• **SEC Offensive Player of the Week** – Texas A&M midfielder Barbara Olivieri, a sophomore from Katy, Texas, logged a goal and an assist as the Maroon & White toppled the No. 9 Clemson Tigers, 3-1, at Ellis Field. After Clemson knotted the match at 1-1 in the 63rd minute, Olivieri put the Aggies back on top 63 seconds later with her first goal of the season. With just over 10 minutes remaining, Olivieri assisted on a goal by Kate Colvin to inflate the cushion to 3-1.

• **SEC Defensive Player of the Week** – LSU goalkeeper Mollee Swift, a junior from Papillion, Neb., did not allow a goal in the run of play in wins at No. 15 USF and at No. 19 UCF. The only goal conceded was off a penalty kick to USF. She made six saves on the week and lowered her GAA to 0.57 while raising her save percentage up to .846.

• **SEC Freshman of the Week** – Texas A&M midfielder Mia Pante, a freshman from Vancouver, British Columbia, had a goal and an assist in a win over No. 9 Clemson. Pante lit the lamp with her first career goal in the 17th minute to put the Aggies up 1-1 and then assisted Barbara Olivieri on the game-winner.

• Seven SEC teams are receiving mention in the United Soccer Coaches preseason poll: Auburn 11th, South Carolina 12th, LSU 17th and Tennessee 22nd. Texas A&M, Ole Miss and Arkansas are receiving votes.

• LSU's Mollee Swift was named the national player of the Week by the United Soccer Coaches (Sept. 1) and TopDrawerSoccer.com (August 31). Joining Swift in earning TDS Team of the Week honors were South Carolina's Jylissa Harris and Texas A&M's Barbara Olivieri.

• Three former SEC soccer players were members of Canada's gold medal winning squad at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics this summer. Allysha Chapman (LS) was a starter while Deanne Rose (UF) and Adriana Leon (UF) were key subs in the gold medal match.

• Arkansas and Texas A&M tied as the favorites to win the 2021 Southeastern Conference women's soccer title in voting by the league's 14 head coaches. South Carolina, Vanderbilt and Tennessee rounded out the top five.

• 79.3 percent (23 of 29) of the players that earned first or second team All-SEC honors in 2020 return for the 2021 campaign. Ten of the 14 first team selections return for this year. Included in that group is SEC Forward of the Year (Anna Podojil, AR), SEC Co-Defender of the Year (Karolina Sample, AM) and SEC Goalkeeper of the Year (Ashley Orkus, UM).

• Sixth players were named to the Preseason SEC Watch List. A complete listing of the players is available on page two of this release.

• At least twenty-two regular season matches will be televised to a national television audience this year on SEC Network and ESPNU. Additionally, more than 100 matches will be available digitally on SEC Network+.

• The SEC had five teams selected to participate in the 2020 NCAA Tournament. Three of those teams earned national seeds.

• Over the last 10 years, the SEC has earned 68 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of nearly seven per year – with all 14 member institutions making at least one appearance during that span. Eight different SEC teams have advanced to the Round of 16 since 2013 and the league has placed teams in the NCAA quarterfinals in each of the last seven seasons.

SEC SOCCER ENTERS 29TH SEASON

As Southeastern Conference women's soccer starts its 29th season in 2021, the conference has firmly established itself as one of the premier conferences in soccer.

While the sport has grown exponentially across the nation, the Southeastern part of the country has been a leader.

The SEC had five teams selected to participate in the 2020-21 NCAA Tournament. Three of those teams earned national seeds.

Over the last 10 years, the SEC has earned 68 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of nearly seven per year – with all 14 member institutions making at least one appearance during that span. Eight different SEC teams have advanced to the Round of 16 since 2013 and the league has placed teams in the NCAA quarterfinals in each of the last seven seasons.

Arkansas and Texas A&M tied for the 2020 SEC Championship with 7-1-0 league records. Vanderbilt earned its first SEC Tournament championship since 1994 and its third overall with a 3-1 win over Arkansas in Orange Beach, Ala.

The SEC's balance has been shown in league play as five different teams – Arkansas, Florida, South Carolina, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC regular season titles in the last 10 seasons. Also, five different teams – Auburn, Florida, LSU, South Carolina and Texas A&M – have won SEC Tournament championships since 2011.

In 2020, Arkansas' Anna Podojil was named the SEC Forward of the Year. Texas A&M's Addie McCain was named SEC Midfielder of the Year while Jimena Lopez and Karlina Sample shared SEC Defender of the Year honors. Ole Miss' Ashley Orkus was named SEC Goalkeeper of the Year. Arkansas' Colby Hale and Texas A&M's G Guerrieri were named SEC Co-Coach of the Year and the Aggie's' Barbara Olivieri was Freshman of the Year. Ole Miss' Chanel Thomas and South Carolina's Lauren Chang were SEC Co-Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

Nine SEC players earned All-America honors from the United Soccer Coaches, including first team selections Lopez and Podojil. McCain earned second team honors while Orkus, Sample, South Carolina's Anna Patten, Ole Miss' Channing Foster, Arkansas' Parker Goins and Vanderbilt's Haley Hopkins were third team picks.

SEC's players have garnered 60 All-America awards

from the United Soccer Coaches since 2011. SEC players have earned 14 first team All-America honors during that time and three have earned multiple first team honors (South Carolina's Sabrina D'Angelo in 2013 and 2014; South Carolina's Savannah McCaskill in 2016 and 2017; and South Carolina's Fisk in 2018 and 2019).

Chang was a 2020 Second Team CoSIDA Academic All-America while Thomas and Georgia's Caroline Chipman were third team selections. Lopez was named the United Soccer Coaches First Team Scholar All-America. Six SEC players earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors this past season.

