### STARTING FIVE

1. Tulane earned its first true road victory of the season defeating Fordham 89-81 in Bronx, New York, on Sunday afternoon. Collin Holloway led all scorers in the game with a career-high 26 points on 10-of-18 shooting to go with five rebounds and a career best three blocks.

2. Junior forward Collin Holloway was named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week on Monday after helping the Wave go 2-0 with wins over Prairie View A&M and Fordham. Holloway averaged 23.0 points on 61.5 percent shooting from the field, 4.5 rebounds, 2.0 steals, and 1.5 blocks in the two victories.

3. This marks the 98th all-time meeting between the Green Wave and the Bulldogs with Tulane trailing the series 41-56. The Wave is 1-5 all-time against the Bulldogs in neutral site games including a 80-66 loss in the latest meeting in the Myrtle Beach Invitational on November 21, 2019. The last time the Green Wave defeated Mississippi State came on December 6, 2014, in New Orleans by a final score of 59-54.

4. Through December 6, the Green Wave leads the AAC in scoring offense (88.4), field goal percentage (.531), free throws made per game (24.4), free throws attempted per game (31.4), steals (10.6), turnovers forced per game (16.71), and turnover margin (+5.1).

5. Kevin Cross leads the American in scoring so far this season and is the only player in the conference to rank inside the top 10 in scoring (1st - 19.5), field goal percentage (6th - .633), rebounding (8th - 7.67), blocks (10th - 1.0), and minutes played (5th - 32.99).

3. This marks the 98th all-time meeting between the Green Wave and the Bulldogs with Tulane trailing the series 41-56. The Wave is 1-5 all-time against the Bulldogs in neutral site games including a 80-66 loss in the latest meeting in the Myrtle Beach Invitational on November 21, 2019. The last time the Green Wave defeated Mississippi State came on December 6, 2014, in New Orleans by a final score of 59-54.

4. Through December 6, the Green Wave leads the AAC in scoring offense (88.4), field goal percentage (.531), free throws made per game (24.4), free throws attempted per game (31.4), steals (10.6), turnovers forced per game (16.71), and turnover margin (+5.1).

5. Kevin Cross leads the American in scoring so far this season and is the only player in the conference to rank inside the top 10 in scoring (1st - 19.5), field goal percentage (6th - .633), rebounding (8th - 7.67), blocks (10th - 1.0), and minutes played (5th - 32.99).

### TULANE BY THE NUMBERS

**292** – Tulane has made at least one 3-point field goal in 292 consecutive games. The last time the Green Wave failed to do so came on Jan. 16, 2014 at home against Louisiana Tech when they went 0-for-14 from outside.

**507** – Head coach Ron Hunter is tied for 50th among active men's basketball coaches with 507 career wins. He has recorded 62 of his victories with the Green Wave.

**58.3** – The Green Wave leads the American and ranks 15th nationally in effective field goal percentage at 58.3 percent.

Effective field goal percentage adjusts the field goal percentage to account for the fact that three-point field goals count for three points, while all other field goals only count for two points.

**4** – The Green Wave has four players that have postseason experience. Jordan Wood and Collin Holloway each played in the NCAA Tournament at their previous school while Gregg Glenn III and Logan Stephens were members of NIT teams last season.

**3** – Tulane was picked to finish third in the American Athletic Conference 2023-24 preseason poll.

**2** – Two members earned Preseason All-AAC Honors. Jaylen Forbes was the only unanimous first team selection while Kevin Cross earned second team honors.

### WITH A WIN OVER MISSISSIPPI STATE...

- Tulane will move to 7-1 on the season - matching its best start since opening the 2019-20 season 7-1.
- The Green Wave would earn its first win over the Bulldogs since 2014 and its first victory against Mississippi State away from New Orleans since February 1, 1965, in Starkville (73-70).
- Head coach Ron Hunter would collect his first career win versus Mississippi State and move to 1-2 overall against the Bulldogs.

### THE OPPONENT - MISSISSIPPI STATE

- The Bulldogs enter the matchup on a two-game losing streak with a 6-2 overall record. Mississippi State dropped its last two contests 60-59 to Southern and 67-59 to Georgia Tech.
- Josh Hubbard leads the Bulldogs offensive attack averaging 16.0 points per game and 43.2 percent shooting from the field and 37.9 percent from beyond the arc.
- Mississippi State is 3-0 so far this season in neutral site contests. The Bulldogs have defeated Arizona State (71-56) in Chicago and Washington State (76-64) and Northwestern (66-57) in Connecticut.
- The Bulldogs are led by their defense which ranks in the top 10 in scoring, field goal percentage defense, and three-point field goal percentage. Mississippi State is 10th nationally in scoring defense (60.2), eighth in field goal percentage defense (36.6), and ninth in three-point defense (25.4).
- In his second season at Mississippi Stats, head coach Chris Jans and the Bulldogs were picked seventh in the SEC this season after finishing ninth last year.

