THE MATCHUP:

Series History

- Vanderbilt dominates the all-time series with Mississippi State boasting a 20-2-1 record
- The programs haven't met since the 2023 season, when the Dores visited Mississippi State and tallying a 0-0 draw
- In Starkville, Vandy is 10-0-1, with the latest resulting coming in 2023
- Under head coach Darren Ambrose, Vanderbilt has faced the Bulldogs six times, allowing only three goals while the Dores posted nine goals

The Opponent

- Mississippi State enters the contest 9-3-1 (4-2-1 SEC) and are coming off a 1-2 loss at Florida on Friday night
- The Bulldogs have not lost a regular-season match at home since Sept. 21, 2023, going 16-0-3 in that span
- The Bulldogs boast an SEC-leading 13 goals in the 70th minute or later, including a conference-best seven in the 80th minute or later

Scouting Report

- The Bulldogs will be without leading scorer Ally Perry on Thursday night after she was shown a red card in the team's last match at Florida. Perry leads the team in goals (seven), assists (assists) - which are a career high and points (20)
- Zoe Main, a junior forward, has the second-most team points (12) and goals (five) and scored to open the scoring in the last two matches for the Bulldogs
- Sophomore goalie Sarah Wommack boats a 9-3-1 record, tallying over 1100 minutes in goal. Wommack has made 39 saves on the year and allowed 14 goals

STORYLINES:

Last Time Out

- Courtney Jones powered No. 21 Vanderbilt soccer to its ninth clean sheet of the season with a 2-0 victory over Missouri at the Vanderbilt Soccer Complex on Friday night.
- Vanderbilt registered its 10th win of the year, for the sixth time under head coach Darren Ambrose. It marks the first time with back-to-back 10-win seasons since 2018 and 2019
- The Commodores (10-3-1, 4-2-1 SEC) controlled play throughout, dominating possession at 66 percent and outshooting the Tigers 19-5. Jones opened the scoring in the 12th minute off a dish from Reagan Pentz to register her fourth goal of the season. Just eight minutes later, Jones doubled the lead with her second of the night, finishing a setup from Olivia Stafford to make it 2-0
- Keeper Sara Wojdelko tallied one save to collect her sixth shutout of the year and 17th of her career as Vanderbilt secured its third straight SEC victory. The Commodore defense kept Missouri (4-9-1, 1-6-0 SEC) to only one shot on goal, while goalkeeper Kate Phillips finished with six saves on the night for the Tigers

VANDERBILT SOCCER

- Opening weekend with was filled with plenty of first for those in black and gold
 - Adysen Armenta, Reagan Pentz, Brooke Dardano, Margo Matula, and Olivia Stafford each clocked their first starts for the black and gold against Austin Peay
 - Armenta, Susanna Soderman and Vicky Pugh scored their first career and Commodore goals
 - Grace Freeman, Pentz and Stafford dished their first career assists
- In the Dores second match of the year against Louisville, freshman Olivia Stafford scored her first career goal off a long ball from Mary Beth McLaughlin, which was later credited as the game winner in the 2-0 victory over Louisville
- Freshman Ellett Smith posted her first career goal and assist in the Dores 3-0 win over Oklahoma

Reagan Pentz Machine

- In her freshman debut against Austin Peay, Reagan Pentz dished three assists, which were the most by a Commodore since Grace Jackson achieved the feat in 2019 against Jacksonville State

Preseason Nods

- The Commodores placed six student-athletes on the SEC Preseason Watchlist, the conference announced on Tuesday afternoon. Commodores included on the list are Courtney Jones, Hannah McLaughlin, Mary Beth McLaughlin, Maci Teater, Sydney Watts and Sara Wojdelko
 - Jones, a midfielder out of Orlando, Florida, started all 21 contests for the Dores during the 2024 season. The junior registered a career-best 14 points off five goals and four assists as the Commodores reached the Sweet 16 for the first time in program history
 - Hannah McLaughlin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, made 19 starts for the black and gold in 2024. The senior was named first-team All-SEC and United Soccer Coaches fourth-team all-region after anchoring a defense that allowed only 19 goals in the season and posted nine shutouts.
 - Mary Beth McLaughlin, a defender out of Cummings, Georgia, appeared in 16 matches, making four starts and logging over 580 minutes of play during her rookie season. The sophomore dished her first career assist in the 2024 conference opener at Auburn and was named SEC All-Freshman Team.
 - Teater, a midfielder out of St. Louis, started in all 21 matches for Vanderbilt in 2024 and dished a team-high-tying six assists. The senior scored her first career goal in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb and helped control a midfield that took down reigning national champion Florida State to advance to the Sweet 16.
 - Watts, a junior out of Lenexa, Kansas, led the team with nine goals last season and dished an assist to register a career-best 19 points. The forward posted the second brace of her career in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament against Lipscomb, with her first brace coming earlier in the season against Saint Mary's (Calif.)
 - Wojdelko, a graduate out of Northville, Michigan, is back in goal after leading the Commodores to a historic season in 2024. The shot stopper made 14 saves in Vanderbilt's penalty kick win over Florida State to advance to the program's first Sweet 16 appearance. Her 14 stops were the most in a single game since Christy Barringer in 1992

New Staff

- Vanderbilt's soccer staff has welcomed three new faces ahead of the 2025 season:
 - **Jennie Clark** joins the program as an assistant after spending the last two seasons as an assistant at Northwestern, has earned a B license and a scouting license through the US Soccer Federation. Clark served as the first assistant coach for Minnesota Aurora FC, helping lead the squad to a perfect regular season and berth in the quarterfinals of the USL W League playoffs. Before joining the pros, Clark was an assistant at Utah Tech for two seasons, helping the program transition from Division II to Division I while coaching seven All-Western Athletic Conference honorees during her stint
 - **Calum Langdale** also joins the Commodores coaching staff as an assistant and goalkeeper coach. Langdale joins the black and gold after spending one season at Arkansas State as an assistant, where he served primarily as a goalkeepers coach. During the 2024 campaign at Arkansas State, Langdale helped the Red Wolves to a top-70 national ranking in all major goalkeeping categories, including save percentage, saves per game, shutout percentage and goals-against average
 - In the director of operations role, **Rachel Biddle** joined the program in March after spending a large part of her career as general manager at several boutique fitness studios in Nashville, combining her passion for sports and wellness. Some of her responsibilities included overseeing daily operations, driving sales, community outreach and programming.

