SERIES HISTORY: MSU LEADS, 33-11

LAST MEETING: MSU WON, 59-14 (9/1/11)

SETTING THE SCENE

- The University of Memphis Tigers return home to Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium this Saturday to host SEC rival Mississippi State at 3:05 p.m. CT. The game will be televised live nationally on ESPN2 and can be heard on the radio on 98.9 THE ROAR OF MEMPHIS.
- This past Saturday, the Tigers earned the team's first road win of the season, taking down Arkansas State, 55-50, in Jonesboro. The win for Memphis at A-State was the first for the program since 2004.
- Last season, Memphis posted a record of 8-3 in head coach Ryan Silverfield's first season at the helm of the program. The Tigers ended the year with a 25-10 win over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl.

SCOUTING MISSISSIPPI STATE

- Mississippi State moved to 2-0 on the season with a 24-10 win over NC State at home in Starkville this past Saturday. MSU opened the year with a come-from-behind win over Louisiana Tech, 35-34.
- Prior to the start of the season, the Bulldogs were picked to finish seventh in the Western Division of the SEC.
- Last season, Mississippi State opened the 2020 season with a bang, taking down No. 6 and defending National Champions LSU in Baton Rouge, 44-34.
- Following that win, the Bulldogs lost four-straight and ended the season with an overall record of 4-7 and 3-7 in SEC play.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- Saturday's game against Mississippi State will mark the 45th all-time meeting between the two programs dating back to the 1951 season.
- Overall, the Bulldogs hold a 33-11 record over the Tigers in the series, including a mark of 17-6 all-time in Memphis.
- The meeting will be the first between the two teams since Sept. 1, 2011.
- Mississippi State has won 12-straight in the series, with Memphis' last win coming on Sept. 4, 1993, 45-35, in Starkville.
- The Tigers last win over the Bulldogs in Memphis came on Oct. 1, 1988, 31-10.
- The two teams are scheduled to open the 2022 season against one another in Starkville on Sept. 3.

Ryan Silverfield became the 25th head coach in Memphis football history in December 2019 and began his tenure by leading the Tigers into their first major bowl game appearance: the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic in Dallas.

In naming Silverfield, the Tigers hired from within. Silverfield served as deputy head coach and offensive line coach

during the 2019 season as the Tigers won their first outright conference title in 50 years. Memphis won the 2019 American Athletic Conference championship with a 29-24 win over Cincinnati at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium.

Silverfield also was part of Memphis staffs that led the program to three-straight American Athletic Conference West Division crowns from 2017-19 and four-straight bowl appearances from 2016-19. Behind Silverfield's contributions, Memphis won 38 games during those four seasons, including going 10-3 in 2017 and 12-1 in 2019. He is the only member of the staff to be part of both 10-plus win seasons.

In his first full season at the helm of the program in 2020, Silverfield led the Tigers to the team's first bowl victory since 2014, a 25-10 win over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl, becoming the first head coach in school history to win a bowl game in his first year.

Silverfield guided Memphis to an 8-3 record on the season, setting the program record for winning percentage (.727) by a first-year head coach, while also matching the school mark for most wins in a debut year (Mike Norvell, 2016). For his efforts, he was named the 2020 Tennessee Sports Writers Association (TSWA) Coach of the Year.

On the field, Memphis ranked 22nd in the nation in total offense (453.1) and finished 17th in the country in both passing offense (307.9) and first down offense (260). Defensively, the Tigers were 13th in turnovers gained (20), 17th in passes intercepted (12) and 19th in red zone defense (.744).

Quarterback Brady White capped his incredible career at Memphis by winning the 31st William V. Campbell Trophy, which is presented to the college football player with the best combination of academics, community service and on-field performance. White was also a First-Team Senior CLASS Award All-American, one of

nine semifinalists for the Wuerffel Trophy and a top-15 candidate for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award.

