

We look forward to hosting all of you at Tiger Stadium on Saturday for the 2020 LSU Football season!

Parking (map below)

- Lot 105: All media will be parking in Lot 105 this season. Lot 105 is the concrete lot in front of the LSU Natatorium and Maddox Fieldhouse. Best way to enter is off of W. Chimes Street from Nicholson Drive. LSUports.net/gameday provides timely information about traffic and recommended routes to the lot.
- Friday Pick-up: For those of you in the Baton Rouge area, parking passes for the Mississippi State game will be available for pickup on Friday, Sept. 24 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Athletics Administration Building front lobby with Lois Stuckey. Please be prepared to show your ID to pick up your pass. If you are unable to pick up on Friday, your parking pass will be available at the Lot 105 entrance with LSU Communications student assistant Haylee Knight.

Check-in/Media Will Call (Legends Club of PMAC; entrance across from the Shaq statue)

- Media Will Call: Opens at 10:30 a.m.
- Before 10:30 a.m.: Please make arrangements with me if you plan to arrive on campus prior to 10:30 a.m.
- Mask Up: LSU safety protocols require that a face mask be worn in all areas during the duration that an individual is on campus.
- Wellness and Temperature check: All credentialed media will be required to go through temperature screening and wellness check in the Legends Club/Practice Facility lobby before entering the Tiger Stadium extended perimeter. Please fill out the CDC COVID-19 Facilities Screening on your phone to show our security staff before entering the facility.
 - CDC check: You can download the LSU Sports app on your mobile device. Click on COVID-19 Screening at the top of the homepage any time after 12:00 a.m. on Saturday. Begin the CDC COVID-19 Screening by scrolling down to the first question. Answer all four questions and you will receive an Approved or Not Approved screen to show to the security staff upon entry.
 - Option: If you do not have the LSU Sports app on your mobile device, you can go directly to www.cdc.gov/screening/index.html.
 - If individuals record a high temperature, there will be medical personnel set up nearby for further testing. Media with an allowable temperature (100.4 or below) will be able to use the stairs of elevator at the back of the lobby to go up to the Legends Club to pick up credentials.
- Bag check: Bags will be searched before advancing to the Legends Club to pick up your credential.
- Please follow signs inside the Legends Club for Media Will Call.
- Please follow signage to exit for the upper concourse of the PMAC to the southwest ramp. Once you have your credential, you can enter at the NW gate of Tiger Stadium (Media Entrance).

Press Box Access

- Elevator access to the Press Level continues to be available, but with limited capacity. Please be prepared for an extended wait time for elevators.
- Other options to access the Press Level are Stairwell 1 and the Southwest Ramp. Enter at the NW Media Entrance and follow the walkway straight ahead to both options.

Meals and Beverages

- All press box meals will be pre-packaged and distributed beginning two hours prior to kickoff
- Bottled and canned beverages will be available for the duration of the event. You are allowed to bring in one factory-sealed water bottle of 32 oz. or less into Tiger Stadium this season.
- Every seat in the Paul Manasseh Press Box is assigned this season, including the Lounge Area.
- You are asked to pick up your meal and beverage and return to your assigned seat.

Pool Photo/Video Access (Advise that you set up your accounts on Friday)

- **Highlights, Photos & Press Conferences:** The SEC and XOS Digital will provide a platform for distribution of game highlights, game photos and press conference content. Highlights from all SEC football games be available via the SEC Media Portal. Whenever school postgame press conferences are available, they will be posted to the portal as well. Still photography will be available in the portal for the media at halftime and following each SEC football game and video will be available after each game. The SEC Media Access Guidelines continue to apply to this content and are outlined in the 2020 credentialing registration process. Standup location

- Due to COVID-19 protocols, media will not be allowed on the field during pregame or postgame to do reports.
- The top of the Southwest ramp of the PMAC will be equipped with power for media to do standups with Tiger Stadium in the background.

SEC ACCESS POLICIES

Host institution can credential up to six (6) non-institutional media photographers at their discretion with priority consideration given to (1) one wire outlet (AP, USA Today, Getty); (2) key local outlets of home team; (3) additional wire outlets, consistent with FWAA committee recommendations.

- Up to two (2) non-institutional media photographers may be permitted on the field/sideline. These photographers must participate in required COVID screening consistent with institutional personnel permitted on the field. One photographer will be assigned to each end of the field. Photographers may move from sideline-to-sideline during the game by moving behind the end zone.
- At no time may a non-institutional media photographer come within 6 feet of the bench area or move behind the bench area.
- Up to four (4) non-institutional media photographers may be permitted to shoot from the stands, or in LSU's case, areas located outside of the fencing around the playing field.
- Per SEC guidelines, all other credentialed media WILL NOT be permitted on the field
