LEADING OFF

Q No. 1/1 Oklahoma Softball heads west to the annual Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic this weekend to play five games in Cathedral City, Calif. Feb. 23-25

• The Sooners (9-0, 0-0 Big 12) begin competition on Friday, Feb. 23 with a 7:30 p.m. CT start against No. 20/25 Mississippi State (8-1, 0-0 SEC) followed by a 10 p.m. first pitch vs. Wisconsin (4-6, 0-0 Big 10). OU meets RV/RV San Diego State (5-5, 0-0 Mountain West) at 2:30 p.m. CT Saturday, Feb. 24. Oklahoma closes its weekend with an 11 a.m. CT first pitch on Sunday, Feb. 25 against Seattle followed by a 1:30 p.m. start vs. Loyola Marymount.

Q The entire Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic will be streamed on FloSoftball (\$). All five games will be broadcast on 1560 AM/103.3 FM The Franchise 2 with Friday and Sunday's contests also airing on 107.7 FM The Franchise.

Q Oklahoma has made regular appearances at the Mary Nutter since 2006, playing in the showcase every season it has been held. OU is 57-21 (.731) all-time at the Mary Nutter and has a 10-game winning streak at the event dating back to Feb. 25, 2022.

ABOUT LAST WEEKEND

• The Sooners enjoyed a 5-0 appearance at the Cowgirl Challenge last weekend, outscoring their opponents 36-1 with four shutouts and three runrule victories. OU's pitching staff allowed just one run on 11 hits and seven walks across 29.0 innings, striking out 39 and holding opponents to a .116 average.

Senior shortstop Tiare Jennings slashed .438/.471/.875 for a 1.336 OPS on the weekend, leading OU with six runs scored and two home runs. Senior centerfielder Jayda Coleman batted .533 (8for-15) while senior outfielder Rylie Boone led the club with six RBIs.

Q Oklahoma's bats produced a .362 average and slugged .583 over the five games. The Sooner lineup homered six times while adding four doubles and three triples for 13 extra-base hits.

AN UNPRECEDENTED STREAK

Q Oklahoma's NCAA-record winning streak stands at 62 games entering the weekend. The historic streak has featured 44 wins over Power Five opponents, 35 shutouts, 27 wins over ranked teams, 27 run-rule wins and just three extra-innings victories. OU has defeated 37 different programs over the course of the win streak, the most wins coming against Texas and Iowa State with four

Q The Sooners have scored 495 runs while allowing just 57 during their winning streak, generating a whopping +438 run differential. OU averages 7.98 runs per game and has recorded a 0.87 ERA in the circle across the stretch.

Q Oklahoma is hitting .364 with a 1.116 OPS during the 62-game streak, blasting 121 home runs and 106 doubles. Opposing teams have hit just .162 off the Sooner staff with a meager .453 OPS over the streak

Q The Sooners' 4-3 victory over Washington on Feb. 9 extended their winning streak to 56 games dating back to Feb. 24, 2023, establishing a new record for the longest winning streak in NCAA history. OU's 56th consecutive win broke the previous all-division record held by then-Division II program Western Kentucky.

TIA TIME

Q Senior shortstop Tiare Jennings enters the weekend on a team-leading six-game hitting streak and is poised to reach a handful of key statistical milestones. The San Pedro, Calif. native is just one RBI away from moving into second all-time in OU

history. She has driven in 253 runs over her Sooner career, one shy of tying Lauren Chamberlain's mark of 254. Jocelyn Alo is the program's career leader in RBIs with 323.

Q Jennings is also just three doubles away from reaching Kristin Vesely (53) for third all-time and ranks ninth in OU annals with 251 hits. She needs 15 to reach Kelli Braitsch for eighth.

J COLE BRINGING THE HEAT

Q Senior centerfielder Jayda Coleman enjoyed a terrific trip to Lake Charles last weekend, leading OU with eight hits and a .533 batting average. She went 8-for-15 on the trip with a double and two RBIs, stole two bags and made a pair of incredible defensive plays in center. Coleman has recorded a hit in each of her last five games.

