### ARIZONA NOTES & NUMBERS

» The Arizona Wildcats welcome SEC foe Mississippi State to Arizona Stadium for their 2022 home opener on Saturday night. Kickoff is set for 8:00 p.m. MST.

» Saturday's game will be nationally televised on FS1 with Alex Faust (PxP) and Petros Papadakis (Analyst) on the call.

» Arizona is 91-21-5 all-time in home openers, but have lost each of their last two. The Wildcats last home-opening win came against Northern Arizona on Sept. 7, 2019, a 65-41 victory.

» This is the first all-time meeting between Arizona and Mississippi State. The Wildcats are 1-5-1 all-time against SEC opponents.

» Arizona's 38 points in last weekend's win over SDSU was the team's highest single-game scoring output since 2019. The Wildcats scored 20+ points only twice during the 2021 season and surpassed the mark in the first half at SDSU.

» During the offseason, the Wildcats signed a nationally lauded recruiting class that ranked second in the Pac-12 and 22nd nationally. Arizona's 2022 class included wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan, a five-star recruit and the highest ranked prospect in program history.

» Arizona's incoming class also featured quarterback Jayden de Laura, who was selected as the 2021 Pac-12 Offensive Freshman Player of the Year after throwing for 2,796 yards and 23 touchdowns at Washington State.

» Punter Kyle Ostendorf earned Preseason First Team All-Pac-12 honors, while wide receiver Jacob Cowing and defensive lineman Kyon Barrs earned a spot on the Second Team. Defensive back Christian Roland-Wallace earned Honorable Mention recognition.

**WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCES**

Head Coach Jedd Fisch is available twice weekly at press conferences each Monday and Thursday of game weeks during the regular season. For road games, each locker room situation will dictate postgame protocol. **VERSUS MISSISSIPPI STATE AND THE SEC:** This is the first all-time meeting between Arizona and Mississippi State. The Wildcats are 1-5-1 all-time against the Southeastern Conference (SEC), with their only win coming against Auburn 31-19 at Arizona Stadium on Sept. 11, 1976. It marks the first meeting against an SEC foe since 2006 when Arizona played Louisiana State (LSU) in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

**ABOUT LAST WEEKEND:** The Wildcats won their season opener at San Diego State, 38-20, to earn the first road victory for Head Coach Jedd Fisch. It was Arizona's first road win since beating Colorado 35-30 on Oct. 5, 2019. Arizona improved to 84-30-5 all-time in season openers and snapped a four-year streak of season-opening losses. It was the Wildcats first season-opening win since a 62-24 victory over Northern Arizona in 2017, and their first season-opening win over an FBS opponent since taking down UTSA 42-32 in 2015. The Wildcats 38 points were the most scored by the program since a 56-38 loss to Oregon State on Nov. 2, 2019.

**DESERT SWARMED:** Arizona's defense held San Diego State to just 62 yards through the air, the fewest passing yards allowed since holding The Citadel to 21 yards through the air in week two of 2010. The Aztecs combined to go just 7-for-16 through the air with one interception. The Wildcat's defense forced a three-and-out on San Diego State's opening possession of the game, a feat accomplished just three times in 2021. Linebacker Jerry Roberts made a career-high 12 tackles to lead the Arizona defensive attack. Roberts bested his previous high of 10 against Utah in 2021. Junior safety Jaxen Turner picked up the Wildcats first interception of the year after Arizona logged just four during the 2021 season. It was Turner's first career INT.

**MR. CONSISTENCY:** Transfer wide receiver Jacob Cowing made an immediate impact for the Wildcats in their week one victory over San Diego State, hauling in eight catches for 152 yards and three touchdowns. With last weekend's performance and dating back through his time at UTEP, Cowing has now recorded at least one reception in 33 consecutive games, tied for the second-longest active streak among all FBS players. During that 33-game stretch, which includes every college game he has logged time in, Cowing has posted multiple catches 28 times and 5+ receptions 18 times.

