## Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss is competing in its 103rd season in football, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 595-425-27, which is the 38th best among Division I FBS teams by winning percentage (.581).
- Hopson, who has led the Golden Eagles to winning seasons in each of his first three years, coached under the legendary Jeff Bower twice at Southern Miss, working as an assistant coach from 2001-03 and from 2005-07.
- Southern Miss has captured four-straight winning seasons and 22 over the last 25 campaigns. They set a school record for victories in 2011 with 12.
- The Golden Eagle will play only five home games for the first time since 2013 this fall and only the third time since 2005. They opened the season with a 38-10 home victory last weekend over Alcorn State, giving them five-straight home victories dating back to last season.
- Despite missing a bowl game last season, the Golden Eagles have been to 25 postseason bowls in its history - posting an 11-14 record in those games.

## The Mississippi State Series

- Southern Miss and Mississippi State have met 29 times in football with the teams tied in the series at 14-14-1. Two of the Golden Eagle victories, in 1975 and 1976 were awarded as forfeit victories. (For a complete breakdown of the series, please go to page five of the notes)
- The series, which dates back to the 1935 season, returned after a 24-year hiatus in 2014 with MSU capturing a 49-0 decision in Starkville. The two teams returned to Hattiesburg the following year with the Bulldogs taking a 34-16 decision in front of a Southern Miss record crowd of 36,641 on Sept. 5, 2015.
- Southern Miss looks to snap a four-game losing streak to MSU in this contest.
- The Golden Eagles are 6-9-1 in games played in Starkville.
- The two teams were a fixture on each other's schedules from 1964 through 1990, only missing 1971 and 1974 on each other's respective schedules.
- The two teams have two more future games scheduled for Sept. 23, 2023 in Starkville, and Aug. 30, 2025, in Hattiesburg.

## The Southern Miss-Mississippi State Connections

- Golden Eagle tight ends coach Reed Stringer worked from 2003-09 in Starkville, holding several jobs there, including Director of Recruiting in 2009.
- Southern Miss assistant strength and conditioning coach William Prince was a four-year starter for the Bulldogs at running back.
- Former Golden Eagle assistant coach and defensive standout Deke Adams (2009-11) is in his first season coaching the defensive line for the Bulldogs.
- MSU Associate Head Coach Tony Hughes is also a former defensive back for the Golden Eagles, who went on to be an assistant coach for the Golden Eagles in 2008.
- MSU Associate Athletic Trainer Melissa Chastang, worked for the Golden Eagle football program for several seasons.
- Bulldog redshirt freshman Jaden Crumedy is the only Bulldogs listed on their preseason roster from the city of Hattiesburg, as the defensive tackle went to Oak Grove High School.

## Against the SEC

- Southern Miss looks to snap a four-game losing streak to Southeastern Conference schools when they travel to Starkville this week.
- The Golden Eagles snapped a 13-game losing streak against SEC foes when they defeated Kentucky, 44-35, to open the 2016 season in Lexington. The previous victory for Southern Miss in defeating an SEC foe was on Sept. 16, 2000, when they blanked Alabama 21-0 in Birmingham.
- The Golden Eagles have a streak of playing an SEC foe in 52 of the last 56 seasons.
- Southern Miss also travels to Alabama later this month.

#### Jay Hopson Head Football Coach | Fourth Season - 22-16 (.579)

Southern Miss football enjoys a long, storied history that includes 71 winning seasons over its first 102 seasons on the gridiron.

Fourth-year coach Jay Hopson holds the distinction with two other Golden Eagle coaches over that span with winning seasons over their respective first three seasons, along with Reed Green and Larry Fedora.

The 27-year coaching veteran on the collegiate level and twice previously a member of the Golden Eagle coaching staff, Hopson said he would hit the ground running when he took over the Golden Eagle program. And he has.

Hopson was named the school's 21st head football coach prior to the school's 100th season in football in 2016.

In his first year directing the program, Hopson started the season by leading the Golden Eagles to their first victory over an opponent in the Southeastern Conference since the 2000 campaign, rallying for a 44-35 win at Kentucky, and leading the team to its second-straight bowl appearance. The Golden Eagles went on to earn a berth in the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl, capturing a 28-21 victory over the Ragin' Cajuns of Louisiana-Lafayette.

