SETTING THE SCENE

- The University of Memphis will open the 2022 season on the road against SEC rival Mississippi State on Saturday, Sept. 3 at 6:30 p.m. The game will be televised nationally on ESPNU.
- Memphis posted a record of 6-6 last season, earning the program's eighth-straight bowl appearance.
- The Tigers were named the EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl Champions after Hawai'i was unable to participate.
- The eight-consecutive bowls streak is tied for the eighth-best in the nation and is the best among all non-Power 5 programs.
- Individually, true freshman quarterback Seth Henigan had a record-breaking season in 2021, earning FWAA Freshman All-America honors. The Denton, Texas native completed 235-of-393 passes for 3,322 yards, 25 touchdowns and eight interceptions.
- On the defensive side of the ball, defensive back Quindell Johnson returns after earning All-AAC Second-Team honors for the second-straight season.
- Johnson ranked 12th in the NCAA in solo tackles (5.5) and 27th in total tackles (8.8)

SCOUTING MISSISSIPPI STATE

- In 2021, Mississippi State ended the season with an overall record of 7-6, earning a berth to the AutoZone Liberty Bowl in Memphis, losing to Texas Tech, 34-7.
- MSU was the only school in the country that faced six teams ranked in the final College Football Playoff Top 25 and was one of four teams with three wins against teams ranked in the final poll.
- Head coach Mike Leach became the first MSU head coach, at least in the modern era, to beat three teams in one season who finished ranked in a final poll.
- In 2021, quarterback Will Rogers – at only 20 years old – became the first MSU quarterback to lead the SEC in passing yards per game (364.5).
- His 4,739 passing yards are the third most in SEC single-season history.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- The meeting between Memphis and Mississippi State on Saturday will mark the 46th game between the two programs dating back to 1951.
- The Bulldogs hold a record of 34-11 over the Tigers, including a mark of 15-4 in Starkville.
- Last year, Memphis snapped MSU's 12-game winning streak in the series with a 31-29 win at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium.
- The Tigers came back from a 17-7 halftime deficit to win the contest, thanks in part to wide receiver Calvin Austin III, who had nine receptions for 105 yards and two touchdowns.
- He also returned a punt 94 yards for a score in the fourth quarter, the longest return for a Tiger since 1975.

Ryan Silverfield became the 25th head coach in Memphis football history in December 2019 and began his tenure by leading the Tigers into their first major bowl game appearance: the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic in Dallas.

In naming Silverfield, the Tigers hired from within. Silverfield served as deputy head coach and offensive line coach during the 2019 season as the Tigers won their first outright conference title in 50 years. Memphis won the 2019 American Athletic Conference championship with a 29-24 win over Cincinnati at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium.

Silverfield also was part of Memphis staffs that led the program to three-straight American Athletic Conference West Division crowns from 2017-19 and four-straight bowl appearances from 2016-19. Behind Silverfield's contributions, Memphis won 38 games during those four seasons, including going 10-3 in 2017 and 12-1 in 2019. He is the only member of the staff to be part of both 10-plus win seasons.

In 2021, Silverfield led the Tigers to the program's eighth-straight bowl game, extending the longest bowl streak of any non-Power 5 team in the country. Memphis was named EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl Champions after Hawai'i was unable to participate.

Silverfield's 14 wins in his first two seasons at the helm of the Tigers are tied for the second-most in program history and also rank him tied for fifth for most victories among all FBS second-year head coaches.

Individually, true freshman quarterback Seth Henigan had a record-breaking season, earning FWAA Freshman All-America honors. The Denton, Texas native completed 235-of-393 passes for 3,322 yards, 25 touchdowns and eight interceptions. His 3,322 passing yards shattered the school's freshman record previously held by Paxton Lynch in 2013 (2056) and rank sixth overall on the program's single-season list. His 25 touchdowns are tied for the seventh-most in school history.

