SERIES RECAP - OLE MISS (Feb. 11-12)

Match 1 (W, 3-0; 25-20, 25-15, 25-17)

A dynamic performance carried Mississippi State to its first sweep of its in-state rival since 2015. State attacked at a .245 hitting percentage while holding Ole Miss to a .057 average.

Match 2 (W, 3-1; 22-25, 25-23, 26-24, 26-24)

State's offense led the Bulldogs to a comeback win over Ole Miss. MSU hit a season-best .290 behind 17 kills (.333) from Gabby Waden and seven kills without an error (.538) by **Lauren Myrick** to complete the series sweep.

KEY STORYLINE: A six-match road swing for the Bulldogs starts right down U.S. highway 82 in Tuscaloosa, Alabama as they face the Alabama Crimson Tide. The two teams are pretty evenly matched, both claiming four wins so far this season.

TRENDING OFFENSE: Mississippi State's offense has shown marked improvement this spring, setting season-high hitting averages in each of its last three matches.

WADEN'S WORLD: MSU's offense is led by right side hitter Gabby Waden, who has been a model of consistency during her junior season.

LILLY THE LIBERO: Freshman libero Lilly Gunter has impressed during her first season on the collegiate level. She has started every set as MSU's libero this season and recieved SEC Freshman of the Week honors following MSU's series sweep of Ole Miss.

TEAM NOTES

OFFENSE TRENDING UP: Mississippi State's offense has shown improvement this fall, setting season-high hitting percentages in each of its last three matches and averaging .259 over those three contests compared to a .186 season average:

- 2/5 at South Carolina: .242% - 2/11 vs. Ole Miss: .245% - 2/12 vs. Ole Miss: .290%*

*MSU's .290 hitting percentage against Ole Miss (2/12) was the best mark by a Bulldog offense since posting a .323 clip against Georgia on Nov. 26, 2016.

WADEN'S WORLD: Right side hitter *Gabby Waden* has been a consistent force for the Bulldog offense. Despite playing just three rotations, Waden ranks in the SEC top 10 in kills (8th - 3.79 per set) and points (9th - 4.05 per set). Notes on Waden's recent achievements:

- Double-digit kills in 11 of 12 matches
- 61 kills (4.07 per set) on a .333 hitting percentage this spring
- 31 kills (.348; 3.88 per set) in series sweep of Ole Miss (2/11-12)
- 14 kills (.370; 4.67 per set) in the series opening sweep of Ole Miss (2/11)

LILLY THE LIBERO: The Bulldog defense is anchored by freshman **Lilly Gunter**, who is impressing in her first season on the collegiate level

Gunter has started every match of her rookie season in the libero jersey, averaging 3.25 digs per set, which rates No. 10 in the league and No. 3 among SEC freshmen. She averaged 4.29 digs per set in the series sweep of Ole Miss (2/11-12) to earn SEC Freshman of the Week honors.

Gunter comes from the same hometown that head coach *Julie Darty Dennis* originated - Oviedo, Florida.

TRANSFER TAKEOVER: State's coaching staff has utilized the transfer portal to much success following the end of the 2019 season, as six transfer student-athletes have committed to the "Julie Darty (Dennis) Experience" since.

Now, eight MSU volleyball student-athletes, half of the 2020-21 roster, started their collegiate careers at a different school but now call the Newell-Grissom Building home.

Five of those student-athletes (Brown, Dean, Kemp, Murr & Myrick) arrived in Starkville prior to the 2020-21 campaign and have already played significant roles for this season's team.

Over the break, MSU gained two more commitments. A transfer setter from Marshall, *Gabby Coulter* is immediately eligible to participate in MSU's spring competition. State also attracted freshman middle blocker *Rebecca Walk*, a Mississippi native who will see her first SEC action come fall after she earned 2020 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year honors at South Alahama

COULTER COUNTER: Junior setter *Gabby Coulter* is 12 assists away from reaching a career milestone 1,500 assists in her third season of collegiate volleyball. Coulter tallied 1,400 assists over two seasons at Marshall, then picked up 88 more this spring.

Coulter made her Bulldog debut in the first match of the South Carolina series (2/4), then recorded her first-career double-double a day later in the finale (2/5). The Brandton, Fla., native is averaging 5.87 assists per set in four matches for MSU.

ON THE SERIES SWEEP at NO.7 TEXAS A&M: Mississippi State earned its first two wins of the season in dramatic fashion, beating No. 7 Texas A&M twice on the road.