New Year, New Faces

- This year, Vanderbilt welcomes eight new freshman to campus: Alexis Smith, Reagan Pentz, Caitlin Chase, Olivia Stafford, Foley Robertson, Vicky Pugh and Ava Sherrer ahead of the 2025 campaign
- Vanderbilt was ranked #13 in top recruiting classes for 2025

Splash in the Portal

- Ahead of 2025, Vanderbilt welcomed three transfers who bring a lot of experience to the squad
 - Brooke Dardano joins the black and gold after four years at Louisville where she appeared in 49 matches (32 starts). At midfield, she posted three goals and dished 11 assists to tally 17 points. Dardano missed the 2023 season due to injury
 - Grace Freeman joins the Commodores after spending her three years at Ole Miss. She appeared in 37 matches, making 32 starts and scored one goal and dished two assists. Freeman missed the majority of the 2022 season due to injury
 - Susanna Soderman joins Vandy after her time at Villanova where she was an All-BIG EAST First Team selection in her senior season while appearing in 51 games and making 34 starts

Family Ties

- This season, Vanderbilt has one set of sisters in the black and gold, Hannah (senior) and Mary Beth (sophomore) McLaughlin. It marks just the fourth time in program history that Vanderbilt will have a set of sisters playing together in the same season.

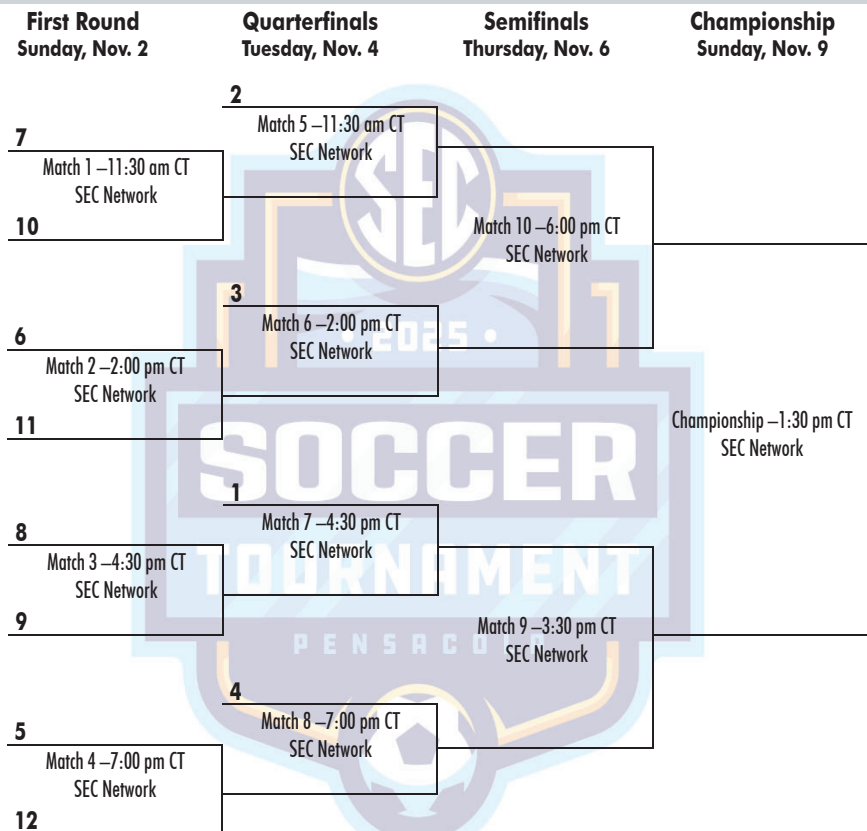

2025 SEC SOCCER TOURNAMENT – PENSACOLA, FLORIDA



There shall be a single-elimination tournament of the top 12 teams played at the conclusion of the regular season schedule. The tournament champion shall be the Conference representative to the NCAA championship.

The top 12 teams with the highest point total will participate in the tournament. The following point system is utilized to determine regular season standings and seeding for the tournament: a win counts as three points, a tie as one, and a loss as zero points. If a game(s) is cancelled, neither team will receive a point and the standings will be determined by average points per game.

Tie-Breaker Procedures

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- Head-to-head competition between the tied teams.
- Points earned versus common opponents.
- Goal differential versus common opponents.
- Goals scored versus common opponents.
- Won-Lost record of the two teams versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if necessary.
- Goal differential versus highest seeded common opponent and proceeding through the No. 16 seed, if

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** The following procedure will be used until the tie is broken. If at any time this tie breaker results in only two remaining tied teams, then the two-team tiebreaker will be used beginning with Subsection A in that procedure and continuing from that point:

- If all teams have played one another, then most points earned in those matches only.
- If all teams have not played, but one team has defeated all teams in the tie break, then that team breaks the tie and shall be placed highest. Remaining teams will continue with the tie break procedure.
- If all teams have not played one another and a team does not have all wins over the tied teams, then use Subsection B in the two-team tie break procedures and continue through the two team tie-break procedures until ties between all teams are broken (except Subsection H will read "if three or more teams are still tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw").
