NCAA TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The SEC leads the nation with seven teams advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- A record-tying nine SEC teams received bids to the NCAA Tournament. That is the second-most among all conferences.
- The SEC's nine NCAA Tournament selections tie the league record set in 2017 and 2018.
- Over the last six years, the SEC has earned 44 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of more than seven per year – with all 14 member institutions making at least two appearances during that span.
- Seven of the SEC's teams were seeded and hosted their first round game. Alabama's No. 1 seed is the first for the SEC since South Carolina in 2017.
- The SEC has had at least one team in the NCAA Quarterfinals in each of the last eight years.
- Eight different schools have made NCAA Round of 16 appearances over the last nine years.
- #1 Alabama** – 5th appearance ... 2nd consecutive ... 2-4-0 (.333) all-time record.
- #3 Arkansas** – 9th appearance ... 7th consecutive ... 11-5-3 (.658) all-time record.
- #7 Georgia** – 10th appearance ... 1st since 2014 ... 7-10-1 (.417) all-time record.
- #8 LSU** – 8th appearance ... 2nd consecutive ... 3-6-2 (.364) all-time record.
- #7 Mississippi State** – 2nd appearance ... 1st since 2018 ... 1-1-0 (.500) all-time record.
- #3 South Carolina** – 16th appearance ... 10th consecutive ... 22-14-3 (.603) all-time record.
- #6 Tennessee** – 14th appearance ... 4th appearance in 7 years ... 16-12-3 (.565) all-time.
- Texas A&M** – 27th appearance ... Played in 27 of last 28 tournaments ... 39-24-9 (.604) all-time.
- Vanderbilt** – 12th appearance ... 5th in the last 6 seasons ... 7-8-3 (.472) all-time.

NEWS & NOTES

- Alabama secured its first SEC Championship in school history. The Crimson Tide became the first team to post a perfect (10-0-0) conference record since South Carolina (11-0-0) in 2016.
- Six different teams – Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, South Carolina, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC regular season titles in the last 12 seasons.
- South Carolina won its third SEC Tournament title with a 1-0 win over Alabama in the championship game.
- Seven different teams – Auburn, Florida, LSU, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt – have won SEC Tournament championships since 2011.
- The SEC was ranked No. 3 in the final regular season RPI.
- Two SEC teams are ranked in the Top 10 of the final regular season RPI (Nov. 7), five are in the Top 30, eight in the Top 40 and 10 in the Top 50.
- Four SEC teams are ranked in the Nov. 1 United Soccer Coaches poll: Alabama 3rd, Arkansas 9th, South Carolina 14th and Tennessee 21st. Vanderbilt is among the teams receiving votes.
- Eight different SEC teams have been ranked in the United Soccer Coaches poll this season.
- Texas A&M's G Guerrieri became the fifth NCAA Division I women's soccer coach to reach the 500-win milestone on Oct. 27.
- Alabama's No. 2 ranking on Oct. 11 was the highest in school history. The high before this season was No. 15 in 2020.
- The SEC led the nation during the regular season in attendance by averaging 1,145 fans per game and in total attendance (153,474) through 134 games this season. South Carolina ranked second in the nation with 2,821 fans per game while Texas A&M is fourth with 2,048, Arkansas is 11th with 1,635, Georgia is 14th with 1,217 and Tennessee is 15th with 1,106.
- All attendance records were left in the dust at the 2022 SEC Tournament in Pensacola, Fla. The top

three single-session crowds in tournament history were recorded at the event, capped off by 3,025 fans attending the championship match. Overall, the total attendance of 10,450 almost doubled the previous record (5,285 in 2009).

- SEC teams won 75.2 percent (72-17-20) of their non-conference games this year. That is the second-best winning percentage in the nation.
- Alabama's Felicia Knox ranks third the nation with 0.73 assists per game. Knox has recorded a school record 16 assists this season.
- Alabama's Riley Mattingly Parker ranks second in the nation with six game-winning goals.
- Mississippi State goalkeeper Maddy Anderson is third in the nation in goals against average (0.333)
- South Carolina's Heather Hinz is fourth nationally with 12 shutouts.
- Arkansas' Anna Podojil (Sept. 14) and South Carolina's Heather Hinz (Nov. 9) were named the United Soccer Coaches National Player of the Week
- The Southeastern Conference is in its 30th season sponsoring women's soccer.
- Over the last six years, the SEC has earned 44 NCAA Tournament bids – an average of more than seven per year – with all 14 member institutions making at least two appearances during that span.
- Eight different SEC teams have advanced to the Round of 16 since 2013 and the league has placed teams in the NCAA quarterfinals in each of the last eight seasons.
- SEC players have garnered 66 All-America awards from the United Soccer Coaches since 2011. SEC players have earned 16 first-team All-America honors during that time and three have earned multiple first-team honors (South Carolina's Sabrina D'Angelo in 2013 and 2014; South Carolina's Savannah McCaskill in 2016 and 2017; and South Carolina's Fisk in 2018 and 2019).

