#### **NATIONAL RANKINGS**

- Texas A&M own an RPI ranking of 12 and boasts a top 25 ranking in all four nationally recognized polls, including No. 13 in the NFCA and Softball America rankings, while sitting at No. 17 in the ESPN/USA Softball and D1 Softball polls.
- Statistically, the Aggies rank top 15 in the nation in numerous categories, including No. 7 in ERA (1.38) and No. 10 in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.89), while the offense is No. 10 in slugging percentage (0.583), No. 11 on-base percentage (.433) and No. 11 in home runs (34).
- Individually, Emiley Kennedy leads the nation with 12 wins and six shutouts, while her 99 strikeouts are fourth most. The junior owns a 0.72 ERA, good enough for 16th best in country.
- Jazmine Hill and Amari Harper rank in the top 25 in on-base percentage, Hill at No. 19 (.560) and Harper at No. 25 (.547). Trinity Cannon's eight home runs is 22nd most in the country, while her .859 slugging percentage is 26th best.

#### **TEXAS A&M IN THE SEC**

- Ol' Sarge's charges rank in the top five of the SEC in numerous offensive categories, including the third most runs scored (168) and total bases (359), while swiping the second most stolen bases (42). The Aggies are No. 4 in batting average (.333), slugging percentage (.583), on-base percentage (.433), hits (205), doubles (40) and home runs (34).
- The pitching staff has registered the second most strikeouts (179), while ranking fourth best in ERA (1.38), opposing batting average (.188) and runs allowed (42).
- Emiley Kennedy leads the league in wins (12), strikeouts (99), strikeouts looking (24) and saves (3), while her 0.72 is fourth best.

#### **INSIDE THE SERIES**

- Texas A&M is 15-11 all-time against Mississippi State, including winners of the last four. Since joining the SEC, the Aggies have won two of three series in Starkville, including series wins the last two trips in 2021 and 2018.
- The Aggies swept the Bulldogs in Aggieland last season, including a six inning run-rule, 9-1, to open the series, followed by winning game two 2-1 and the finale 5-1. Allie Enright hit 4-of-8, including one double, one RBI and one run, while Julia Cottrill homered, while driving in four runs and Koko Wooley was 5-of-11 with a double, triple and three RBI in the series. Emiley Kennedy led the pitching staff striking out eight in 8.1 scoreless innings, while earning two wins. Emily Leavitt tossed 4.2 innings, while yielding a run and two hits in a win and Shaylee Ackerman recorded a save, totaling 4.1 innings and five strikeouts on the weekend.

#### **COUNTRY JAZ MAKING NOISE**

- Jazmine Hill has made her presence felt in Aggieland hitting .413 at the dish with seven home runs, while leading the team with a .560 on-base percentage, 26 hits and 29 runs. The graduate is riding a team best 16 game on-base streak and has scored a run in all but three games this season, including at least one run in the previous 12 games.
- · Hill has started every game in center field showcasing her range and flashing the leather, while keeping runners from advancing with 19 putouts and one assist with an unblemished 1.000 fielding percentage.
- The Arizona State transfer came to Texas A&M to be reunited with head coach Trisha Ford and her staff after their departure from Tempe following the 2022 season. Under Ford and her staff's guidance from 2020-22, Hill batted .344 at the dish with a .673 slugging percentage, including 30 home runs and 30 doubles.

#### IT STARTS AND ENDS IN THE CIRCLE

- The Texas A&M pitching staff has reaped the benefits of head coach Trisha Ford's mentoring as the group boasts a 1.32 ERA and .968 WHIP, while holding opposing batters to a .188 batting average.
- Emiley "Lefty" Kennedy has showcased her versatility as a pitcher to start and finish games, whether that's from beginning to end or being called on from the pen. The junior has registered nine 10 games in 11 starts, while earning three saves. She boasts a .830 WHIP, while batters are averaging .162 against her at the plate.

#### **WE LIKE IT WITH 2**

- Texas A&M has found success facing two outs batting .349 and driving in 66 runs, both rank second most in the SEC. Allie Enright leads the team in 2-out RBI with 14, followed by Jazmine Hill driving in 13. The duo also leads the team in 2-out batting average with Hill hitting .478 and Enright registering at .406.
- The Aggies have scored 41% (69-of-168) of their runs with two outs, including 13 home runs when facing the final out. Enright, Hill and Trinity Cannon lead the team with three round trippers and two outs.

#### STARTING HOT

- The 23-2 ledger is the hottest start for Texas A&M since the 2017 campaign, a year the Aggies last reached the Women's College World Series.
- Emiley Kennedy earned win No. 10 in Texas A&M's 21st game of the season. She became the fastest Aggie starter to double-digit wins since Samantha Show claimed win No. 10 in game 17 of the 2016 campaign.
- Ol' Sarge's charges attack early and often scoring 51% (85-of-168) of their run production in the first three innings.

#### **WEEKLY HONORS**

- Emiley Kennedy earned D1 Softball National Pitcher of the Week honors following her dominating performances in the SEC opening series sweep of No. 22 South Carolina March 8-10. The left-handed thrower finished the weekend series 2-0 and earned a save, while grinding through 13.0 scoreless innings. She totaled 15 punch outs and kept batters limited to a .182 average at the dish. Kennedy joins Megan Gibson (April 13, 2008) as the only Aggie pitchers to receive a national weekly honor.
- Texas A&M has garnered three SEC weekly honors this season, including Kennedy in back-to-back weeks on Feb. 19 and Feb. 26 to become the first Aggie pitcher to win conference pitcher of the week recognition in consecutive weeks since Megan Gibson was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week twice in a row in March 2008. Allie Enright also earned SEC recognition on Feb. 19 taking home Co-Player of the Week honors. It marked the third time that two Aggies earned honors in the same week since joining the league and the second consecutive season to do so after Keely Williams (Freshman of the Week) and Koko Wooley (Co-Player of the Week) did so on April 11, 2023.