**JUST GETTING STARTED:** Sophomore quarterback Jayden de Laura had a breakout first game with Arizona, throwing for 299 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Wildcats to a 38-20 win on the road. He improved to 6-0 in his collegiate career when throwing three-plus touchdowns. De Laura's four touchdown passes were the most by an Arizona QB in their Wildcat debut since Anu Solomon threw four against UNLV in 2014. He completed 29-of-35 passes and connected with Jacob Cowing three times for touchdowns, as well as Tetairoa McMillan once for a TD. De Laura led Washington State to a 7-6 record and a berth in the Sun Bowl after throwing for 2,798 yards and 23 touchdowns on 227-for-359 passing. He was named 2021 All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention. De Laura threw multiple touchdown passes in eight games and led WSU

to their first Apple Cup victory since 2012. He earned Rose Bowl Game Pac-12 Player of the Week honors after win over Oregon State in which he threw for a career-high 399 yards and three scores. As a first-year freshman in 2020 went 78-of-129 passing for 886 yards and five touchdowns in four games. De Laura prepped at powerhouse program St. Louis High School in Honolulu and helped lead program to two state championships. He went 11-0 and won state as a junior to earn second team All-Hawaii recognition. Followed that up with an undefeated season as a senior, steering team to 12-0 finish and another state championship. De Laura was honored as a High School All-American according to MaxPreps. He was named 2019 Hawai'i Gatorade Player of the Year. De Laura, as a senior in 2019, threw for 3,452 yards and 29 touchdowns on 228-of-319 passing. Up for a challenge? De Laura's full name is: Jayden pūkonakona ha'awi mai nā makua hā 'ele mai ka hiapo e wili 'ia me ke aloha de Laura.

**A GAME OF FIRSTS:** Head Coach Jedd Fisch led the Wildcats to their first road victory under his leadership and the first road win of his coaching career. Freshman wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan made the first touchdown reception of his collegiate career on a six-yard pass from de Laura. Junior wide receiver Jacob Cowing posted a career performance during his first game with the Wildcats, making eight catches for 152 yards and three touchdowns. It was the most receiving touchdowns in a debut for a Wildcat since Cayleb Jones hauled in three scores through the air against California on Sept. 20, 2014. It was the first time that a player making their Power Five debut scored three touchdowns since Texas Tech's Michael Crabtree in 2007. Redshirt freshman safety Dalton Johnson blocked a punt on SDSU's second drive, marking the first of his career. Last season, Arizona led the Pac-12 and ranked 17th nationally with two blocked punts. Running back DJ Williams set the tone on the ground in his first game with Arizona, gaining 88 yards and recording one touchdown.

**BUILDING UNDER HEAD COACH JEDD FISCH:** The Wildcats enter the second season of the Jedd Fisch era with a reenergized roster in tow. Coach Fisch and staff pulled in the No.21/No. 22 recruiting class nationally (per Rivals/247Sports) with key additions at multiple positions. That recruiting class ranked first (per Rivals) and third (per 247Sports) in the Pac-12 behind Oregon and Stanford. Fisch reeled in 23 commits with five four-stars and 18 three-stars. Arizona landed the highest-ranked recruit in program history, wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan out of Servite High School. A five-star prospect that was ranked No. 5 at his position. McMillan was joined by teammates Keyan Burnett (TE), a four-star tight end, and Noah Fifita (QB) a three-star QB, out of Servite HS in Anaheim. The success in recruiting marked one of the top classes in program history.

**ON THE RUN:** Senior running back DJ Williams gained a team-leading 88 yards and rushed for one touchdown during his Arizona debut against San Diego State. He averaged 6.29 yards per rush and recorded a long rush of 17 yards. It marked the third-most rushing yards in a single game for his career, and most since 2019 with Auburn. Williams joins the Wildcats after three seasons with Florida State (2021) and Auburn (2019-20). The running back room combined to gain 162 yards with freshman Jonah Coleman adding 42 yards on 13 attempts, junior Michael Wiley rushing six times for 34 yards, and freshman Rayshon 'Speedy' Luke adding 12 yards on four carries.

**PAVING THE WAY:** Offensive lineman Jordan Morgan appeared in all 74 offensive snaps and did not allow a sack or a hurry during the 20th game of his collegiate career last weekend at SDSU. Morgan was named to the preseason watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy, which is presented to the FBS player who best combines exemplary community service with leadership achievements on and off the field. Morgan was one of 115 players to make the initial list. A native of Marana just north of Tucson, Morgan has established himself as a consistent force on the Wildcats offensive line. After appearing in eight games over his first two seasons in Tucson he took over the regular starting left tackle during the 2021 season, starting in each of Arizona's final 11 games of the year.

