 for 572 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions through the air. He has thrown a school-record 139 straight passes without an interception, a streak that stretches 11 quarters.

• Only twice have the Bulldogs put up less than 420 yards of total offense when **Dak Prescott** starts (22 times) a game (South Carolina, 2013 with 385; LSU, 2015 with 378).

• MSU has produced at least 420 yards of total offense in 15 out of its last 16 games dating to 2013.

• Jr. LB **Richie Brown** leads MSU in tackles with 22, which ranks fifth in the SEC. Brown is the first Bulldog to collect double-digit tackles in the first two games of a season since 2002 (Haggan).

• Jr. DE **A.J. Jefferson** is tops on the squad in tackles for loss with four, which ranks fifth in the SEC and 17th nationally. Jefferson has had at least 1.5 tackles for loss in three straight games.

• Jr. WR **Fred Ross** leads the SEC in receptions with 14 (7.0 per game). That mark is also 14th nationally. Ross had a career-best nine catches against LSU and he is averaging 70.5 ypg.

• Jr. RS **Brandon Holloway** leads the SEC and is second nationally in kickoff return average (49.0)

DAN MULLEN

No one has had more of a profound impact on shaping Mississippi State football into a national contender than Dan Mullen. The 2014 National and Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year, Mullen is in his seventh season in Starkville after guiding the Bulldogs into unprecedented territory, including the fastest ascent from unranked to No. 1 in college football history.

Seven years into his tenure, Mullen (47-32, .595) owns the highest winning percentage as a State coach since the late Allyn McKeen from 1939-48 (.764), and he is third in school history in victories (47). Prior to Mullen's arrival, the school record for consecutive bowl game appearances was three. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs have been to a school-record five consecutive bowl games, including their first Orange Bowl berth in 73 years in December 2014.

No coach in school history had ever been a finalist for a national coach of the year honor until Mullen won the Maxwell Football Club's National Coach of the Year award in 2014. He also claimed the Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year award that same fall.

The 2014 season was arguably the best in school history as Mullen's group won 10 regular season games for the first time and 10 overall for just the third time. The Bulldogs claimed six SEC wins -- the most by MSU since 1999 -- while finishing second in the difficult SEC West.

Mullen developed a team that went from unranked to No. 1 quicker than any in college football history (five weeks; Ohio State made the move in six weeks in 1964). The Bulldogs were the nation's No. 1 team for the first time in 80 years of Associated Press polls following wins over No. 6 Texas A&M and No. 2 Auburn during a raucous stretch in Davis Wade Stadium. MSU became the first team since 1983 Auburn to defeat three consecutive top-10 ranked teams. The Bulldogs also became the first squad to hold the No. 1 ranking in the inaugural College Football Playoff poll.

The year was capped with a berth in the Orange Bowl for the first time since 1941. Mullen's squad rewrote the MSU record books in 2014, shattering 22 single-season records, including 10 by National Player of the Year finalist Prescott. The Bulldogs led the SEC in total offense for the first time since 1982, putting up a school-record 513.8 yards per game. State earned its highest Associated Press poll finish since 1940 (No. 11), and it tied its highest finish ever in the USA Today Amway Coaches poll (No. 12).

MSU has shattered 68 team or individual single-season and career statistical records under Mullen. The Bulldogs have also produced a first-team All-America selection in five straight years. Linebacker Benardrick McKinney became the latest recipient in 2014 before being selected in the 2015 NFL Draft.

Player development has been key in Mullen's six previous seasons. Eighteen MSU players have been chosen in the NFL Draft under Mullen's watch since 2010. The five selections in 2015 were the most through the first six rounds of a draft in school history and the most overall in a draft since a school-record five went in 1995. Of the five Bulldogs drafted, three earned "two stars" in high school, while two were "three-star" recruits before arriving in Starkville. An additional school-record seven players signed NFL free agent contracts following the 2015 NFL Draft.

Off the field, Mullen's players are constant achievers in the classroom and the community donating countless hours to the Starkville area and state of Mississippi. Twenty Bulldogs were named to the 2014 SEC Academic Fall Honor Roll. During Mullen's entire six-year tenure at MSU, 110 players have earned the distinction of SEC Honor Roll recipient.