Wide receiver Calvin Austin III was unanimously chosen by the AAC coaches to the first team, one of just three players to be unanimously selected. Joining Austin III on the All-AAC First Team are tight end Sean Dykes, offensive lineman Dylan Parham and linebacker JJ Russell. The four first-team honorees are the most for Memphis since the program had six in 2017. Earning second-team all-conference accolades for the Tigers are defensive lineman John Tate IV and defensive back Quindell Johnson.

In his first full season at the helm of the program in 2020, Silverfield led the Tigers to the team's first bowl victory since

2014, a 25-10 win over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl, becoming the first head coach in school history to win a bowl game in his first year.

Silverfield guided Memphis to an 8-3 record on the season, setting the program record for winning percentage (.727) by a first-year head coach, while also matching the school mark for most wins in a debut year (Mike Norvell, 2016). For his efforts, he was named the 2020 Tennessee Sports Writers Association (TSWA) Coach of the Year.

On the field, Memphis ranked 22nd in the nation in total offense (453.1) and finished 17th in the country in both passing offense (307.9) and first down offense (260). Defensively, the Tigers were 13th in turnovers gained (20), 17th in passes intercepted (12) and 19th in red zone defense (.744).

Quarterback Brady White capped his incredible career at Memphis by winning the 31st William V. Campbell Trophy, which is presented to the college football player with the best combination of academics, community service and on-field performance. White was also a First-Team Senior CLASS Award All-American, one of nine semifinalists for the Wuerfel Trophy and a top-15 candidate for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award.

Five players earned honors from the American Athletic Conference following the season, with wide receiver Calvin Austin III and defensive lineman O'Bryan Goodson being named to the first team. Defensive back Quindell Johnson was named to the second team, while both tight end Sean Dykes and defensive lineman Morris Joseph earned All-AAC Honorable-Mention accolades.

During the 2019 season, Silverfield developed a young offensive line that returned only two starters from 2018. One of starters -- Dustin Woodard -- moved to center as a regular for the first time in his collegiate career. Silverfield molded a line that blocked for the fourth-best offense in program history (6,249 yards) and the program's third-best scoring offense (527 points).

Two of Silverfield's linemen received all-conference accolades in 2019. Woodard was named to the All-American Athletic Conference second team and Dylan Parham earned all-league honorable mention recognition. Silverfield's line blocked for Kenneth Gainwell, The American's Rookie of the Year and the program's fifth 1,000-yard rusher all-time (1,425 yards), and for all-league second team performers in quarterback Brady White, wide receivers Damonte Coxie and Antonio Gibson, and tight end Joey Magnifico. White had more than 3,000 yards passing and Coxie posted more than 1,000 yards receiving, both for a second-straight campaign. After the season, Woodard was a seventh round draft selection in the 2020 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots.

Silverfield served as the offensive line coach and run game coordinator in 2018, overseeing the team's most consistent unit with all five starters playing every game. One year after blocking for an offense that featured consensus All-American wide receiver Anthony Miller and set a school record for

passing touchdowns, the offensive line spent the 2018 season in the trenches blocking for the program's first unanimous All-American in running back Darrell Henderson. During the 2018 season, Memphis set school records for total yards, points scored and rushing touchdowns. In 2017, they set the standard for passing touchdowns.

Collectively, Silverfield's 2018 unit was one of 10 semifinalists for the Joe Moore Award, given to the best offensive line in college football. For his role leading the offensive line, Silverfield was named one of six finalists for the offensive line coach of the year award sponsored by FootballScoop. Silverfield also was recognized as one of the top recruiters in his time at Memphis. In 2017, he was ranked the fourth-best recruiter in The American by 247sports.com.

A 2018 Frank Broyles Award candidate, Silverfield first came to Memphis in 2016 with more than 18 years of coaching experience at the high school, college and NFL levels. He remains the only coach to have worked with an NCAA single-season rushing leader and an NFL single-season rushing leader. At UCF, Silverfield helped tutor Kevin Smith when the junior back led college football with 2,567 yards in 2007. Five seasons later in 2012, Silverfield was at Minnesota, where the Vikings' offensive line paved the way for Adrian Peterson's 2,097-yard season.