### MILESTONE WATCH

- Senior Jaylen Forbes is two points away from becoming the eighth player in program history to score 1,500 points. He

- Forbes ranks eighth in career free throws made (372) only 62 behind Tulane career leader Jerald Honeycutt at 434. He is also 24 steals from joining the top 10 in career steals at Tulane sitting at 136.

- Senior Kevin Cross is 12 rebounds from the top 20 in career boards, 42 assists from the top 10 in career assists, and 23 blocks from the top 10 in career blocks at Tulane.

- Cross currently ranks sixth in career offensive rebounds at Tulane (267) - 79 behind the career leader Anthony Reed (346).
- Senior Tre' Williams is four games from 100 games played in his career.

- Junior Sion James is 245 points away from 1,000 in his career and 10 steals from the top 10 in career steals at Tulane sitting at 150 in his career.

### 2023-24 NON-CONFERENCE REVIEW

#### WAVE OUTLAST FORDHAM ON THE ROAD

- Tulane outlasted Fordham on the road to improve to 6-1 on the season by defeating the Rams 89-81 on Dec. 3.

- As a team, the Green Wave shot 54.2 percent from the field marking the sixth time in the first seven games of the season Tulane connected at a 50 percent clip or better from the floor.

- A career performance by forward Collin Holloway fueled the victory for the Wave. Holloway tallied a career-high in points and blocks finishing with 28 points on 10-of-18 shooting to go with three blocks.

- All four of the other starters for the Green Wave also posted double figures in scoring against Fordham. Jaylen Forbes finished with 18, Kolby King had 14, Tre' Williams posted 13, and Sion James added 12. King led the team with three steals while James pulled down a team high nine rebounds.

#### TULANE SHOOTS PAST PRAIRIE VIEW

- Tulane dominated the second half to defeat Prairie View A&M 98-77 on Nov. 29 and improve to 5-1 on the season.

- As a team, the Green Wave shot 62.2 percent from the field and tallied 40 points in the paint. The shooting performance marked the highest field goal percentage by Tulane in the Coach Hunter era.

- The Wave also did damage from the free throw line knocking down 36-of-48. The 36 makes from the charity stripe is the second most in program history behind 38 makes against UNC-Charlotte in 1994.

- Ten different players scored in the game including five in double figures led by Kevin Cross with 21 points and Collin Holloway with 20.

#### WAVE SPLIT IN SOCIAL CHALLENGE

- Tulane suffered its first loss of the season in its first game in California losing 80-77 to Bradley on Nov. 20.

- Jaylen Forbes led the team in scoring with 17 points against the Braves.

- The Green Wave came from behind to defeat Cal 84-81 in its second contest on Nov. 22 and improve to 4-1 on the season.

- Tulane erased an 11-point deficit in the second half to take down the Bears and earn its first win against a Pac-12 team since defeating Utah 65-61 at the Myrtle beach Invitational in 2019.

- Associate head coach Ray McCallum served as the team's head coach against Cal because head coach Ron Hunter was unavailable due to non-COVID illness.

- Kevin Cross scored 24 points in the win to lead Tulane and also earn Surf Division All-Tournament Team.

#### GREEN WAVE ROLLS PAST SACRAMENTO STATE 92-57

- Stingy and opportunistic defense powered Tulane to a blowout 92-57 win over Sacramento State on Nov. 17 to improve to 3-0 for the second year in a row and the fourth time

- On offense, the Wave shot 58.9 percent from the field and 44.0 percent from beyond the arc including knocking down a season-high 11 threes.
- Sion James led five players in double figures for Tulane scoring 21 points on 8-of-10 shooting from the field.

### TULANE DOMINATES THE PAINT AGAINST NORTHWESTERN STATE TO START 2-0

- Tulane scored 52 points in the paint to defeat Northwestern State 88-71 on Nov. 9.
- The Green Wave shot an impressive 51.8 percent from the field while outscoring the Demons 52-32 in the paint.
- Tulane also turned in an outstanding performance from the free throw line shooting 29-of-32 for 90.6 percent as a team.
- Four players scored in double figures again for the Wave with Kevin Cross leading the way with 23 points along with eight boards and six assists.
- Kolby King scored 20 to become the second player since 2010 to score 20 or more in the first two games of the season (Kevin Cross 2022-23).

### TULANE REPRESENTS TEAM USA AT WORLD UNIVERSITY GAMES

- Tulane Men's basketball represent Team USA in the 2023 World University Games over the summer in China.
- The team won the bronze medal in the games by defeating

Argentina 102-91 to finish 5-1 overall.