- Mississippi State had only one ranked win in program history prior to Wednesday (Oct. 14, 2011 vs. No. 25 Kentucky), though never in a road match.
- The Bulldogs pulled off consecutive SEC wins for the first time since 2016.
- MSU collected its first-ever wins in the 14-match series history against A&M despite having never won a set in Reed Arena prior to the 2020 series.
- State's defense held the Aggies to a combined .173 hitting percentage in the series; A&M ranked No. 4 in the league with a .252 mark going into the series.
- Gabby Waden averaged 4.89 kills per set and a .344 hitting percentage to lead MSU to its series sweep of No. 7 Texas A&M. Waden's 24 kills in the second match of the series at A&M tied her career-high and set her career-high for an SEC match.
- In the series, Waden became the first Bulldog to tally 20 kills in consecutive matches since Emily Hill in 2016.

DEJA'S BLOCK PARTY: Junior middle blocker *Deja Robinson* collected 17 total blocks in MSU's season-opening series against Arkansas. In the series finale, Robinson's 12 blocks were the most since Bali Leffall-Young (12) in 2014, tying the second-highest mark in Bulldog history.

Robinson's seven solo blocks this season have moved her up the MSU career leaderboard for the category.

Robinson led the Bulldogs with 107 blocks and 83 block assists as a sophomore in 2019, and finished No. 2 on the squad with 24 solo blocks. She collected three or more blocks in 18 matches both as a sophomore and as a freshman.

An SEC All-Freshman Team selection in 2018, Robinson set the teamhigh mark in block assists (70) and ranked No. 2 among her teammates in total blocks (94) and solo blocks (24).

NEW HEIGHTS: As Mississippi State volleyball aims to continue its rise in the SEC in year three of the *Julie Darty Dennis* era, its roster boasts a greater height advantage compared to years past.

In 2019, MSU's tallest student-athlete measured at 6-foot-1. MSU now has three active student-athletes standing 6-foot-1 or taller (Kemp, McBride, Robinson).

Of the student-athletes who saw action in 2019, only four stood 6-feet or taller. MSU's 2020-21 active roster boasts six such players.

AVCA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD: MSU was named a recipient of the AVCA Team Academic Award prior to the 2020-21 season, the fifth such honor in program history.

The award, initiated in the 1992-93 academic year, honors programs that maintain a year-long grade-point average of 3.30 on a 4.0 scale or 4.10 on a 5.0 scale. State posted a 3.32 mark as a group and earned 10 combined recognitions between the 2019 Fall SEC Academic Honor Roll and 2019-20 First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll.

RECORD HONOR ROLL: A program record 10 student-athletes were named to the 2020 Fall SEC Academic Honor Roll.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL: MSU volleyball's student-athletes have a new leadership structure in place for the 2020-21 season, as the team elected *Margaret Dean, Kendall Murr*, and *Gabby Waden* to its leadership council for the season.

STAMATIS STAYS IN STARKVEGAS: Following a strong career in maroon and white, former Bulldog setter *Alleah Stamatis* (2018-19) now serves as the program's director of operations.

Stamatis was a recipient of the American Volleyball Coaches Diversity Award while serving as the program's technical coordinator in the fall, which allowed her to "participate in a series of educational, developmental, and relationship building experiences in conjunction with the 2020 AVCA Virtual Convention." Her award was sponsored by SEC assistant coaches.

As a senior in 2019, Stamatis became just the seventh Bulldog to collect 1,000 assists in a single season (1,017). She also played under head coach *Julie Darty Dennis* as a freshman and sophomore at Jacksonville (2016-17).

JULIE DARTY DENNIS

HEAD COACH THIRD SEASON AT MSU

On January 10, 2018, Julie Darty Dennis was officially introduced as the 12th head coach of Mississippi State volleyball. Since then, Darty Dennis has gone to work building her program into a competitor in the SEC.

Her 2020 signing class marks her newest achievement. In a group that includes nine total newcomers, Darty Dennis's five-player freshmen class earned the distinction of high honorable mention from PrepVolleyball.com. Four transfer student-athletes also joined the mix. The 2020 freshman group includes state champions, All-Americans and a laundry list of individual awards.

Darty Dennis's talented group of newcomers adds to a strong base. In her second season as State's head coach in 2019, Darty Dennis lead her club to an 11-1 start, tied for the best 12-match start in program history (2000, 1992). State added a season sweep of Auburn during conference play, and took three conference opponents to five sets.

Part of the team's success in 2019 came from anchoring performances from seniors Alleah Stamatis and Amarrah Cooks, two student-athletes that had played under Darty Dennis at her previous post at Jacksonville. After they earned all-conference honors as sophomores in Jacksonville, Darty Dennis helped prepare the duo for life in the SEC, where they developed into two of the best Bulldogs to play their respective positions. As a senior, Stamatis became just the seventh State setter to collect 1,000 assists in a season. Cooks, a middle blocker, led all qualified attackers in hitting percentage both seasons in maroon and white on her way to setting the Bulldog career record for the category (.303).

Darty Dennis's ability to recruit and develop also showed through in firstyear outside hitter Callie Minshew, a two-time Mississippi Gatorade Player of the Year in high school. Minshew started all 30 matches and was one of two student-athletes to play all 114 sets for State in 2019. The rookie from Brandon, Mississippi, led all SEC freshmen in digs (268) and tied for No. 2 among conference rookies in service aces (29).