Just prior to coming to Memphis, Silverfield spent the last half of the 2015 football campaign with the NFL's Detroit Lions. In a mid-season staff shake-up, the Lions brought in Silverfield as an assistant offensive line coach, and the hire paid immediate dividends. His tenure with the Lions was Silverfield's second stint in the NFL.

Before Silverfield's arrival, the Lions had a 2-7 record in the three games before he came on board, Detroit's offensive line allowed 15 sacks for 105 yards. In the season's final stretch, Silverfield helped mold an offensive line that propelled the Lions to a 5-2 record. The Lions' offensive line allowed just more than three sacks per game in the last seven contests, and quarterback Matthew Stafford thrived behind Silverfield's new-look offensive line. In the seven games with Silverfield on staff, Stafford threw 17 touchdowns and only one interception. Before that, Stafford had 15 touchdowns and 12 interceptions.

Preceding his 2015 mid-season jump to the NFL, Silverfield was a senior offensive analyst on head coach Todd Graham's Arizona State staff. In his short time in Tempe, Ariz., the Sun Devils posted a 5-5 record on their way to a final 6-6 regular-season mark and a Motel 6 Cactus Bowl berth.

Silverfield served as an offensive consultant at Toledo in 2014 and helped the Rockets to a 9-4 overall record and a 7-1 Mid-American Conference (MAC) mark. Toledo tied for the MAC West crown and earned a GoDaddy.com Bowl berth. The Rockets' nine wins were the most since 2001, and Toledo's 63-44 bowl victory over Arkansas State was its first postseason win since 2011.

The Rockets' offensive line helped put one of the most prolific offensive seasons in Toledo football record book. The

2014 offense set school records for total offense, total rushing yardage and first downs per game and also ranked among the program's top-five in points per game (2nd), touchdowns scored (3rd) and rushing touchdowns (3rd).

Leading the charge on Silverfield's offensive line was Greg Mancz, the 2014 Vern Smith Award/MAC Player of the Year award recipient. Mancz, also an All-America second team selection, became the first offensive lineman in MAC history to be honored as the league's Player of the Year. Fellow linemen Josh Hendershot and Jeff Myers joined Mancz in earning All-MAC recognition.

Toledo's offensive line proved fruitful for the 2014 Rockets' attack. Toledo led the MAC in scoring offense, total offense, rushing offense and first downs. Rockets running back Kareem Hunt led the MAC in rushing (1,631 yards) and was tops in the nation in yards per carry (8.0). Hunt was an All-MAC first team pick and also earned GoDaddy.com Bowl MVP honors (271 yards/5 touchdowns).

Before jumping back to the collegiate ranks, Silverfield spent six seasons on the Minnesota Vikings staff. In his time in Minnesota, Silverfield helped the Vikings to two NFC North Division crowns and three NFL playoffs appearances, including a trip to the 2009 NFC championship game. Silverfield began his Vikings' stint as an offensive quality control staffer, before moving to a defensive line staff assistant in 2009 and 2010. He moved to the offensive side from 2011-13, assisting Jeff Davidson with the offensive line.

It was in the midst of his three years working with the Minnesota offensive line that Peterson had one of the most-prolific, single-season rushing performances in NFL history. In 2012, Peterson ran for a league-best 2,097 yards, falling just eight yards shy of Eric Dickerson's NFL record of 2,105. Peterson was named the 2012 NFL MVP.

Prior to his time in the NFL, Silverfield spent the 2006 and 2007 seasons at UCF. In his two campaigns in Orlando, Fla., he served as an offensive graduate assistant his first season and moved to a defensive graduate assistant spot in 2007. Silverfield was a member of the 2007

Knights staff that led the squad to a 10-4 record, a 7-1 Conference USA mark and the C-USA East Division crown. UCF defeated Tulsa in the C-USA championship game and earned the league's AutoZone Liberty Bowl berth.