LUDLAM LIGHTS UP

Q Graduate catcher Riley Ludlam has quickly made an impact in the OU lineup in her lone season with the program. The grad transfer from Furman is third on the club with seven RBIs and is 5-for-11 (.455) at the plate. She started three games, two at DP and one behind the plate, last weekend to help the Sooners go 5-0.

WHAT A RELIEF

Q Oklahoma's bullpen has been lights-out to open the 2024 campaign. The Sooner pen' has yet to allow a run in 23.1 innings this spring, limiting opponents to a .115 average (9-for-78) with a 20:5 strikeout-to-walk ratio. All nine hits allowed by the relievers have been singles, helping the group record a 0.60 WHIP.

A FAMILIAR FACE

Q Oklahoma's first game of the Mary Nutter pits the program against Mississippi State, led by head coach and Sooner legend Samantha Ricketts. A two-time all-american at Oklahoma, Ricketts graduated in 2009 as the Sooners' career leader in home runs and RBIs.

SOONERS SHINE SOUTH OF THE BORDER

- **Q** OU went 4-0 at the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge over opening weekend, extending their NCAA-record win streak to 57 games dating back to last season. The Sooners improved to 10-2 all-time in Puerto Vallarta and outscored their four opponents 31-6.
- $m{Q}$ Oklahoma earned their first two ranked wins of 2024 last weekend by downing No. 9/11 Duke 3-0 and No. 10/7 Washington 4-3 in eight innings.
- The OU lineup produced 7.75 runs per game, batting .327 with eight home runs and a 1.027 OPS over the four games.
- **Q** Alyssa Brito slashed .417/.533/1.167 for a 1.700 OPS with three home runs and five RBIs to earn most-outstanding-player honors. Kelly Maxwell and Kasidi Pickering joined her on the all-tournament team. Maxwell went 2-0 in her two appearances and logged 7.2 scoreless innings while Pickering hit a team-leading .455 and drove in seven runs.
- **Q** Oklahoma's pitching staff allowed just three earned runs, recording a 0.78 staff ERA, and limited opponents to a lone extra-base hit in 109 plate appearances. Opponents batted .186 with a meager .464 OPS on the weekend.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW, KP

• Freshman outfielder Kasidi Pickering put the softball world on notice in her first collegiate plate appearance, launching an opposite-field grand slam in the first inning against Utah Valley. Pickering earned all-tournament team honors and enters week two leading the Sooners in batting average (.455), RBIs (7) and hits (5).

NCAA RECORD SHATTERED

Q The Sooners' 4-3 victory over Washington on Feb. 9 extended their winning streak to 56 games dating back to Feb. 24, 2023, establishing a new record for the longest winning streak in NCAA history. OU's 56th consecutive win broke the previous all-division record held by then-Division II program Western Kentucky. Oklahoma's win streak currently stands at a NCAA-record 57 games.

GASSO'S CLIMB CONTINUES

Q Head coach Patty Gasso moved into third in NCAA history with her 1,458th career win in OU's victory over Duke on Feb. 9, passing Margie Wright (Fresno State). Carol Hutchins (Michigan) is the all-time leader in career wins with 1,707 while Mike Candrea (Arizona) is second with 1,674. Gasso leads all active NCAA coaches in career wins.

2023 IN REVIEW

- **Q** The Sooners capped a national championship season in 2023 with a 61-1 record, the best win percentage in NCAA Division I softball history (.984) and Big 12 regular season and tournament titles while pacing the country in a plethora of categories, including ERA (0.96), batting average (.367) and fielding percentage (.988).
- **Q** The dominant run included an NCAA-record 53-game win streak, a nation-best and program-record 35 shutouts, 29 wins by run rule and a 28-0 record vs. ranked opponents.
- **Q** Additionally, OU ranked No. 1 over the final 11 weeks of the 2023 season in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and has held the top spot in 42 of the last 43 polls dating back to 2021.
- **Q** A nation-high five Sooners were named NFCA First Team All-Americans, eight Sooners earned All-Big 12 accolades and five were tabbed WCWS All-Tournament Team selections.

