OPENING SERVE

• The Duke volleyball team heads to Starkville, Mississippi to compete against Mississippi State at 7 p.m. (EST) inside Newell-Grisson Building. The matchup is part of the Showdown at the Net tournament, which features 16 ACC schools and 16 SEC schools. The match will be streamed on SEC Network+.

LAST TIME OUT

• The Blue Devils competed in the Classic City Clash in Athens, Georgia last weekend, picking up a win against Alabama State (3-1), but dropping matches to Texas Tech (1-3) and Georgia (0-3).

• The Blue Devils opened the weekend facing the Red Raiders. Duke tied the fourth set 11 times, including at 26-26, but its rally to force a fifth frame fell short as Texas Tech scored the final two points to secure a 3-1 win. Sophomore outside hitter Taylor Williams led the offensive charge for Duke, logging 14 kills, and freshman outside hitter Ashby Zubchevich followed with 13. Freshman setter Charlotte Glass tallied a match-high 30 assists. On defense, sophomore libero Mailinh Godschall tallied a match-best 21 digs, and redshirt senior Ngozi Iloh led Duke at the net, earning four total blocks.

• Duke's freshman outside hitter Olivia Wayne and sophomore outside hitter Avery Hamlin posted 16 kills apiece to lead the Blue Devils' offense past Alabama State, 3-1 (23-25, 26-24, 25-21, 25-20), Thursday evening inside Stegeman Coliseum. Duke earned the advantage in kills, posting 70 while constricting the Hornets to 43. In addition to career-high offensive performances from Wayne and Hamlin, freshman middle blocker Zoë Gillen-Malveaux posted a career-high 12 kills. Defensively, sophomore libero Mailinh Godschall tallied a match-high 17 digs, while Gillen-Malveaux posted four block assists and one solo block.

• The Blue Devil volleyball team closed action in the Classic City Clash, falling to Georgia, 3-0 (30-28, 25-21, 25-23), Friday afternoon. Duke tallied a total of 43 kills, led by redshirt senior middle blocker Ngozi Iloh with 12 and sophomore outside hitter Avery Hamlin followed with 10. Redshirt junior setter Millie Muir dished out a career-best and match-high 24 assists. Defensively, sophomore libero Mailinh Godschall led the Blue Devils with 11 digs.

INAUGURAL SHOWDOWN AT THE NET

• Duke volleyball is set to compete in the inaugural "Showdown at the Net" tournament at Mississippi State inside the Newell-Grisson Building Wednesday, Sept. 10 in Starkville, Miss., as announced by ESPN Events May 22.

• The tournament is set to take place Sept. 9-10. It features 16 ACC schools and 16 SEC schools. ESPN will host one neutral site matchup, featuring two ACC and SEC schools, while all other matches will be played at ACC or SEC schools' locations.

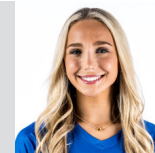

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SERIES

• Duke owns the 1-0 advantage in the all-time series history.

• In the previous matchup between the Blue Devils and Bulldogs, Duke earned a 3-0 sweep during the 1984 season.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

• Mississippi State owns a 6-0 overall ledger, going 3-0 in matches it plays at home.

• Lindsey Mangelson leads the Bulldogs with 68 kills and Cayley Hanson has dished out a team-best 209 assists.

• Defensively, McKenna Yates leads Mississippi State in digs (74), while Gha'Naye Whitefield-Moss leads with 30 total blocks.

HELLO, NEW BLUE DEVILS!

• Duke welcomes five freshmen for the 2025 season - Zoë Gillen-Malveaux, Ashby Zubchevich, Olivia Wayne, Aly Donoghue and Charlotte Glass.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

• The Blue Devils own a 0-1 road record this season and a 1-1 mark in neutral site matches. In their lone road contest, they fell to Georgia, 3-0. Duke earned a 3-1 victory over Alabama State and dropped a 3-1 decision to Texas Tech to account for its neutral site ledger.

TWENTY-SEVEN YEARS

• Head coach Jolene Nagel has been at the helm of the Blue Devils since 1999 and is heading into her 27th season this fall.

• Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11.

• Nagel earned her 700th career victory November 5, 2023 as the Blue Devils downed Virginia Tech in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the ninth active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 700 career victories.