As an offensive graduate assistant, Silverfield worked with Smith in 2006. That season – Smith's sophomore campaign – he rushed for 934 yards in only nine games, setting up his explosive junior season. As a junior, Smith was the NCAA rushing champion.

In Silverfield's season working with the Knights defense, UCF ranked among the top four in C-USA in scoring defense, rushing defense, passing defense and turnovers forced. The Knights held half of their opponents to 20 or fewer points in the 2007 campaign.

In 2005, Silverfield served as the quarterbacks coach at Jacksonville University. In 2004, at the age of 23, Silverfield served as head coach at Memorial Day High School in Savannah, Ga.

A 2003 Hampden-Sydney College (Va.) graduate, Silverfield coached four seasons at his alma mater, starting as an offensive assistant in 2000. Then, at age 20, he was tapped as the Tigers defensive line coach and spent two seasons at that post (2001-02). In 2003, Silverfield moved back to offense and coached the tight ends and H-backs. That season, the Tigers went 9-1 and had the nation's No. 1 scoring offense in the country (47.0 ppg). Hampden-Sydney scored 45 or more points in seven of its 10 games in 2003.

Silverfield started coaching in 1999 at his alma mater, The Bolles School in Jacksonville, Fla. He played for the Bulldogs and was a member of two Florida state championship teams (1995 and 1998). During his playing career, Silverfield helped Bolles to a No. 1 ranking in the USA Today Super 25 national high school football poll. Immediately after his playing career, Silverfield jumped to the coaching ranks as a Bolles School assistant.

Silverfield and his wife, Mariana, live in Memphis.

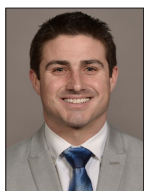

GAME NOTES

ONE OF THE ELITE PROGRAMS IN THE NATION

- Memphis has posted 71 victories since 2014, giving the Tigers the 12th-most wins in the nation during that stretch along with Oklahoma State and San Diego State.
- The 71 wins are the most among American Athletic Conference schools during that stretch.
- The Tigers also rank 14th in the country in winning percentage dating back to 2014 with their 71-32 (.689) mark.

RARE ROAD OPENER

- Memphis will start the season on the road for the first time since the 2010 season on Saturday.
- The last time the Tigers opened a year away from Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium was on Sept. 4, 2010 - a 49-7 loss at Mississippi State.
- The road opener snaps an 11-year streak of opening seasons at home for Memphis.
- The Tigers are 43-60-3 all-time in season-opening contests.

YOUTH IS SERVED

- Nine redshirt-sophomores or younger are currently listed as starters on the Memphis offensive and defensive depth charts.
- Of the 62 players listed on the depth chart, a total of 32 (51.6%) are redshirt-sophomores or younger.
- Memphis ranks 12th in the nation in percentage of underclassmen on the roster at 70.5%.
- Of the 119 student-athletes on the team, 84 (43 freshmen, 41 sophomores) are underclassmen, which is tied for 16th-most in the country.
- In 2021, Memphis played a total of 27 redshirt or true freshmen. Of that total, 12 were true freshmen.

SIVLERFIELD'S START

- Ryan Silverfield is tied for the second most wins (14) in his first two seasons as head coach in program history.
- Silverfield is also tied for fifth nationally in most wins among coaches entering their third seasons in 2022.

STANDOUT SOPHOMORE

- Quarterback Seth Henigan posted one of the best seasons in program history in 2021 and he did it as a true freshman.
- In 2021, Henigan earned FWAA Freshman All-America honors after starting all 11 games in which he played for the Tigers.
- The Denton, Texas native completed 235-of-393 passes for 3,322 yards, 25 touchdowns and eight interceptions.
- His 3,322 passing yards shattered the school's freshman record previously held by Paxton Lynch in 2013 (2056) and rank sixth overall on the program's single-season list. His 25 touchdowns are tied for the seventh-most in school history.
- Henigan also became the first true freshman quarterback to start a season opener in school history.