SEC fans have taken notice of the conference's rise nationally. The SEC has had at least five teams rank in the Top 25 nationally in attendance in eight of the last nine years (not counting the COVID affected 2020 campaign). South Carolina and Texas A&M have both ranked in the Top Five in each of the last six years with the Aggies leading the nation with an average of 2,652 fans per game in 2018.

The incremental growth, combined with increasing exposure on the national and regional scene, has SEC women's soccer looking to blossom to new heights in the year 2020 and beyond.

- Three members of Tokyo Olympics gold medal winning team
- Two MAC Hermann Semifinalists
- Three CoSIDA Academic All-America
- Six CoSIDA Academic All-District picks
- 13 programs earning United Soccer Coaches' College Team Academic Awards
- Nine United Soccer Coaches' All-Americans, including two first team selections
- 27 student-athletes on the United Soccer Coaches' All-Region teams
- Five teams advancing to the NCAA Championships
- At least one team in the NCAA Quarterfinals for the seventh consecutive year
- Eight different schools have made Round of 16 appearances over the last eight years

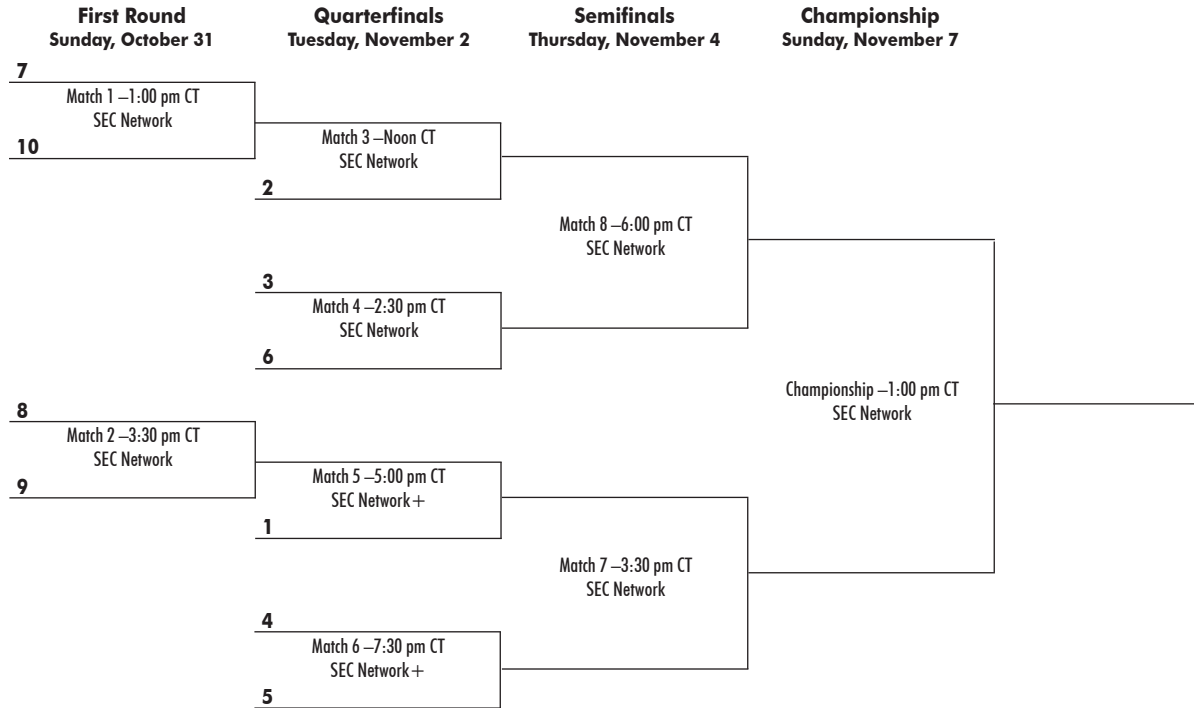

2021 SEC SOCCER TOURNAMENT – ORANGE BEACH, ALABAMA



There shall be a single-elimination tournament of the top ten teams played at the conclusion of the regular season schedule. The tournament champion shall be the Conference representative to the NCAA championship.

The top ten teams with the highest point total, regardless of divisions, will participate in the tournament, with the two division champions serving as the top two seeds. The following point system is utilized to determine regular season standings and seeding for the tournament: a win counts as three points, a tie as one, and a loss as zero points. If a game(s) is cancelled, neither team will receive a point and the standings will be determined by average points per game.

Tie-Breaker Procedures

The tournament will be seeded 1-14 based on the point system implemented to determine regular season standings. The two division champions shall be the top two seeds. If teams are tied, the following procedures, in order as follows, will be used to break the tie:

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- Head-to-head competition between the tied teams.
- Points earned versus common opponents.
- Goal differential versus common opponents.
- Goals scored versus common opponents.
- Won-Lost record of the two teams versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.

F. Goal differential versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.

G. Goals scored versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.

H. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** The following procedure will be used until the tie is broken. If at any time this tie breaker results in only two remaining tied teams, then the two-team tiebreaker will be used beginning with Subsection A in that procedure and continuing from that point:

A. If all teams have played one another, then most points earned in those matches only.

B. If all teams have not played, but one team has defeated all teams in the tie break, then that team breaks the tie and shall be placed highest. Remaining teams will continue with the tie break procedure.

C. If all teams have not played one another and a team does not have all wins over the tied teams, then use Subsection B in the two-team tie break procedures and continue through the two team tie-break procedures until ties between all teams are broken (except Subsection H will read "if three or more teams are still tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw").
