JAY BUCKLEY HAS ANOTHER DOUBLE-DOUBLE IN DEFEAT AT FRESNO STATE

>> Jakevion Buckley had another double-double, but the Fresno State Bulldogs (5-2, 0-0 Mountain West) used a career night from Jake Heidbreder to knock off the University of New Orleans Privateers (2-3, 0-0 Southland) 85-76 at the Save Mart Center on Friday night.

Buckley finished with a season-high 23 points on 9-of-16 shooting. He also led the Privateers with a career-high 14 rebounds. Friday's game marked the second double-double of his career and his second in the past three games. Buckley joins Texas A&M-Corpus Christi's Sheldon Williams as the only Southland student-athletes with two double-doubles this season.

MJ Thomas had another solid outing since returning to the starting lineup three games ago. The sophomore finished with 16 points and eight rebounds. TJ Cope earned the first start of his career and recorded a career-high nine points on 4-of-8 shooting in 26 minutes. Cope got off to a hot start, scoring the first six UNO points of the game.

Trailing by 11 with 5:22 left in the first half, free throws from Buckley and Kedrick Osby along with layups from Buckley and Thomas quickly cut the deficit to three with 2:50 remaining. The Privateers held the Bulldogs without a field goal for the final six minutes of the half and trailed by four at the break.

Heidbreder scored a career-high 33 points and made 11 of his 13 field-goal attempts, including 4-of-6 from beyond the arc and 7-of-8 at the free-throw line. Any time UNO clawed back into the game, the redshirt senior seemed to answer.

Thomas made 1-of-2 at the line with just over three minutes left to play, cutting the Bulldogs' lead to four before Heidbreder responded on the other end with a second-chance layup. Jake made five straight free throws down the stretch as the Bulldogs pulled away for the win.

Like Buckley, Bulldog guard Zaon Collins finished with a double-double -14 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists. Fresno State outshot UNO 47% to 43%, and the teams tied on the glass at 36 rebounds apiece. Both teams finished with six steals.

NEW ORLEANS BASKETBALL NEWS & NOTES

NO LIMITS ANYMORE

>> The University of New Orleans has named **Percy "Master P" Miller** as **President of Basketball Operations** for the men's basketball program on Feb. 26. A New Orleans native, entrepreneur, and former college player, Miller brings experience from coaching elite AAU teams and playing in the CBA and NBA summer leagues. Head coach Stacy Hollowell praised his basketball knowledge and community ties. Miller said his goal is to rebuild UNO's winning tradition while mentoring student-athletes and strengthening the program's connection to the city. DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES

>> Jakevion Buckley has two career double-doubles - both coming in the last three games. Jay finished with 15 points and 12 assists at Tulane - the first Privateer points/assists double-double since 2018 and just the seventh since 1996. Two games later he finished with 25 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Buckley is averaging 5.8 assists per game with games of 12 assists and Tulane and 9 assists at TCU. Three of his five games at UNO have features five or more assists. **He ranks No. 2 in the SLC in both assists per game, and total assists (29). He's also No. 5 in the SLC in rebounding (7.0) and total steals (9), and No. 9 in scoring (16.0).**

He joined the Privateers coming off an **All-Southland season for Southeastern last season**. Jay averaged 14.5 points per game with 4.2 assists in Hammond last year. He was also named to the **Southland Conference All-Defensive Team** after averaging 1.9 steals per game, and was a **two-time Southland Conference player of the week last season**.