Five players earned honors from the American Athletic Conference following the season, with wide receiver Calvin Austin III and defensive lineman O'Bryan Goodson being named to the first team. Defensive back Quindell Johnson was named to the second team, while both tight end Sean Dykes and defensive lineman Morris Joseph earned All-AAC Honorable-Mention accolades.

During the 2019 season, Silverfield developed a young offensive line that returned only two starters from 2018. One of starters -- Dustin Woodard -- moved to center as a regular for the first time in his collegiate career. Silverfield molded a line that blocked for the fourth-best offense in program history (6,249 yards) and the program's third-best scoring offense (527 points).

Two of Silverfield's linemen received all-conference accolades in 2019. Woodard was named to the All-American Athletic Conference second team and Dylan Parham earned all-league honorable mention recognition. Silverfield's line blocked for Kenneth Gainwell, The American's Rookie of the Year and the program's fifth 1,000-yard rusher all-time (1,425 yards), and for all-league second team performers in quarterback Brady White, wide receivers Damonte Coxie and Antonio Gibson, and tight end Joey Magnifico. White had more than 3,000 yards passing and Coxie posted more than 1,000 yards receiving, both for a second-straight campaign. After the season, Woodard was a seventh round draft selection in the 2020 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots.

Silverfield served as the offensive line coach and run game coordinator in 2018, overseeing the team's most consistent unit with all five starters playing every game. One year after blocking for an offense that featured consensus All-American wide receiver Anthony Miller and set a school record for passing touchdowns, the offensive line spent the 2018 season in the trenches blocking for the program's first unanimous All-American in running back Darrell Henderson. During the 2018 season, Memphis set school records for total yards, points scored and rushing touchdowns. In 2017, they set the standard for passing touchdowns.

In five seasons at Memphis, Silverfield has coached five offensive linemen to all-conference honors. Gabe Kuhn (guard) and Trevon Tate (tackle) were first-team honorees in 2017, and Woodard was a first-team pick at guard in 2018 and a second-team selection at center in 2019. Parham was an honorable mention honoree in 2019.

Collectively, Silverfield's 2018 unit was one of 10 semifinalists for the Joe Moore Award, given to the best

offensive line in college football. For his role leading the offensive line, Silverfield was named one of six finalists for the offensive line coach of the year award sponsored by FootballScoop. Silverfield also was recognized as one of the top recruiters in his time at Memphis. In 2017, he was ranked the fourth-best recruiter in The American by 247sports.com.

A 2018 Frank Broyles Award candidate, Silverfield first came to Memphis in 2016 with more than 18 years of coaching experience at the high school, college and NFL levels. He remains the only coach to have worked with an NCAA single-season rushing leader and an NFL single-season rushing leader. At UCF, Silverfield helped tutor Kevin Smith when the junior back led college football with 2,567 yards in 2007. Five seasons later in 2012, Silverfield was at Minnesota, where the Vikings' offensive line paved the way for Adrian Peterson's 2,097-yard season.

Just prior to coming to Memphis, Silverfield spent the last half of the 2015 football campaign with the NFL's Detroit Lions. In a mid-season staff shake-up, the Lions brought in Silverfield as an assistant offensive line coach, and the hire paid immediate dividends. His tenure with the Lions was Silverfield's second stint in the NFL.

Before Silverfield's arrival, the Lions had a 2-7 record in the three games before he came on board. Detroit's offensive line allowed 15 sacks for 105 yards. In the season's final stretch, Silverfield helped mold an offensive line that propelled the Lions to a 5-2 record. The Lions' offensive line allowed just more than three sacks per game in the last seven contests, and quarterback Matthew Stafford thrived behind Silverfield's new-look offensive line. In the seven games with Silverfield on staff, Stafford threw 17 touchdowns and only one interception. Before that, Stafford had 15 touchdowns and 12 interceptions.

Preceding his 2015 mid-season jump to the NFL, Silverfield was a senior offensive analyst on head coach Todd Graham's Arizona State staff. In his short time in Tempe, Ariz., the Sun Devils posted a 5-5 record on their way to a final 6-6 regular-season mark and a Motel 6 Cactus Bowl berth.

