SOCCER HEADLINES

- Louisiana Tech begins their first road trip of the 2022 with a pair of SEC matchups in Ole Miss and Mississippi State after starting with four straight at home. Tech finished the home stand 2-1-1 and fell to No. 12 Ole Miss in the first road match of the season. After the Mississippi pair, Tech will continue the road swing at Same Houston and Little Rock to wrap up the non-conference schedule.
- Tech's Schedule has proved more than formidable in the early going with opponents combining for an 11-8-2 record including Ole Miss and Mississippi State yet to drop a match this season.
- LA Tech picked up its 175th program victory in its 19th season of competition with the win over Abilene Christian last Friday.
- Sydnee Korchak was named the C-USA Goalkeeper of the Week for her two shutout performances against Abilene Christian and UL-Lafayette. Korchak registered 11 saves, including seven against UL-L, one shy of her career high. The award is the first of the sophomore keeper's career.
- Korchak followed up her seven save performance with a career-tying eight saves against No. 12 Ole Miss.
- Korchak produced a stratech of 238 scorless minutes in net over a three-game span before conceededing a goal in the 21' against Ole Miss.
- LA Tech has compiled 38 shots through five matches with 21 coming on goal and have netted four goals off of five assists for a total of 13 points.
- •Tech's opponents have put 35 shots on target out of the 78 total attempted scoring ten goals against the LA Tech defense. LA Tech's keepers have netted 24 saves and a .706 save percentage through five games.
- The Techsters return a core of last season's group only losing eight letterwinners off the 2021 squad while welcoming three new incoming freshmen to the roster.
- •LA Tech returns their top four minute getters from 2021 in Josie Studer (1,399), Laura Ogando (1,344), Libe Banuelos (1,195), and Tomoyo Kuroyanagi (1,084).
- In 2021, Josie Studer tied for the team lead in goals (4), while Studer and Maci Geltmeier tied for the team lead in points (9).
- Studer's four goals is tied for the most ever scored by a LA Tech defender. Studer has yet to take the field for the Techsters in 2022 due to injury.
- LA Tech returns all three goal keepers that made starts last season in Libe Banuelos (12), Sydnee Korchak (3), and Christina Hjelvik (2). Combined, the keepers allowed 21 goals last season while notching 84 saves with a 1.18 goals against average while registering five cleansheets during 2021.

NEWS AND NOTES

ROBERT MACK CARUTHERS SET FOR SECOND SEASON

At around 2 a.m. on April 25, 2019, an F3 tornado sliced through Ruston and the Louisiana Tech campus. Part of the destruction was the Lady Techster Soccer Complex as the equipment shed, press box, light poles and bleachers were either mangled or destroyed.

As a result, LA Tech was forced to play both the 2019 and the 2020-21 COVID season at different venues while the Robert Mack Caruthers Field was being built.

The Lady Techsters have now returned to the same location they played their inaugural season in the spot across from the Lambright Center.

The facility is named in honor of former Petroleum Engineering professor Dr. Robert Caruthers. LA Tech graduate Tim Cutt and his wife Carolyn donated \$250,000 to assist in the rebuild of the soccer facility.

The first ever game in "The Mack" was highlgithed by it's first win with a 9-0 victory over ETBU on Aug. 20, 2021. LA Tech registered a 4-3-1 record in the Mack's inagural season while going a perfect 3-0-0 in the non-conference schedule outscoring their opponents 15-1.

Tech is now 5-1-1 in its two short season inside The Mack in non-conference play.

HOME SWEET HOME

Even though LA Tech has spent two seasons (2019 and 2020-21) at an alternate "home" site due to the tornado destroying its former complex, the Lady Techsters have still continued their amazing home pitch advantage.

Since 2009, LA Tech has dominated the opposition at home with an overall record of 79-28-10 and a 47-9-4 record in non-conference action. Here are a couple other home nuggets:

- Combined 48-16-7 record at home since 2014
- Record of 27-11-4 in Conference USA action (2013-present)
- Since Oct. 5, 2016, the team is 29-11-6 at home
- LA Tech is 13-6 in all-time in home openers
- LA Tech is a perfect 6-0-0 in season home openers

VOLTZ HAS NTERIM TAG REMOVED

Head coach Steve Voltz, who took over at the helm last season on an interim basis during 2021, had the interim tag removed following last season's campaign. Voltz spent the 2020 season at Tech on staff as an assistant coach. Prior to LA Tech, Voltz compiled a record of 62-46-5 in eight years at Millsaps College for the men's soccer program, leading the Majors to two South-

ern Athletic Association regular season titles and the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance. Voltz's Tech squad went 6-8-3 last season.

KEY RETURNERS

LA Tech returns 21 players, anchored by former Second Team All-Conference USA and All-Louisiana defender Josie Studer who tied for the team-lead in goals (4) and points (9) last season. Studer is also the active leader in minutes played and played all but six minutes of conference play last season.