SHARP SHOOTING TEXAN

>> **Colton Benson was named Southland Player of the Week last week** after a 33-point, 8-of-12 from three night at Tulane last Friday. He is the first Southland Player of the Week for the Privateers since Jordan Johnson won the award twice in 2023. His **eight made three pointers that night were one shy of the school record** for a single game. **Benson scored 22 points in the season opener at TCU - the first time a Privateer scored since Derek St. Hiliare scored 21 in the 2021 season opener at Ole Miss.**

I WANNA BE LIKE MIKE

>> Sophomore sensation MJ Thomas has picked up right where he left off last season. After coming off the bench against TCU and LSU, Thomas is back in the starting lineup and averaging 8.8 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. **He ranks No. 1 in the SLC in rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game (5.8), No. 5 in total rebounds (41), No. 8 offensive rebounds per game (2.6).**

Last season he averaged 11.2 points and 7.8 rebounds in 31 games. His 243 total rebounds ranked No. 1 in the Southland Conference and No. 55 in the NCAA. His rebounding average was the highest by a Privateer since Hector Romero in the 2002-03 season. Thomas was one of just 8 freshmen in the NCAA last season to record a 32-point game, and one of only 3 with 18 or more rebounds in a game. He finished 6 double-doubles and averaged 13.0 points and 8.8 rebounds per game in Southland play.

UNO vs. TOP 25

>> The Privateers are 4-33 all-time against members of the Associated Press Top-25, and have lost five in a row dating back to a 65-63 victory at No. 21 NC State thanks to TJ Worley's floater in the lane with three seconds to play. UNO is just 2-22 on the road against Top 25 competition. This season marks the first time since 2013 that UNO will play multiple ranked opponents in the same season. They lost at No. 5 Michigan State, and at No. 17 Butler that season.

TRAVEL WEEK

>> The Privateer travel schedule has been crazy lately - last Monday the team flew 1,670 miles to Los Angeles before a short bus trip to Malibu to face Pepperdine on Tuesday. They then bussed 3.5 hours on Thursday to Fresno to take on the Bulldogs Friday night before making the 1,750 mile trip home and arriving back in New Orleans on Saturday evening. This week they will make the five hour bus trip to Starkville, Miss on Monday before bussing back after the Mississippi game and catching another flight to Lubbock, Texas on Tuesday morning.

NEW LOOK PRIVATEERS

>> For the second consecutive season, the Privateers will feature at least 10 newcomers on the roster. All-Southland guard Jakevion Buckley transfers in from Southeastern, three-point specialist Coleton Benson joins from Texas State, center Churchill Abass arrives from Wake Forest, and center Mathok Majok transfers from Oral Roberts.

They are joined by junior transfers T.J. Cope and Kedrick Osby. Sophomore William Patterson, who originally signed with Syracuse, spent last season at Three Rivers Community College. The roster also includes five freshmen — Enzo Boudouma, Jamal Chretien II, Eze Nwakkamma, Panagiotis Pagonis and Vieux Sanneh.

YOU LOOK TALLER

>> New Orleans has eight student-athletes at six-foot-eighth or taller - tied with Clemson, DePaul, Georgia, Mississippi State, Missouri and Penn for the second most in the NCAA. Mathok Majok is tied for the third tallest student-athlete NCAA Div. I basketball: only Trent Burns, 7-5 (Missouri), Gabe Dynes 7-5 (USC), Oliver Rioux, 7-9 (Florida) are taller. Michigan is the only other school with two student-athletes that are 7-2 or taller - Malick Kordel (7-2) and Aday Mara (7-3).

LONE STAR STATE ON THE LAKEFRONT

>> Five Privateers - Jakevion Buckley (Shelbyville), Coleton Benson (Austin), Eze Nwakkamma (Dallas), Jamal Chretien II (Katy), and MJ Thomas (Denton) all call Texas home. TJ Cope (South Plains) and Kedrick Osby (Odessa) also played community college basketball in Texas. One third of the current roster hails from Texas.

Privateer assistant coach Javan Felix played in 132 games for the University of Texas and was an All-Big 12 selection in 2014. Assistant Coach Silvy Dominguez coached at Lamar from 2008-2011.

Head Coach Stacy Hollowell was an assistant coach for Texas Southern under Johnny Jones for the 2023-2024 season - the season before he came to UNO. He also graduated from St. Edwards in Austin, Texas.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOUR

>> Five Privateers — Churchill Abass (Edo State, Nigeria), Enzo Boudouma (Fribourg, Switzerland), Irish Coquia (Vancouver, British Columbia), Mathok Majok (Kuajok, South Sudan) and Panagiotis Pagonis (Athens, Greece) — hail from outside the United States. Boudouma and Pagonis have both represented their countries in EuroBasket competition at the U18 and U20 levels.