Silverfield served as an offensive consultant at Toledo in 2014 and helped the Rockets to a 9-4 overall record and a 7-1 Mid-American Conference (MAC) mark. Toledo tied for the MAC West crown and earned a GoDaddy.com Bowl berth. The Rockets' nine wins were the most since 2001, and Toledo's 63-44 bowl victory over Arkansas State was its first postseason win since 2011.

The Rockets' offensive line helped put one of the most prolific offensive seasons in Toledo football record book. The 2014 offense set school records for total offense,

total rushing yardage and first downs per game and also ranked among the program's top-five in points per game (2nd), touchdowns scored (3rd) and rushing touchdowns (3rd).

Leading the charge on Silverfield's offensive line was Greg Mancz, the 2014 Vern Smith Award/MAC Player of the Year award recipient. Mancz, also an All-America second team selection, became the first offensive lineman in MAC history to be honored as the league's Player of the Year. Fellow linemen Josh Hendershot and Jeff Myers joined Mancz in earning All-MAC recognition.

Toledo's offensive line proved fruitful for the 2014 Rockets' attack. Toledo led the MAC in scoring offense, total offense, rushing offense and first downs. Rockets running back Kareem Hunt led the MAC in rushing (1,631 yards) and was tops in the nation in yards per carry (8.0). Hunt was an All-MAC first team pick and also earned GoDaddy.com Bowl MVP honors (271 yards/5 touchdowns).

Before jumping back to the collegiate ranks, Silverfield spent six seasons on the Minnesota Vikings staff. In his time in Minnesota, Silverfield helped the Vikings to two NFC North Division crowns and three NFL playoffs appearances, including a trip to the 2009 NFC championship game. Silverfield began his Vikings' stint as an offensive quality control staffer, before moving to a defensive line staff assistant in 2009 and 2010. He moved to the offensive side from 2011-13, assisting Jeff Davidson with the offensive line.

It was in the midst of his three years working with the Minnesota offensive line that Peterson had one of the most-prolific, single-season rushing performances in NFL history. In 2012, Peterson ran for a league-best 2,097 yards, falling just eight yards shy of Eric Dickerson's NFL record of 2,105. Peterson was named the 2012 NFL MVP.

Prior to his time in the NFL, Silverfield spent the 2006 and 2007 seasons at UCF. In his two campaigns in Orlando, Fla., he served as an offensive graduate assistant

his first season and moved to a defensive graduate assistant spot in 2007. Silverfield was a member of the 2007 Knights staff that led the squad to a 10-4 record, a 7-1 Conference USA mark and the C-USA East Division crown. UCF defeated Tulsa in the C-USA championship game and earned the league's AutoZone Liberty Bowl berth.

As an offensive graduate assistant, Silverfield worked with Smith in 2006. That season – Smith's sophomore campaign – he rushed for 934 yards in only nine games, setting up his explosive junior season. As a junior, Smith was the NCAA rushing champion.

In Silverfield's season working with the Knights defense, UCF ranked among the top four in C-USA in scoring defense, rushing defense, passing defense and turnovers forced. The Knights held half of their opponents to 20 or fewer points in the 2007 campaign.

In 2005, Silverfield served as the quarterbacks coach at Jacksonville University. In 2004, at the age of 23, Silverfield served as head coach at Memorial Day High School in Savannah, Ga.

A 2003 Hampden-Sydney College (Va.) graduate, Silverfield coached four seasons at his alma mater, starting as an offensive assistant in 2000. Then, at age 20, he was tapped as the Tigers defensive line coach and spent two seasons at that post (2001-02). In 2003, Silverfield moved back to offense and coached the tight ends and H-backs. That season, the Tigers went 9-1 and had the nation's No. 1 scoring offense in the country (47.0 ppg). Hampden-Sydney scored 45 or more points in seven of its 10 games in 2003.