In his second year, Hopson led the Golden Eagles to eight victories, marking the second time in the last three seasons that the program had reached at least eight victories and the third consecutive year as well as 25th overall time to reach a bowl game.

In his first three seasons, Hopson has overseen eight Conference USA first-team selections and he mentored three former Golden Eagles that were taken in the 2017 National Football League draft.

The Golden Eagles finished in the Top 25 in both total offense (21st/472.8 ypg) and total defense (15th/324.8) in his first year and the Nasty Bunch defense ranked No. 20 in in total yards allowed in 2017 (331.9 ypg).

That string of national ranked defenses continued in 2018 in which that squad enjoyed its highest ranking under Hopson at No. 3, giving up 278.4 yards per contest.

A native of Vicksburg, Miss., Hopson returned to Southern Miss after a successful four-year stint as the head coach at Alcorn State. During his tenure there, Hopson led the Braves to a 32-17 record and consecutive Southwestern Athletic Conference championships the last two seasons. Alcorn State also recorded at least nine victories in each of the last three seasons, including a 10-3 mark in 2014 and following this season, Hopson led the Braves to the inaugural Celebration Bowl, a postseason football bowl featuring two standout programs from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU).

His team also captured the SBN Black College Championship in 2014.

Prior to his arrival at Lorman, Hopson worked as linebackers coach for two seasons at Michigan (2008-09) and worked as defensive coordinator at Memphis during the 2010 and 2011 campaigns.

His first two stints at Southern Miss as an assistant coach came from 2001-03 (defensive backs) and then again from 2005-07 (linebackers, defensive coordinator).

Hopson's defensive units led Conference USA in scoring defense each of his three seasons as defensive coordinator. In 2006, the Golden Eagles led C-USA in third down defense and red zone defense while his 2005 unit led the league in turnovers forced per game as well as led the nation in fumbles gained.

During his first stint with the Golden Eagles, the defensive unit led the nation in fewest passing touchdowns allowed and finished fourth nationally in pass efficiency defense in

2002. Southern Miss led C-USA and finished fifth nationally in pass defense during the 2003 season and each year during that stretch, Southern Miss ranked in the Top 15 nationally in scoring defense.

Hopson spent 2004 at his alma mater, the University of Mississippi, as defensive backs coach and was the program's recruiting coordinator. The Rebels' pass defense improved from 109th nationally in 2003 to 49th during the 2004 campaign.

Hopson's coaching experience also includes positions at Marshall (1996-2000) and Delta State (1993) as defensive backs coach. He was a member of the Herds' 1996 NCAA I-AA National Championship staff and coached the team to four straight Mid-American Conference championships. Hopson also held defensive graduate assistant positions at the Florida (1995), LSU (1994) and Tulane (1992). He helped the Gators to the Southeastern Conference championship and played for the national championship in the Fiesta Bowl.

He earned four-year letters and received the 1991 John Howard Vaught Award as a player at Ole Miss. A CoSIDA Academic All-American, Hopson graduated from Ole Miss with a bachelor's degree in business administration (1992) and received a master's of health in physical education and recreation from Delta State (1994).

Hopson and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Hyde and Hannah.

## Last Time Out Versus Mississippi State

### Mississippi State 34, Southern Miss 16 Sept. 5, 2015

**HATTIESBURG, Miss.** – Despite a 311-yard passing performance from Nick Mullens and a M.M. Roberts Stadium record crowd of 36,641, Southern Miss dropped its season opener Saturday night to Mississippi State, 34-16, in front of a nationally televised audience.

Southern Miss, who entertained the Bulldogs for the first time here since 1989, started the game by holding on to the football for 13:15 minutes of the opening quarter to jump out to a 10-7 advantage.

Stephen Brauchle, in his first game for the Golden Eagles, got the squad on the board first with a 31-yard field goal, but the Bulldogs bounced right back with a 100-yard return on the ensuing kickoff from Brandon Holloway.