**TREMENDOUS TRANSFER:** Jacob Cowing (Jr.) had a breakout game during his debut with Arizona. He made eight catches for 152 yards and three touchdowns to help the Wildcats to a season-opening 38-20 win at San Diego State. The junior from Maricopa, Cowing was named to the Maxwell Award Watch List, Biletnikoff Award Watch List, East-West Shrine Bowl 1000, preseason Second-Team All-Pac-12, and the Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List. Cowing played three seasons at UTEP prior to transferring to Arizona. He led the Miners in receiving yards all three years, including a 2021 campaign in which he finished with 69 receptions for 1,354 yards and seven touchdowns. Cowing earned First Team All-Conference USA honors in 2021 and Second Team recognition in 2020. He finished the 2021 season ranked ninth nationally among all FBS players in receiving yards (1,354). For his career at UTEP, he hauled in 141 receptions, 2,595 yards and 13 touchdowns.

**SERVITE CONNECTION:** The Wildcats have four freshmen out of Servite High School entering the 2022 season. Tight end Keyan Burnett, quarterback Noah Fifita, linebacker Jacob Manu, and wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan. Fifita led Servite to an appearance in the 2021 CIF Southern Section title game, passing for over 300 yards and two touchdowns against Mater Dei. McMillan caught 15 passes for 163 yards and a pair of touchdowns in the first meeting between the two teams.

**FOUR WILDCATS NAMED PRESEASON PAC-12:** Kyle Ostendorp is selected First-Team All-Pac-12, Jacob Cowing and Kyon Barrs are honored with Second-Team selections, and Christian Roland-Wallace are named honorable mention following a vote among media members. Ostendorp (1st Team) was fourth in the nation in 2021, in average punt distance (49.2), leading the Pac-12 last season. He kicked the longest punt of the season, 71 yards against San Diego State on Sept. 11, and punted for 2,852 total yards on his way to 2021 All-Pac-12 First Team honors. Cowing (2nd Team) was a standout at UTEP prior to transferring to Arizona. He led the Miners in receiving all three seasons, including a 2021 campaign when he finished with 69 receptions for 1,354 yards and seven touchdowns. Cowing was named First Team All-Conference USA honors in 2021 and Second Team recognition in 2020. Barrs (2nd Team) earned All-Pac-12 Second Team in 2021, after making 33 tackles for loss, and a team-leading five sacks. He finished tied for eighth in the Pac-12 in sacks a season ago. Barrs was named to the Lott IMPACT Trophy Watch List yesterday and has made 63 total tackles including 8.0 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks through 26 games played over three seasons. Roland-Wallace earned honorable mention after making 48 tackles, good for fourth-most on the team in 2021. Recorded 1.5 sacks marking the first of his career with a half sack against UCLA and a solo sack at Washington State.

**247SPORTS PRESEASON TRUE FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICAN TEAM:** Freshman offensive lineman Jonah Savaiinaea and freshman wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan made the 247 Sports preseason true freshman all-American team for 2022. These are players who have "next" in college football. It might be from Week 1 of the season, or it could be much later in the year, but these 247Sports Preseason True Freshmen All-Americans are players who will have an impact on the 2022 season, based on feedback from across our network of local scouts and analysts.

**KYLE AWESOMEDORP:** Punter Kyle Ostendorp (Jr.) has pulled in numerous preseason honors after being selected to the Sporting News Second-Team All-America team, East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 watch list, preseason First Team All-Pac-12 team, Ray Guy Award watch list, for the nation's top punter, First Team Pro Football Network Honors, AP Preseason Second-Team All-American. Ostendorp set an Arizona record and led the Pac-12 averaging 49.2 yards per punt. He posted a Pac-12 best 28 punts that traveled 50+ yards and downed 17 inside the 20.

**MAKING AN IMPACT:** Defensive lineman Kyon Barrs (Jr.) added his name to the award watch list season. Barrs has put his name on Lott IMPACT Trophy Watch List, Second-Team All-Pac-12, East-West Shrine Bowl 1000, and Outland Trophy Watch List

**NEW FACES ON THE COACHING STAFF:** Arizona hired Johnny Nansen to be the Defensive Coordinator following the departure of Don Brown after last season. Nansen spent the previous two seasons coaching the defensive line for UCLA and has coached in the Pac-12 since 2009. Once aboard with the Wildcats, Nansen played a key role in building Arizona's 2022 signing class that ranked second in the Pac-12, 22nd nationally, and included the first five-star signee in program history. Jason Kaufusi joined the Wildcats as an Assistant Coach in charge of Defensive Ends and Outside Linebackers. Kaufusi came from UCLA as well, where he was the outside linebackers coach from three seasons from 2019-21. In 2021, Kaufusi coached alongside new Arizona defensive coordinator Johnny Nansen and helped the UCLA defense rank second in the Pac-12 in sacks per game (2.2) and rushing defense (124.2).