Mullen has helped the program improve its NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) nearly every year in his tenure, including the SEC's fourth-best football APR with a score of 974 in 2013. During the historic run to No. 1 in 2014, the Bulldogs' 2.76 grade point average was the program's highest ever while 20 of the 21 seniors have earned undergraduate degrees.

MSU and Northwestern State are meeting for the third time and the first since 1946 ... The Bulldogs blanked the Demons, 54-0, on Nov. 17, 1945 in Starkville and then won 27-0 on Nov. 16, 1946 in Starkville ... 338 miles separate the two campuses from Starkville to Natchitoches, La. ... MSU has outscored Northwestern State 81-0 in the series ... MSU is 6-0 against FCS opponents under **Dan Mullen** ... The Bulldogs are 4-0 all-time against current Southland Conference foes (vs. Lamar 2-0) ... This is the first game against a Southland team for State since defeating Lamar, 37-21, on Oct. 12, 1974.

THE NOTEBOOK

MSU, NORTHWESTERN STATE TIES

Dak Prescott's brother, Jace Prescott, played on the offensive line at Northwestern State from 2007-10. He started all 11 games as a senior in 2010 and played in 23 career games. Dak was in high school at Haughton at the time. Current Northwestern State sophomore quarterback J.D. Almond was quarterback at Haughton High School after Prescott graduated.

MSU IS 25-5 IN NON-CONFERENCE GAMES UNDER MULLEN

The Bulldogs are 25-5 in all non-SEC games under **Dan Mullen**, including a 22-3 mark in the regular season. The Bulldogs have won eight consecutive regular season contests against non-conference foes dating back to their Sept. 7, 2013, win against Troy. MSU's last non-conference regular season loss was to No. 13 Oklahoma State on Aug. 31, 2013. Under Mullen, the Bulldogs are 15-2 against non-SEC foes at home with both losses coming in his first season of 2009 (Georgia Tech, Houston).

GRADUATES & SCHOLARS

Four players on the 2015 MSU roster have already received their undergraduate degrees and all four are starters: CB **Taveze Calhoun** (interdisciplinary studies), OG **Justin Malone** (criminology), QB **Dak Prescott** (educational psychology) and OT **Justin Senior** (political

science). Both Malone and Prescott earned their degrees last December prior to the Orange Bowl. Calhoun graduated in the spring, and Senior is MSU's most recent graduate in August 2015. Prescott is on pace to receive his master's degree in workforce leadership this December. Calhoun, a four-time SEC Honor Roll recipient, is a National Football Foundation scholar-athlete nominee with a 3.5 grade point average. Junior linebacker **Richie Brown** currently owns a 3.8 GPA in industrial technology. In the fall of 2014, MSU's 2.76 team grade point average was its highest ever.

"BEAR" WILSON MAKING PLAYS, ROSS TOPS IN RECEPTIONS

Junior wideout **De'Runnya Wilson**, nicknamed "Bear", currently ranks seventh in the SEC in receiving yards per game with 70.5. Wilson caught eight passes for a game-high 86 receiving yards, including a five-yard touchdown pass that brought MSU within two points against LSU in the fourth quarter.

- Wilson, a Birmingham native, did not start playing football until he was a junior in high school and he has developed into an NFL prospect. He ranks fifth all-time in MSU career receiving touchdowns with 13.
- Junior wide receiver **Fred Ross** leads the SEC and ranks 15th nationally in receptions per game with 8.0. Ross hauled in a career-best nine passes against LSU.
- A total of 12 different Bulldogs have combined for 56 receptions, a mark that leads the SEC and ranks sixth nationally.

EIGHT-GAME HOME WINNING STREAK SNAPPED

State saw its eight-game home winning streak come to an end with the loss to LSU last Saturday. The streak goes down as the sixth-longest in school history and the longest since winning 16 in a row from 1998-2000. Last season, the Bulldogs completed the first undefeated home season since 1999 and tied the school record for home wins (7, 1999 as well). The Bulldogs are 18-4 in the last four seasons at home and 28-14 all-time in Davis Wade Stadium under **Dan Mullen**. All four losses were to top-16 ranked teams.

