COMING SOON: A NEW LOOK TO THE HUMP

- Humphrey Coliseum will become one of the premier arenas in the nation as major renovation plans were announced on Oct. 30.
- Mississippi State has joined with Dale Partners Architects and AECOM Sports to design a comprehensive plan that will see the Hump revamped with modern amenities and the arena's first premium ticket options.
- One of those new options will be a new club level that offers premium ticket holders a dedicated entrance and lobby that leads down to a 6,000-square foot sideline sideline club that offers nearly 580 club seats and 80 loge seats.
- The new-look Hump also will include nearly 160 terrace seats at the concourse level in addition to an expanded and updated concourse.
- The renovation plan includes two grand lobbies at the entrances on the east and west sides that feature direct views into the seating bowl.

CONSENSUS TOP 25 TEAM

- Mississippi State holds the No. 25 spot in the Associated Press and USA Today/Coaches Top 25 polls this week.
- The Bulldogs are ranked inside the AP Poll for the fourth consecutive time to start the season for the first time since the 2004-05 season when Mississippi State appeared in the opening 12 editions.
- Mississippi State collected a No. 15 rankings in both polls on Nov. 19 which marks the first time the Bulldogs were inside the top 15 in both polls since Dec. 26. 2011.
- The last time MSU was a consensus pre-season top 25 squad was in 2009-10 when the Bulldogs were ranked identically at No. 18 by the AP and at No. 19 by the USA Today Coaches polls.

MEDIA PREDICTS MSU TO FOURTH-PLACE SEC FINISH

- Mississippi State was selected to finish fourth by a panel of SEC and national media members announced on Oct. 16.
- The fourth-place nod is the highest pre-season prognostication for the Bulldogs since the SEC moved to its current format with no divisions leading into the 2011-12 season.
- Mississippi State was chosen to finish second overall and win the SEC Western Division in 2010-11.

WHAT'S BACK FROM 2017-18

- Mississippi State returns its top six scorers from last season which include Quinndary Weatherspoon (14.4 PPG), Aric Holman (10.9 PPG), Nick Weatherspoon (10.8 PPG), Lamar Peters (9.6 PPG), Tyson Carter (8.9 PPG) and Adbul Ado (7.8 PPG).
- The six players combined for 2,264 points and 83.4 percent of the team's scoring a season ago. They also accounted for 118 of the team's 128 efforts in double figures.

25 WINS AND A SUCCESSFUL NIT RUN

• Ben Howland guided Mississippi State to a 25-12 record and a NIT Final Four appearance in 2017-18.

• The 25 victories were the fourth-highest season total in program history only behind the 1995-96, 2001-02 and 2003-04 squads.

Q BACK ON THE JERRY WEST AWARD LIST

- Quinndary Weatherspoon was one of 20 players named to the prestigious Jerry West Award Watch List by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on Oct. 16.
- Weatherspoon has been on the West Award Watch List in back-to-back seasons. The Bulldogs have been represented on the list three times in four seasons under Ben Howland.
- The West Award is one of five preseason honors presented by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame. The list includes the Bob Cousy, Jerry West, Julius Erving, Karl Malone and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar awards.

Q AND ARIC NOTCH ALL-SEC PRE-SEASON NODS

- Quinndary Weatherspoon and Aric Holman garnered All-SEC Pre-Season First-Team and Second-Team nods from the league's coaches on Nov. 6
- The Bulldogs were joined by Alabama, Auburn, Florida, Kentucky and Tennessee with two selections apiece.
- The last time Mississippi State had two players listed on the pre-season teams by coaches was heading into the 2015-16 season.
- Weatherspoon tucked away All-SEC Pre-Season Second-Team accolades from the media for the third straight season.
- He joins the illustrious list of Tennessee's Allan Houston along with Kentucky's Keith Bogans and Alex Poythress as the only players to notch three pre-season All-SEC accolades from the media.
- Weatherspoon also received votes for SEC Pre-Season Player of the Year for the second straight season.

Q CLIMBING UP THE SCORING LIST

- Quinndary Weatherspoon has amassed 1,485 career points which ranks 13th on Mississippi State's all-time scoring list.
- Weatherspoon is attempting to become the fifth player in program history to average double figures during all four seasons of his MSU career.
- The list includes Rickey Brown (1977-78-79-80), Ray White (1976-77-78-79), Dee Bost (2009-10-11-12) and Craig Sword (2013-14-15-16).
- Weatherspoon enters Friday's action 8 points shy of passing Tony Watts (1989-90-91-92) and Craig Sword (2013-14-15-16) for 11th place. The senior guard also is 19 points away from breaking into the top 10.