- Tulane began competition overseas with an exhibition game against China before the World University Games started. Kolby King and Jaylen Forbes combined for 41 points to help the team defeat China 96-91. King led all scorers in the game with 22 points followed by Forbes with 19 points. Gregg Glenn III and Tre' Williams posted 15 points each, while Sion James finished with 10.
- Before the team's first competition in the games, the players, coaches, and staff marched in the World University Games Opening Ceremonies alongside athletes from more than 120 other countries.
- In the first game of pool play, Tulane defeated Poland 96-82 behind strong outside shooting knocking down 13 threes on 43 percent shooting from downtown as a team. Five players finished in double figures for Team USA led by King with 19 points and Forbes with 18. Glenn III tallied 15 points followed by a 13-point performance by Tre' Williams. Collin Holloway rounded out the top scorers by posting a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds.
- Team USA dominated Japan from start to finish in the second game of pool play to record a 93-56 victory. Eleven different players found the scoring column for the United States including four in double figures. Asher Woods led the team with 17 points to go with three steals off the bench. King shot 7-of-10 from the field to tally 16 points. Percy Daniels finished with 14 points followed by Holloway with 11.
- The team finished undefeated in pool play by defeating the Czech Republic 76-72. Team USA outscored the Czech Republic 26-21 in the fourth quarter to secure the victory. Jaylen Forbes led a trio of player with double-digits in scoring with 17 points. Holloway recorded 14 points followed by King with 12 points.
- In the quarterfinals of the games Team USA was propelled by a 29-9 third quarter to defeat the Republic of Korea 86-68 and advance to the semifinals. King led a quartet of player for Team USA in double figures with 18 points. Holloway finished with 14 points while Kevin Cross posted 12 points, eight boards, and four assists. Forbes rounded out the top scorers with 11 points.
- Team USA lost its lone game of the trip in the semifinals when it dropped a 95-82 contest to Brazil. King led all scorers in the game with 21 points to go with five rebounds and three steals.
- The team claimed the bronze medal by beating Argentina 102-91 behind 20-point scoring performances by three players. Forbes led all scorers with 27 points followed by

King with 23 points. Sion James filled up the stat sheet with 22 points, seven rebounds, six assists, and three blocks.

- Four players averaged double figures for Tulane during the games led by King with 18.2 points per game which ranked second in the tournament. Forbes followed with 15.7 points per game and made a team-high 17 threes. James averaged 11 points along with 5.3 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 1.0 block in the six games played for Tulane. Cross rounded out the top performers for Team USA with 10.6 points per game.

- As a team, Tulane led the games in two-point field goal percentage shooting 59 percent and tied for the top overall field goal percentage at 46 percent. The team ranked second overall in scoring averaging 89.2 points per game.

- Off the court, the team got the opportunity to meet and interact with other student-athletes from more than 120 other countries in the World University Games Village on the Chengdu University campus. There were activities such as karaoke, virtual reality games, and a movie theater for the student-athletes to enjoy in the village.

#### FORBES' THE FLAMETHROWER

- The senior led the team in three-pointers attempted (227), three-pointers made (88), free throw percentage (.861), and total points scored (572).

- Forbes scored 20+ in 14 games last season including a season-high 30 points in the Green Wave's 90-87 win.

- The Florence, Mississippi, native's 30 20-point performances are the fifth most by a Green Wave player behind Anthony Reed (32), Paul Thompson (33), John Williams (36), and Jerald Honeycutt (51).

- His 219 career threes are the most in program history as he

surpassed Jordan Callahan (2009-13) with 217.

#### WELCOME TO UPTOWN

- Tulane has seven newcomers this season including five transfers and two freshmen.

- The five transfers to Uptown are graduate student Jordan Wood from Howard, junior Logan Stephens from Rutgers, and sophomores Gregg Glenn III from Michigan, Kolby King from St. John's, and Asher Woods from VMI

- The two new freshmen for the Wave are Mier Panoam and Spencer Elliott.

#### SEASONED COACHING STAFF

- Head coach **Ron Hunter** has assembled a veteran coaching staff featuring former NCAA Division I head coach - **Ray McCallum** (Ball State - 1993-2000; Houston 2000-04; Detroit Mercy - 2008-16) alongside **Claude Pardue** who has been with Coach Hunter for 13 seasons. **Sean Mock** begins his sixth season with Coach Hunter and his fifth at Tulane.

- **Darryl LaBerrie** joins the coaching staff this season with 16 years of coaching experience.

# RON HUNTER

**HEAD COACH | 507-372**

**Fifth Season (30th Overall) | Miami (Ohio), 1986**

Ron Hunter was introduced as the 25th men's basketball head coach in Tulane history on March 26, 2019 and enters his fourth season leading the program in 2022-23.