The Golden Eagles responded by taking their last lead of the game when Mullens, who finished 30-of-44 passing, hit tight end Jay'Shawn Washington for his first career touchdown on a 19-yard strike with 2:20 left in the quarter.

The scored remained that way until MSU then took the lead for good on a Justin Johnson 5-yard pass from Dak Prescott with 10:57 to go in the second quarter.

Prescott, who finished with a pair of touchdown passes, added his second scoring strike with 12:15 to go in the third quarter on a four-yard toss to Gus Walley before Westin Graves extended the MSU lead to 24-10 with a 38-yard field goal just under two minutes later.

The two teams then traded field goals after that as Brauchle added a 27-yarder midway through the third, before Graves tallied his second try of the night from 37 yards. Brauchle opened the final period with a 27-yard field goal to cut the margin to 27-16. It was Prescott, though, who added another scoring tally with 5:55 remaining on a seven-yard scoring run.

Golden Eagle running back Ito Smith tallied a team-best 69 yards on eight carries, while redshirt freshman Korey Robertson added six catches for 81 yards for the home squad.

Prescott led the Bulldogs with 72 yards on the ground and 237 in the air on 22-of-38 passing.

## Five Time C-USA Champions

Southern Miss has five Conference USA titles, including one since divisional play started during the 2005 campaign. They captured their first league title contest and the school's fifth overall league crown - more than any other school in the conference - when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.

## Against the SEC

- Southern Miss looks to snap a four-game losing streak to Southeastern Conference schools when they travel to Starkville this week.
- The Golden Eagles snapped a 13-game losing streak against SEC foes when they defeated Kentucky, 44-35, to open the 2016 season in Lexington. The previous victory for Southern Miss in defeating an SEC foe was on Sept. 16, 2000, when they blanked Alabama 21-0 in Birmingham.
- The Golden Eagles have a streak of playing an SEC foe in 52 of the last 56 seasons.
- Southern Miss also travels to Alabama later this month.

## Notes From the Opener

- The Golden Eagles won their third season opener in four tries under Jay Hopson and improved to 66-36 in openers over the 103-year history. There is no score recorded for the 1916 opener.
- The victory was the 150th at M.M. Roberts Stadium since the start of the 1976 season. The start of the 1976 campaign began a new era of Golden Eagle football, after the school renovated the stadium and played away from Hattiesburg for the entire 1974 and 1975 campaigns.
- Five Golden Eagles were first-time starters including Torrence Brown, Tanner Hawthorne, Ray Ladner, Delmond Landry and Santrell Latham.
- Senior Jordan Mitchell recorded his second career 100-yard receiving game with 133 yards on seven catches.
- Graduate transfer Terry Whittington, who played his first three seasons at Alcorn State, tallied two tackles against his former team, both sacks, in his initial game with the Golden Eagles.
- Punt Zac Everett enjoyed a solid night by averaging 45.0 yards on three punts with a long of 51 yards. He also converted a two-point conversion in the third quarter.
- Freshman place kicker Andrew Stein enjoyed a perfect night in his debut hitting three-for-three extra points and all three field goal attempts (20, 19, 24).
- The defense, which was one of four FBS schools to not allow a 100-yard rusher last season, extended its string to 15 games as the Braves' top rusher managed just 56 yards.
- The Golden Eagles improved to 14-3 under Jay Hopson when the opposition is held to under 300 total offensive yards (219). It also was the 16th time Southern Miss limited its opponent to under 100 yards rushing under Hopson, improving to 12-4 in those contests.

## Jaylond Adams Returns Kickoff and Punt Back for Touchdown

Jaylond Adams (Adamsville, Ala.) opened the 2019 Golden Eagle season by returning a kickoff 89 yards for a touchdown and then later tallied an 80-yard score on a punt return. In addition, he added three catches for 21 yards and returned two punts for a total of 93 yards to finish the day with 203 all-purpose yards. His kickoff return for a score was the first for a Golden Eagle since the 2015 season and his punt return for a TD was the first for a Golden Eagle since the opening game last season. Adams became the first Golden Eagle to score on a kickoff which was the first offensive touch of the game for Southern Miss since Francisco Llanos returned a kick 87 yards against Tulsa (11/26/10), after the Golden Hurricane scored on the game's initial drive. He is also the first Southern Miss player to have a touchdown on both a kickoff and punt return in the same season since Tracy Lampley in 2009 and the first player to record two special team return touchdowns in the same game since James Henry accomplished that feat against UTEP in the 1988 Independence Bowl.