- Weatherspoon collected a steal with four seconds remaining and went coast-to-coast for a layup to give Mississippi State a 61-59 win over Dayton on Dec. 3.
- Most recently, Weatherspoon got a friendly bounce off the front rim on a long-distance, three-pointer to give the Buldogs a 78-77 victory over Baylor during the NIT Second Round on March 18.
- Weatherspoon knocked down a buzzer-beater three-pointer against Vanderbilt for a 75-74 win as a freshman on Feb. 16.

- A sharp-shooting first half carried over into the second half as No. 25 Mississippi State canned a season's best 61.1 percent from the field to trounce Alcorn State by an 88-65 margin.
- Five Bulldogs (5-1) factored in with double-figure scoring performances ignited by 17 apiece from Lamar Peters and Nick Weatherspoon on a combined 11-of-20 shooting clip. The duo also accounted for seven of Mississippi State's 11 treys headed by Peters' five triples.
- Reggie Perry notched his first double-double of his young career with 16 points and 11 rebounds. The Georgia native was a sparkling 7-of-8 from the field.
- Quinndary Weatherspoon added 14 points and three steals followed by Tyson Carter's team-leading 10 points and two assists off the bench. The Bulldogs have won 17 of 19 games when Carter reaches double figures over the last two seasons.
- Setting up Mississippi State's hot shooting night was a season-high 24 assists on 33 baskets. Peters headed the charge with seven dimes followed by Robert Woodard II's solid allaround effort with six points, six rebounds and five assists against zero turnovers.
- The Bulldogs claimed a 36-26 edge in the battle of the boards and grabbed 29 of the game's 45 rebounds on the defensive side. Aric Holman chipped in six points accompanied by six rebounds. KeyShawn Feazell garnered two points, while E.J. Datcher tallied a pair of rebounds.

FROM THE BENCH WITH COACH HOWLAND

"I'm glad we got the win. That trip (to Las Vegas) was a grueling trip ... We're still a little bit recovering from the effects of that. I really ran them hard Saturday and Sunday so I was very pleased today with our 88 points on 54 shots, 24 assists on the 33 baskets. 24 of the 33 baskets made were assisted upon."

"I thought Lamar had a really good first half — moving the ball, sharing the basketball and really did a nice job shooting it because he's letting it come to him, which was good. I thought that Reggie Perry had a really nice game, obviously, and as did Robert Woodard (II). Robert had five assists, zero turnovers. That was big to go along with his six rebounds. I thought we did a good job defensively in the first half in particular, holding them to 34 percent. We attacked the zone well and getting the ball to the high post. It's all we worked on yesterday was zone offense. Obviously, it was important for us. I'm glad that we got this as we get ready for a very tough road trip coming up at the end of the week."

MOMENTS THAT MATTERED

- Nick Weatherspoon's three-pointer started an 11-0 run after Alcorn State opened the scoring. A dunk by Perry capped the run and gave the Bulldogs an 11-2 lead with 17:03 left.
- After the Braves closed within two at 15-13, Quinndary Weatherspoon answered with a jumper on the offensive end.
 A 3-pointer by Perry would later stretch the lead to 25-18 with 8:59 remaining in the half.
- Alcorn State kept within striking distance at 27-22 with 7:55 on the clock before the Bulldogs busted loose a 12-0 to take control for good. Holman and Peters canned consecutive treys within 35 seconds to make it 39-22 at the 3:54 mark.
- The Bulldogs took a 44-29 lead into the locker room and extended it to 20 inside the first minute of the second half.
- Mississippi State pushed the advantage to 64-34 at the 13:41 mark. Peters would rattled home consecutive three-pointers and an old-fashioned three-point play courtesy of Quinndary Weatherspoon capped the run.
- For the contest, the Bulldogs hit 33-of-54 shots from the field (61.1 percent), 11-of-24 shots from three-point range (45.8 percent) and 11-of-14 shots from the foul line (78.6 percent). The Braves hit 22-of-59 shots from the field (37.3 percent), 7-of-30 shots from 3-point range (23.3 percent) and 14-of-20 shots from the foul line (70.0 percent).
- MSU had 24 assists and 17 turnovers, while the Braves had 10 assists and 12 turnovers.
- Alcorn State (1-6) was led by Deshaw Andrews with 26 points and seven rebounds.