EIGHT-STRAIGHT BOWLS

- Memphis' appearance in the 2021 EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl marked the eighth-straight season that the Tigers have made a bowl game.
- The 2021 EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl was canceled due to Hawai'i being unable to participate.
- The eight-straight bowl game streak is tied for the eighth-best in the nation and is the best among all non-Power 5 programs.

JOHNSON EARNS SPOTS ON NUMEROUS WATCHLISTS

- After a standout season in 2021, defensive back Quindell Johnson was named to numerous preseason watchlists prior to the year.
- Johnson was named to the Reese's Senior Bowl Watchlist, the Bednarik Award Preseason Watchlist, the Bronko Nagurski Trophy Watchlist, the Paycom Jim Thorpe Award Preseason Watchlist and the Wuerffel Trophy Watchlist.
- A preseason First-Team All-AAC choice by Phil Steele this year, Johnson was named second-team All-AAC for the second-straight season in 2021 after ranking second in the conference in total tackles (104) and solo tackles (66).
- He also ranked third in the league in tackles per game (8.7) and sixth in pass breakups (11). Johnson also had 4.5 tackles for loss, one sack and one interception on the year.

TIGERS PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON AAC POLL

- Prior to the season, Memphis was picked to finish fifth in the American Athletic Conference (AAC) preseason media poll.
- The Tigers (162 points) were picked fifth behind Houston (243), Cincinnati (242), UCF (225) and SMU (187).
- Memphis won the AAC Championship in 2019, 29-24, over No. 24-ranked Cincinnati.

GAME NOTES**HENIGAN NAMED TO PRESTIGIOUS MANNING AWARD WATCHLIST**

- Following a historic true freshman season in 2021, quarterback Seth Henigan was named to the prestigious Manning Award Watchlist in August.
- Henigan was the only true sophomore of the 30 honorees named to the Manning Award Watchlist.
- The Denton, Texas native was also named to the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watchlist.
- In 2021, Henigan earned FWAA Freshman All-America honors after starting all 11 games in which he played for the Tigers. He completed 235-of-393 passes for 3,322 yards, 25 touchdowns and eight interceptions.
- His 3,322 passing yards shattered the school's freshman record previously held by Paxton Lynch in 2013 (2056) and rank sixth overall on the program's single-season list. His 25 touchdowns are tied for the seventh-most in school history.

LIKES EARNS SPOT ON RIMINGTON TROPHY PRESEASON WATCHLIST

- Offensive lineman Jacob Likes was named to the Rimington Trophy Preseason Watchlist prior to the 2022 season.
- In 2021, Likes started all 11 games in which he appeared for the Tigers, allowing just two sacks and three quarterback hurries in 451 pass protection snaps.
- He helped Memphis rank 16th in the nation in passing offense (298.8) and 38th in total offense (434.9).
- For his career, Likes has appeared in 19 games and is a three-time AAC All-Academic Team honoree.

DOYLE NAMED TO RAY GUY AWARD WATCHLIST

- Punter Joe Doyle was named to the Ray Guy Award Watchlist for the second-straight season.
- In 2021, he punted 41 times on the season for an average of 46.0 per attempt with four touchbacks, 14 fair catches, 16 inside the 20-yard line and 16 punts of over 50 yards.
- Doyle currently ranks in a tie for third on the program's career punting average list at 46.0.

DUCKSWORTH NAMED NOMINEE FOR ALLSTATE'S 31ST AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM

- Defensive lineman Wardalis Ducksworth was named a nominee for Allstate's 31st Good Works Team.
- Ducksworth has appeared in 25 games over the past three seasons for the Tigers, totaling 56 tackles, nine tackles for loss, nine sacks and two fumble recoveries.
- Off the field, Ducksworth has been very involved, helping recruit people for Be The Match, a bone marrow drive, as well as volunteering with LeBonheur Children's Hospital.
- He also has volunteered with the Madonna Learning Center, Read Across America, Sea Isle Elementary and the Holiday Heroes gift Wrapping Party.