Silverfield started coaching in 1999 at his alma mater, The Bolles School in Jacksonville, Fla. He played for the Bulldogs and was a member of two Florida state championship teams (1995 and 1998). During his playing career, Silverfield helped Bolles to a No. 1 ranking in the USA Today Super 25 national high school football poll. Immediately after his playing career, Silverfield jumped to the coaching ranks as a Bolles School assistant.

Silverfield and his wife, Mariana, live in Memphis.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Memphis has won 16-straight games at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium – the fourth-best streak among FBS teams in the nation. Clemson (29 games), Notre Dame (25), and Cincinnati (22) are the only teams with longer streaks.
- Memphis' last loss at home came to No. 9/10 UCF on Oct. 13, 2018 in a tight, 31-30 setback. The 15-game winning streak began three weeks later on Nov. 10, 2018 with a 47-21 victory over Tulsa.
- The Tigers have also won 21-consecutive non-conference games at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium dating back to a 31-7 win over Arkansas State on Sept. 21, 2013.
- The streak includes a 37-24 victory against No. 13 Ole Miss on Oct. 17, 2015 and a 48-45 win against No. 25 UCLA on Sept. 16, 2017.
- Five of those games were against Power 6 programs (Cincinnati in the AAC title game, Kansas, Ole Miss twice and UCLA).
- Memphis continues to make Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium a difficult place to play. Since Silverfield joined the coaching staff in 2016, the Tigers are 32-3 (.917) at home, including a pair of perfect 7-0 records in 2017 and 2019 and a 6-0 mark in 2020.

ONE OF THE ELITE PROGRAMS IN THE NATION

- Memphis has posted 67 victories since 2014, tying the Tigers for the ninth-most wins in the nation during that stretch.
- The 67 wins are the most among American Athletic Conference schools during that stretch.
- The Tigers also rank 11th in the country in winning percentage dating back to 2014 with their 66-26 (.720) mark.
- Memphis is one of only five FBS programs with at least eight wins each of the last seven seasons (Alabama, Clemson, Georgia and Oklahoma).

MEMPHIS OFFENSE AMONGST BEST IN NATION

- Through two weeks of the season, the Memphis offense is amongst the best in the nation.
- The Tigers rank first in the NCAA in total offense (633.5), seventh in scoring offense (48.5), eighth in rushing offense (292.5) and 13th in passing offense (341.0).

AUSTIN III EARNS AAC WEEKLY HONORS

- Wide receiver Calvin Austin III was named the AAC Offensive Player of the Week after his outstanding performance in a 55-50 road win at Arkansas State on Sept. 11.
- Austin III has the best game of his career in a 55-50 win at Arkansas State this past Saturday, reeling in six catches for 239 yards and three touchdowns.
- His 239 receiving yards were the second-most in single-game, program history behind Anthony Miller's 250-yard performance vs. Tulsa, Oct. 29, 2016.
- Austin III totaled more than 100 receiving yards for the seventh time in his career, the third most 100-yard games in program history.

THOMAS LEADS NCAA IN RUSHING

- Redshirt freshman Brandon Thomas has been spectacular for Memphis through two weeks, leading the NCAA in rushing yard (338) and rushing yards per game (169.0).
- Thomas also ranks third in the nation in rush yards per carry (9.94) and eighth in the country in all-purpose yards (169.0).
- In 2020, Thomas appeared in four games for the Tigers, rushing twice for eight yards.

TRUE FRESHMAN HENIGAN CONTINUES TO SHINE

- Through two weeks, true freshman Seth Henigan has been one of the best quarterbacks in the nation.
- Henigan ranks fifth in the NCAA in yards per completion (16.63), sixth in passing yards per game (341.0), seventh in passing touchdowns (7), ninth in passing yards (682) and 15th in passing efficiency (181.7).
- After his 22-of-33 for 417 yards and five touchdown performance at Arkansas State on Sept. 11, Henigan was named to the Davey O'Brien Award's Great 8 and to the midseason Davey O'Brien Award Watch List.
- Against Nicholls on Sept. 4, Henigan became the first true freshman QB to start a season opener in Memphis football history.