RECORD 50,000+ SEASON TICKETS SOLD

MSU has sold over 50,000 season tickets for the first time in school history. The previous high for was 45,575 last year, and prior to that was 43,894 in 2013. Last August, a \$75 million expansion and renovation of Davis Wade Stadium was completed. With the net increase of 6,255 seats, the capacity now sits at 61,337. In 2014, the Bulldogs set attendance records in single-season total attendance (427,892), single-game average attendance (61,127) and single-game attendance (62,945).

IN THE POLLS

MSU is receiving votes in both the Amway Coaches and Associated Press polls. The Bulldogs finished the 2014 campaign No. 11 in the AP rankings - its highest finish since No. 9 in 1940 and second-highest finish ever -- and No. 12 in the Coaches poll. It tied the 1999 squad as its highest Coaches poll finish ever. The Bulldogs spent five straight week's as the nation's No. 1 ranked team last season. Following a 38-23 win over then-No. 2 Auburn, the Bulldogs vaulted to No. 1 in the polls on Oct. 12 for the first time in the 115-year history of the program. The Bulldogs were the first team in the Associated Press poll's 78-year history to go from unranked to No. 1 in five weeks. The previous mark was six weeks by Ohio State in 1954. MSU has been ranked in 11 out of the last 13 polls.

MULLEN THIRD IN MSU ALL-TIME WINS WITH 47

Dan Mullen, the 2014 Maxwell Football National Coach of the Year and Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year, has spearheaded Mississippi State to unprecedented success in now his seventh year. With a 47-32 (.595) record, the 43-year-old is just the third coach in school history to win 47 games and the quickest to do it since Allyn McKeen in 1944. McKeen, a College Football Hall of Famer, and Mullen are the only two coaches in school history to post 45 wins and own a winning percentage over .500. Mullen has led MSU to five consecutive bowl games for the first time in school history while recording a school-record three bowl wins.

BRANDON HOLLOWAY NO. 2 NATIONALLY IN KICKOFF RETURNS

At 5-foot-8, he is the shortest player on the team but **Brandon Holloway** currently is second nationally and tops in the SEC in average yards per kickoff return (49.0). He is one of only 12 FBS players this season to return a kickoff for a touchdown.

- His impact was felt in a big way in the season-opener at Southern Miss. With 4.4 speed, Holloway showed it, returning a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown to put the Bulldogs on the board with 5:26 to go in the first quarter.
- It tied the school record for longest kickoff return and was the fourth 100-yard kickoff return in school history. Others to do it: Jameon Lewis vs. Ole Miss (Nov. 24, 2012), Fred Reid vs. Memphis (Oct. 11, 2003) and Glen Young (Nov. 15, 1980).
- Holloway had the only kickoff return for a TD by an SEC player in week 1 and was one of only three FBS players in week 1 with a 100-yard kickoff return for a TD. Others to do it: Burns of Kansas State and Phillips of Western Michigan.
- The junior became the only player in school history with multiple kickoff returns of 95 yards or more in a career. He tallied a total of 135 total yards on his first two touches of the opener.

RETURN OF THE DAK

Dak Prescott delivered the most prolific season by a quarterback in State history in 2014. He owns a 15-7 record as a starter and is a candidate for every National Player of the Year award. Dak finished eighth in the Heisman Trophy vote last season, marking the highest finish by an MSU player in the award's storied history.

- Dak is seeking to become the second player in SEC history to rush for 40 touchdowns and throw for 40 touchdowns in a career. Another **Dan Mullen** protege is the record holder (Tim Tebow). Prescott is seven rushing TDs shy of achieving the feat. He has rushed for 33 scores and thrown for 44.
- Prescott is attempting to become only the third FBS quarterback in the last 20 years to rush for 10 touchdowns in three straight seasons. Tebow and former Nevada QB/current San Francisco 49er Colin Kaepernick both did it.