Adams is on the Southern Miss player to return a kickoff and a punt for a score in the same game and the first person to open the season with a kickoff return for a touchdown.

## Former Players on NFL Rosters

Eleven former Southern Miss football players have made 53-man rosters to start the 2019 NFL season. Nine different squads currently hold a Southern Miss player on its roster as the San Francisco 49ers (Tarvarius Moore, Nick Mullens) and Tampa Bay Buccaneers (Demar Dotson, Rakeem Nunez-Roches) have two players each. ## All C-USA Preseason Performers

Southern Miss, along with North Texas, had the most overall preseason All-Conference USA selections with five, in a vote of the 14 league coaches headed into the season. The Golden Eagles enjoyed one offensive preseason selection in redshirt junior wide receiver Quez Watkins, while the defense included linemen senior Demarrio Smith and RS-junior Jacques Turner, RS-junior linebacker Racheem Boothe and RS-junior defensive back Ky'el Hemby.

Here is a look at those five Golden Eagles, who are expected to lead the Golden Eagles this season:

- Watkins led the team with 72 catches for 889 yards and nine receiving TDs in 11 games, while also leading C-USA in receptions per game at 6.5. He earned first-team C-USA honors following last season.
- Hemby highlights the defensive returners for the Golden Eagles as the top returning tackler from a season ago. Hemby finished second in 2018 in total tackles for the Golden Eagles defense that ended the year No. 3 nationally in total defense (278.4) with 51 stops. He also added a team-best six interceptions, which tied for the league lead.
- The next highest tackler returning, Boothe, finished with 48 stops of which 10 were for loss and four sacks. He added a team-high two fumble recoveries, five QB hurries and three PBUs.
- Turner, who was first-team selection following last fall, returns with the most tackles among Southern Miss lineman this season with 33 tackles. He posted 10 of those for loss and five sacks among that total. He added two forced fumbles during the year which was tied for second in C-USA per game.
- Smith registered 17 tackles with one tackle for loss, one sack and blocked a FG attempt at Auburn.

### Abraham Opened Season at QB

Jack Abraham (Oxford, Miss.) opened the season at quarterback for the second-straight year by throwing for 293 yards on 18-of-28 passing and a touchdown against Alcorn State. It was his 10th career game and ninth start (a 10th start was at WR against Louisiana Tech last year) and he has thrown for more than 200 yards in a game eight times and for 300 yards or more three times. Since the start of the 1987 season, the Golden Eagles have started 27 different quarterbacks. The three former Southern Miss QBs to make the most starts over that span include Austin Davis (45), Brett Favre (43) and Nick Mullens (41). Abraham went on to throw for 2,347 yards on 223-of-305 throws with 10 interceptions for a 73.1 completion percentage last season. His completion percentage finished No. 1 in the country in the FBS, while his completions per game (24.78) ranked No. 4. He also was No. 22 in passing yards per game at 260.8. He has fought Tate Whatley for the starting job all during fall camp.

### Abraham Throws for 400-Plus against Rice Last Season

Abraham threw for the fourth-most passing yards in school history in 2018 against Rice, Sept. 22, with 428 on 25-of-34 passing with four touchdowns and an interception. It was his second four TD game of the season. He finished with 15 TDs on the year versus 10 interceptions as he threw for over 200 yards in his first seven starts. He tossed for 210 yards versus Charlotte (10/27), before leaving in the fourth quarter with an injury and missing two games.

Abraham started last season by throwing for four touchdowns - the first, four TD game since Nick Mullens did it on Oct. 1, 2016 against Rice - against Jackson State. Versus ULM, his 31 completions tied for the fifth most in a game by a Golden Eagle quarterback with Austin Davis (South Carolina/2010).