TIGER OFFENSE EXPLODES IN WIN AT A-STATE

- Memphis gained 680 yards of total offense in a 55-50 win at Arkansas State on Sept. 11.
- The 55 points scored were the most for the team on the road since a 59-41 win at East Carolina, Nov. 3, 2018.
- Quarterback Seth Henigan completed 22-of-33 passes for 417 yards and five touchdowns, while wide receiver Calvin Austin III reeled in six catches for 239 yards and three scores.
- Running back Brandon Thomas rushed 18 times for 191 yards and two touchdowns, while tight end Sean Dykes had nine receptions for 143 yards and two scores.

GAME NOTES

DANTON BARTO REMEMBERED

- On Aug. 23, 2007 M-Club Hall of Fame inductee Danton Barto passed away at 50 years old.
- The University will honor him with a moment of silence prior to the Tigers' game against Mississippi State on Sept. 18.
- Barto is the school record holder for career solo tackles (273) and career total tackles (473) and ranks second all-time with 200 assisted career tackles.
- An All-South Independent first team honoree in 1991, 1992 and 1993, Barto was named the All-South Independent Defensive Player of the Year in 1992 after leading Memphis with four interceptions.
- Barto earned All-Independent Football Alliance (IFA) Conference first-team honors in both 1992 and 1993 and was the All-IFA Defensive Player of the Year in 1992.
- Following his Tiger career, Barto spent five years playing professional football in the CFL and AFL. The Niceville, Fla., native coached in the AFL2 for the Memphis Xplorers, a team he guided to its first-ever league championship, earning Coach of the Year honors.

SEVEN-STRAIGHT BOWLS

- Memphis' win over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl marked the program's seventh-straight season with a bowl game appearance.
- The 25-10 victory over FAU under head coach Ryan Silverfield marked the first win in a bowl game since earning a 55-48 win over BYU in the Miami Beach Bowl in 2014.
- Entering 2021, Memphis has the longest active streak of bowl appearances in the AAC at seven.

STERLING START

- Head coach Ryan Silverfield had a tremendous first season at the helm of the Tiger Football program in 2020, leading the team to an 8-3 record and a win in the Montgomery Bowl, the first for the Tigers since 2014.
- With that victory over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl, Silverfield became the first head coach in school history to win a bowl game in his first year.
- Silverfield set the program record for winning percentage (.727) by a first-year head coach, while also matching the school mark for most wins in a debut year (Mike Norvell, 2016).
- For his efforts, he was named the 2020 Tennessee Sports Writers Association (TSWA) Coach of the Year.
- Prior to being named head coach in 2019 before the team's appearance in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic in Dallas, Silverfield served as deputy head coach and offensive line coach during the 2019 season as the Tigers won their first outright conference title in 50 years.
- Silverfield also was part of Memphis staffs that led the program to three-straight American Athletic Conference West Division crowns from 2017-19 and four-straight bowl appearances from 2016-19.
- Behind Silverfield's contributions, Memphis won 38 games during those four seasons, including going 10-3 in 2017 and 12-1 in 2019. He is the only member of the staff to be part of both 10-plus win seasons.

MADE IN MEMPHIS

- Since 2015, 12 Memphis players have been drafted by the National Football League.
- RB Kenneth Gainwell was drafted by the Philadelphia Eagles in the fifth round (150th overall) in the 2021 NFL Draft.
- With his selection, Memphis has had at least one player selected in eight-straight NFL Drafts.
- On current NFL rosters, five former Tigers are listed at running back (Antonio Gibson, Darrell Henderson, Tony Pollard, Kenneth Gainwell Patrick Taylor Jr.).
- Currently, 12 Tigers are on NFL rosters – RB Tony Pollard (Dallas), RB Patrick Taylor Jr. (Green Bay), WR Anthony Miller (Houston), RB Darrell Henderson (Los Angeles Rams), LB Wynton McManis (New Orleans), DL Bryce Huff (New York Jets), LB Genard Avery (Philadelphia), K Jake Elliott (Philadelphia), RB Kenneth Gainwell (Philadelphia), CB Arthur Maulet (Pittsburgh), RB Antonio Gibson (Washington) and CB Bobby McCain (Washington).