HARD WORK PAYS OFF

>> At various times in his basketball journey Grant Kemp was: cut from his eighth grade basketball team, told he wasn't good enough for NAIA basketball, and told he wouldn't play Div. I minutes - but on Jan. 17, 2025 due to his tireless efforts on and off the court **KEMP EARNED A DIV. I SCHOLARSHIP** from Coach Hollowell after starting the season as a walkon. The Madisonville native played in 22 games last season at an average of 11.1 minutes off the bench.

HONORING THE PAST

>> Ledell Eackles ('86-'88) and Bo McCalebb ('03-'08) were inducted into the Louisiana Basketball Hall of Fame on May 3. Duane Reboul ('69-'71), Ronnie Grandison ('85-'87) and Eackles were inducted into the New Orleans Athletics' Hall of Fame on Nov. 7.

Former honorable mention All-American McCalebb - who still leads both UNO and the Sun Belt's all-time scoring lists with 2,679 career points will have his No. 1 Jersey retired at the Dec. 6 home game against HCU. It will be the third jersey number retired in UNO's basketball history: Sandra Hodge's #44 was retired in 1989, and Ervin Johnson's #40 was retired in 1999.

Raiders beat UNO at its own strategy

LUBBOCK, Texas — For the first time in seven games, UNO met its match.

And then some.

The Privateers' six-game winning streak ended Saturday night as Texas Tech shut them down, 64-48, in front of 5,338 fans in the Lubbock Municipal Coliseum.

There was nothing complicated about this one as the Red Raiders played the Privateers' game — only they played it better.

"I thought that was the best-coached team we played against all year," UNO Coach Tim Floyd said. "Their shot selection was better. I thought things were going our way at halftime. The first 20 minutes went pretty much the way we wanted them to.

"We hoped to take the game down to two or three minutes with a chance to win. We hoped to be within three or four and maybe make something happen."

UNO followed the script well for the first half. The Privateers held the score down, and even though Tech center J.D. Sanders made 6 of 7 shots for 12 points, UNO trailed 22-20 at halftime.

"They played well and did a good job of shortening the game," Texas Tech Coach Gerald Myers said. "We had to do a good job defensively for 45 seconds each time and that's difficult to do.

"The turning point came right at the start of the second half, the first three or four baskets. That

gave us a lead, a little cushion, and they started to come out of their game."

Sanders scored the first two baskets of the second half on a layup and a dunk to give Tech a 26-20 lead.

Sean Gay, the Red Raiders' leading scorer who didn't have a point in the first half, then started hitting from the outside. His three jumpers helped push the lead to 34-24.

Moments later, Tony Harris, UNO's leading scorer, went to the bench after committing his fourth foul. His replacement, Leonard Bennett, gave the Privateers a brief lift. He scored eight straight UNO points to pull the Privateers to 41-35 with nine minutes left.

But Tech scored eight straight with Steve Miles' layup giving the Red Raiders a 48-35 lead with 5:58 left.

The only notable occurrence after that came when UNO's William Moore, after being fouled by

Tracy White, threw the ball at White and was called for a technical. Floyd also got a technical for arguing, his third technical in two games.

Gay made two of three free throws to give Tech a 55-39 edge. The game and UNO's winning streak were over.

"The start of the second half killed us," Floyd said. "The two cheap baskets in transition really hurt us. When we got down six or eight, we didn't have nearly the poise we needed.

"We didn't take good shots. It was really the first time in seven ball games we were behind at a key point. That's when I hoped we really would start to execute and we didn't."

UNO, 8-4, will open American South Conference play against Lamar on Monday night in Lake-

front Arena. Tech improved to 6-8.

Gay had 14 points and Todd Duncan 10 for the Red Raiders. Willie Richardson and Robert Hokett led UNO with 10 apiece. Harris had nine points and one rebound in 27 minutes before fouling out.