Senior Sophie Fijneman is back on the pitch for LA Tech after as the active career leader in goals (7) and assists (7).

Junior midfielder Tomoyo Kuroyanagi and Erin Chung are the only two players to have played in all 17 matches last season, both are expected to return to similar roles this season.

Junior Captain Emma Jones is also returning after suffering a season ending ACL injury after just six games last season. In her six starts, Jones scored one goald and tallied four assists including three against Louisiana College tying a program single-game record.

Tech also returns three of last season's goal keepers including saves leader Libe Banuelos. Banuelos registered 61 saves while keeping two cleansheets and picking up three wins and three ties while in net in her 12 starts.

IN THE CONFERENCE

LA Tech has the fifth most victories in C-USA from 2013-21. They are one of only three programs (Rice and North Texas) to win at least five conference matches in each of the last six of the last seven years. (Entering the 2022 season)

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE

LA Tech has qualified for the conference tournament eight times in the last 12 years, including six straight from 2014-19. The Lady Techsters are 2-6-3 all-time in conference tournament matches, falling in 2018 and 2019 on penalty kicks.

OT SUCCESS, BUT NO MORE OT

In their last 25 OT matches (dating back to September of 2017), they have only lost four of them while compiling an 10-3-12 record. However, with a new rule change in effect this year all regular season matches will end in a draw after 90 minutes of

FAMILIAR FACES, FINALLY

After bringing in 18 newcomers during 2021, which accounted for half of the roster, the 2022 roster returns 21 of the previous season's 36 players while welcoming in only three new faces.

Of the 21 returners, 18 are letterwinners from the 2021 campaign.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

LA Tech finds players from all over the global (literally) to come to Ruston, Louisiana Tech and play soccer.

This season, the program is represented by 9 different countries across four different continents: Norway, Spain, Sweden, Japan, the Netherlands, Australia, Ireland, Germany and Canada.

Techv also find players from all over the United States with student-athletes from Hawai'i, Oregon, New Jersey, North Carolina and Texas.

FRESH, BUT SEASONED

Incomcing Candian freshmen duo, Flavie Dube and Riley Bonadie, have made instant impacts to the Techsters lineup in 2022.

The duo played up as 15 year olds on the Canadian's Ottawa TFC 17U national championship squad.

After showing what she was capable of with an exhibition hat trick agianst ETBU, Dube has been a constant threat in the box for opposing teams scoring her first career goal against Northwestern State and is second on the team in shots (6), shots on goal (4), and leads the team in on goal shot percentage (.667 - with a minimum of four SOG).

Bonadie leads the team in assists (2) and has produced numerous chances with her unselfish play in her action off the bench.

CAREER FIRSTS

In the 2022 season opening weekend, there were several highlights of few career firsts for some of the players.

Against Murray State:

- Carmen Suarez earned her first career-winning goal
- Suarez also scored her first career penalty kick goal
- Lena Radler was credited with her first career assist
- Riley Bonadie & Flavie Dube made their collegiate debuts

Against Northwestern State:

- Flavie Dube scored her first career goal
- Riley Bonadie registerd her first career assist

Against Abiliene Christian:

- Alma Cedefors scored her first career game-winner
- Caitlin Le Roux registerd her first career assist

KORCHAK NAMED C-USA GK OF THE WEEK

Sydnee Korchak earned her first career C-USA Player of the Week award after posting two shutouts in a 1-0 win over Abilene Christian and forced a 0-0 tie against UL-Lafayette.

Korchak registered 11 saves, inclduing seven against UL-L, one shy of her career high.

She is the third LA Tech goalkeeper to win the award and the first since teammate Christian Hjelvik did so in 2020-21.

/// RUSTON STRONG

The day of April 25, 2019 was less than two hours old and most of the western hemisphere was sound asleep. Then out of nowhere came an F3 tornado on a southwest-to-northeast route straight through the heart of Ruston, Louisiana. Two people died that night. Just tragic.

Most of the Louisiana Tech campus was spared, except for the athletic facilities.

Chunks of concrete from the roof of J.C. Love Field were scattered on Tech Drive. Light poles at the baseball, softball, soccer, tennis and track & field complexes were either bent in half or laying on the ground. Scoreboards were mangled. Huge pine trees were sawed in half and draped over all of the facilities. Fences were ripped apart. Equipment sheds shredded. Press boxes destroyed. Signs from the facilities were later found miles away.

It was a solemn day for Louisiana Tech University and the city of Ruston.

But, it marked the beginning of a massive movement. A recovery. A rallying cry. A powerful show of Ruston strength. "Nothing we can do but come back stronger," said soccer player Elizabeth Doll. The new Robert Mack Caruthers Field was completed in the summer of 2021.