HENIGAN MAKES HISTORY

- Seth Henigan became the first true freshman quarterback to start a season opener in Memphis football history against Nicholls on Sept. 4.
- Henigan helped lead the Tigers to a 42-17 victory over the Colonels, going 19-for-32 for 265 yards and a touchdown.

DO-IT-ALL DOYLE

- Having never attempted a field goal in his collegiate career, Joe Doyle made it look easy against Nicholls, finishing the game 5-for-5 on field goals and 3-for-3 on extra-point attempts.
- For his efforts, Doyle was named the AAC Special Teams Player of the Week.
- Doyle finished the game with 18 points, the most for a Memphis kicker since Riley Patterson (21) since the Cotton Bowl against Penn State on Dec. 28, 2019.

GAME NOTES

HOME OPENERS

- The Tigers' game on Sept. 4 against Nicholls marked the 11th-straight season the Tigers opened at home, the longest stretch of opening a season at home in program history.
- With the 42-17 victory of Nicholls, Memphis improved to 52-49-5 all-time in home openers and to 43-60-3 in season-opening contests.
- Also with the win, the Tigers extended the team's home-opener win-streak to eight-consecutive.

TIGERS PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON AAC POLL

- Prior to the season, Memphis was picked to finish fifth in the American Athletic Conference (AAC) preseason media poll.
- The Tigers (168 points) were picked fifth behind Cincinnati (262), UCF (241), SMU (188) and Houston (181).
- Memphis won the 2019 AAC title and finished third in the league last season.

DYKES RETURNS FOR ANOTHER SEASON

- Memphis' all-time leading receiver as a tight end, Sean Dykes, will return to the Tigers for a final season in 2021.
- Prior to this season, he was named to the Mackey Award Watch List and the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List.
- Last season, Dykes earned Honorable-Mention All-American Athletic Conference honors after reeling in 47 receptions for 581 yards and seven touchdowns.
- He averaged 12.4 yards per catch and totaled two games with over 100 yards receiving, including a standout performance in the victory over USF, going for 147 yards and two scores on seven catches.
- Entering the season, Dykes has 80 receptions for 1,169 yards and 12 touchdowns in his Memphis career. He is the school-record holder for most receiving yards by a tight end.

AUSTIN EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

- Wide receiver Calvin Austin III was named to both the Maxwell Award Watch List and the Biletnikoff Award Watch List prior to the season.
- Austin III had a breakout season for the Tigers in 2020, earning First-Team All-American Athletic Conference honors. He finished the year with a team-high 63 receptions for 1,052 yards and 11 touchdowns. He also added a punt return score, averaging 9.4 yards on 20 returns.
- He also led the AAC in both receiving yards and receiving touchdowns in 2020, ranking eighth and sixth in the nation, respectively, in those categories.

QUINDELL JOHNSON LANDS ON WATCH LISTS

- Defensive back Quindell Johnson was named to the Bednarik Award Watch List, as well as the Thorpe Award Preseason Watch List before the 2021 season.
- Johnson also had a tremendous season for Memphis in 2020, earning Second-Team All-AAC accolades after totaling a team-high 81 tackles and three interceptions to go with two tackles for loss, five pass breakups, two forced fumbles and a blocked kick.
- Johnson led the conference with 60 solo tackles on the season, ranking him 22nd in the nation at 5.5 per game. He also ranked 31st in the country in interceptions.

PARHAM EARNS PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Offensive lineman Dylan Parham was named to both the Outland Trophy Preseason Watch List and the Rotary Lombardi Award Watch List.
- Parham started all 11 games at right tackle in 2020, helping Memphis rank 22nd in the nation in total offense (453.1) and finish 17th in the country in both passing offense (307.9) and first down offense (260).