"They played excellent defense," Harris said. "You can't take anything away from them. They played a great game. Their coach coached them very well. They just came out ready."

A glance at the box score showed Tech doing to UNO just what the Privateers had been doing to their opponents recently.

UNO, which had shot better than 54 percent in each of its previous four games, watched Tech shoot 73 percent (24-for-33). That set a Tech record, surpass-

BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Hollowell enters his second season on the Lakefront after being named the 13th men's basketball coach in school history in April of 2024. He replaced Mark Slessinger who spent 13 seasons as Privateers head coach and tallied the most wins in school history.

Hollowell came to New Orleans after spending last season the 2023-2024 season at Texas Southern as an assistant coach under Johnny Jones. During his one season

Hollowell helped the Tigers to a 12-6 mark in the SWAC and a run to the SWAC tournament finals.

During the 2022-23 season Hollowell joined Kermit Davis' staff at Ole Miss as the Associate Athletic Director for Men's Basketball. During his time in Oxford, Hollowell oversaw day to day operations of the program with a focus on development and mentorship of student-athletes. He also helped the program achieve a top-12 recruiting class that season according to ESPN's rankings.

It was at Loyola (New Orleans) where Hollowell wrote his name into Louisiana folk lore. Hollowell left Loyola (New Orleans) after the 2021-22 season as the second winningest coach in school history and a national champion. During his eight seasons in charge of the Wolfpack he compiled a record of 166-78 (.680) and 90-51 (.638) record in conference play. His final team uptown won the 2022 NAIA National Championship - the second in school history and the first since 1945. His national championship team set a Loyola record with 37 wins that season, and the record for winning percentage at .974. That squad also set school records for points in a game (143) and the largest winning margin in school history (78). In an ironic twist of fate Hollowell beat UNO at Lakefront Arena in an exhibition game to start his run to the national title.

While at Loyola (New Orleans) Hollowell won 20+ games five times, won a pair of conference tournaments (2019, 2021) along with a regular season championship (2021). Prior to being named the head coach at Loyola he served as an assistant on the Wolfpack coaching staff starting in 2009 where he was part of another 20-win campaign. In total Hollowell has been part of six of the schools' ten total 20+ win seasons. He coached 19 All-Conference selections, and individual student athletes to Conference Player of the Year, Conference Defensive Player of the Year, Conference Newcomer of the Year and Conference Freshman of the Year status.

Hollowell was instrumental in the recruitment and development of two of Loyola New Orleans' best ever players - Zach Wrightsil and Myles Burns. Wrightsil was named both the 2021-2022 NAIA National Player of the Year, and Southern States Athletic Conference Player of the Year following the national championship. He is the program's all-time scoring leader, and first all time in assists, and second all-time in rebounds and steals. He also owns both the most points and rebounds in a single season in school Wolfpack.

Burns was named a three-time Southern States Athletic Conference Defensive player of the year. He ranks No. 1 in Wolfpack history in career rebounds, and holds both the single season record, and single season number two mark for rebounding in program history. Burns also finished his career with the most steals in program history, and the second most points.

Both Wrightsil (Marquette) and Burns (Ole Miss) transferred to Div. I schools after the national championship - a testament to Hollowell's ability to develop talent. Burns spent last season playing in the NBA G-League for Raptors 905.

Hollowell's career also boasts extensive international experience - having coached abroad in over 30 countries. Before first joining the Loyola staff as an assistant coach in 2011, Hollowell gained international experience coaching professionally in Qatar, Lithuania, Bahrain, and China. As assistant coach for the Qatar National Team under former New Orleans men's basketball coach Joey Stiebing, Hollowell helped the team qualify for the 2006 FIBA World Championship, the only world championship appearance in Qatar's history.

Hollowell was born in Shreveport, La. and raised in Mandeville, La. He was a four-year basketball player at Mandeville High School. He and his wife Nicole have three children, Emma, Jett and Jax, and stepson Aaron Traub.

His goal is to inspire young people and uplift their communities.