DAK HAS NOT THROWN AN INTERCEPTION THIS YEAR

- QB **Dak Prescott** has not thrown an interception in 90 attempts so far this season.
- Dating back to last season, he has not thrown an interception in 139 consecutive attempts, a streak that spans 11 quarters and is also the longest streak in school history. Prescott's last interception came on the third play of the 2014 Orange Bowl against Georgia Tech with 14:04 remaining in the first quarter.
- Dak broke the mark of Wesley Carroll (2007) and Tyler Russell (2012), who each had 137 attempts without a pick.
- Dak's streak is currently the fourth-longest in FBS:

DAK PRESCOTT, MSU SCHOOL RECORD HOLDER

QB **Dak Prescott** has broken 20 MSU school records (12 single-season and eight career), and he has shattered three career records so far this season.

- He broke three school records in the LSU game last weekend: completions in a game (34), career completions (474) and consecutive completions without an interception (139). Prescott broke his old record of 33 of completions in a game set in last year's Orange Bowl. Dak surpassed Wayne Madkin (1998-2001) in MSU career completions. He is now 474-of-782 for his career.
- The next record that could fall is MSU career passing yards. Dak is **181** yards shy of tying that record also owned by Madkin. Prescott has thrown for 6,155 yards in four seasons.
- Dak moved up to 15th all-time in SEC career touchdowns responsible for with 77, and he is 5 shy of cracking the top 10. Tim Tebow, another **Dan Mullen** protege, owns the record with 145.
- Dak is **294** rushing yards away from tying John Bond's (1980-83) MSU career record for rushing yards by a quarterback. Prescott is 981 yards from tying Tebow's SEC record. Dak has rushed for 1,984 yards during his career, which is fifth in SEC history. He is **183** rushing yards away from tying fourth-place owned by Texas A&M's Johnny Manziel.
- Prescott already own school career records for touchdowns responsible (77), total offense (8,141), completion percentage (.606), 200-yard passing games (19), interception percentage (.0260) and passing touchdowns (44).

A total of 18 Bulldogs have made their collegiate debuts this season, including 15 at Southern Miss (three junior college transfers, nine redshirt freshmen and three true freshmen) and three against LSU in week two (two redshirt freshmen and one true freshman). **LB Gerri Green** (RFr.), **S Brandon Bryant** (RFr.), **S Jamal Peters** (Fr.), **CB Chris Rayford** (RFr.), **DE Will Coleman** (Junior College Transfer), **WR Malik Dear** (Fr.), **DE Johnathan Calvin** (Junior College Transfer), **OG Deion Calhoun** (RFr.), **WR Donald Gray** (Junior College Transfer), **TE Justin Johnson** (Fr.), **WR Jesse Jackson** (RFr.), **RB Aeris Williams** (RFr.), **RB Dontavian Lee** (RFr.), **QB Nick Fitzgerald** (RFr.) and **OT Elgton Jenkins** (RFr.) all made their debuts against Southern Miss. **S Mark McLaurin** (Fr.), **DT Braxton Hoyett** (RFr.) and **DT Cory Thomas** (RFr.) saw the field against LSU.

JUSTIN SENIOR ONLY CANADIAN IN THE SEC

Justin Senior, MSU's most experienced offensive lineman with 16 career starts, is the SEC's only current football player who hails from Canada. Senior is one of 14 Canadian natives who are currently playing in the Power 5 Conferences. Senior grew up in Montreal, Quebec, before attending Hargrave Military Academy in Chatham, Virginia. Senior started all 13 games last season at right tackle.

MANNY DIAZ RETURNS TO STARKVEGAS

A familiar face is roaming the sideline as Bulldog defensive coordinator and linebackers coach in 2015. **Manny Diaz**, who spent the 2014 campaign as DC at Louisiana Tech, returns to Mississippi State after serving in the same role in 2010. Diaz developed 10 players on that 2010 Bulldog team who went on to sign NFL contracts, including six who were in the 2015 NFL playoffs. Diaz' 2014 Louisiana Tech team led the nation in turnovers gained (40). MSU's 2010 defense ranked among the top 25 nationally in scoring defense, rushing defense and tackles for loss. Diaz replaces Geoff Collins, who is currently defensive coordinator at Florida.