### Quez Watkins Leading Receiving Corps

Redshirt junior Quez Watkins (Athens, Ala.) is expected to lead a talented wide receiver corps after leading the squad in both catches (72), receiving yards (889) and touchdown catches (9). The first-team 2018 All-Conference USA performer and preseason all-league pick started last season in fine fashion by tallying a career-high 138 yards on eight catches with three touchdown receptions (28, 22, 24) and also added a punt return of 81 yards for a score in the season opener versus Jackson State en route to being named the C-USA Special Teams Player of the Week. He was the first Golden Eagle receiver to collect three touchdown catches since Allenzae Staggers did it against Rice on Oct. 1, 2016, while his punt return is also the first since Staggers returned a boot 75 yards the same season against Savannah State (Sept. 10). Watkins did not play in the season opener against Alcorn State.

### Stability on the Offensive Line

Three Golden Eagles, which each started at least 10 games are back on the offensive line, including senior Drake Dorbeck (Vicksburg, Miss.) and junior Arvin Fletcher (Madison, Miss.), who each started in all 11 games. Senior Ty Pollard (Hattiesburg, Miss.) started in 10 games. Sophomore Trace Clopton, who was one of only nine freshman to start for his team on the offensive line during the opening weekend last season, went on to start seven games and play in all 11 en route to earning FWAA Freshman All-America honors. All three started in the season opener against Alcorn State.

### Freshman Leads Golden Eagles in Rushing in Opener

Freshman Dee Baker (Flowood, Miss.) led the Golden Eagles in rushing in the season opener with 35 yards on eight carries. Quarterback Jack Abraham had the only rushing score in the game, from 14 yards out, tying his career-long rush.

## Improving on Turnover Margin

After holding a -17 on turnover ration during the 2016 campaign, which included 32 turnovers committed for the most allowed since giving up 38 in 2013, the last two seasons has seen the Golden Eagles improve that takeaway/giveaway number decrease to just -1 as the Golden Eagles forced 22 turnovers in 2018. It was the most takeaways by a Southern Miss defense since collecting 24 during the 2015 campaign.

The Golden Eagles started off the 2019 campaign by registering two takeaways, while giving the ball up twice, once by interception and once by fumble.

## Total Offense and Total Defense Under Hopson

For the third straight season under Jay Hopson in 2018, Southern Miss finished in the Top 25 in total defense. Last year, the Golden Eagles ranked No. 3 (278.4), enjoying their highest finish since placing No. 2 (268.2) in 2000.

The Golden Eagles finished in the Top 25 in both total offense (21st/472.8 ypg) and total defense (15th/324.8) under Jay Hopson in his first season in 2016. It was the first time in school history that the Golden Eagles finished in the Top 25 both nationally in the same season. The Nasty Bunch defense ranked No. 20 in total yards allowed in 2017 (331.9 ypg), while the offense placed 43rd (424.6 ypg in 2017).

## Holding The Foes Under 300 Yards

Southern Miss held its foes to under 300 yards six times last season and started this season by limiting Alcorn State to 229 yards. Their current string of limiting foes under 300 total offensive yards is five of the last seven games. The Golden Eagles were 5-1 in those contests in 2018 and held its foes to under 200 yards three times, including Jackson State (199), UTSA (174) and UTEP (187). Under Jay Hopson, the Golden Eagles have limited opponents to under 300 yards in 17 games and are 14-3 in those contests. They have also surrendered 200 or fewer offensive yards five times under Hopson for a perfect 5-0 mark in those contests.

## Turner Looking to Highlight a Strong Defensive Front Line

Redshirt junior Jacques Turner (D'Iberville, Miss.) headlines the Golden Eagle defensive front as he has played in 25 career games, including 11 starts. Also, back on the front line is senior Demarrio Smith (Canton, Miss.) who was a preseason all-league pick after compiling 17 tackles a year ago. They helped to limit opponents to just 102.7 yards per contest which ranked No. 6 nationally last season in the FBS. Turner opened the 2019 season by registering three tackles.