TRANSFORMATIVE RENOVATIONS ANNOUNCED FOR SIMMONS BANK LIBERTY STADIUM

- The University of Memphis and the City of Memphis have announced plans to pursue a \$150-200 million renovation to Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium to revitalize and modernize the home of Memphis Tiger Football.
- Priority elements of the wide-ranging project include a transformation of the stadium's west side, providing several innovative premium seating options, creating a hospitality experience within the halo space surrounding the stadium, other new seating options, such as family boxes on the north end and party deck patios for students on the south end and a potential repurpose and retrofit of the east side suite tower.
- The goal for completion of the project is prior to the 2025 football season.

MEMPHIS ATHLETICS UNVEILS MAXIMUM

- In response to the July 1, 2021 NCAA ruling permitting student-athletes to use their Name, Image, and Likeness (NIL) for personal gain, the University of Memphis launched MaximUM—an in-house NIL resource program designed to help student-athletes get the maximum out of their NIL.
- Bridget Perine leads MaximUM as the Student-Athlete Branding + Image Coordinator and is one of only 21 professionals across the NCAA dedicated to NIL.
- MaximUM provides best-in-class education and services to student-athletes as well as resources for the community to equip individuals and businesses with the knowledge and understanding of NIL.
- Memphis Marketplace, powered by Opendorse and launched in May, was one of the first school-specific NIL marketplaces, creating a consumer-facing avenue for completing deals.
- Now, Memphis fans, brands, sponsors, and donors can browse, book, pitch, and pay any Memphis student-athlete for NIL activities in one compliant platform, built specifically for the athletes' needs.

BEST AGAINST THE BEST

- Since 2012, Memphis has posted a record of 8-13 (.381) against top-25 ranked opponents.
- The .381 winning percentage ranks the Tigers 19th overall in the nation among teams with at least 20 games against top-25 foes.
- The winning percentage is also the best mark for any non-Power 5 team in the country.

GAME NOTES

STERLING START

- Head coach Ryan Silverfield had a tremendous first season at the helm of the Tiger Football program in 2020, leading the team to an 8-3 record and a win in the Montgomery Bowl, the first for the Tigers since 2014.
- With that victory over Florida Atlantic in the Montgomery Bowl, Silverfield became the first head coach in school history to win a bowl game in his first year.
- Silverfield set the program record for winning percentage (.727) by a first-year head coach, while also matching the school mark for most wins in a debut year (Mike Norvell, 2016).
- For his efforts, he was named the 2020 Tennessee Sports Writers Association (TSWA) Coach of the Year.
- Prior to being named head coach in 2019 before the team's appearance in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic in Dallas, Silverfield served as deputy head coach and offensive line coach during the 2019 season as the Tigers won their first outright conference title in 50 years.
- Silverfield also was part of Memphis staffs that led the program to three-straight American Athletic Conference West Division crowns from 2017-19 and four-straight bowl appearances from 2016-19.
- Behind Silverfield's contributions, Memphis won 38 games during those four seasons, including going 10-3 in 2017 and 12-1 in 2019. He is the only member of the staff to be part of both 10-plus win seasons.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Memphis has had a great home field advantage at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium, posting a record of 36-5 (.878) since head coach Ryan Silverfield joined the coaching staff in 2016.
- As a head coach, Silverfield is 11-2 (.846) at the Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium.

NON-SATURDAY SUCCESS

- Since the start of 2014, Memphis is 22-5 (.815) in non-Saturday games.
- Memphis is 14-3 (.824) in games on Friday since 2014.
- The Tigers are 6-0 in Thursday night games and 10-0 at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in non-Saturday games.
- Memphis will host Houston on Friday, Oct. 7 at 6:30 p.m. and Tulsa on Thursday, Nov. 10 this season.

SIX TIGERS EARN ALL-AAC HONORS IN 2021

- Six Tigers earned All-AAC honors following the completion of the regular season.
- Wide receiver Calvin Austin III was unanimously chosen by the AAC coaches to the first team, one of just three players to be unanimously selected.
- Joining Austin III on the All-AAC First Team are tight end Sean Dykes, offensive lineman Dylan Parham and linebacker JJ Russell.
- The four first-team honorees are the most for Memphis since the program had six in 2017.
- Earning second-team all-conference accolades for the Tigers are defensive lineman John Tate IV and defensive back Quindell Johnson.