#### YEAR TWO HITTING PRODUCTION

• The Aggie offense has seen a drastic improvement under second-year hitting coach Jeff Harger through 25 games this season compared to a year ago.

#### **EXPERIENCED AGGIES**

- Four Aggies have logged more than 175 career games played, including transfers Jazmine Hill (203), Julia Cottrill (203), while Rylen Wiggins (194) and Trinity Cannon (179) each have played their entire careers in the Maroon & White.
- Koko Wooley has appeared in 131 games as an Aggie and is one triple away from career No. 14, which would tie her with the third-most on the Aggie all-time list with Pattie Holthaus (1981-84).
- Cottrill is the lone Aggie with Women's College World Series action after she helped lead the Oklahoma State Cowgirls to Oklahoma City in 2022. Allie Enright was a member of the Arizona Wildcats squad that made the trip in 2022 and Brooke Vestal was on Oklahoma's national championship roster during the 2021 season.

#### THE GANG IS BACK

- The Aggies return the nucleus of their offensive firepower from a season ago, including over 80% of their hits (314-391) and home runs (38-47), as well as over 75% of their RBI (206-261) and runs (222-286).
- Every offensive category leader from a season ago is back for 2024, including All-American Julia Cottrill who led the Maroon & White in slugging percentage (.617), total bases (95), RBI (43), doubles (12) and home runs (10).
- Five of seven returning position starters recorded 50-or-more starts last season, including senior Rylen Wiggins, junior Koko Wooley and sophomore Amari Harper who started all 56 games.

Fourteen-year head coaching veteran and four-time conference coach of the year Trisha Ford was hired as the Texas A&M softball program's 10th head coach on June 7, 2022.

Ford made an immediate impact in her first season leading the Maroon & White to a 35-21 record and a 12-12 ledger in SEC play. The Aggies won five of eight conference series, marking the most regular season wins and conference series victories since the 2018 season. The Aggies made their 21st-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance after earning a No. 2 seed to the Austin Regional. Ford was one of three head coaches and the only Power 5 head coach to lead their team to the NCAA Tournament in year one at their current school in 2023.

Texas A&M finished the campaign ranked No. 23 in the D1 Softball national ranking and received votes in the NFCA, ESPN/USA Softball polls. For the first time since 2019, the Aggies lived in the NFCA, ESPN/USA Softball and D1 Softball national polls, including 15-straight weeks in the D1 Softball poll and climbed as high as No. 13 nationally. In her third game as an Aggie, Ford secured career win No. 400 on Feb. 10, 2023.

Known across the nation as a pitching guru, the Aggie pitching staff benefited with improvement in overall team ERA, 2.70 (2023) compared to 3.71 (2022) the year prior to her arrival, and K-to-BB ratio, 2.44 (2023) compared to 1.50 in 2022. The staff combined to throw three no-hitters, including Madison Preston tossing a five inning no-hitter, Emiley Kennedy recording a seven inning no-no and a combined five inning no-hitter from Kennedy and Emily Leavitt.

Individually, Julia Cottrill was named to the NFCA All-America Third Team, marking the 42nd All-America recognition in program history. Cottrill also garnered All-SEC First Team and NFCA All-South Region First Team honors, while Rylen Wiggins earned All-SEC First Team honors, Amari Harper was named to the NFCA All-South Region Third Team and Koko Wooley earned All-SEC Second Team and NFCA All-South Region Second Team recognition.

In 2022, Ford was named the Pac-12 Coach of the Year after guiding ASU to its first Pac-12 Championship since 2011 and in 2018 when the Sun Devils made their first NCAA Women's College World Series appearance since 2013. In her six seasons in Tempe, Ford mentored five All-Americans and 20 All-Conference selections.

Prior to arriving in Tempe, Ford served a four-year stint as the head coach at Fresno State from 2013-16. Most notably, she was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016 after leading the Bulldogs to back-to-back Mountain West Conference Championships. She guided the teams to consecutive 40-win seasons, including a 2016 campaign with a 42-12-1 record and an incredible 22-1 mark in MWC action. The Bulldogs went unbeaten through April and recorded a then-nation-leading 23-game win streak, setting a school record for consecutive victories.

Ford spent nine years as an assistant coach with the Stanford Cardinal (2004-12), including four seasons as associate head coach. She helped guide Stanford to a Women's College World Series appearance (2004) and six NCAA Super Regional appearances (2004, '05, '06, '08, '09, '11) totaling a 385-155 (.713) overall record during the span.

Prior to joining Stanford's coaching staff, Ford spent two seasons as the head coach at her alma mater Saint Mary's College.

Arguably one of the best softball players in Saint Mary's history, she is the only female student-athlete in school history to have her number (9) retired.

Ford graduated from Saint Mary's with a degree in politics in 1999 and was inducted into the Gaels' Hall of Fame in 2007. A native of Fremont, California, she earned nine varsity letters in softball, volleyball and basketball during her prep career at American High School.

Ford and her husband, Eddie, married in the summer of 2005, and have two children, Emma and EJ.