## Boothe Returns as Only Linebacker Starter in 2019

Redshirt junior Racheem Boothe (Bassfield, Miss.) is back as the only starter at linebacker from a year ago. Boothe, who was a FWAA Freshman All-American after the 2017 campaign and a first-team All-Conference USA pick last season, finished with 48 stops of which 10 were for loss and four sacks. He added a team-high two fumble recoveries, five QB hurries and three PBU's. He collected three tackles, added a forced fumble and a quarterback hurry in his first game of the 2019 season.

## Hemby is Back to Lead the Secondary and a Jim Thorpe Watch List Participant

Redshirt junior Ky'el Hemby (Abingdon, Md.), who was picked as a preseason All-Conference USA selection and a member of the Jim Thorpe Watch List, highlights the Golden Eagle defense as the top returning tackler from a season ago. Hemby finished second in 2018 in total tackles for the Golden Eagles defense that ended the year No. 3 nationally in total defense (278.4) with 51 stops. He also added a team-best six interceptions, which tied for the league lead.

The preseason watch list includes 46 of the nation's best defensive backs, representing 10 conferences and one Independent. The preseason watch list is selected by a screening committee who compiles a list of 30-50 players. His first game of the year ended with six solo tackles.

## Kicking Game Sees New Blood

The Golden Eagles will have a much different look on field goal and kickoff duties this year after the graduation of standout Parker Shaunfield (16-20 FG, 24-25 XP) and injury to Briggs Bourgeois (lower-body injury). Freshman Andrew Stein got the call on the placements, hitting all six kicks, three extra points and three field goals (19, 20, 24), while averaging 66 yards on seven kickoffs that included five for touchbacks.

Zac Everett will again be the starting punter. The 2017 Conference USA All-Freshman honoree had another strong season last year, averaging 39.2 yards over 40 punts. He also had a 70-yarder against ULM and had two others of 50-plus, with 12 kicks inside the 20. Hattiesburg native and redshirt-senior Tyler Flathau also earned some reps last season.

Everett started the year by averaging 45.0 yards on three punts, including a long of 51 against Alcorn State. He also added a two-point conversion in the game as the team's holder.

## Game Recaps

**Game 1: at Southern Miss 38, Alcorn State 10 (Aug. 31, 2019)**

**HATTIESBURG, Miss.** -- Jaylond Adams certainly put the special in special teams Saturday night at M.M. Roberts Stadium against Alcorn State.

The Southern Miss sophomore returned a kickoff and punt for touchdowns in the Golden Eagles' season-opening 38-10 victory over the Braves.

Adams took the season's opening kickoff 89 yards for a touchdown. The last time a Golden Eagle had run back a kickoff was Jalen Richard against Charlotte in 2015.

With Southern Miss up 28-10 early in the fourth quarter, Adams fielded an Alcorn State punt at his 20-yard line and went 80 yards as the majority of the announced 31,706 roared their approval of Adams for a second time.

The last time a Golden Eagle returned a punt for a touchdown was Quez Watkins in the 2018 season opener with Jackson State.

Adams' kickoff return and two short field goals by freshman signee Andrew Stein gave the Golden Eagles (1-0) a 13-0 halftime lead.

ASU (0-1) pulled within 13-7 early in the third quarter on De'Shawn Waller's 15-yard run to get the Braves within 13-7.

But Southern Miss answered immediately when quarterback Jack Abraham found Neil McLaurin for a 55-yard score. Holder Zac Everett ran in the 2-point conversion and Southern Miss led 21-7.

ASU got within 21-10 on Corey McCullough's 46-yard field goal, but Abraham squeezed through the left side of a collapsing pocket to score on a 14-yard run, and after ASU was forced to punt away its ensuing possession, ripped through the middle of the field and the Braves' coverage to leave Southern Miss up 35-10.

Stein wrapped up the scoring with his longest field goal of the night, a 24-yarder.

Abraham came through with an 18-of-28 performance, throwing for 293 yards and a touchdown. His favorite target, Jordan Mitchell, had seven catches for 133 yards.

Tim Jones finished with 68 yards on five catches.

Alcorn senior quarterback Noah Johnson finished 17-of-31 for 143 yards against a Southern Miss defense that sacked him four times and banged him around on another dozen occasions.

The Braves were limited to 219 total yards.
