



#### **MSU's Borges Top Seed In 2019 NCAA Singles** Championship; Borges/Rakic No. 3 In Doubles

The Mississippi State Bulldogs will be sending four players to the 2019 NCAA Individual Championships in Orlando, Florida. It marks the ninth-straight season State has had at least one representative in the NCAA Individual Championships and the 34th year all-time.

Senior All-American Nuno Borges earned a third-straight NCAA Singles bid in 2019 after an absolutely incredible season on the court.

Debuting at No. 1 nationally for the first time in his career in the May 1 ITA Rankings, he also earned the No. 1 seed in the 2019 NCAA Singles Championship (the third Bulldog ever to do so,  $\rightarrow$  28th NCAA Championship appearance (24th joining Thomas Dupre [1997] and Marco Baron [2001]). As such, he will earn ITA All-American hon- → 14th NCAA Championship Round of 16 ors for the third year in a row. He is the only Bulldog to earn a Top 4 NCAA Singles seed three times during a career.

The senior, who became the first MSU player ever to reach the NCAA Singles semifinals in 2017, → Eleven wins over top 25 foes, three in the top 15 repeated that result in 2018. He also earned SEC  $\rightarrow$  24 wins are one shy of the program record of 25 Player of the Year honors for an unprecedented third consecutive season in 2019. He has compiled an incredible 32-2 record this season and is riding → Nuno Borges gains All-America status after earning an amazing 26-match win streak into NCAA action in Orlando.

In doubles, Borges and senior Strahinja Rakic will represent State in the NCAA Doubles Championship for the second-straight year after → Borges named SEC Player of the Year and All-SEC becoming the first MSU pair ever earn the No. 1 seed a year ago. As the No. 3 seed, the duo will once again earn All-America status in doubles.

The tandem picked up right where they left off from their NCAA Doubles quarterfinal run a  $\rightarrow$  Borges named SEC Tournament MVP; year ago, holding a 21-10 overall mark in 2018-19. This spring, the duo anchored the No. 1 position → Borges also named SEC Men's Tennis Scholarwith a 16-7 ledger (9-2 SEC). Together, Borges and Rakic hold the most wins by a doubles pair in program history with 55.

Junior Giovanni Oradini, who earned his first career bid to the NCAA Singles draw in 2018 and capitalized on it by advancing to the Round of 16 to earn All-America status, is in that field for ths second year in a row.

Ranked 61st nationally at present, Oradini is 18-12 in singles overall and earned All-SEC First Team honors for the second year in a row.

Niclas Braun and Oradini (ranked 32nd at present) received an atlarge bid to the 2019 NCAA Doubles field. The pair has been outstanding this season, holding a team-best 29-7 overall record (17-2 in dual matches). The duo is also steadily climbing up the charts for wins by an MSU doubles pair, ranking third all-time with 47.

#### **MSU's NCAA Individual Championship History**

State's selections to this year's NCAA singles and doubles field give Mississippi State men's tennis 86 all-time selections in the national individual championships - 59 in singles and 27 in doubles.

The best finish State has ever had in the NCAA Singles Championship was the semifinals with Nuno Borges doing so each of the last two seasons. In doubles, All-American Bulldogs Laurent Miguelard and Joc Simmons paired to claim the 1994 NCAA Doubles crown in South Bend, Ind.

#### No. 7 MSU Men's Tennis Continues Success In 2019

While State is sending players to the NCAA Individual Championships again, the Bulldog team also had incredible success in 2019, ending with its 28th all-time NCAA Championship bid.

While maintaining a Top 10 ranking the entire season, the Maroon & White claimed the SEC Tournament Championship crown for the second consecutive season.

The Bulldogs, led by head coach Matt Roberts and assistant coach Andrew Goodwin, secured the program's second-most wins ever (24), while advancing to the NCAA Round of 16 for the third time in the last four seasons.

#### **Borges Named SEC Player of The Year** For Record Third Time; Four Bulldogs **Earn All-SEC**

Senior and top-ranked Nuno Borges has simply been dominant for the Maroon & White all year, posting an amazing 32-2 singles record while becoming the first Bulldog ever to go undefeated during the dual match season (25-0). Borges' efforts were rewarded when the league announced him as the 2019 SEC Player of the Year, the first player in league history to win the award three times.

Borges was also named the SEC's Scholar-Athlete of the Year for men's tennis for the second year in a row. A member of the All-SEC First Team, he headlined MSU's dominance.

Joining Borges on the All-SEC First Team was junior Giovanni Oradini and senior Strahinia Rakic, each having outstanding seasons of their own. Oradini was 12-5 in SEC play overall this spring and is ranked No. 61 in singles and 32nd in doubles. Rakic went 15-6 in league matches.

Rounding out State's SEC player honors, senior Niclas Braun garnered Second Team All-SEC laurels for the third year in a row. Braun has been a stalwart in the MSU lineup during his career. This season, he is a combined 52-17 in all matches, 31-7 in dual match competition, 14-4 in the SEC.

#### MISSISSIPPI STATE'S NO. 1 **NATIONAL RANKINGS IN TENNIS**

Mississippi State Tennis has had five singles players and four doubles teams hold No. 1 national rankings during their careers, Nuno Borges becoming the most recent in the May 1, 2019, ITA Rankings.

Two of the five singles players have ended seasons ranked in the country's top spot (Thomas Dupré in 1997 and Marco Baron in 2001) and one of the doubles teams has done so (Nuno Borges and Strahinja Rakic in 2018).