During 2021 fall camp, Jalen Harris won the No. 1 on defense and Stanley Berryhill III won No. 1 on offense. Harris carried over No. 1 for the defense into 2022. It was announced that wide receiver Anthony Simpson would don the No. 1 jersey. Simpson earned the jersey after his effort on special teams and offense during fall camp. "We made a decision that Anthony Simpson has done an incredible job on special teams," Head Coach Jedd Fisch said, "He's committed to being a four-core guy." In 2021, Harris finished fifth on the team in tackles (47) marking a career high, including six tackles for loss and four sacks.

**#ITSPERSONAL:** The No. 1 message Jedd Fisch has been pushing since he arrived on campus in December 2020 is "It's Personal." It's not just a catchy slogan that gets printed on shirts and that you see on social media, it is how the Arizona Football program is approaching every aspect of the 2022 season. From how the team plays on the field to how the coaches work on the recruiting trail... Its Personal.

**POLYNESIAN PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST:** Freshman wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan is joined by fellow freshman Jonah Savaiinaea (OL) and sophomore transfer defensive lineman Tiaoalii Savea on the Polynesian Player of the Year Watch List, as voted on by members of the Polynesian Hall of Fame. McMillan and Savaiinaea were also selected to the 247 Sports True Freshman All-American Team. The Award is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player of Polynesian ancestry that epitomizes great ability and integrity. The Watch List is composed of 85 players from 43 different FBS schools.

**FOUR WILDCATS ON REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST:** Junior wide receiver Jacob Cowing, redshirt senior defensive lineman Jalen Harris, junior cornerback Christian Roland-Wallace, and senior safety Christian Young were selected to the Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List. The Reese's Senior Bowl is the nation's most prestigious college all-star game, as it annually serves as the first step of the NFL draft process, which explains their hashtag, #TheDraftStartsInMOBILE. The Reese's Senior Bowl has had 106 total players and 36 selected in the first three rounds of the 2021 NFL Draft. The 106 figure represents 41% of the total draft. Next year's game will be held February 4, 2023, and broadcast live on NFL Network. Practices are live on ESPN; with NFL Network producing a daily recap show airing in primetime.

Veteran NFL and college coach Jedd Fisch was hired as the head coach of Arizona Football on Dec. 23, 2020. He enters his second season with the Wildcats in 2022. Fisch came to Arizona after eight years of coaching at the collegiate level, including stints in the ACC, Big Ten and Pac-12 and 13 years in the NFL, most recently with the New England Patriots.

Fisch's first year with the Wildcats in 2021 was highlighted by a marked defensive improvement, his first win at Arizona, and seven All-Pac-12 selections. Under his leadership, the Cats placed two players on the All-Pac-12 First Team for the first time in over a decade.

Under the guidance of Fisch and defensive coordinator Don Brown, the Wildcats defense finished the 2021 season ranked fifth in the Pac-12 in total defense, up from a 12th-place finish the year prior. Defensive linemen Kyon Barrs (second team) and Trevon Mason (HM), along with linebacker Anthony Pandey (HM) all earned All-Conference nods.

Fisch's first win at Arizona came in dramatic fashion, with a Michael Wiley rushing touchdown in the waning minutes sealing the Wildcats 10-3 victory over the visiting California Golden Bears.

Following his first season leading the Wildcats, Fisch and his staff successfully inked the nationally-lauded 2022 signing class. His first complete signing class, which included the first five-star player in program history, ranked second in the Pac-12 and 22nd nationally according to 247Sports. The 2022 class was headlined by five-star wide receiver Tetairoa McMillan, high school quarterback Noah Fifita, transfer quarterback Jayden de Laura, and numerous other highly-touted prep players and transfers. De Laura, who transferred to Arizona from Washington State, was named the 2021 Pac-12 Offensive Freshman of the Year after passing for 2,757 yards and 23 touchdowns with the Cougars.

The 44-year-old Fisch has been a part of championship seasons throughout his career, including with the Los Angeles Rams as a member of head coach Sean McVay's staff as the Rams won the NFC championship and appeared in Super Bowl LIII. Fisch's coaching pedigree also includes working under future NFL Hall of Famers Bill Belichick and Pete Carroll, as well as college football Hall of Fame member Steve Spurrier and Michigan's Jim Harbaugh.

Fisch has served on coaching staffs that reached five bowl games, highlighted by the 2016 Orange Bowl when he served as Michigan's passing game coordinator. His college coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Florida under Spurrier as the Gators advanced to the 2000 Citrus Bowl and the 2001 Sugar Bowl and won a SEC championship.