MADE IN MEMPHIS

- Since 2015, 13 Memphis players have been drafted by the National Football League.
- OL Dylan Parham was selected in the third round of the 2022 NFL Draft by the Las Vegas Raiders, while WR Calvin Austin III was taken by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the fourth round.
- With the selections, Memphis has had at least one player selected in nine-straight NFL Drafts, with 15 players being taken over that span.
- On current NFL rosters, five former Tigers are listed at running back (Antonio Gibson, Darrell Henderson, Tony Pollard, Kenneth Gainwell and Patrick Taylor Jr.).
- Currently, 16 Tigers are on NFL rosters – RB Tony Pollard (Dallas), PK Riley Patterson (Detroit Lions), RB Patrick Taylor Jr. (Green Bay), DB Jacobi Francis (Houston), RB Darrell Henderson Jr. (Los Angeles Rams), OL Dylan Parham (Las Vegas), DL Bryce Huff (New York Jets), K Jake Elliott (Philadelphia), RB Kenneth Gainwell (Philadelphia), WR Calvin Austin III (Pittsburgh), CB Arthur Maulet (Pittsburgh), WR Anthony Miller (Pittsburgh), LB Genard Avery (Tampa Bay), LB JJ Russell (Tampa Bay), RB Antonio Gibson (Washington) and DB Bobby McCain (Washington).

MEMPHIS IN OVERTIME GAMES

- Memphis has been involved in nine overtime games (2-7). The Tigers have played a total of four multi-overtime affairs and have a 2-2 record in those games.
- The Tigers came up just short in the 2017 American Athletic Conference Championship game in double-OT at UCF, 62-55. The Tigers and Knights combined to score 117 points, the highest total in a conference title game in FBS history.
- Memphis ended the 2014 season with the first overtime game in five seasons, defeating BYU 55-48 in double-OT at the Miami Beach Bowl.

GAME NOTES**THANK YOU, TOM III**

- TOM III, the beloved Bengal Tiger mascot for the University of Memphis who was a part of one of the most glorious periods in University and athletics history, passed away on Sept. 18, 2020, less than three weeks after his 12th birthday.
- TOM III was remembered with a moving ceremony as his ashes made a final lap around Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium in his custom-designed, climate-controlled trailer prior to the 50-49 win over UCF on Oct. 18, as the Tigers' 21-point come-from-behind victory was the largest in school history.
- TOM III's last game attended came as the No. 16 Memphis Tigers defeated No. 21 Cincinnati in a come-from behind, 29-24 victory in the 2019 American Athletic Conference Championship at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium on Dec. 7.
- TOM III attended his first game at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium as a cub in 2008.
- He was born Aug. 31, 2008 and arrived in Memphis a few short months later on Oct. 23. His first game at Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium was on Nov. 22 against UCF. In 73 games attended, TOM III produced a 44-29 home record. Since he arrived in Memphis, the Tigers went 73-73 (.500) overall and 45-29 at home.

- **Ken Irwin**, DB, played for the Buffalo Bills, New Orleans Saints and Minnesota Vikings (1995-2005). Inducted into the University of Memphis Athletic Hall of Fame in 2018.
- **Harry Schuh**, OT, a member of the Oakland Raiders' All-Time Team who played in the second AFL-NFL World Championship Game. Was an All-Pro player for the Raiders before concluding his playing career with the Los Angeles Rams and Green Bay Packers (1965-74).
- **DeAngelo Williams**, RB, was a first-round draft pick by the Carolina Panthers in 2006 and rushed for over 8,000 yards in his 11-year NFL career. In 2008 and 2015, Williams was the NFL's rushing touchdowns leader. Williams is one of six Tigers to have their jerseys retired and he was inducted into the M Club Hall of Fame in 2014.