The longest any player has held the No. 1 ranking was Thomas Dupré for 364 days (12/10/96-12/9/97), which spanned nine releases of the national rankings.

Borges and Daniel Courcol are the only Bulldogs to ever hold No. 1 national rankings in both singles and doubles during a career and Laurent Miquelard is the only MSU player to ever hold the No. 1 national doubles ranking with two different partners.

Five-time All-American who has established himself as the greatest and most-decorated student-athlete in Mississippi State's storied tennis history...Ranks first in five career categories including total wins (182), singles wins (116), dual match wins (135), dual match singles wins (81) and wins by a doubles pair (55 w/ Strahinja Rakic)...Is on pace to finish as State's all-time leader in overall and singles winning percentage as well... Is already State's all-time leader in career winning percentage in overall dual matches (75.8%) and dual match singles (87.1%)...Attained the ITA's No. 1 national singles ranking on May 1, 2019, for the first time in his career and is the No. 1 seed in the 2019 NCAA Singles Championship, earning ITA All-America honors in singles for the third straight year...Has spent all but one poll the entire season in the Top 5 in singles...NCAA Singles semifinalist in 2017 and 2018...Against the 2019 NCAA singles field (including alternates), Borges is 30-7 in his four years...Will become the first Bulldog to earn All-America honors three years in a row since Marco Baron (1999-2001) and only the third all-time to earn at least three All-America singles honors in a career... By earning both singles and doubles All-America status for the second season in a row, he becomes the first Bulldog ever to do so and the first to earn All-American honors at least twice in both singles and doubles since Daniel Courcol (1991-93)... He and Courcol are also the only Bulldogs to ever be ranked No. 1 in the country in both singles and doubles during a career...The 2019 SEC Player of the Year after an unprecedented senior campaign, becoming the first player in SEC history to three-peat the honor...Was also named 2019 SEC

Scholar-Athlete of the Year to become the first Bulldog to earn the honor twice and only the second in SEC history to do so...Also named First Team All-SEC, as well as to the SEC Community Service Team - both for the third year in a row...Named MVP of the 2019 SEC Championship after clinching MSU's second straight tournament title...Leads the Bulldogs with an incredible 32-2 (94.1%) singles mark this season - a perfect 25-0 (100.0%) in dual matches...He is the only State player ever to finish the dual season undefeated while also going 12-0 in SEC play, all at the No. 1 position...Has 24

Junior from Rovereto, Italy...Mainstay for the Bulldogs at the No. 2 position in singles this season, while also spending the entire season at No. 2 doubles...Moved into the 2019 NCAA Singles field on May 7, after being named first alternate...Earned an at-large bid in the 2019 NCAA Doubles Championship with Niclas Braun...Against the 2019 NCAA Singles field (including alternates), Oradini is 10-10 in his three years...Earned First Team All-SEC honors for the second straight year after going 13-9 in dual matches and 7-4 in league play at No. 2 singles & 17-2, 5-1 at No. 2 doubles...Earned a career-high doubles ranking of 3rd on March 5 w/Braun, while opening the fall at a career-best No. 5 in singles...This spring, has earned five ranked singles wins (25 in his career), with three of those coming against top 50 foes... The best of those came on March 24 against Georgia's 13th-ranked Jan Zielinski, which tied the match at 3-all to set up Trevor Foshey's clincher... After reaching the NCAA Doubles quarterfinals last year as the top seed, Nuno Borges and Strahinja Rakic are back for more as the No. 3 seed in their final season...As a Top 8 seed, the duo earns All-America status for the second straight year... Against doubles pairs in the NCAA Championship, including alternates, the duo is 10-7...The tandem currently ranks second on the team with 21 wins (16 in dual matches, all at No. 1)...Have defeated eight ranked foes this spring, 19 for their careers...The team clinched a team-high 11 doubles points in 2019...As a pair, Borges and Rakic rank as MSU's all-time leaders in career wins by a doubles pair with 55...41 of those 55 victories have come the last two seasons...The duo has spent the entire 2018-19 season ranked, opening the fall as the top-ranked pair in the nation...Borges and Rakic earned First-Team All-SEC honors for being the top doubles pair in the SEC for the second year in a row... In the fall, the pair advanced to the consolation doubles final of the ITA All-American Championships, where they dropped a hard-fought three-setter to teammates Niclas Braun and Giovanni Oradini.

Niclas Braun and Giovanni Oradini immediately clicked when paired in 2017-18, becoming one of MSU's largest doubles threats...That carried over to 2018-19, as the duo has won a team-high 29 matches en route to earning an at-large bid in the 2019 NCAA Doubles Championship...Those 29 wins are the most by a State pair since Simon Larose and Matt Pledger won 31 in 1997 (and just three shy of the school record of 32)...Currently ranked 32nd, the duo is riding a six-match win streak, and has claimed 13 of its last 14 decisions...The tandem spent most of 2018-19 highly-ranked, climbing from No. 7 in the fall to a career-high No. 3 on March 5...Against 2019 NCAA Doubles duos, including alternates, they are 5-4...The pair has four ranked wins this year, including top-ranked teammates Nuno Borges and Strahinja Rakic in the consolation final of the ITA All-American Championships...The pair clinched four doubles points this spring...In the fall, they captured the doubles title at the ITA Southern Regional Championships, while also reaching the doubles quarters at the Oracle ITA National Fall Championships...Braun earned Second Team All-SEC honors (third time) while Oradini captured First Team laurels (second time).