A widely-respected offensive mind, Fisch has helped guide top offenses in the NFL with three of his offenses finishing in the Top 10 in total offense, including the top-ranked offense with the Denver Broncos and the second-ranked offense with the Rams. While offensive coordinator at UCLA in 2017, Fisch guided the Bruins' offense to a top-three ranking in the Pac-12 before leading the Bruins in their final regular season game and to the Cactus Bowl as the interim head coach.

Fisch arrived in Tucson after spending the 2020 season as the quarterbacks coach for the New England Patriots. Prior to his position with the Patriots, Fisch spent two seasons as a member of McVay's offensive staff with the Rams as they posted the top offense in the NFL in 2018 with quarterback Jared Goff making back-to-back Pro Bowls.

Fisch's offense at Michigan produced the Big Ten's top scoring and red zone offenses, as tight end Jake Butt won the Mackey

Award and consensus All-America honors in 2016. Butt was one of 10 offensive players for Michigan to receive All-Big Ten honors that season. Fisch's impact was instant on the Wolverine offense as Jake Rudock became only the second quarterback in school history at the time to throw for more than 3,000 yards in a season.

In his second and third seasons as a college coach, the University of Miami's offense flourished under Fisch's quarterback tutelage. Stephen Morris set a single-season record for total offense with 3,415 yards in 2012 after Jacory Harris set a single-season Miami record with an efficient 65.0% completion for the season. Fisch first coached in a full-time capacity in college with the Minnesota Golden Gophers, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks' coach in 2009.

Fisch broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the Houston Texans in 2001, serving as an assistant to head coach Dom Capers. He would go on to join the coaching staffs with the Broncos, Baltimore Ravens, Seattle Seahawks and Jacksonville Jaguars working for head coaches Mike Shanahan, Brian Billick, Pete Carroll and Gus Bradley respectively.

Fisch is a native of Livingston, N.J. and graduated from the University of Florida with a degree in Criminology in 1998. He earned his Master's degree from the University of Florida.

Fisch and his wife, Amber, have three daughters: Zaylee, Ashlee and Kendall.

**SAN DIEGO (AP)** — Jayden de Laura threw four touchdown passes, three to fellow transfer Jacob Cowing, and Arizona beat San Diego State 38-20 on a sizzling Saturday to spoil the debut of Snapdragon Stadium.

The Aztecs (0-1) waited two years for their new stadium to be built next to where 70,000-seat SDCCU Stadium once stood, and then were embarrassed by the Wildcats (1-0) on a 100-degree day. SDSU announced a sellout of 34,046. Many seats were empty at kickoff and the east stands, totally exposed to the sun, were mostly empty by the fourth quarter.

Arizona avenged a 38-14 loss to SDSU in its home opener last year during a 1-11 season. De Laura, who transferred from Washington State, completed 22 of 35 passes for 299 yards. He was intercepted once. Cowing, a transfer from UTEP, had eight catches for 152 yards.

The Wildcats sacked transfer Braxton Burmeister on the first play from scrimmage, forced SDSU to punt and then scored the stadium's first points on Tyler Loop's 25-yard field goal.

De Laura, the Pac-12 Freshman Offensive Player of the Year at Washington State last season, hit Cowing for on a 17-yard pass for a 10-0 lead and then found freshman Tetairoa McMillan on a 4-yarder to make it 17-3 midway through the second quarter.

SDSU pulled to 17-10 on Burmeister's 11-yard pass to Tyrell Shavers. The Aztecs had a great chance to tie the game after Noah Tumblyn intercepted de Laura at the 40. Chance Bell rumbled into the end zone from 25 yards, but the play came back on a holding penalty. Jaxen Turner intercepted Burmeister on the next play and returned it 20 yards to set up de Laura's 4-yard scoring pass to Cowing with 28 seconds left in the first half.

Arizona took the opening kickoff of the second half and moved 75 yards in five plays, with Cowing pulling in a 25-yard scoring pass for a 31-10 lead.

SDSU scored 10 points in just more than three minutes to close to 31-20. Punting from his own end zone, Arizona's Kyle Ostendorf booted the ball into a lineman's backside and Jaylon Armstead recovered for a touchdown. Jack Browning kicked a 23-yard field goal.

THE TAKEAWAY

Arizona looked nothing like the team that staggered to a 1-11 finish in coach Jedd Fisch's first season. The Wildcats reloaded with 50 new players, including 11 from the transfer portal. De Laura transferred from WSU after throwing for 2,796 yards and 23 touchdowns, while Cowing moved over from UTEP after tallying 1,354 yards receiving.