BRADY REELS IN HONORS

- Prior to the season, long snapper Preston Brady was named an Allstate AFCA Good Works Team nominee, as well as to the Wuerffel Trophy Watch List.
- Brady has played in 39 games over the course of his career with the Tigers, seeing action as the team's primary holder.
- In 2019, he was named the recipient of the Peter Mortell Holder of the Year Award and was also named to the 2017-18 American Athletic Conference All-Academic team.

*GAME NOTES***MEMPHIS IN OVERTIME GAMES**

- Memphis has been involved in eight overtime games (2-6). The Tigers have played a total of four multi-overtime affairs and have a 2-2 record in those games.
- The Tigers came up just short in the 2017 American Athletic Conference Championship game in double-OT at UCF, 62-55. The Tigers and Knights combined to score 117 points, the highest total in a conference title game in FBS history.
- Memphis ended the 2014 season with the first overtime game in five seasons, defeating BYU 55-48 in double-OT at the Miami Beach Bowl.

THANK YOU, TOM III

- TOM III, the beloved Bengal Tiger mascot for the University of Memphis who was a part of one of the most glorious periods in University and athletics history, passed away on Sept. 18, 2020, less than three weeks after his 12th birthday.
- TOM III was remembered with a moving ceremony as his ashes made a final lap around the Liberty Bowl in his custom-designed, climate-controlled trailer prior to the 50-49 win over UCF on Oct. 18, as the Tigers' 21-point come-from-behind victory was the largest in school history.
- TOM III's last game attended came as the No. 16 Memphis Tigers defeated No. 21 Cincinnati in a come-from-behind, 29-24 victory in the 2019 American Athletic Conference Championship at the Liberty Bowl on Dec. 7.
- TOM III attended his first game at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium as a cub in 2008.
- He was born Aug. 31, 2008 and arrived in Memphis a few short months later on Oct. 23. His first game at the Liberty Bowl was on Nov. 22 against UCF. In 73 games attended, TOM III produced a 44-29 home record. Since he arrived in Memphis, the Tigers went 73-73 (.500) overall and 45-29 at home.
- TOM III's predecessors did not have the same level of on-field success. The university's first live mascot, TOM, recorded an 85-119-6 (.405) record from 1972-91.
- Starting in 1992, TOM II paw-trolled the sidelines and saw Memphis produce an 84-108 (.438) mark until his passing in 2008.

TIGER GREATS WHO PLAYED IN THE LEAGUE

- **Charlie Babb**, DB, member of the Miami Dolphins' undefeated, Super Bowl VIII championship team (1972-79).
- **Marcus Bell**, DT, Memphis' current director of community and Tiger alumni relations played for the Arizona Cardinals, Detroit Lions and New York Giants (2001-07).
- **John Bramlett**, LB, Pro Bowl player for both the Denver Broncos and Miami Dolphins before concluding his playing career with the New England Patriots and Atlanta Falcons (1965-71).
- **Isaac Bruce**, WR, four-time Pro Bowl selection whose 15,208 receiving yards ranks fourth all-time in the league. Played for the St. Louis Rams and San Francisco 49ers (1994-2008).
- **Ken Irwin**, DB, played for the Buffalo Bills, New Orleans Saints and Minnesota Vikings (1995-2005). Inducted into the University of Memphis Athletic Hall of Fame in 2018.
- **Harry Schuh**, OT, a member of the Oakland Raiders' All-Time Team who played in the second AFL-NFL World Championship Game. Was an All-Pro player for the Raiders before concluding his playing career with the Los Angeles Rams and Green Bay Packers (1965-74).
- **DeAngelo Williams**, RB, was a first-round draft pick by the Carolina Panthers in 2006 and rushed for over 8,000 yards in his 11 year NFL career. In 2008 and 2015, Williams was the NFL's rushing touchdowns leader. Williams is one of six Tigers to have their jerseys retired and he was inducted into the M Club Hall of Fame in 2014.