OFFENSIVE THREATS

• The Blue Devils have tallied a total of 209 kills this season and poll at eighth in the ACC, averaging 13.18 kills per set. Sophomore outside hitter Taylor Williams leads Duke with 67 kills and boasts a .187 kill percentage. She tallied a career-best 18 kills to help surge the offense to a 3-1 triumph over Bryant, and has posted double-digit kills in three matches this season.

• Freshman Ashby Zubchevich boasts the team's second-highest kill count with 51. Against FIU, she posted a career-high 14 kills to lead the Blue Devils' offense while also matching a game-best three service aces. She helped pace the offense against Texas Tech, garnering 13 kills and served two aces.

• Freshman middle blocker Zoe Gillen-Malveaux boasts the team's best attack percentage, with .345. She has tallied 43 total kills and notched a career-best 12 kills against Alabama State to help lead Duke's offense -- her first time garnering a double-digit kill count.

DISHING OUT ASSISTS

• The Blue Devils rank eighth in the conference in assists per set, averaging 12.27. Duke has totalled 270 helpers in 22 sets played.

• Freshman setter Charlotte Glass owns a team-best 122 assists. She reached the 100 assist mark, posting 104 assists in just four games and 13 sets. In her collegiate debut, she dished out a match-best 45 helpers. Against Houston, she tallied 14 assists and closed the weekend with 14 helpers against FIU.

• Glass ranks ninth in the ACC, averaging 7.18 assists per set.

DEFENSE LOCKED AND LOADED

• Duke has totalled 331 digs and earned 43 blocks.

• The Blue Devils rank third in the ACC, averaging 15.05 digs per set.

• Sophomore libero Mailinh Godschall, who polls at third in the conference averaging 4.68 digs per set, leads the Blue Devils with 103 digs. She has tallied 20 or more digs in three matches this season -- Bryant, Houston and Texas Tech.

• Duke has totalled 43 total blocks, and post an average of 1.95 blocks per set. Freshman middle blocker Zoë Gillen-Malveaux leads the Blue Devils with 23 total blocks, including three solo blocks. Redshirt senior Ngozi Iloh boasts the teams second best total blocks (19) and has tallied two solo blocks.

Freshman middle blocker Zoë Gillen-Malveaux posted a career-high 12 kills.
- Sophomore libero Mailinh Godschall dished out a career-high eight assists. On top of Hamlin's career-best 16 kills, she matched her career-high blocks (2) and assists (2).

- Four Blue Devils - Kerry Keefe, Grace Penn, Nikki Underwood and Rachel Richardson - were announced to the 2024 Academic All-District Volleyball Team, selected by College Sports Communicators, recognizing the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances on the court and in the classroom.

2025 CAPTAIN

- Millie Muir will serve as Duke's captain for the 2025 season.
- She serves as the team's captain for the second consecutive year. Last season she totaled 36 assists, 10 digs and four blocks in 33 sets played.
- So far this season, she has tallied 75 helpers and posted a career-high 25 assists against Georgia. Along with her assists, she has earned 14 digs and added four kills.

DEKALB JOINS STAFF

- Aaron DeKalb joined the Blue Devils for the 2025 season as an assistant coach, following two three-year stints at Cornell. From 2021-23, he helped recruit and develop standout players Joanna Cheng, Casey Justice and Jill Bennett, who earned All-Ivy recognition. Additionally, Eliza Konvicka was named to the All-Ivy Second Team and led the league in kills, while Sydney Moore ranked third in the conference for blocks per set.
- During his 2015-18 tenure at Cornell, DeKalb was instrumental in the Big Red's turnaround. The program had its best single-season improvement during 2016, with a 12-12 record, which doubled its win total from the previous season. In 2017, he helped guide the team to an 8-6 conference record and a third-place finish in the Ivy League.

HEAD COACH // 27TH SEASON AT DUKE

Jolene Nagel became Duke University's fifth head volleyball coach in 1999, joining the Blue Devil staff after successful stints at Cornell and Georgetown. Under her guidance, Duke has earned a reputation as one of the elite programs on the East Coast. Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11. A perennial contender in the ACC, Duke has recorded 20 or more wins in 14 of Nagel's 26 campaigns. Nagel earned her 700th career victory November 5, 2023 as the Blue Devils downed Virginia Tech in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became just the ninth active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 700 career victories. The winningest Duke volleyball coach on record, she also ranks among the league coaching leaders in overall winning percentage, ACC winning percentage, ACC wins and NCAA Tournament appearances.
