FIRST SERVE

The Oklahoma volleyball team is back on the road, heading east to Mississippi for a pair of matches. The Sooners will start their weekend with a 1 p.m. matchup at Ole Miss on Friday, followed by a 2 p.m. Sunday match against Mississippi State.

WEEKEND REWIND

The Sooners picked up their first win over a top 10 team since 2014, defeating No. 9 Texas, 25-21, 25-27, 19-25, 25-17, 15-9, in an incredible five-set thriller Sunday afternoon in the first of two Red River Rivalry matches this season.

Down 2-1 in the match, the Sooners claimed the final two sets to pull off the upset win. The victory marked the Sooners' first win over the Longhorns since 2014. Alexis Shelton had her best match of the season, registering 27 kills with 15 digs for her seventh double-double of the season. The junior hit at a .365 clip as she recorded her 23rd straight match with double-digit kills.

SHELTON EARNS SEC HONOR

After leading the Sooners to an upset-victory over No. 9 Texas, junior outside hitter Alexis Shelton has been named the Southeastern Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Week. This is the first weekly award in Shelton's career. The Charlotte, N.C., native shared the honor with Florida's Kennedy Martin as she picked up OU's second weekly honor of the year. Senior Payton Chamberlain was named co-setter of the week in September.

In the Sooners lone match of the weekend, Shelton was dynamite as she led OU to its first win over the Longhorns since 2014 and first over a top 10 opponent since 2014. Shelton led all players with a season-high 27 kills and recorded a season-high 15 digs for her seventh double-double of the year. With her sixth 20-kill performance of the season, Shelton has now recorded 23-straight matches with double-digit kills, dating back to 2023. Shelton's .365 hitting percentage was her second-highest mark of the season and fifth mark over .300 in 2024.

MILESTONES IN THE MAKING

Senior setter Payton Chamberlain is nearing in on an impressive career milestone. The Roanoke, Texas, native needs just 24 assists to reach the 3,000-career mark. Chamberlain has recorded at least 40 assists in 11 matches this season and could reach the milestone in her next two games. Chamberlain averages 41 assists per match.

Junior outside hitter Alexis Shelton is nearing a milestone of her own, closing in on the 1,000 career kills mark. Shelton currently sits at 979 for her career, needing just 21 to hit the milestone. The senior is averaging 17.5 kills/match and 4.33 per set on the season. Shelton is coming off a season-high 27-kill performance at Texas and has

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Sooners played their entire non-conference slate away from the friendly confines on McCasland Field House. Despite being on the road for four straight weekends, the Sooners finished non-conference action 6-2, with their only losses to TCU and UCSB. In SEC play, the Sooners will be on the road for eight of their 16 matches, bringing their total road matches to 16. After this weekend's matches, the Sooners will have just one more road match, closing out the regular season at Arkansas on Nov. 27.

WELCOME TO THE BLOCK PARTY

The Sooners defense has been a force to be reckoned with this season, recording at least eight blocks in 16 matches this season. Against Tulsa on Sept. 13, the Sooners put up an impressive 20.0 blocks, the most by a Sooner squad since tallying 19.0 against Kansas State in 2020. OU has recorded at least 7.0 blocks in every match this year and reached the double-digit mark on 10

occasions. Against Texas on Nov. 3, the Sooners tallied 16.5 blocks, their most in conference play and the most Texas has allowed all season. In conference play the Sooners are second in blocks/set at 2.69, and first in all matches with 2.80 per set.

DOUBLE THE FUN

Junior Alexis Shelton and senior Payton Chamberlain have combined for 13 of Oklahoma's 15 double-doubles on the season, notching seven and six, respectively. On two occasions, against Kentucky and Texas, the duo each recorded a double-double. Shelton's seventh of the season was her most impressive with a season-high 27 kills and season high 15 digs. Chamberlain's best of the year was a 52 assist, 13 dig performance against Arkansas in October.

STATS & RANKINGS

Multiple Sooners are ranked in their respective strengths in conference action. Lydia Martyn continues to rank at the top of the hitting percentage group with a .439 mark in league play. Payton Chamberlain is fourth in assists with

10.00 per set, and Alexis Shelton is 10th in kills per set with 3.86. As a team, the Sooners are second in hitting percentage at .270. Nationally, the Sooners are No. 10 in blocks per set at 2.80 and No. 21 in hitting percentage at .272

STELLAR SHELTON

After missing the final two matches of the 2023 season due to injury, junior Alexis Shelton has picked up where she left off, recording double-digit kills in every match this season. Shelton has now recorded 23 consecutive matches with double-digit kills going back to the 2023 season. In her last 42 games, she has reached the double-digit kill mark on 39 occasions. The junior has notched six 20-plus kill games this season and recorded 15 kills or more in 12 matches. Against Texas on Nov. 3, she posted a season-high 27 kills. Shelton also ranks second on the team in digs with 154 and second in blocks with 65, proving herself to be quite the all-around player.