CO-CAPTAINS

- Graduate catcher Kinzie Hansen and senior infielder Tiare Jennings will both wear the "C" on their jerseys in 2024 as the Sooners' co-captains.
- **Q** Hansen, the 2023 Johnny Bench Award winner, blasted 13 home runs and drove in 57 runs last season while slashing .409/.438/.759 for a 1.197 OPS as the Sooners' backstop. The graduate student ranks sixth in program history with a .734 career slugging percentage and 10th with 49 home runs. Hansen's work behind the plate defensively is equally impressive as she owns a .993 career fielding percentage and has thrown out 36% of would-be base stealers.
- **Q** One of the most accomplished hitters in program history, Jennings enters her senior campaign ranked among OU's career leaders in multiple offensive categories. A career .427 hitter with 73 home runs, 49 doubles and 245 RBIs to her credit, Jennings is second in program history in batting average, third in home runs, slugging percentage, runs batted in and extra-base hits, fourth in total bases, fifth

in doubles and eighth in runs scored and on-base percentage. Jennings slashed .415/.477/.781 last season for a 1.258 OPS while belting 17 home runs and 16 doubles and registering 66 RBIs.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Multiple Sooners have garnered preseason honors from the Big 12, Softball America and D1 Softball entering 2024.
- Q Senior pitchers Nicole May and Kelly Maxwell, senior outfielders Rylie Boone and Jayda Coleman, senior infielders Alyssa Brito and Tiare Jennings and senior catcher Kinzie Hansen were among the 19 players chosen to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team by the league's head coaches. Jennings was one of three unanimous selections to the team.
- Q Oklahoma was one of just two programs to have multiple selections as Texas ranked second with five representatives. Baylor, BYU, Houston, Iowa State, Oklahoma State and Texas Tech each had one honoree. Student-athletes were chosen regardless of position and coaches could not vote for their own players.
- Maxwell, Coleman, Jennings, Brito and Hansen each added first-team preseason All-America honors from both Softball America and D1 Softball while May received a second-team nod from Softball America. Oklahoma led all programs with its five first-team honorees.

NEW THREADS

- The Sooners added four transfers ahead of the 2024 campaign, providing depth at a key position and filling key areas of need on the pitching staff.
- Right-handed pitcher Karlie Keeney, catcher Riley Ludlam and left-handed pitcher Kelly Maxwell joined the program as graduate transfers while righthander Paytn Monticelli came to OU with three years of eligibility remaining.
- Keeney joined the Sooners following a tremendous career at Liberty. The three-time All-ASUN Second Team selection owns a career 2.32 ERA across 665.0 innings of work while pitching to a 69-29 record. Known for her ability to carve through a lineup, she has limited opponents to an OPS below .632 each of her last three seasons.
- **Q** Ludlam came to the Sooners after four seasons at Furman where she was a career .309 hitter with 45 doubles, 25 home runs and 117 RBIs. The NFCA All-South Region Second Team selection started 49 games for the Paladins last year, hitting .372 with 10 home runs, 15 doubles and 41 RBIs.
- Maxwell headed southwest to OU following a terrific four-season stretch at Oklahoma State. The lefthander has won 58 collegiate games while posting a 1.58 ERA and striking out 746 batters over 494.2 innings pitched (10.6 K/7). A two-year All-America selection. Maxwell earned second-team honors last spring after going 16-7 with a 1.91 ERA and 229 strikeouts in 142.2 innings.

Q Oklahoma head coach Patty Gasso announced on Jan. 29 that JT Gasso has been elevated to associate head coach.

JT Gasso, who has served the past eight seasons as Oklahoma's assistant coach, will continue to serve as the hitting coach, directing the offense and working with the outfielders.

• During JT Gasso's tenure, the Sooners have won seven Big 12 regular season titles and four Big 12 tournament crowns (the tournament was not played during Gasso's first season, finished in 2019 or played in 2020) while making seven Women's College World Series appearances and winning five national titles.