In his fourth season, Hunter led the Green Wave to its best performance since joining the American Athletic Conference. Tulane tallied 20 wins in 2022-23 which marked the first 20-win season for the program since 2012-13. The team's 12 league victories were the most for the program since joining the AAC.

Hunter's culture started to sink in during his third year at the head of the program. Tulane won 14 games which tied for their most wins since the 2017-18 campaign. The Wave won nine home games and ten conference games, their most since joining the American.

In his second season, Hunter led the program into the second round of the AAC tournament. A feat they hadn't accomplished since 2016.

In his first season leading the Green Wave, Hunter made the program's impact felt nationally and across the American Athletic Conference. Tulane secured a neutral court win over Utah, marking the team's first win over Pac-12 Conference opponent since the 1950's. The Green Wave also posted league wins over Cincinnati and SMU at home, as well as road victories over UCF and Temple.

Hunter arrived at Tulane after spending eight seasons at the helm of Georgia State University's program where he compiled a record of 171-95. In 26 years on the bench, Hunter owns a career record of 457-332 and has been named conference coach of the year three times. His 374 wins at the Division I level prior to taking the helm in New Orleans made him the winningest coach ever hired to lead Green Wave basketball.

During his eight-year tenure at GSU, Hunter directed the Panthers to six postseason appearances, including three trips to the NCAA Tournament in his final five seasons.

Ron Hunter significantly changed the national perception of the Georgia State program. Prior to his arrival, the Panthers had broken .500 just nine times in 49 years. During Hunter's eight-year tenure at GSU, he directed the Panthers to seven winning seasons and is responsible for six of the nine most successful seasons in program history.

His stint at Georgia State also featured three Sun Belt Conference titles in the last five years. In 2014-15, the Panthers won 25 games and advanced to the third round of the NCAA tournament following the shocking upset of No. 3 seed Baylor.

It was the 2014-15 season that put Georgia State on the map. After winning the Sun Belt regular season title for the second year in a row, the Panthers claimed the tournament title for just the third time in program history. In the postgame celebration, Hunter tore his Achilles, a clip that went viral across the nation.

Prior to his arrival at GSU, Hunter spent 17 seasons at IUPUI, where he guided the program through its transition from the NAIA and Division II levels into NCAA Division I and the Summit League. He is the school's winningest coach, both in number of victories and winning percentage, and he led IUPUI to its only appearance in the NCAA tournament in 2003 in just the school's third season as a Division I program.

Named Summit League Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006, Hunter led IUPUI to the conference championship game five times from 2002-10, including the 2003 title game victory over top-seeded Valparaiso. Between 2005 and 2010, the Jaguars never finished lower than fourth in the league standings under Hunter, including runner-up finishes in 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2010.

Hunter also established a reputation for developing players, as he has coached 27 all-conference honorees and five conference player of the year selections during his head-coaching career at Georgia State and IUPUI.

He also mentored George Hill at IUPUI, who was drafted in the first round of the 2008 NBA Draft (26th selection) by the San Antonio Spurs. Seven years later, he would see his son R.J. Hunter get selected in the first round of the NBA Draft by the Boston Celtics.

Prior to his arrival at IUPUI, Hunter spent one year as the top assistant coach at his alma mater, Miami University (Ohio), under former Arizona State head coach Herb Sendek. During that season, the Redhawks were 19-10, finishing second in the Mid-American Conference (MAC) and making an appearance in the postseason National Invitation Tournament (NIT).

Hunter's coaching career began in 1987, when he served as an assistant at Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

Off the court, Hunter earned national notoriety for his humanitarian efforts, partnering with Samaritan's Feet, an organization that collects shoes for underprivileged children around the world.

Hunter's resume includes numerous national honors including an NABC Guardians of the Game Pillar Award for Service, the 2009 Giant Steps Award from the National Consortium for Academics and Sport (NCAS), a Minority Achievement Award from the Center for Leadership Development (CLD) and the 2018 Gene Bartow Award.

He was one of seven head coaches who served on the Division I Basketball Academic Enhancement Group, as appointed by late NCAA President Myles Brand, and he is a member of the National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) Board of Directors. He served as President of the NABC in 2015-16 and served on an ad hoc committee to the NCAA Selection Committee in 2016-17.

He was honored by the American Diabetes Association in May 2015 as its Father of the Year and a week later earned the Positive Collegiate Coach of the Year at the Georgia Positive Athlete Awards.

Hunter earned his bachelor's degree in education at Miami (Ohio) in 1986 and added a master's in 1987. He was a standout player on strong Miami teams of the mid-1980s, along with high school and college teammate Ron Harper, who went on to enjoy a long NBA career. The Redhawks were 81-30 during Hunter's four-year career and earned three consecutive NCAA tournament berths while winning two MAC championships.

Hunter and his wife, Amy, have two children, Jasmine and R.J.