RETURNING FROM INJURY

MSU welcomed the return of several players who saw their 2014 seasons be cut short due to injury. S **Kendrick Market**, the leader of the secondary, ruptured his Achilles tendon in the first half of last November's Egg Bowl matchup against Ole Miss. After a dilligent rehab and sitting out the spring, the senior Market made the start at Southern Miss. CB **Cedric Jiles**, who played as a true freshman in 2012 and a sophomore in 2013, missed the 2014 campaign after suffering a season-ending hamstring injury during a camp scrimmage in August 2014. He came off the bench against USM. LB **Dezmond Harris** played in the first six games of the 2014 season before suffering a torn ACL against Auburn on Oct. 11, 2014. He missed the final seven games of the year. OT **Damien Robinson**, a sixth-year senior, was slated to start at tackle in 2014 but tore his ACL during August 2014 camp.

MISSISSIPPI STATE OF MIND

Of the 105 players who make up Mississippi State's roster, 60 of them hail from the state of Mississippi (57.1 percent of the roster). 111 of MSU's 176 signees since 2009 (63 percent) are Mississippi natives. By comparison: Southern Miss is 39 percent and Ole Miss 37 percent.

In 2004, State's average attendance was 43,792, while in 2014 it was 61,127, marking a percentage increase of 39.6. MSU trails only Texas A&M, which saw a 41.1 percentage increase from 2004-14.

MSU Pulls Away From Southern Miss, 34-16

Dak Prescott threw for two touchdowns, rushed for another and accounted for 309 yards of total offense as Mississippi State pulled away from a much-improved Southern Miss squad, 34-16, in the first meeting between the two teams in Hattiesburg since 1989. **Brandon Holloway** got the scoring going for the Bulldogs, answering a USM field goal with a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown with 5:26 remaining in the first quarter. Trailing 10-7 midway through the second quarter, Prescott found true freshman **Justin Johnson** for a 5-yard TD strike. The Bulldogs held USM short of the goal line on four straight plays from inside the 3-yard line to take a 14-10 lead into the half. Prescott culminated a nine-play, 95-yard drive escaping and finding **Gus Walley** for a 4-yard touchdown pass with 12:15 to go in the third quarter. The big play of the drive was Prescott's 49-yard scamper down the sideline to set up the score. **Westin Graves** booted the first made field goals of his career to tack on the lead and Prescott closed the scoring with a 7-yard TD run with 5:55 remaining. Prescott finished with 72 yards on the ground and 237 yards through the air. **Richie Brown** was MSU's leading tackler with 11 and one interception. A.J. Jefferson notched seven tackles, including two sacks. Jefferson provided the crucial fourth down stop that prevented the Golden Eagles from scoring before the first half. **Will Redmond** added an interception.

MSU Rally Comes Up Short Against LSU, 21-19

No. 25 MSU nearly overcame a 21-6 deficit in the fourth quarter, but No. 14 LSU escaped with a 21-19 win in the Southeastern Conference opener in Davis Wade Stadium. **Dak Prescott** was a career-best 34-of-52 for 335 yards and one touchdown, including a 5-yard TD pass to **De'Runnya Wilson** with 4:00 to play that pulled the Bulldogs within two. The 34 completions set an MSU team and individual single-game record, breaking Prescott's old mark of 33 set in the 2014 Orange Bowl. MSU came up short on the two-point conversion attempt when Prescott and **Ashton Shumpert** weren't able to connect in the corner. Prescott was a perfect 6-of-6 on the 82-yard drive. The Bulldogs retained possession with 1:32 left in the game. Prescott again marched MSU down the field from its own 11-yard line. However, **Devon Bell's** 52-yard field goal sailed wide right as time expired. The Tigers held the Bulldogs to only 43 rushing yards. MSU trailed 14-3 at the half at the hands of LSU's Leonard Fournette who finished with 159 yards rushing and three touchdowns. For the second straight game, **Richie Brown** was the Bulldogs' leading tackler with 11, including 1.5 for loss and one sack. **A.J. Jefferson** collected two tackles for loss, while **Kendrick Market** had nine tackles.

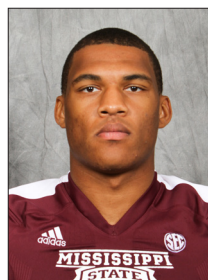