In 2018, Darty Dennis helped lead standout middle blocker Deja Robinson to SEC All-Freshman Team honors as well as SEC Freshman of the Week honors. Robinson found herself in Mississippi State's freshman record book with 94 total blocks (No. 3), 70 block assists, for the sixth-place spot and 24 solo blocks (No. 6). In 2019, Robinson ranked tied for fifth in the league in blocks, averaging one per set.

Darty Dennis's first SEC win came in dramatic fashion, as her team fought back from trailing 2-0 to win in five sets against Auburn.

Prior to her arrival in Starkville, Darty Dennis turned Jacksonville into one of the Atlantic Sun's top programs. The 2013 and 2014 AVCA "Thirty under 30" award winner, she led the Dolphins to the 2014 Atlantic Sun Tournament championship and an NCAA tournament appearance during her first year as a collegiate head coach.

During her Jacksonville tenure (2014-17), Darty Dennis coached 11 All-Atlantic Sun honorees, including five first-team selections, alongside five ASUN All-Tournament selections and three ASUN All-Academic Team members. In her final season in Jacksonville, she guided the Dolphins to an 18-10 overall record and a 9-2 home mark, while overcoming adversity left in the wake of Hurricane Irma. Jacksonville's Swisher Gymnasium was unplayable for much of the season, and the Dolphins were forced to practice and play in several area gymnasiums.

The Dolphins also finished the season with a 12-2 mark against ASUN Conference opponents to earn the No. 2 seed in the league tournament. It was

the first time since the 2013 season that Jacksonville posted 10 or more wins in the ASUN and received higher than the third seed in the ASUN tournament. Six Dolphins earned All-ASUN accolades and Mackenzie Swan was the second player under Darty Dennis's leadership to earn ASUN Defensive Player of the Year accolades.

Darty Dennis posted 58 career wins in four seasons, and she earned her 50th career victory in 2017 - a 3-1 victory over Kennesaw State. Other notable victories during her tenure included a 3-1 triumph over Lipscomb, which crowned the Dolphins the 2014 ASUN Tournament Champions; a 3-2 defeat win Stephen F. Austin in 2015; a 3-0 sweep of Presbyterian in 2016; and a 3-2 conquest over Bethune-Cookman in 2017 to push JU to 51-0 all-time against the Wildcats.

In 2017, Darty Dennis's squad ranked first in overall digs in the Atlantic Sun with 1,846. Jacksonville finished 38th in the NCAA and first in the conference with 16.94 digs per set. The Dolphins also finished third in the ASUN with 1,425 team kills and 211.5 total blocks.

In January 2017, Darty Dennis also took on the role of director of volleyball over the university's beach program. Under Darty Dennis's tutelage, the team captured back-to-back appearances in the ASUN Championship (2015-16), and the 2016 season also saw the Dolphins sweep South Carolina in the Gamecock Invitational.

In her first season with the Dolphins and her first year as a head coach, Darty Dennis led the indoor program to its third conference tournament championship. Jacksonville won four of its final five ASUN matches to earn the No. 3 seed in the league tournament. Defeating each opponent, 3-1, the Dolphins were crowned the 2014 ASUN Champions, earning an automatic berth to the NCAA tournament.

Year two saw an improved win mark in league play (8-6) and several league distinctions including All-Atlantic Sun Defensive Player of the Year, two All-Atlantic Sun First Team honors, an Academic All-Conference honor, and an All-Atlantic Sun Tournament honor.

Before Jacksonville, Darty Dennis spent two seasons at the University of South Carolina (2012-13) where she was the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Gamecocks. After the 2012 season, she was named to the AVCA's "Thirty Under 30" list as one of the rising stars in the coaching world. In her time in Columbia, the Gamecocks won 30 games and posted just their second winning record in a decade during the 2012 season.

Prior to South Carolina, Darty Dennis spent a pair of seasons at Villanova University, where the Wildcats posted back-to-back top-four finishes in the 15-team Big East in the 2010 and 2011 seasons. She got her start as an assistant coach at Lake Mary (Fla.) High School. At the same time, she helped with two club teams in the Orlando area.

As a student-athlete, Darty Dennis was a standout at Mercer University from 2004-07. In all four seasons, she led the Bears in kills per set. As a sophomore in 2005, she compiled a team-best .277 attacking percentage. In the Mercer record book, Darty Dennis currently holds the second-place spot in career kills (1,264) and career kills per set (3.18), while having the third-most career total attacks (3,376) and the fourth-most blocking assists in a single season (92 in 2006). In 2004, Darty Dennis earned A-Sun All-Freshman honors.

Darty Dennis graduated from Mercer with a degree in communications. She married Bryan Dennis in May 2020, and the couple lives in Starkville.