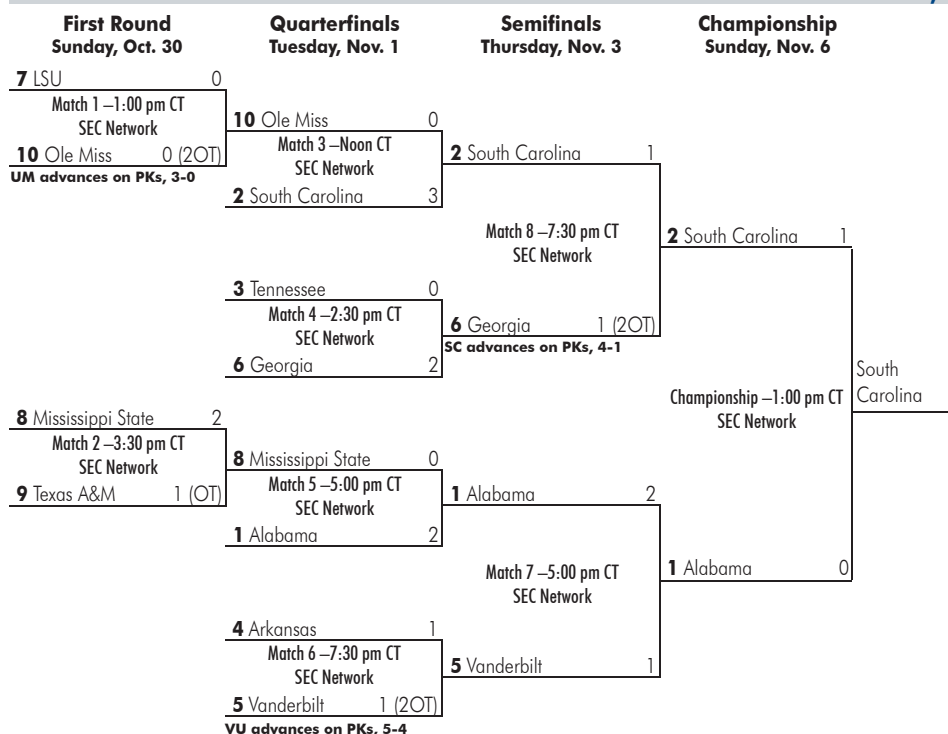

There shall be a single-elimination tournament of the top ten teams played at the conclusion of the regular season schedule. The tournament champion shall be the Conference representative to the NCAA championship.

The top ten teams with the highest point total, regardless of divisions, will participate in the tournament, with the two division champions serving as the top two seeds. The following point system is utilized to determine regular season standings and seeding for the tournament: a win counts as three points, a tie as one, and a loss as zero points. If a game(s) is cancelled, neither team will receive a point and the standings will be determined by average points per game.

Tie-Breaker Procedures

The tournament will be seeded 1-14 based on the point system implemented to determine regular season standings. The two division champions shall be the top two seeds. If teams are tied, the following procedures, in order as follows, will be used to break the tie:

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Head-to-head competition between the tied teams.
- B. Points earned versus common opponents.
- C. Goal differential versus common opponents.
- D. Goals scored versus common opponents.
- E. Won-Lost record of the two teams versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- F. Goal differential versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- G. Goals scored versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary.
- H. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** The following procedure will be used until the tie is broken. If at any time this tie breaker results in only two remaining tied teams, then the two-team tiebreaker will be used beginning with Subsection A in that procedure and continuing from that point:

A. If all teams have played one another, then most points earned in those matches only.

B. If all teams have not played, but one team has defeated all teams in the tie break, then that team breaks the tie and shall be placed highest. Remaining teams will continue with the tie break procedure.

C. If all teams have not played one another and a team does not have all wins over the tied teams, then use Subsection B in the two-team tie break procedures and continue through the two team tie-break procedures until ties between all teams are broken (except Subsection H will read "if three or more teams are still tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw").