WE DIG IT

On Sunday, Oct. 6, Callie Kemohah found herself in the top two all-time in career digs. With 220 digs on the season, Kemohah now sits at 1,521 for her career as a Sooner. The senior is now one of just two players in program history to reach 1,500 career digs. Kemohah started the season in sixth place and rapidly moved her way into the top two where she will end her career etched in the record books.

FRESHMAN IMPACT

The freshman class of Whitney Wallace, Jasmine Ellison and Kamille Gibson have been quietly making an impact on the 2024 season. Gibson is third on the team with 162 kills and has added 31 blocks. Ellison leads the way with 19 service aces and has notched 110 digs to rank fourth. Wallace boasts 12 aces along with 81 digs.

CALIFORNIA LOVE

Loyola Marymount transfer and California native Kari Geissberger has been a welcome addition to the Oklahoma offense in 2024. The graduate student has recorded a hitting percentage of .300 or better in 11 matches this season. Against K-State on Sept. 22, Geissberger notched a season-best .667 hitting percentage with eight kills on 12 attempts and no errors. She ranks second on the team in hitting percentage with a .316 mark and third in blocks with 54.

MCCASLAND MAGIC

The Sept. 29 win over Tennessee was extra special, for more reasons than one. While also being the first conference victory as members of the SEC, the win marked the first over a ranked opponent since Oct. 25, 2014 when the Sooners took down No. 2 Texas in Austin. The win was also the first over a ranked opponent inside McCasland since Sept. 27, 2014 when the Sooners defeated No. 23 Kansas.

BATTING 1.000

On Aug. 31, Kelli Jo Burgess became just the second player in Oklahoma history to have a perfect hitting percentage in a match (minimum 10 kills). Burgess was 11-for-11 on the day in the four-set match, the first Sooner to achieve the perfect hitting mark in a four-set match. Previously, Grace Whitley had recorded an 11-for-11 performance in a three-set match in 2011.

THE OPPOSITION

OLE MISS: The Rebels are 14-8 on the year with a 4-6 record in conference play. Ole Miss is coming off a 3-1 loss to No. 24 Florida on Sunday. The squad is led by Nia Washington's 3.56 kills/set and Mokihana Tufono's 786 assists. On the defensive side, Payton Brgoch and Sasha Ratliff each boast 1.04 blocks/set, while Cammy Niesen has recorded 360 digs.

MISSISSIPPI STATE: The Bulldogs are 10-8 on the year and 4-5 in league action. Mississippi State is coming off a big win over Texas A&M, sweeping the Aggies on Sunday. Arissa Smith was named the conference defensive player of the week, as she set a career high with nine blocks and added a .462 hitting percentage.

LOOKING AHEAD

After two weeks away, the Sooners will return home for a midweek matchup with former Big 12 rival Texas A&M. The match is slated for a 7 p.m. start on Wednesday, Nov. 13, on SEC Network.

OKLAHOMA HEAD COACH AARON MANSFIELD

- Aaron Mansfield enters his second season as Oklahoma head volleyball coach in 2024.
- In his first season with the Sooners, Mansfield recorded an 11-17 record, while helping Alexis Shelton to All-Big 12 honors.



• Before his time with the Sooners he was the Loyola Marymount head coach for six seasons, leading the Lions to a 94-68 (.580) record and taking them to a pair of NCAA Tournaments. While at LMU, he was an assistant coach for the women's beach volleyball program from 2017-19.

- During the 2022 fall campaign, Mansfield guided Loyola Marymount to 18-10 overall and 13-5 (third place) conference records, including a trip to the NCAA Tournament.
- Mansfield's LMU squads led the West Coast Conference in aces in 2017, 2018 and 2021, and paced the league in kills and assists in 2018. He has also enjoyed success on the recruiting trail, signing top-25 classes for LMU in 2019 and 2020.
- Prior to his time in Los Angeles, Mansfield spent five seasons on Santa Clara's staff, the last three as associate head coach of the indoor team and head coach of its sand team. The Broncos made three NCAA Tournament appearances (2012, 2014 and 2015).
- Mansfield served as an assistant on the UC Santa Barbara men's volleyball staff for five seasons and as a volunteer assistant on the women's staff one season.