• Gasso's lineup has produced nearly 7.8 runs per game over his eight seasons on staff while posting a .350/.439/.613 slash line for a 1.052 OPS. OU has blasted 800 home runs over that span, has struck out in just 9.2% of its plate appearances and has drawn walks at an 11.6% clip during his tenure. His hitters have earned two USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year awards and have garnered six Big 12 Player of the Year honors. Oklahoma led the NCAA in batting average in 2019, 2021, 2022 and 2023 and owns single-season national records for home runs (161), team batting average (.405), slugging (.778), on base percentage (.490), runs scored (638) and total bases (1,279), all set in 2021.

A NEW HOME FOR SOONER SOFTBALL

Love's Field, the new home of Oklahoma softball officially opens March 1, 2024.

The facility features a 10,669-square-foot indoor training center and several team spaces, including a training room, locker room and classroom. It also has space for a recognition area to showcase national championships, All-Americans and other outstanding accomplishments.

Q Constructed at the northwest corner of South Jenkins Avenue and Imhoff Road, Love's Field is approximately one-half mile south of the current stadium location and will accommodate a capacity of 4,200.

The complex's overall square footage is 44,000, compared to 15,168 at Marita Hynes Field, OU's previous facility. The team areas grew from 2,598 square feet to 5,593 square feet and the indoor practice facility jumped from 4,744 square feet to 10,669 square feet.

Entering her 30th season at the University of Oklahoma in 2024, NFCA Hall of Fame head coach Patty Gasso has molded the OU softball program into a national power and permanently placed herself among the elite college softball coaches in the country.

Oklahoma has won seven national championships (2000, 2013, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022 and 2023) and is one of just three programs in NCAA history to win more than two national titles. Gasso has reached the Women's College World Series 16 times during her tenure, and has advanced to the postseason in each one of her 29 seasons (no tournament in 2020).

With 33 seasons as a head coach to her name, Gasso has a career collegiate coaching record of 1,617-404-3 (.799) and holds a record of 1,456-345-2 (.808) at OU.

She has won more Big 12 games (394-87; .819) than any coach in the league's history and has more than twice as many overall wins as any other coach in OU annals. The Sooners have claimed 15 Big 12 regular season titles, including an unprecedented 11 straight since the 2012 season, and eight conference tournament titles under her direction. Gasso's teams have finished second or higher 23 times in the 27 years since the inception of the Big 12 in 1996.

Numerous Sooner players have prospered under Gasso's tutelage and garnered national, regional and conference recognition. Most recently, Jocelyn Alo helped lead the Sooners to back-to-back titles en route to winning consecutive USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year awards in 2021 and 2022. Keilani Ricketts was also a two-time USA Softball Player of the Year in 2012 and 2013. Gasso has recruited and coached 79 All-Americans, 145 All-Region honors and 192 all-conference selections at OU.

In the Big 12 era, Sooners have been named Big 12 Player of the Year a total of 16 times and Big 12 Pitcher of the Year nine times, while nine have been selected as Big 12 Freshman of the Year and one as Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. In 2010, Amber Flores became the first player in league history to earn player-of-the-year honors twice, Shelby Pendley joined her in 2015 before Alo claimed the honor in consecutive seasons in 2021 and 2022.

The OU softball success under Gasso has also spilled over into the classroom where the Sooners have been honored with 170 academic all-conference honors. Twenty of those have gone on to become Academic All-Americans, including Lana Moran, the 2000 Academic All-American of the Year.

Gasso and her staff have consistently been recognized for their efforts on and off the field. The staff was awarded three consecutive Speedline/NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year awards from 1999-2001 and received the national honor in 2000, 2013, 2016, 2017 and 2023. Gasso and staff have claimed the regional honor in 15 of their 29 seasons, with the most recent award coming in 2023. In addition, Gasso has been named the Big 12 Coach of the Year 15 times: 1996, 1999, 2000, 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2023.
